**No. 21 Hurricanes Travel Back on the Road for North Carolina Swing...**

The 21st-ranked University of Miami volleyball team gets back to the road this weekend with a tough road stretch at NC State (Oct. 7) and UNC (Oct. 9). The Canes enter the weekend working on a four-match win streak and have won four-of-five true road matches this year.

Miami (13-1, 4-1 Atlantic Coast Conference) has the third best hitting percentage in the league right now, sporting a .272 clip while holding opponents under the .200 percent mark.

Behind the setter duties of redshirt senior Katie Gallagher (Winter Park, Fla.), the Canes have the second-most assists per set (13.33) in the conference. Gallagher is tied for first with 11.00 assists per set.

Miami is also atop the league in digs per set (18.89), second in kills (14.59 per set) and third in service aces (1.24 per set).

Senior All-America outside hitter Lane Carico (Manhattan Beach, Calif.) is ranked in the league's Top 10 for several statistical categories, including fourth kills (3.39 k/s), fifth in service aces (0.32 sa/s) and sixth in digs (4.23 d/s). She is also sixth in points with 172 total.

This weekend's road trip serves as the fourth and fifth road matches in the last seven for the Canes. On the season, UMIAMI has played just five of its 15 matches inside the friendly confines of the James L. Knight Sports Complex.

**Scouting NC State...**

The Wolfpack of NC State are led by senior outside hitter Margaret Salata in kills this season with 191 (3/13 per set). Junior setter Megan Cyr leads the team with 686 assists. On defense, senior Kelly Wood paces the Wolfpack in digs with 249 on the campaign, and it's Salata leading the squad in blocks (75).

The Wolfpack are 14-4 overall on the year and just 2-4 in the ACC. They enter the weekend with a two-match losing skid after tough decisions to Clemson and UNC, respectively.

**Series against the Wolfpack...**

Miami leads the all-time series against the Wolfpack with a commanding 12-1 edge. The Wolfpack took their first win against the Hurricanes last season on the heels of a 3-0 decision in Raleigh, N.C. In the 13 matches played between the two schools, only six of them were not sweeps. All others were won by 3-1 decisions.

**Scouting North Carolina...**

Sitting at a perfect 5-0 in the ACC, the University of North Carolina rides into the weekend with a seven-match win streak firmly intact. On the year, the Tar Heels hold a record of 13-3.

UNC's offense continues to roll, ranking amongst the best on the country. UNC is second in the nation and leads the ACC in assists per set at a 13.78 clip. Carolina also tops the conference in kills per set (14.80) and ranks third nationally. The Tar Heels are seventh in the country and second in the league in hitting percentage with a .279 attack efficiency.

Four Tar heels have tallied 100 or more kills on a .235 attack percentage or better: Emily McGee (216/.293), Kayla Berringer (147/.238), Tia Gaffen (135/.358) and Chaniel Nelson (131/.249). Erica Behm has 403 assists this season and an 8.06 assist per set average. On defense, the Tar Heels are led by Kaylie Gibson in digs with 208 and Chaniel Nelson with 55 blocks.

**Series against the Tar Heels...**

In a series that has determined ACC regular season standings the last three years, UNC and UM are tied at 9-all. UNC has won three of the last five against the Canes, while it was UM earning the last win on a 3-1 count in Coral Gables a season ago. The two teams split the yearly series last year.

**Lane Carico Earns Third ACC Weekly Honor...**

For the third time this year, Lane Carico picked up ACC Player of the Week honors after a stellar performance against Wake Forest and Duke last weekend.

Carico helped Miami extend its winning streak to four matches and its home court winning streak to 10 straight as she registered 5.50 kills per set and 3.67 digs per set in wins over Wake Forest and Duke, respectively. The native of Manhattan Beach, Calif. hit .389 over the weekend and put down a team-high 33 kills against just five errors on 72 swings for the Canes.

She helped Miami sweep Duke and break a three-match losing skid to the Blue Devils, recording the first win over Duke since a 3-0 decision in 2008. Additionally, Carico became the school's all-time leader in kills with 1,495, surpassing Karla Johnson for the top honor. In both matches on the weekend, Carico picked up double-doubles to extend her streak to four and increase her total to nine on the year.

# Nicole Lantagne Welch

**Head Coach**  
**11th Year at Miami**  
**Maryland, 1994**

Nicole Lantagne Welch is in her 11th season as head coach of the University of Miami volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in eight of the last 10 seasons,

including ending the 2010 campaign ranked No. 26 in the RPI polls and No. 28 in the Pablo rankings.

Last season, Lantagne Welch helped guide the Canes to their second 20-win season in the last three years, and the second consecutive year in which UMiami advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Miami ended the season with a 23-9 overall mark (13-7 Atlantic Coast Conference) and finished third in the conference regular season standings. Along the way, the Hurricanes defeated NCAA Tournament participants Florida State, Middle Tennessee State, Georgia Southern, Wichita State and North Carolina.

At the end of the year, Lantagne Welch saw her first-ever AVCA All-American honored in the form of Lane Carico, collecting third team accolades following a record-breaking year. Carico became the first player in school history with 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in a career, as well as leading the ACC in double-doubles – and later being the only player in the league to amass at least 400 kills and 400 digs on the campaign.

Carico and teammate Katie Gallagher each claimed AVCA All-East Region Team honors, while freshman libero Ryan Shaffer set a new school record for digs by a freshman (539 / 4.53 per set). As for Carico, she would also earn her



third consecutive All-ACC Team nod and All-East Region honor.

In 2009, Lantagne Welch helped the Hurricanes to their second NCAA Tournament appearance, competing in the Gainesville [Fla.] Regional. UM earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after holding the 33rd toughest schedule in the nation according to the end-of-year RPI rankings. Earlier in the season, Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to the Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic championship.

She would add to her growing list of All-Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes, as well as All-America honorable mention performers, seeing senior libero Cassie Loessberg and sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico named to both lists. Carico and Loessberg each collected AVCA All-America Honorable Mention selections, while both were tabbed to the AVCA All-East Region Team.

During the 2008 campaign, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by four seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08, '10) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her 10 years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 19.2 wins per seasons with a career record of 192-109.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a

major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Coral Gables.

## Hurricanes VB Media Policy

### KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, in-between the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Alex Rodriguez Park, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

### MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Office of Athletic Communications. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

### MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-set and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post match notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Athletic Communications Director Bryan J. Harvey.

### WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Office of Athletic Communications at (305) 284-3244.

### INTERVIEWS

With her next conference win, UMiami 11th-year head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will achieve her 100th career conference win – all at the helm of the Hurricanes program.

### **Hurricanes Cross the Hurdle...**

Though trailing the all-time series against Duke, 10-3, Miami was able to overpower the Blue Devils last weekend in Coral Gables. For the Canes, the win snapped a three-match skid against their nemesis from Durham.

### **Home Is Where the Heart Is...**

With two wins coming inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex last weekend against league foes Wake Forest and Duke, the University of Miami extended its home winning streak to 10 matches dating back to last year. The last home loss was a 3-2 decision against the Blue Devils of Duke on Oct. 22, 2010.

Since 2008, UMiami is 39-10 at home, including a 5-0 mark this year.

### **Coaching Milestone Achieved...**

UMiami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch collected her 200th career win following the Hurricanes 3-0 win over Auburn. Lantagne Welch is already the winningest coach in UM volleyball history, and has served as the only coach since the program was brought back in 2001.

Playing in its first match ever as a ranked team, Miami fell to homestanding Florida State in the league-opener for both teams Wednesday, Sept. 14 at Tully Gym in Tallahassee.

The Canes had their 14-match regular season winning streak snapped in front of a national television audience on ESPNU as part of the station's *Wednesday Night Volleyball* package.

### **Miami Takes Hurricane Invitational Title...**

With wins against FAMU, Auburn and nationally ranked Oklahoma, the Hurricanes collected their second consecutive Hurricane Invite title inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex. Overall, the Canes have won four of the last five Hurricane Invitational titles. The win over No. 18 Oklahoma was the first win for the Hurricanes over a ranked team since Dec.

The Manhattan Beach, Calif. native compiled 30 kills on a .258 hitting percentage for 3.75 kills per set and had 32 digs in eight sets. She also had five blocks and four service aces. Carico came up huge in the win over No. 18 Oklahoma with 19 kills and 16 digs to help pull off the come-from-behind upset. It was the first victory over a ranked opponent for the Hurricanes since December 7, 2002, when Miami beat No. 15 Wisconsin in the NCAA Tournament.

### Carico, Gallagher, Johnson All-Tournament...

Lane Carico, Katie Gallagher and Alex Johnson were all named to the Hurricane Invitational All-Tournament Team after helping UMIami to the tournament title. Carico picked up Hurricane Invitational MVP honors in staking a season-high 19 kills and posting 16 digs in the championship match win over the Sooners.

Carico has been named to the All-ACC Team the last two years and the All-ACC Freshman Team in 2008.

### Lowe's Senior CLASS Award...

Senior outside hitter Lane Carico is one of 30 women's volleyball student-athletes from around the nation to be named a candidate for the 2011 Lowe's Senior CLASS award.

To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition.

### Miami Predicted to Finish Fourth in ACC Preseason Poll...

The Canes have been predicted to finish fourth in the Preseason ACC Poll voted on by head coaches from around the league.

UMiami was predicted to finish fourth last

season before ending the year third in the final standings.

### Recapping the Last Match - vs. Duke (Oct. 2)...

With a match-high 14 kills, senior Lane Carico became the school's all-time leader in kills as the No. 20 Miami Hurricanes defeated the Duke Blue Devils, 3-0 [25-22, 26-24, 25-20], in ACC action Sunday inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex.

Carico, a 2010 All-America performer, broke a six-year old record with her fourth kill that allowed Miami to take a 7-4 lead in the set. The record, formerly held by Karla Johnson (2002-05), now stands at 1,495.

Miami snapped a three-match losing skid to the Blue Devils and pushed its home court winning streak to 10 matches dating back to last season.

The Hurricanes cruised to the win in the opening set before Duke battled to a 14-13 lead in the second set behind timely kills from Christiana Gray and setter Kellie Catanach. Catanach was able to keep Duke alive in the second frame by eying the UMiami defense and attacking instead of setting.

But the Canes used an Alex Johnson service ace and a kill from Christine Williamson to keep the Blue Devils at bay, 21-18. Moments later,

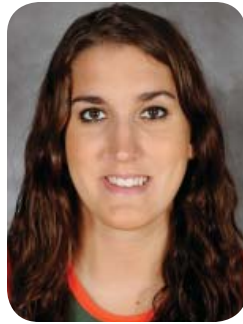

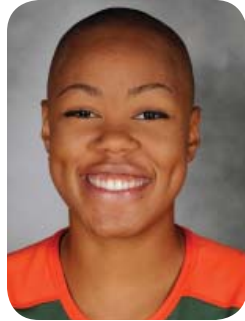
