THE FACTS...

This weekend is critical for the University of Miami Hurricanes as they are slowly but surely crawling back to the top of the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings. The 'Canes are playing exciting volleyball of late having defeated Georgia Tech and Clemson in back-to-back matches for the first time ever in a two-match stretch. It was also the 'Canes first time beating Clemson in six attempts, bringing the series record to 7-2 in favor of the Tigers. The 'Canes also swept Georgia Tech for the first time in a season series with a 3-2 win at the James L. Knight Sports Complex last Friday night.

Miami comes into Thursday night's match at the Dean E. Smith Center looking for a chance at their first ACC title in school history. The Hurricanes defeated the Tar Heels in their last meeting, 3-1, in Coral Gables. However, since that time UNC has rolled off eight consecutive wins and garnered an ACC Player of the Week nod in Briana Eskola--who shared the award with UM's Genny Mayhew two weeks ago.

The ACC title is up for grabs with the Tar Heels nursing a one match lead over the 'Canes. UNC sits with a record of 13-4, while the Orange and Green hold a 12-5 mark in league play.

UM will need solid play in North Carolina this week as their previous trip to North Carolina ended with a sour note on the back end. After defeating Duke in Durham, a night later in Winston-Salem, the 'Canes were swept by Wake Forest to end their 15-match winning streak. History, is on the side of the Orange and Green in Raleigh while they hold a 4-0 mark against NC State on the road. However, against UNC the Hurricanes are just 1-3 ... and dropped their last three matches in Chapel Hill.

The last time Miami won a match in Chapel Hill was on Oct. 17, 2004 in their first-ever meeting. UM took the match, 3-1 (26-30, 30-27, 30-25, 30-28) in a classic affair.

ON NORTH CAROLINA...

North Carolina comes into Thursday night's affair as one of the hottest teams in the ACC, if not the hottest, winning their last eight consecutive matches dating back to a loss in October to UM in Coral Gables. Six of those victories by the Tar Heels have come by way of a shutout performance, including a sweep of rival Duke and in-state foe Wake Forest.

UNC is charged by Lauren Prussing (273 kills) and Suzanne Haydel (245 kills) on offense. In the last meeting, it was UNC's Courtney Johnston registering 13 kills and Christine Vaughen leading the way with 14 of her own. The Heels look towards Briana Eskola for defense as the one-time Player of the Week has swept up 508 digs to rank her number one in the league in that category. Cassie Loessberg (UM) trails her by just eight digs.

The setter for UNC is a two-set system, again that has caused the 'Canes trouble this year, utilized primarily with Stephanie Jansma (625 assists) and then with Erica Behm (408 assists). Ingrid Hanson-Tuntland is second in the league in blocks per set with an average of 1.40.

ON N.C. STATE

NC State is a team that is capable of an upset at any time, and a dangerous team for many in the league. The Hurricanes swept the Wolfpack last month in Coral Gables, but the effort of the Pack was not to be outdone. Scores of 25-16, 25-20, 25-17 showed how close each set actually was.

They are led by the play of Arlee Tamietti with 311 kills, while teammate Aiwane Iboaya sits behind her with 206 kills to her name. Tamietti also has 243 digs and 65 blocks. The setter for the Pack is Alex Smith with 913 assists under her belt, placing her eighth in the league in that category.

Head Coach ... Nicole Lantagne Welch



Nicole Lantagne Welch enters her eighth season at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in five of the last seven seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In the 2006 season-opener, Lantagne Welch recorded her 100th career win with a 3-2 victory over Alabama. In 2007, UM finished 14-17 overall and 8-14 in ACC play, pushing Lantagne Welch's career

record to 125-81 overall in seven seasons as a head coach, all at Miami.

Her career at UM is highlighted by two consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins (2003 & 2004) and a trip to the Sweet 16 in the Hurricanes' firstever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her seven seasons at the helm, the Hurricanes have averaged 17.8 wins per season.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. As a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered first-team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and 1993, and earned second-team honors in 1991. She was also named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

As team captain her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career at Maryland, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7th, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

HURRICANES VB MEDIA POLICY

KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Betweengame and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Information Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

TELEPHONES

Telephone lines at the Knight Sports Complex are limited to home radio and the visiting teams' "official" sports administrator/Media relations contact. All media wishing to files stories should contact Bryan J. Harvey prior to the conclusion of the game in order to make arrangements to be escorted back to the Sports Media Relations Office in order to work in a work-friendly environment. Any and all questions will be addressed in this designated area. Gametracker on www.hurricanesports.com. A select number of them will feature radio broadcast through WVUM...the official student radio station for the University of Miami. That is also followed by a pair of matches on ACC Select sponsored through the Atlantic Coast Conference. The matches to be shown on ACC Select include home stands against Duke (Oct. 31) and a match at home against Clemson (Nov. 16).

MIAMI VS. UNC SERIES ...

Miami leads this all-time series by the slimmest of margins, 5-4. The 3-1 win over the Tar Heels in Coral Gables last month proved to be the deciding edge in what has been a fantastic series to date. The home team has won every meeting in this series dating back to the first meeting in October of 2004.

MIAMI VS. N.C. STATE SERIES...

UM holds a commanding 9-0 lead in this series that dates back to 2004. Miami took the last meeting between these teams, 3-0. In fact, five of the nine matches played have been sweeps in favor of the Hurricanes.

MIAMI IN THE ACC RANKINGS...

UM has several players ranked among the top 10 in several categories for the ACC this year. Leading things off for UM is senior Angelica Ellis in hitting percentage (7th) with a .333 clip (200-58-427). Freshman Lane Carico is sixth in the league in kills (334 / 3.21 kps) and teammate Genny Mayhew is right behind her in eighth place (320 / 3.14 kps). Setter Katie Gallagher is fifth in assists (1067 / 10.46 aps), while also ranked seventh in service aces (31). Carico is 10th in service aces (31), and teammate Lici McGee is ninth in blocks (64 / 1.08 bps). Cassie Loessberg is third in digs (500 / 4.81 dps).

ON THESE DATES IN HISTORY...

For Nov. 20 and 21 throughout history, Miami holds an impressive 11-5 overall mark, including a 7-3 record on Nov. 20. These ates include wins over NC State and UNC, respectively, over the past three years. On Nov. 21, UM is 4-2.

HURRICANES HAVE GREAT HOME RECORD ...

Finishing the 2008 regular season with a record 12-1 at home in the James L. Knight Sports Complex, after defeating Clemson last weekend, the Miami Hurricanes registered their best home effort since moving to the ACC in 2004. Prior to that, UM collected an equally impressive 12-1 mark in 2002--the same year they ventured into the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament.

LOESSBERG MAKES ACES INTO SCHOOL HISTORY ...

Against North Carolina on Oct. 18, junior libero/defensive specialist Cassie Loessberg registered six service aces in the match. That last ace moved the Sacramento, California native into a tie for second place all-time in UM history for aces in a single match. She is now tied with Kristi Sprenkel who set the original second-place mark back on Oct. 24, 2001 against Nova Southeastern.

GALLAGHER, MAYHEW HAVE HISTORICAL NIGHTS ...

In the loss to the Virginia Cavaliers on Oct. 24, sophomore setter Katie Gallagher had 51 assists to give her sole possession of second place all-time in school history for assists. Gallagher passed Mallory James (2001-04) with 2,202 assists to her credit in just two years in the Orange and Green. She trails all-time leader Jill Robinson (2003-06) by 2,735. Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew's 17 digs added her name to an elite group of athletes in UM volleyball history as she moved into the "500 Club", now holding more than 500 kills and 500 digs in a career.

20-WIN SEASON IN THE BAG FOR FIRST TIME IN ACC ...

After defeating ACC power Duke last Friday night in Coral Gables, the University of Miami volleyball team assured themselves their first 20-win season since joining the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC). The 'Canes are now 20-5 overall, and have a chance to record their best record in NCAA Division I history. The current record (27-6) was set during their magical NCAA Sweet 16 run in 2002. The school record, however, is a 49-14-1 season back in 1980 when the Hurricanes were members of the old AIAW league, not associated with the NCAA.

MIAMI SETS NEW RECORD IN WINS ...

With their 12th ACC win coming last weekend against foes Georgia Tech and Clemson, UM set a new school record for ACC wins. The previous high had been 11 coming in both 2004 and 2005. They are now just one victory away from their first 25-win season since 2002, and just the fourth in school history overall.

HOME IS WHERE THE HITS ARE ...

At home this year in the friendly confines of the James L. Knight Sports Complex, the 'Canes have yet to hit below a .200 clip. In fact, they are averaging a .263 hitting percentage (528-166-1375) at home. Meanwhile, opponents are being held to a .180 clip (461-207-1409) at "The Knight."

SHUTTING THE DOOR

Miami has shutout 13 opponents this season in 27 matches on the campaign. Last year, the Hurricanes managed eight shutouts in 2007 altogether. The 2006 class had just four and 2005 with six. This is now the most shutouts for the Hurricanes since joining the ACC back in 2004.

TRACKING LOESSBERG AND THE DIGS...

Junior libero Cassie Loessberg continues to jump up the charts this season as she now has 500 digs on the campaign, upping her career total to 1,370. The Sacramento, Calif. junior is just 251 digs behind the all-time leader, Jamie Grass (2001-04) for the top place in school history. With an average of 4.86 digs per set, and at least 15 sets to play, the junior All-ACC Candidate could break the record by the 10th match of the 2009 season.

MAYHEW NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC TEAM...

Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew was named to the Preseason All-ACC Team as voted on by head coaches around the Atlantic Coast Conference. Mayhew, a 5-foot-11 junior from Clovis, Calif. (Clovis HS), finished ninth in the conference in both kills (428) and points (465) a year ago. She also finished fourth on the squad in digs (224) and tied for fifth in blocks (43) alongside teammate Ariell Cooke while playing in 111 games for the 'Canes.

CLEMSON PREDICTED TO WIN ACC ... AGAIN...

After finishing atop the league last season, the Clemson Tigers have been predicted to repeat as conference champs after collecting 11 of a possible 12 first place votes. Georgia Tech received the other first place vote while being predicted to finish second. Duke and North Carolina were third and fourth, while Florida State and Virginia tied for fifth, respectively.

<u>'CANES STUMBLE IN RECORD SEEK-ING...</u>

Seeking to tie or break the school record for wins to start the year (15-0, 2002), the 2008 Hurricane squad went 13-0 before falling at Wake Forest. It was, however, the second-best start for any Miami volleyball team in school history. Only one other time had the 'Canes held an undefeated record entering the month of October.
