COMING UP

- Miami welcomes FAU, Florida Gulf Coast and UCF to the James L. Knight Sports Complex Friday and Saturday for the two-day Sunshine State Challenge.
- The Canes open up their 2018 season hosting FAU on Friday night at 7 p.m.
- Miami will return to "The Knight" on Saturday morning to face FGCU at 11 a.m., and then return for the final game of the tournament against UCF at 7 p.m..

COACHING MILESTONE

- Head coach Jose "Keno" Gandara enters the 2018 season with a 99-54 record, just one win away from 100.
- Gandara sits third on the all-time wins list in Miami volleyball history, and is just 17 behind Cheryl Holt (1978-81) for second place.

INTERNATIONAL CANES

- Two of Miami's 15 players on the 2018 roster come from outside the United States: redshirt sophomore outside hitter Elizaveta Lukianova (Russia) and senior middle blocker Lucia Pampana (Italy).
- Head coach Jose "Keno" Gandara is a Puerto Rico native and came to the United States to attend UCSB, where he played volleyball.

HALEY'S SENIOR CAMPAIGN

- Haley Templeton enters her senior season after garnering her fourth-straight Preseason All-ACC Team selection.
- Templeton competed with the U.S. Collegiate National Team over the summer, participating in competition in Detroit and representing the U.S. in Croatia.
- The standout setter is three-time All-ACC selection, most recently in 2017 when she also was named AVCA All-America honorable mention and AVCA All-East Coast Region.
- Templeton was one of the best freshmen in the country in 2014, being named the ACC Freshman of the Year and the AVCA East Coast Region Freshman of the year.
- Templeton was also named to the 2014 ACC All-Freshman Team after winning five ACC Freshman of the Week awards.
- Templeton sits third in program history for career assists with 3,583, trailing Jill Robinson for second place by 1,354 assists.

#WELCOMETOTHEU

- The Hurricanes welcome seven freshmen to the 2018 roster: Chloe Brown, Taylor Burrell, Emily Damon, Priscilla Hernandez, Maddie Naumann, Maya Sullivan and Sophie Walls.
- Miami also welcomes transfer Bridget Wallenberger to Coral Gables. The junior middle blocker enrolled at Miami in January after spending her first two seasons at Milwaukee.
- Brown was named the Gatorade Oregon Volleyball player of the year and recorded 369 kills, 257 digs, 48 service aces and 23 blocks, while posting a kill percentage of .452 and a hitting percentage of .364 at Westside Christian High.
- Burrell also enrolled at Miami in January, graduating early from West Boca High School and becoming the first early enrollee under head coach Jose "Keno" Gandara.
- Hernandez is the younger sister of Sylvia Hernandez, who was the starting libero the last two seasons for the Hurricanes.
- The freshmen feature three defensive specialists, two outside hitters, one middle blocker and one setter.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- The Hurricanes first road trip of the 2018 season will be to Guaynabo, Puerto Rico for the Puerto Rico Invitational.
- The Canes will face Towson on Aug. 31 and Missouri on Sept. 1 in their first trip to head coach Jose "Keno" Gandara's native country.

COACHING STAFF



JOSE "KENO" GANDARA

Head Coach Sixth Season UC Santa Barbara, 1990

Jose "Keno" Gandara accepted the position of head volleyball coach at the University of Miami on March 20, 2013, becoming the second head coach since the program returned in 2001.

The Hurricanes returned the NCAA Championship in 2017 for the fourth time in five seasons under Gandara's leadership. Miami won its first postseason match since 2014, defeating the College of Charleston in the opening round of the tournament in a Gainesville, Fla. The Canes fell to No. 2 Florida in four sets in an exciting second round matchup to close the season 22-6 and finish with their best winning percentage since 2012.

Senior outside hitter Olga Strantzali was named ACC Player of the Year and AVCA East Coast Region Player of the Year. Strantzali was joined by redshirt junior setter Haley Templeton on the All-ACC First Team and AVCA All-East Coast Region team. Strantzali and Templeton topped off a memorable season with AVCA All-America Honorable Mention recognition. The Canes both started and finished the campaign strong, winning the first nine matches and the seven contests prior to falling to second-seeded Florida. Miami topped the ACC in service aces with 1.71 per set and finished the season in the top three of two additional categories – hitting percentage (second with .246) and kills (tied for third with 13.64 per set).

In 2016, Gandara led a resilient Miami squad that proved to rise to the occasion when it stepped into an opponent's gym. The 2016 Hurricanes won 11 matches away from Coral Gables, picking up big road wins at Notre Dame and Louisville. Junior outside hitter Olga Strantzali developed into one of the best players in the country, receiving AVCA All-America honorable mention and earned AVCA All-East Coast Region and First Team All-ACC honors. Strantzali and freshman setter Hannah Sorensen were named to the All-ACC Academic Team in recognition of their success on the court and in the classroom.

Gandara led the Hurricanes to three straight NCAA Tournaments in his first three seasons at the helm of the Miami volleyball program. The Canes were selected to the 2015 NCAA Tournament, where they faced Iowa State in a first round match in Madison, Wis. The Canes finished the season 21-10 and 14-6 in the ACC, while Miami's 21 wins marked the second consecutive 20-win season under Gandara's leadership. The Hurricanes saw seniors Alexis Mourning and Taylor Scott, as well as sophomores Olga Strantzali and Haley Templeton, named to the 2015 All-ACC Second Team with Strantzali and Templeton also earning AVCA All-East Coast Region Honorable Mention.

Miami reached the NCAA Tournament for the sixth consecutive season in 2014 and seventh time in program history. The Hurricanes, who finished the season 22-9, defeated UCF in five sets in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The victory was Gandara's first NCAA Tournament win as a head coach. Miami's 22 wins also gave Gandara his first 20-win season at the helm of the program.

The Canes reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to No. 8 Florida in four sets. But Gandara helped develop several players to reach unprecedented levels of success.

Senior outside hitter Savanah Leaf was named 2014 ACC Player of the Year and a second team AVCA All-American, while freshman Haley Templeton earned ACC Freshman of the Year honors. Leaf was joined by senior middle blocker Emani Sims on the All-ACC First Team, while Templeton was picked for the All-ACC Second Team and the All-ACC Freshman Team. The accolades continued for the trio as Leaf and Sims were named AVCA East Coast All-Region selections and Templeton was tabbed as the AVCA East Coast Region Freshman of the Year.

The 2013 season was filled with firsts for Gandara. He secured his first win as a NCAA head coach on Aug. 30, when Miami defeated Austin Peay, 3-1. Gandara collected his first home win when Miami beat LSU in five sets on Sept. 14. The first-year head coach tallied his first ACC win when the Canes defeated Boston College in five sets on Sept. 28. Gandara also guided the Canes to their fifth straight NCAA Tournament appearance and first under his tutelage.

The Hurricanes dropped their first round match against Oregon in three sets, but 2013 was still a successful first season under Gandara. Miami had four players earn All-ACC distinction, including Savanah Leaf and Emani Sims (first team), Alexis Mourning (second team) and Ryan Shaffer (third team). The Canes defeated No. 12 North Carolina at home and earned one of the coveted 64 spots in the NCAA Tournament.

Gandara came to Miami after spending eight years as an assistant at the University of Washington. He previously served as an assistant at UNLV and his alma mater, UC Santa Barbara.

Gandara is a highly-respected teacher who has played and coached at the top levels of college and professional volleyball. Keno assisted former Washington head coach Jim McLaughlin with all aspects of coaching, including opponent scouting and contributing to the Huskies' defensive package.

Gandara began his coaching career at UCSB in 1992 as an assistant with the men's team and was an assistant with the women's team in 1994. He also spent one season as a head coach/player with the San Juan Volleyball club in the Puerto Rico Professional League.

A San Juan, Puerto Rico, native, Gandara graduated from UC Santa Barbara in 1990 after a successful volleyball career with the Gauchos as a middle blocker. Gandara was a first team All-America selection in 1989 and second team selection in 1988 after leading UCSB to the national title match. He was also a two-time all-conference honoree. Gandara has also been inducted into the UCSB Hall of Fame. He also represented both the United States and Puerto Rico in international competition as a member of their respective national volleyball teams.

Gandara is married to Stephanie Cox who was a standout setter at UCSB and played on the AVP Tour. The couple welcomed their first child, a son named Lucas, in April 2011.

2017 (Junior): Had eight of her 11 kills, eight of her nine digs, as well as her only block in the Southern Miss Invitational, against Nicholls State (Aug. 26), hitting .386 against the Colonels ... Had one of the best matches in her career in the Sunshine State Classic opener, notching career-high 17 kills, tying her career-best with three assists, in addition to notching season-best five blocks against FAU (Sept. 1) ... capped off the tournament with another double-figures performance at FGCU (Sept. 2) - 12 kills on .321 hitting and six digs on the defensive end ... Repeated career-high of 17 kills and recorded seven digs, a block and an assist in ACC opener against Viriginia Tech (Sept. 22), earning a start in the five-set victory over Virginia (Sept. 24) ... Tied a career high of three assists along with 11 kills, two aces and eight digs in a sweep against defending champion North Carolina (Oct. 29) ... Recorded 11 kills, five digs and two blocks in sweep over Florida State (Nov. 1) before picking up 18 kills, two digs and an assist at Pittsburgh (Nov. 3) ... Contributed 11 kills, five digs, an assist and a block in a win over Boston College (Nov. 9) before recording 11 kills, seven digs, two service aces, two blocks and an assist in a victory over Syracuse (Nov. 12) ... 
