TONIGHT'S GAME

The UConn men's basketball team finishes competition in the Charleston Classic by taking on the University of Miami in a battle for third place at TD Arena in Charleston, S.C. The game is scheduled for a 1 p.m. tipoff and will be televised on ESPN2.

The Huskies (3-2) are coming off a heartbreaking 75-74 loss in double overtime to nationally-ranked Xavier in the Classic semifinals on Friday. UConn has five double-figure scorers, led by senior Christian Vital (16.4), who also tops the team in rebounding (9.8), assists (3.8) and steals (3.6). Freshman James Bouknight (13.5), junior Josh Carlton (12.4), junior Tyler Polley (10.8) and redshirt junior Alterique Gilbert (10.8) are the others in double-figures.

Miami (4-2) also bowed in the semifinals Friday, falling to Florida, 78-58. The Hurricanes are led in scoring by Kameron McGusty (14.7) and Dejan Vasiljevic (14.3), while Rodney Miller is the top rebounder (6.5).

HUSKY BITES

⇒ **Coach Dan Hurley** is in his second season as the 19th head coach in the history of UConn men's basketball. Hurley owns a collegiate coaching record of 170-124 (.578) in nine-plus seasons -- two at Wagner College, six at the University of Rhode Island and one-plus at UConn. He has taken two teams to the NCAA Tournament and is a former Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year.

⇒ **UConn** and Miami met 22 times while both were members of the Big East Conference (1992-2004), with UConn holding a 14-8 edge. They met once before that, a 74-70 UConn win in the 1956 Orange Bowl Tournament in Miami, and have met once since, a 76-63 UConn win on a neutral court in the 2008 Paradise Jam at St. Thomas, U.S.V.I.

⇒ **UP NEXT:** UConn will take a week off before returning to action at home, playing host to longtime New England rival Maine on Sunday, Dec. 1, at the XL Center in Hartford. The game is set for a 1 p.m. tipoff and will be televised by SNY.

NOVEMBER TOURNAMENTS: UConn is participating in a November tournament for the 15th consecutive season, starting with 2005-06. In the previous 14 years, plus this season, the Huskies have an overall record of 26-13 (.667) in the bracketed portion of those tournaments, with five tournament championships -- the 2005 Maui Invitational, the 2006 Hispanic College Fund Classic, the 2008 Paradise Jam, the 2010 Maui Invitational and the 2013 2K Sports Classic.

NEUTRAL SITE GAMES: UConn will be playing its first three neutral site games of the season at the Charleston Classic. Over the last 10 years, plus this season, UConn has an overall record of 50-28 (.641) in neu-

tral site contests and over the last 25 years, plus this year, UConn's overall record in neutral-site games is 130-58 (.691). Under Coach Dan Hurley, UConn is 3-5 in neutral site games.

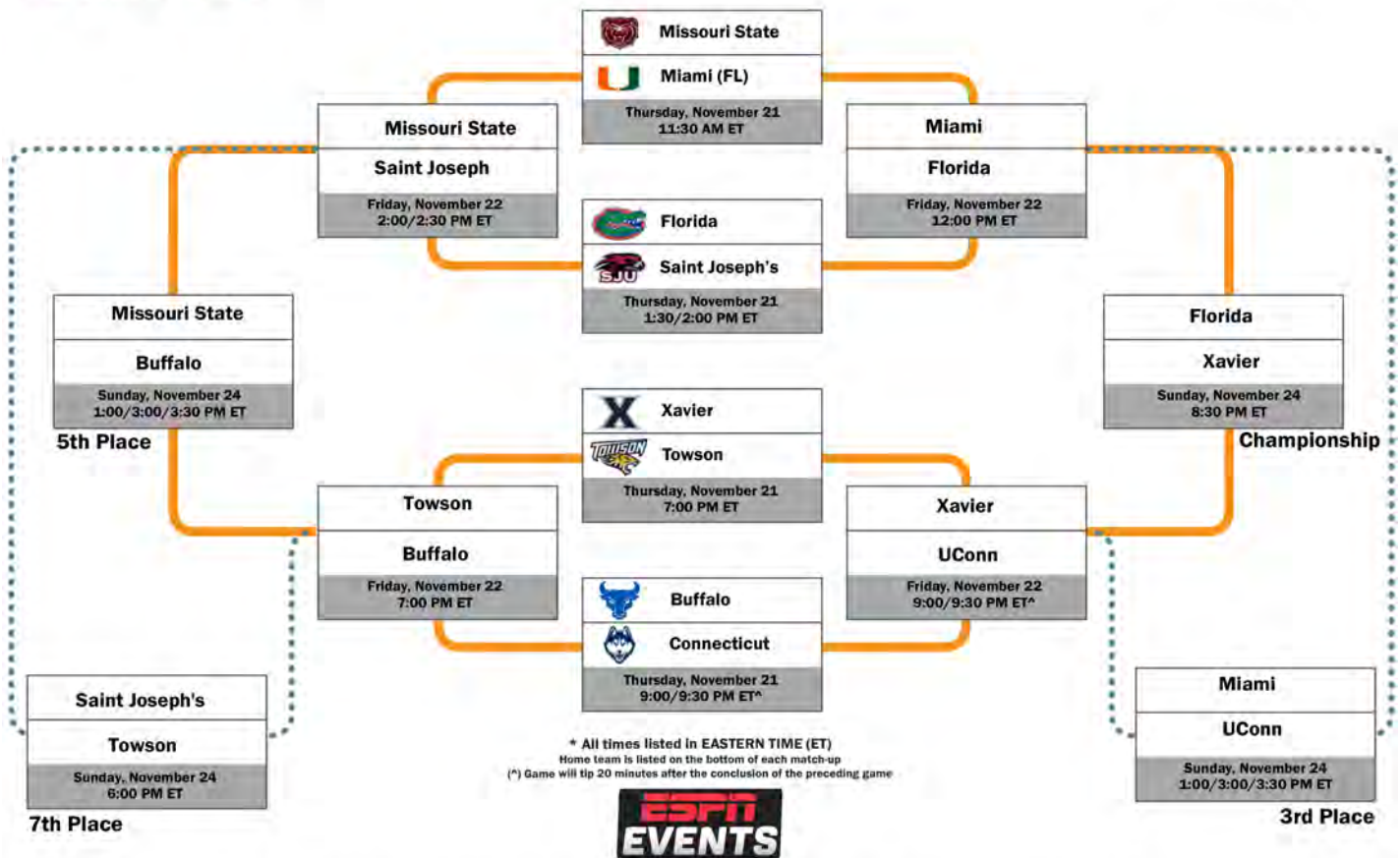
LAST TIME OUT: In perhaps a preview of Big East Conference games to come, UConn and #18/#21 Xavier staged a classic before the Huskies bowed, 75-74 in double overtime, UConn's first multi-overtime game since a Jan. 3, 2018, contest at Tulsa. The game came down to the final seconds of the second overtime as UConn freshman **James Bouknight** put the Huskies in front, 74-73, with a hard drive to the hoop with 0:20 to go. But with 0:10 left, Xavier's Jason Carter





2019 Charleston Classic

November 21, 22 & 24

The **2019 Charleston Classic** is celebrating its 12th season, starting in 2008, although this is **UConn's** first time at the event, as is the case with six of the eight teams in this season's tournament. Only Miami -- which has made two appearances, in 2009 and 2014, and won the tourney title both times -- and Saint Joseph's, which also appeared in 2011, have been previous participants. The remainder of this year's field -- **UConn**, Buffalo, Xavier, Towson, Florida and Missouri State are making their initial appearances.

The tournament consists of 12 games, held over a four-day period, with four games each on Nov. 21, 22 and 24. The venue for all games is the TD Arena (capacity: 5,100) in downtown Charleston, the in-season home of the College of Charleston Cougars.

After Friday's results, Miami and UConn will kick off the final

day of action Sunday, meeting at 1 p.m. (ESPN2) to determine the third- and fourth-place finishers.

On the consolation side of the bracket Sunday, Missouri State takes on Buffalo at 3:30 p.m. (ESPN2) to determine the fifth- and sixth-place finishers, while Saint Joseph's and Towson clash at 6 p.m. (ESPN2) to find out the seventh- and eighth-place finishers.

Finally, the Charleston Classic championship game between Florida and Xavier begins at 8:30 p.m. (ESPN).

Last year's winner of the Classic was Virginia Tech, which defeated runner-up Purdue, 89-83. Previous Charleston Classic champions include Clemson (2008), Miami (2009), Georgetown (2010), Northwestern (2011), Colorado (2012), Massachusetts (2013), Miami (2014), Virginia (2015), Villanova (2016), and Temple (2017).

hit two free throws to give the Musketeers the lead and UConn could not find the basket with a final attempt. Bouknight had a career-high 19 points to lead the Huskies, while redshirt junior **Alterique Gilbert** had 14, including 9-of-9 from the foul line. Juniors **Tyler Polley** and **Josh Carlton** added 10 points apiece, while senior **Christian Vital** pulled down 12 rebounds.

FIRST-ROUND WIN: In a fast-paced, up-and-down battle, **UConn** used an 11-2 run in the opening minutes of the second half to take a lead it would never relinquish as the Huskies outlasted Buffalo, 79-68, in the first round of the Charleston Classic on Nov. 21 at TD Arena. UConn got a huge contribution off the bench from sophomore **Brendan Adams**, who had a career-high 20 points, while senior

Christian Vital (16 points, 10 reb) and junior **Josh Carlton** (12 points, 10 reb, 4 blocks) each had a double-double. Redshirt freshman **Akok Akok** added a career-high 11 points and 5 rebounds, while freshman **James Bouknight** made his season debut with 8 points and 6 rebounds in 11 minutes.

TOP 25 VICTORY: **UConn** recorded its second win over a ranked team in two years and its first win at home over a ranked team in four years when it upended #15 Florida, 62-59, on Nov. 17 at Gampel Pavilion. The Huskies took the lead in the closing minutes of the first half and turned back numerous challenges from the Gators throughout the second half to thrill the sellout crowd. UConn held a one-point lead with 2:43 remaining and never gave it up, clinch-



ing the win when senior **Christian Vital** stole the ball on Florida's final possession. Vital and junior **Tyler Polley** led UConn with 15 points apiece, while junior **Josh Carlton** added 13 points and 8 rebounds. Redshirt junior **Alterique Gilbert** had 10 points and 4 assists, while redshirt freshman **Akok Akok** snagged 8 boards and blocked 2 shots.

CONFERENCE HONORS: For the second consecutive week, UConn senior **Christian Vital** was named to the **American Athletic Conference Weekly Honor Roll** on Nov. 18 after he averaged a double-double (20.5 pts, 10.0 reb) in games against St. Joseph's and Florida.

NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: Over the last seven seasons plus this year, UConn owns an overall record of 63-30 (.677) in regular-season, non-conference games and a home record of 45-9 (.833) in regular-season, non-conference games.

AT HOME AT MSG: When UConn appears in the Jimmy V Classic against Indiana, it will mark the fifth consecutive season and the sixth season out of the last seven that the Huskies have played in **Madison Square Garden**, since the breakup of the Big East in 2013-14. It will also be UConn's 120th game at MSG, more than any other venue besides UConn's home courts in Storrs and Hartford. The Huskies own an all-time record of 63-56 (.529) at the Garden and they have won **10 championships** there, including seven Big East Conference titles. UConn Coach Dan Hurley is 1-2 at MSG with the Huskies. UConn has appeared in Madison Square Garden in 36 of the last 37 years.

MOVING UP THE LADDER: UConn senior guard **Christian Vital** scored 8 points against Xavier on Nov. 22 to up his career total to 1,310 points, moving up to No. 29 on the all-time UConn scoring list. No. 28 on the list is **Doron Sheffer** (1993-96) with 1,329 points. Vital became a member of UConn's 1,000-point club on Jan. 19, 2019, in a victory over Tulane at Gampel Pavilion. Vital also had two 3-pointers against Buffalo to hike his career total to 210 three-pointers made, No. 7 on that all-time list.

CONSECUTIVE GAMES: UConn senior guard **Christian Vital** owns the current longest UConn streak of games played with 74 straight, while junior center **Josh Carlton** has the longest streak of games started at 40.

Two Sign With UConn

The UConn men's basketball program has received signed National Letters of Intent from guard **Andre Jackson** and center **Javonte Brown-Ferguson**.

Jackson, a versatile 6-7, 195-pound wing from Albany, N.Y., and Brown-Ferguson, a 7-foot, 240-pound big man from Pickering, Ontario, will enroll in UConn classes starting in the summer of 2020.

Jackson, who currently attends Albany Academy, averaged 17.4 points, 10.5 rebounds, 4.6 assists, 3.0 steals and shot an impressive 69 percent last season as he helped the Cadets post a 19-3 record and win the New York Class A State Championship. Jackson is a top 50 prospect out of the Albany City Rocks AAU program.

Brown-Ferguson, who just turned 17 years old in September and is in his senior year at Thornlea Secondary School in Thornhill, Ontario, is averaging 24.5 points, 12.0 rebounds, and 3.0 blocks in the 2019-20 season. Brown-Ferguson, who carries a 4.0 GPA and is reclassifying from the Class of 2021 to 2020, also played in the Under Armour Canada Elite AAU program.

2nd year at UConn

It didn't take long for Dan Hurley to put his stamp on the UConn men's basketball program. Three games into his first season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2018-19, the team had three victories, including its first win over a nationally-ranked opponent in three years.

As the architect of two previous college basketball rebuilding projects, however, Hurley was well-aware that the challenge of returning the four-time NCAA champion Huskies to national prominence wasn't going to be that easy. As with his two other program turnarounds, there clearly was going to be struggles and growing pains, and UConn's final 16-17 record, while disappointing, was not all that surprising.

Suffering eight losses by margins of seven points or less and dealing with the injury-related absences of starting guards Jalen Adams and Alterique Gilbert for lengthy periods, UConn's progress could easily have included a number of extra wins and the possibility of postseason play. Nevertheless, Hurley clearly instituted a change of culture during Year One and with a Top 20 recruiting class arriving in Year Two, has the program headed in the right direction.

Although he was a national recruit coming out of St. Anthony High School and he put together an impressive college career at Seton Hall, it is as a coach that Hurley has made the basketball world take notice – not only as a winner, posting a 167-122 (.578) career record in nine years as a Division I head coach, but as a program-builder and a positive guiding force for young men. While still a youthful coach in college basketball terms, Hurley has already taken charge of three struggling hoop programs – one prep and two college – and built them into competitors on the national stage. And if his previous stints at St. Benedict's Prep, Wagner College and the University of Rhode Island are any indication, the UConn basketball program has been placed in good hands.

Hurley, who was named the 19th head coach in the history of UConn men's basketball on March 22, 2018, is a product of one of the most well-known basketball families in the country, led by his father, Bob Sr., a Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame inductee following a legendary high school coach-

ing career at powerhouse St. Anthony in Jersey City (N.J.) and including older brother Bobby, an All-American and two-time National Champion player at Duke, who played for five years in the NBA, and is currently the head coach at Arizona State.

While following in those giant sneaker prints has understandably never been an easy task, Dan Hurley has always embraced the challenge and built himself an extremely impressive basketball resume in the process.

Hurley came to UConn following six years at Rhode Island, where he took a program that went 7-23 in the season before he arrived to a combined 51-18 mark and two NCAA Tournament appearances in his final two years, URI's first NCAA appearances in 18 years. In each year, Hurley guided the Rams to a first-round NCAA tourney victory.

In 2017-18, Hurley's URI team posted a 26-8 record, the most wins by a Rams team in eight years, which included a 16-game winning streak, the second-longest in school history. Rhode Island swept to the Atlantic 10 regular-season title with a 15-3 mark, and spent seven weeks ranked in the national polls, rising as high as No. 14 in the USA Today Coaches poll. Earning a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, URI defeated Oklahoma in the first round before bowing to second-seeded Duke. Hurley was named Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year, earned his second USBWA District I Coach of the Year Award and sent two of his players to NBA teams, Jared Terrell to the Timberwolves and E.C. Matthews to the Grizzlies.

The previous season, Hurley took Rhode Island to a 25-10 record, earning an automatic NCAA tourney bid by capturing the Atlantic 10 Championship. The 11th-seeded Rams upset sixth-seeded Creighton in the NCAA first round before suffering a three-point loss to No. 3 seed Oregon.

In his six seasons in Rhode Island, Hurley's teams were a combined 113-82 (.579), but an even more impressive 91-43 (.679) with two NCAA appearances and an NIT berth during his last four years.

Previous to his tenure in Kingston, Hurley spent two years at his first Division I head coaching job at Wagner College in the Northeast Conference. Taking over a program that had just five wins in 2009-10, Hurley immedi-

ately upped the win total to 13 in his first season of 2010-11 and nearly doubled that total to a 25-6 mark in 2011-12. His overall record in the Northeast Conference was 24-12.

Disregarding his initial seasons at his three college stops – meaning after he has had a chance to change the culture and instill his system – Hurley's overall college coaching record is 130-67, an impressive winning percentage of .660.

It was at St. Benedict's, where he also taught history, that Hurley maintains he really learned his craft, building the program into a national prep school powerhouse. In nine seasons, Hurley compiled a sterling 223-21 record, with four Top Five finishes in the national rankings. He coached four McDonald's All-Americans as well as future NBA players J.R. Smith, Tristan Thompson, and Lance Thomas.

Born (1/16/73) and raised in in Jersey City, Hurley was an outstanding high school player at St. Anthony. At Seton Hall, he played under head coaches P.J. Carlesimo and George Blaney, amassing career totals of 1,070 points and 437 assists.

Dan and wife Andrea, who met while both were attending Seton Hall, are the parents of two sons, Danny and Andrew.
