**Miami Continues Road Swing at Boston College and Maryland...**

Miami continues its four-match road stretch this weekend traveling to Boston (Oct. 16) and Maryland (Oct. 18) to close-out the northern road swing. The Hurricanes collected a 1-1 record last weekend with a win at Wake Forest, and tough defeat a night later at Duke. UM has now split an even 3-3 in its last six conference matches, including a thrilling 3-2 win over Georgia Tech just under two weeks ago.

As a team, UM is currently fifth in the league in kills and assists, while sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico leads the league in kills (280 / 4.31 kps). Additionally, Carico is ranked 22nd nationally in kills. Senior libero Cassie Loessberg tops the ACC in digs (353 / 4.53 dps) while also sitting 12th in the nation for digs. As a team, the 'Canes are atop the league in digs. UM holds 1,016 total digs (15.63 dps).

Last week against Wake Forest, Carico became the first player this season in the league to post a 20-20 match with 22 kills and 22 digs in the 3-1 win over the Demon Deacons in Winston-

Salem, N.C. This came just a days after Carico was announced as last week's ACC and CVU.com Player of the Week.

Miami is also putting down blocks well with the help of sophomore Ali Becker and junior Lici McGee. Together, they have been vital for the Hurricanes up front, leading them to a third place mark in the league for blocks (158 total / 2.44 bps) as a team, and ranking 44th nationally.

Quick Hits on Boston College...

Boston College comes into the weekend sporting an 11-7 overall record, and a mark of 1-6 in the ACC. In their lone conference win of the year, the Eagles took down NC State, 3-0, back on Oct. 3. Boston College opened the year winning 10 of its first 11 matches, including a 10-match winning streak from Aug. 29 through Sept. 19.

The Eagles are led by Mollie Kolosky with 240 kills, while teammates Taylor Williams (192) and Jordan Meredith (158) are also over the 150-kill plateau. The setter for the Eagles is Krissy Mussenden, leading the squad with 659 assists. Brennan Clark leads the squad in digs with 317 digs and Kristen Baader has 172.

Series Against Boston College...

Against Boston College, the Hurricanes of Miami own an all-time record of 8-2. UM has won the last three meetings, including 3-0 scores in each match. The last BC win was a 3-0 count back on Oct. 12, 2007.

Quick Hits on Maryland...

The University of Maryland comes into the weekend holding an even 10-10 record while being 2-5 in the ACC. The Terps use Maddi Lee for kills, leading the team with 210 (2.84 kps) and 22 total blocks. Behind her is Katie Usher with 194 kills and 64 total blocks (53 assists).

The setter for the Terrapins is Taylor Jones with a team-best 548 assists, and teammate Sharon Strizak has 219 assists to her credit—second on the squad in that category. Digs are accumulated by libero Sam Rosaio with a team-leading 303, as well as Brittney Grove with 183.

Series Against Maryland...

The University of Maryland leads the all-time series against Miami with a 7-4 count. However, UM swept the Terps last year for the first time in history, but the Terps had previously taken three in a row prior to the 2009 season sweep for the 'Canes.

Life in the Fast Lane...

Miami sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico recorded 22 kills and 22 digs in a 3-1 win over Wake Forest (Oct. 8), the first 20-20 performance in the ACC this season. Additionally, she recorded another double-double with 15 kills and 13 digs in a 3-0 loss to Duke (Oct. 10) to run her streak to seven straight matches with a double-double. Overall, Carico has a league-leading nine double-doubles.

Fast Noting the 'Canes...

The Hurricanes have out-hit their opponents in nine of their 10 wins in 2009. Junior setter Katie Gallagher (299) is one set assists away from making Miami the third league team to have two players post at least 300 assists this season.

Carico Sets School Records...

Sophomore Lane Carico shattered two school records in two matches for the Hurricanes just under two weeks ago. She eclipsed the UM school record for kills in a match with 36 coming against Clemson on Oct. 2. Carico bested the old mark of 31 previously set by Karla Johnson (vs. Wake Forest – 10/22/05). She also set a new record at UM for points in a match, posting 37.5 against Clemson, adding a service ace and a block assists to go along with her 36 kills.

Carico would also break the school record for attacks

# Nicole Lantagne Welch

**Head Coach**  
**Ninth Year at Miami**  
**Maryland, 1994**  
**Record at Miami: 161-94**  
**Overall Record: Same**



This season marks Nicole Lantagne Welch's ninth year at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in six

of the last eight seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

Last season, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.



Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by three seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her eight years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 18.9 wins per seasons with a career record of 151-87.

While new records were set during the 2007 campaign, the 2008 season saw even those records fall as Lantagne Welch and her staff assembled one of the best records in school history. Lantagne Welch led Miami to its best ACC record in school history. It was also the second-best record in school history on the Division I level of athletics.

Katie Gallagher moved in sole possession of second place all-time at UM for assists in a career during the 2008 season, while Cassie Loessberg placed herself in second place for digs in a career. In addition, Loessberg broke her own school record from a year ago for digs in a single-season, upping the new record to 554—besting her old school-record mark by two.

As for Gallagher, she etched her name once again as one of the Top 10 single-season assists leaders in school history. Already sitting at third place in school history from the 2007 season where she collected 1,243 assists, Gallagher added to that total with 1,202 in 2008—good enough for sixth place all-time in school history.

Freshman Lane Carico broke the freshman record for kills in a single-season for UM with 369, adding her name to 10th all-time for single-season kills. Meanwhile, Miami tied a school-record for hitting percentage in a five-set match, collecting a .329 percentage at Florida State on Nov. 26, 2008. The 'Canes would also collect the second-best single-set hitting mark in school history with a .615 clip against Boston College in the third set on Oct. 10, 2008.

Lantagne Welch would see two more student-athletes graduate following the 2008 season. Angelica Ellis and Bridget Bomhack both earned their Bachelor's Degree, while Ashley Woods completed her Master's Degree.

Woods placed her name eighth all-time in sets played (367), as well as eighth place all-time in total attacks (1,764). Ellis now ranks ninth in attacks (1,209), while also collecting the third-highest individual single-season hitting percentage (.350) from the 2008 campaign. Overall, Ellis is third in school history in career hitting percentage with a .275 clip through 318 sets and 1,209 attacks. Woods is tied for fifth in career hitting percentage, holding a .256 clip, sitting alongside Ciara Michel (2004-07).

The eighth-year head coach also coached three All-ACC Second Team members with

Lane Carico, Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. In addition, Carico and Ellis were each named as AVCA All-America honorable mention, while Carico was selected the 2008 AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico was also the true definition of "student-athlete" as she was named to the All-ACC Academic Team.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

**Hurricanes VB Media Policy**

**KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX**

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

**MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES**

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

**MEDIA SERVICES**

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

**WEBSITES**

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

Last Time Out - vs. Duke (10/9/09)...

Duke's Rachael Moss stamped 19 kills and Becci Burling supplied another 14 to lead homestanding Duke University past the University of Miami, 3-0 (25-22, 25-17, 25-23) in an ACC volleyball matchup Friday evening at Cameron Indoor Stadium in Durham, N.C.

Miami (10-7, 3-4 ACC) kept the first set close in a frame that saw six ties and three lead changes in its attempt to unseat Duke (16-2, 6-0 ACC) of the final remaining title of ACC-unbeaten. With the Hurricanes trailing, 11-10, following a kill from sophomore Ali Becker, the Blue Devils used a 7-2 momentum swing with kills from Moss and Burling to leap out to a sizeable 18-12 advantage.

UM tied the set late, 21-21, on the strength of blocks by Lane Carico, Lici McGee and Nrithya Sundararaman, as well as a kill from Christine Williamson. Three Duke attack errors were also big for the 'Canes in the comeback attempt. But Duke's Kellie Catanach connected for a kill on an over attempt by Miami to give the Blue Devils the opening set, 25-22.

The Blue Devils ran out to a quick 6-0 margin in the second set, increasing their lead to as large as 12-1 with Nailah Waterfield's service ace. Miami got two kills from Ariell Cooke and McGee to close to within 20-14, but it was as close as the Hurricanes would come. Amanda Robertson and Sophia Dunworth each posted kills down the stretch to help the Blue Devils with the 25-17 win, staking a 2-0 lead in the match.

In the third set, UM fought toe-to-toe with Duke as the set managed six ties—the second time a set saw as many ties on the evening.

With the set tied at 21-all, Burling placed a kill and Moss another to give the Blue Devils a 23-21 edge. The 'Canes came back behind a Duke attack error, followed by a kill from Williamson, to cut the lead at 24-23. But Moss' placement on shots was too good tonight as she posted her 19th kill for the match-winner, 25-23, in the third frame.

Duke was led on the night by Moss' 19-kill, 12-dig

performance, as well as Burling with 14 kills and four blocks (two solo). Setter Catanach handed out 39 assists and libero Claire Smalzer grabbed in a match-high 20 digs.

Miami was led by Carico's 15 kills and 13 digs, continuing her double-double streak to seven consecutive matches in a losing effort. It was her ninth double-double of the year, appropriately.

Williamson continues to swing a hot hand collecting eight kills, while McGee added six kills and four blocks (assisted). Sundararaman had 29 assists and three blocks, and libero Cassie Loessberg pitched in on defense with a team-high 15 digs.
