QUICK HITS

- Coppin State is in the midst of an 8-game road trip and heads down South to face the Miami Hurricanes on December 21 at 2 pm. The game will be televised on the ACC Network.

- Miami owns a 2-0 series lead with the two previous meetings coming in 1987 and 1988.

- CSU is coming off losses at Davidson and UMBC but recently showcased an 85-75 win at East Carolina which was Coppin's first win over a BCS Opponent since it beat Oregon State on November 10, 2013. Five Eagles finished in double figures against the Pirates, led by **Koby Thomas'** 19 points and eight rebounds. **Kamar McKnight**, the Robinson twins and **Ibn Williams** all had 10+ pts.

- Coppin won back-to-back games with victories over Cornell on November 23 and at James Madison on November 26. At James Madison, five Eagles finished in double figures. The Robinson twins combined for 38 points and ten 3-pointers. **Aaron Robinson** had a career-high 20 points and 6 3-pointers while **Andrew Robinson** notched his first career double-double, setting career-highs in points (18) and rebounds (11). His three assists was also a career-high.

- CSU picked up its second win of the season with a 68-66 overtime victory over Cornell at the PEC. It was the first time since the 2013-14 season that the Eagles won multiple non-conference

games in a season. **Kamar McKnight** finished with a team-high 22 points, leading three Eagles in double figures against the Big Red. **Koby Thomas** recorded a season-high 19 points and **Andrew Robinson** added 15 points.

- **Dejuan Clayton** became the 23rd Eagles player to record 1,000 career points with a 21 point effort last game at Pacific on November 19.

- In Coppin's historic upset win at Loyola Chicago, **Dejuan Clayton** scored 21 points and made a career-high 12-of-14 free throws. **Kamar McKnight** and **Andrew Robinson** combined for 27 points. CSU made 9-of-10 free throws in the final 32 seconds to seal the win.

- 45.8 Percent of Coppin's shot attempts have come from long range this season. Coppin has made 37.4% of its 3-pointers in wins and just 24.3% in losses.

- CSU has also been outrebounded by an average of 9.0 boards per game in its eight losses. In its four wins, that margin is just 2.5 rebounds.

- A First Team Preseason All-MEAC selection, Clayton was a Second Team All-MEAC selection after the 2018-19 season after leading the Eagles with 14.5 points per game, 119 assists and 28 steals while making 134-of-179 (74.9%) free throws.

HEAD COACH JUAN DIXON



Coppin State University Director of Athletics Derek Carter announced on Wednesday, April 26, 2017 that Juan Dixon had been named the seventh head coach in Coppin State University men's basketball history.

In his first two seasons at the helm of the Eagles program, Dixon has helped two players receive All-MEAC accolades (Lamar Morgan Third Team in 2017-18 & Dejuan Clayton Second Team in 2018-19). This past season, the Eagles swept the regular season series with Morgan State and also defeated the Bears in the 1st Round of the MEAC Tournament before falling in overtime to North Carolina A&T. Following the 2018-19 season, Morgan (Portugal) and Cedric Council (Georgia), both of whom Dixon brought to Coppin prior to his first year,

signed professional contracts overseas.

Dixon returned to his hometown of Baltimore from the University of the District of Columbia, where he posted a 3-25 record in his only season with the Firebirds women's basketball team in 2016-17.

Prior to UDC, Dixon served as the Special Assistant to the Head Coach on the Men's Basketball coaching staff at his alma mater, University of Maryland. There he supported 2015 Big 10 Conference Coach of the Year, Mark Turgeon, by enhancing game plans and strategizing how to attack opponents offensively and defensively. He helped implement offensive sets and defensive principles, analyzed and broke down film, and mentored, motivated, counseled and developed student-athletes, including future NBA players Alex Len, Diamond Stone, Jake Layman and Robert Carter, Jr.

Dixon also coached DMV's Finest and Team Maryland during The Basketball Tournament (TBT) in Philadelphia, PA, and directs his own Juan Dixon Basketball Camp and Premier Basketball Camp, both in Baltimore, MD.

One of the most celebrated student-athletes in Maryland history, Dixon remains the all-time leading scorer in program history (2,269 points) after leading the Terrapins to their first national title in 2002 as a senior. He holds six different records in program history, ranging from points, games played, steals and 3-pointers.

The Most Outstanding Player of the 2002 NCAA Final Four and ACC Player of the Year, Dixon earned two All-America selections, three First Team All-ACC selections and two All-ACC Tournament selections throughout his illustrious career. He averaged 16.1 points, 4.2 rebounds, 2.6 assists, and 2.4 steals in 141 games from 1998-2002.

Dixon was drafted with the 17th pick of the 2002 NBA draft by the Washington Wizards, where he spent three seasons. He signed with the Portland Trail Blazers in 2005, and he averaged a career-high 12.3 points during his first season with the team. After stops in Toronto and Detroit, Dixon wrapped up his nine-year NBA career with the Wizards in 2008-09.

Throughout his NBA career, Dixon played under Hall of Fame Player Doug Collins and Patrick Ewing (Wizards), Monty Williams and Nate McMillan (Trail Blazers), 2007 NBA Coach of the Year Sam Mitchell (Toronto Raptors), Flip Saunders (Detroit Pistons), and Eddie Jordan (Wizards). He also played alongside the following: Charles Oakley, Jerry Stackhouse, Gilbert Arenas, Antawn Jamison, Christian Laettner, Tyronn Lue, (former Maryland backcourt-mate) Steve Blake, Zach Randolph, Theo Ratliff, Chris Bosh, TJ Ford, José Calderón, Chauncey Billups, Richard Hamilton, Rasheed Wallace, Antonio McDyess and Caron Butler. During his first stint with the Wizards, he was also teammates with and mentored by NBA legend Michael Jordan.

Dixon, a graduate of Calvert Hall College High School in Towson, MD, earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Family Science in 2013 from the University of Maryland. During his student-athlete career at Maryland he earned numerous distinctions including: NCAA Senior CLASS Award (2002), Chip Hilton Award (2002), ESPN Shooting Guard of the Year (2002), Wooden Player of the Year Award candidate (2002), Third Team NABC All-American (2001) and Third Team USBWA All-American (2001). He was inducted into the University of Maryland Athletics Hall of Fame in October 2012, and he was selected as one of 75 All-Time March Madness Players in 2012.

Inside CSU's Victory at Loyola Chicago

Coppin State's victory at Loyola Chicago on November 12, 2019 was the Eagles' first victory over a non-MEAC Division I team since they defeated UMBC on December 11, 2013.

It was CSU's first road victory against a non-MEAC Division I team since beating Towson on December 19, 2012.

Not Just the Other Juan Anymore

When talking about Coppin State basketball today, most will think immediately of its head coach Juan Dixon. Redshirt junior Dejuan Clayton is making people rethink that as he was a Second Team All-MEAC selection last season and was named a Preseason First Team All-MEAC honoree in October. Clayton led the Eagles with 14.5 points per game, 119 assists and 28 steals while making 134-of-179 (74.9%) free throws last season. In conference action, Clayton put up 17.3 points to go with 3.0 rebounds and 72 assists.

Clayton is rapidly climbing the CSU record books and became the 23rd Eagles player to score 1,000 career points with a 21 point effort at Pacific. Clayton came into the season with 908 points and now has 1,056 in his career.

Mighty (Kamar) McKnight

Redshirt Kamar McKnight adds another go-to scorer for the Eagles after spending the last two seasons at Tennessee State and scoring nearly 600 points with over 60 3-pointers and 118 free throws. Through 12 games this season, McKnight has averaged a team-high 15.8 points, including a team-high 24 points and a career-high nine free throws in the season-opener against Rider. He also led the Eagles with 22 points in an overtime win over Cornell.

Road Warriors (15,898 Miles)

Coppin will embark on two long road trips during the non-conference portion of its schedule with a five-game road trip over 11 days in November. After hosting Cornell on November 23, the Eagles will go on an eight-game road trip that will go from November 26 to December 30.

With trips ranging from Virginia Tech to the Chicago area (Loyola Chicago/Northern Illinois) to Cincinnati (Northern Kentucky) and Sacramento (Pacific) in early-mid November, the Eagles will travel approximately 6,742 miles including the return trip back to Baltimore.

CSU will make trips totaling 9,156 miles over their eight-game road trip before MEAC play, accumulating nearly 16,000 miles (15,898) during their two extended road trips.

Opening the Season at Home

For the first time since the 2000-01 season, Coppin State opened the season against a Division I team at home when they faced Rider on November 5, 2019. It was also the first time since 2011-12 season they opened the season at the PEC against any opponent.

In its heyday during the 1990s, Coppin's roster boasted a large amount of players from the City of Brotherly Love. During Juan Dixon's first two years, he brought in Karonn Davis and Chad Andrews-Fulton from Philly, and this season he welcomes junior Koby Thomas, a Philadelphia native who is transferring in from Robert Morris. After leading Imhotep Charter to a Public League Championship, Thomas was the 2017-18 NEC Rookie of the Year, averaging 12.0 points and a team-high 6.9 rebounds. Last season, Thomas put up 7.3 points and 4.8 rebounds in 20 games.

International Flavor

Coppin's roster consists of three international players with Kamar McKnight (Canada), Giir Ring (Australia) and Kenan Sarvan (Netherlands), matching Howard and Maryland Eastern Shore with the most international players in the MEAC. There are 16 international players on MEAC rosters this season.

Back for Another Round

Outside of Dejuan Clayton, also returning to the Eagles are junior Jordan Hardwick and sophomores Nigel Marshall, Brendan Medley-Bacon, Giir Ring and Ibn Williams. With just six players back from last season, Coppin returns just 35.6% of its points and 23.0% of its rebounds. At just 6-foot-2, Clayton is the leading returning rebounder on the team at 2.9 rebounds per game which was the 7th-most on the team last year.

Hardwick Remains

Only junior Jordan Hardwick remains from Dixon's first recruiting class at Coppin which saw five players finish their eligibility last season. After flashing as a freshman with an 8-point, 11 rebound, 5 block performance at Hampton as a freshman, Hardwick missed most of last season and appeared in just three games. Hardwick came up big in Coppin's victory at Loyola Chicago, matching a career-high with eight points and pulling down ten rebounds.

Sophomore Backcourt Duo Reunited

Best friends since they were in grade school and playing AAU, sophomores Nigel Marshall and Ibn Williams played three seasons together at St. Anthony's (N.J.) before transferring together to Bishop McNamara HS just outside of Washington, D.C., for their senior seasons. The duo both signed with Coppin prior to last year and combined for 7.2 points, 3.1 rebounds and 48 assists last season. Marshall showed flashes of greatness last season, scoring in double figures four times with a season-high 13 at Wofford. Williams came on strong towards the end of the season which included a season-high 12 points and 3 steals versus Howard.

Big Man on Campus

Baltimore native Brendan Medley-Bacon became just the third 7-footer in CSU history last season and the first since the 2004-05 season. As a freshman, Medley-Bacon put up 2.4 points and 2.8 rebounds with 16 blocked shots. Medley-Bacon had his best game at North Carolina Central where he went for a season-high 11 points and 7 rebounds. He blocked 4 shots in games at Navy and also against South Carolina State.

Do You Come from a Land Down Under?

One of three international players on the roster, sophomore Giir Ring grew up in Sydney, Australia and played prep school ball at Bella Vista College Prep in Scottsdale, Ariz. The cousin of former NBA All-Star Luol Deng, Ring averaged 1.8 points and 0.9 rebounds as a freshman in 2018-19 and had his best game in a win over Bethune-Cookman with six points and three rebounds.

To Be Enshrined

During Homecoming Weekend on February 22, 2020, former men's basketball player Stephen Stewart, as well as the 1975-76 Men's Basketball Team will be inducted into the CSU Athletics Hall of Fame. Also going in are Rashida Suber (women's basketball), Gary Robertson (women's basketball coach) and Brian Pisani (baseball).

A 2011 MEAC Hall of Fame inductee, Stewart was named the MEAC Player of the Year in back-to-back seasons (1993-94 & 1994-95) after being named the 1992-93 MEAC Rookie of the Year and MEAC Tournament MVP. In his third and final season at Coppin, Stewart scored 19 points in the NIT against Saint Joseph's which was CSU's first-ever postseason victory. Stewart was a 1994-95 Black College Sports First Team All-American and went on to play professionally in Europe and Australia. Despite playing just three seasons at Coppin, Stewart ranks 8th in school-history in points (1,393), 9th in rebounds and 3rd in free throws. Stewart's teams went 47-1 in MEAC play, 65-26 overall and 30-1 at home. Stewart is currently an assistant at Delaware State, who the Eagles will play for Homecoming.

Finishing with a 39-2 record, the 1975-76 men's basketball team won the NAIA National Championship which is the school's only National Title. After winning the Potomac Intercollegiate Conference Championship, Coppin was awarded the ninth seed in the NAIA Tournament and won five games in six days, defeating Dowling (N.Y.), Wisconsin-Parkside, Texas Southern, Marymount and Henderson State (Ark.). CSU Hall of Famer Joe Pace was named the NAIA Tournament Most Valuable Player and scored 43 points in the Championship Game victory over Henderson State which ended in a 96-91 score.
