The Opening Tip

- Duke (19-3, 6-1) faces Miami (13-7, 4-3) on Sunday, Feb. 5 at Cameron Indoor Stadium. Tipoff is set for 3:05 p.m.
- **Jon Sciambi** (play-by-play), **Jimmy Dykes** (analyst) and **Allison Williams** (sideline) will call the game for ESPNU.
- Duke is ranked No. 7 in the AP Poll and No. 5 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. Miami is unranked in both polls. The Blue Devils are 78-20 all-time when ranked seventh in the AP Poll.
- The Blue Devils are looking to top the 20-win mark for the 16th consecutive season. Duke has won 30 or more games in each of the last three seasons.
- Duke ranks No. 1 in Strength of Schedule and No. 2 in RPI according to ESPN.com. The Blue Devils are one of four teams (Syracuse, Michigan State & Kansas) in the NCAA to rank in the top 10 of the RPI, Strength of Schedule, AP and Coaches Polls.

Duke-Miami Series

- Duke and Miami have met 17 times heading into Sunday's game with the first meeting between the two schools coming on Dec. 21, 1962.
- The Blue Devils lead the all-time series 15-2, including a 7-0 mark at Cameron Indoor Stadium.
- Duke has won 11 of the 12 meetings since the Hurricanes joined the Atlantic Coast Conference.
- **Mike Krzyzewski** is 15-1 at Duke against Miami with a 7-0 mark at home.
- Duke has won five straight games in the series with three of the five victories coming by 10 points or less.
- Krzyzewski's only loss to Miami was a 96-95 defeat on Feb. 20, 2008. It was also the last time the Blue Devils lost a game when scoring 90 or more points. Duke is 265-8 under Coach K when scoring 90+ points in a game.
- Duke has scored 80 or more points in 12 of its 17 games against Miami.

Numbers Game

● Duke has been ranked in the top 10 of the AP Poll for 87 straight weeks, the third-longest streak in NCAA history.

● The Blue Devils are one of seven teams in the NCAA with five or more players averaging 10 or more points per game. Duke has finished the year with five double-figure scorers six times under Mike Krzyzewski.

● Duke is the only school in the ACC with five players averaging over 11.0 points per game in league play. **Ryan Kelly** (13.9), **Austin Rivers** (12.9), **Andre Dawkins** (11.9), **Mason Plumlee** (11.4) and **Seth Curry** (11.4) each rank in the top 25 in the ACC in scoring through seven league games.

● The Blue Devils rank 11th nationally in scoring at 80.0 points per game, despite facing seven opponents that rank in top 50 nationally in scoring defense.

● Duke is one win shy of reaching the 20-win plateau for the 16th consecutive season. The Blue Devils have won 20 or more games 26 times under Mike Krzyzewski.

● **Austin Rivers**, a five-time ACC Rookie of the Week pick, is averaging a team-high 14.1 points per game. **Johnny Dawkins** was the last Blue Devil freshman to lead the team in scoring in 1983.

● **Mason Plumlee** is one of two players (joined by Keith Clanton, Central Florida) in the NCAA averaging at least 10.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.5 blocks per game.

● **Ryan Kelly** leads the ACC in three-point percentage among players who have attempted at least 50 threes. He is shooting 47.2 percent (25-of-53) from three-point range on the season, including 51.9 percent (14-of-27) over the last 12 games.

● **Mason Plumlee** has improved his free throw shooting over the last four games, going 22-of-29 (.759) from the line during that span. He was shooting 39.8 percent (37-of-93) from the free throw line prior to that stretch. Plumlee ranked fourth in the ACC in free throw attempts per game (5.5 ftpg.).

● **Tyler Thornton** leads the Blue Devils with a +15.52 points per game plus/minus ratio per 40 minutes played.

● **Ryan Kelly** is one of just two players (Wake Forest's C.J. Harris) in the ACC shooting over 45.0 percent from the field and from three-point range.

● **Mason Plumlee** and **Miles Plumlee** combine to average 15.6 rebounds per game. One of the Plumlees has led the team in rebounds in 20 of 22 games. The brother tandem has also combined for 14 double-figures rebounding efforts.

● **Austin Rivers** is averaging a team-high 15.4 points and shooting 50.0 percent (57-of-114) from the field in Duke's 11 home games.

• Duke has been ranked in the AP Poll an NCAA-best 90 straight weeks. The Blue Devils have been ranked in the top 10 for the last 87 weeks, including 12 weeks at No. 1.

NCAA All-Time Wins Leader

• **Mike Krzyzewski** is the winningest coach in NCAA Division I history with 919 career victories. He passed mentor Bob Knight with a 74-69 win over Michigan State at Madison Square Garden on Nov. 15, 2011.

• With over 800 wins as the Duke head coach, Krzyzewski is one of five coaches in NCAA history to win at least 800 games at one school. He is currently fourth on the list with 846 wins at Duke.

• Krzyzewski is the winningest coach in NCAA Tournament history with 79 tournament wins. He has 21 more NCAA Tournament victories than the next active coach.

• Krzyzewski ranks second all-time in ACC history with 380 conference wins.

The Last Time Out

• Duke posted a 75-60 road win over Virginia Tech on Thursday in Blacksburg. The Blue Devils never trailed in the contest en route to their 19th win of the season.

• **Austin Rivers** scored a game-high 18 points to go along with five rebounds, five assists and a steal. Rivers was 7-of-11 from the field, including 4-of-6 from three-point range, in the win.

• **Ryan Kelly** added 15 points and four rebounds for the Blue Devils. He knocked down a pair of three-pointers in the game and was 5-of-10 from the field overall.

• **Seth Curry** added 11 points, while **Mason Plumlee** had 10 points, six rebounds and two blocks against the Hokies.

• **Josh Hairston** made his first career start and finished with six points, three rebounds and a steal in 15 minutes of action.

• The Blue Devils committed a season-low seven turnovers in the contest.

• Duke's bench outscored the Hokies, 34-13, on the night. Kelly and Curry both came off the bench to score in double figures.

Balanced Offensive Attack

• Duke has had 85 double-figure scoring performances on the season.

• The Blue Devils are 13-1 on the year when at least four players score 10 or more points in a game.

• Nine Blue Devils have scored 10 or more points in a game with **Austin Rivers** reaching double-figures a team-high 18 times.

• Five Duke players are averaging over 10.0 points per game. Duke is one of seven teams in the NCAA with five or more double-figure scorers.

• Six Blue Devils have led the team in scoring in a game. **Austin Rivers** has paced the Duke ofensive attack in a team-best nine games.

- **Miles Plumlee** is averaging 7.0 points, 6.1 rebounds and 1.4 blocks over the last 11 games. He is 32-of-48 (.667) from the field in that span.
- Plumlee recorded his fourth career double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds in the win over Presbyterian.

- Plumlee carries a 3.44 grade point average as a double major in Psychology and Cultural Anthropology.

Kelly Providing Scoring Punch

- Junior **Ryan Kelly** has scored in double figures in 15 games this season and now has 24 career double-figure scoring games. Duke is 23-1 when he scores 10 or more points in a game.
- Kelly recorded his first career double-double with 18 points and 12 rebounds against Penn. He also had a double-double with 20 points and 10 rebounds in a home win over Wake Forest.
- Kelly is shooting 47.4 percent (27-of-57) from three-point range on the year. He is 15-of-27 (.556) from behind the arc over the last 12 games.
- Kelly scored a career-high 21 points in the win over Georgia Tech. He was 14-of-14 from the free throw line in the win including 10-of-10 in the final 4:09 of play.
- Kelly's 14-for-14 performance from the free throw line against Georgia Tech is tied for the second best in Duke history. **Dick Groat** went 17-for-17 in 1950, and both **Gene Banks** (1980) and **J.J. Redick** (2005) went 14-for-14 in a game.
- Kelly ranks 10th in the ACC in free throw percentage (.800) and fifth in free throws per game (5.2).

Curry Steady in Backcourt

- **Seth Curry** has scored in double figures 13 times on the year. He has 29 double-figure scoring games, including five 20-point efforts, at Duke.
- Curry currently ranks fifth at Duke in career three-point field goal percentage (.405).
- Curry leads the ACC (19th in NCAA) in free throw percentage at .887 (63-of-71).

Dawkins a Premier Perimeter Threat

Mike Krzyzewski

Head Coach • Army '69 • 36 seasons (32nd season at Duke)

919-287 overall • 846-228 at Duke

Winning seasons, superb graduation rates for his players and a basketball team that is as close as family are all attributes that reflect on the man who is in his 32nd year as the head coach of the Duke Blue Devils, Hall of Famer Mike Krzyzewski.

Coach K became the winningest coach in NCAA Division I history, passing his mentor Bob Knight, with a 74-69 win over Michigan State on Nov. 15. Krzyzewski now has 919 career wins, while also ranking fourth in wins at one school (846), second in career ACC wins (380) and first in NCAA Tournament victories (79). He owns a 919-287 career record while attaining an 846-228 mark at Duke.

Krzyzewski's record as Duke's all-time winningest coach offers further evidence of his success: 846 total wins; 480 weeks ranked in the top 25; 419 weeks ranked in the top 10; 104 weeks ranked No. 1; 11 Final Four berths in the last 26 years, including five straight appearances from 1988-92; 26 seasons with at least 20 wins; 26 upper-division finishes in the ACC in the past 28 years; 12 seasons with 30 or more wins (most by any coach all-time); 12 regular season ACC crowns and 13 Atlantic Coast Conference Tournament titles, including 10 of the last 13 years (a record five in succession from 1999-2003). Coach K has also led the Blue Devils to three consecutive 30-win seasons and NCAA-best 12 overall 30-win seasons.

But most impressive are the four National Championships (1991, 1992, 2001 and 2010) that make Coach K one of only three coaches in NCAA history to earn four or more NCAA titles. In addition to Krzyzewski, only John Wooden (10), and Adolph Rupp (4) have accomplished that feat. With back-to-back national championships in 1991 and 1992, Coach K became the first coach since Wooden in 1972-73 to earn consecutive NCAA crowns. The Blue Devils grabbed their third title in 2001 with an 82-72 win over Arizona in Minneapolis, Minn. Duke defeated Butler, 61-59, in the 2010 championship game in Indianapolis, Ind. to give Krzyzewski his fourth NCAA Championship.

Krzyzewski and the Blue Devils have been a fixture on the national basketball scene with 16 consecutive NCAA Tournament berths from 1996-2011 and 27 in the last 28 years. Overall, he has taken his program to postseason play in 28 of his 31 years and is the winningest active coach in NCAA Tournament play with a stunning 79-23 record for a .775 winning percentage. He also ranks first in NCAA Tournament history in wins (79) and games (102).

From 1999-2002, Duke finished number one in the nation in the final Associated Press poll for a record four consecutive seasons. In 2003-04, the Blue Devils reached the nation's top spot in the AP poll, marking the seventh straight year they had been number one (only UCLA's string of 12 consecutive years reaching No. 1 from 1964-75 was longer).

Krzyzewski has mentored seven National Players of the Year (nine selections), 23 All-Americans (37 selections), eight ACC Players of the Year (10 selections) and 74 All-ACC selections during his tenure at Duke. In the past 13 years, four different Blue Devils — Elton Brand, Shane Battier, Jason Williams (twice) and J.J. Redick (twice) — have earned National Player of the Year honors.

Coach K has coached 43 NBA Draft picks, including 23 first round selections. An NCAA-best 16 Blue Devils have been NBA Lottery picks with Elton Brand (1999) and Kyrie Irving (2011) being taken No. 1 overall in their respective drafts.

Krzyzewski earned his 900th career victory on March 20, 2011 with a 73-71 win over Michigan in the third round of the NCAA Tournament. On March 1, 2008, Krzyzewski became the sixth coach in Division I history to reach 800 wins with an 87-86 victory at N.C. State. Coach K became just the fifth coach in NCAA history to record 800 wins at one school with a win over Kansas State on Nov. 23, 2010. On Nov. 17, 2000, Krzyzewski earned his 500th win at Duke with a 98-85 triumph over Villanova. That night, the fabled floor of Cameron Indoor Stadium was dedicated as Coach K Court. On Feb. 13, 2010, Krzyzewski became the eighth coach in Division I history to coach 1,000 games at one school.

In all, Coach K has been named the National Coach of the Year 12 times in eight different seasons, including *Basketball Times*, UPI and Chevrolet (1986), Naismith (1989), the NABC (1991), *The Sporting News* and Naismith (1992), *Basketball Times* (1997), the NABC and Naismith (1999), Chevrolet (2000) and the Victor Awards (2001). He was named Coach of the Decade for the 1990s by the NABC and was the second recipient of the John R. Wooden Legends of Coaching Award. On October 5, 2001, Coach K was presented by his college coach Bob Knight as one of three members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame class of 2001.

Krzyzewski was named *Sports Illustrated* Sportsman of the Year on Dec. 5, 2011. In 1992, *The Sporting News* named him the Sportsman of the Year, becoming the first college coach to win the honor. Krzyzewski also received another prestigious honor in 2001 as he was named "America's Best Coach" by *Time* magazine and CNN.

On the court, Coach K has averaged more than 25 wins a season during his career at Duke. The Blue Devils have won at least 30 games in 10 of the past 20 seasons. He directed his teams to nine straight trips to the NCAA Sweet 16 from 1998-2006, as well as joining Wooden as the only coach to guide a team to the Final Four five consecutive years.

Krzyzewski added to his already impressive list of accomplishments on Sept. 26, 2005 when he was named head coach of the USA Basketball Men's Senior National Team program for 2006-2008. With Krzyzewski at the helm, Team USA won the gold medal at the 2008 Beijing Summer Olympics with a 118-107 victory over Spain. In the summer of 2007, he guided the USA squad to a gold medal victory and an unblemished 10-0 record in the FIBA Americas Championship. Krzyzewski has been honored by USA Basketball as the National Coach of the Year four times.

On July 21, 2009, he resumed his role as head coach of the USA Basketball Men's Senior National Team through 2012. Coach K guided Team USA to a 9-0 record and gold medal at the 2010 FIBA World Championships.

The Duke basketball program has held a prominent spot in the national basketball scene since the beginning of the post-World War II era. The final national rankings are just one measuring stick in which the Blue Devils are among the elite in the history of the sport.

In the Coach K era, which began in 1980-81, Duke has finished in the Associated Press top 25 a total of 25 seasons, including seven times as the No. 1 team in the nation. With consecutive AP number one finishes from 1999-2002, Duke became the first school in college basketball history to be ranked at the top of the final AP poll for four straight years.

- Duke has been ranked No. 1 at some point in the season in 17 of the past 26 years (AP & USA Today polls)
- **Mike Krzyzewski** has spent more weeks ranked in the top 25 (480 weeks), top 10 (419) and No. 1 (104) than any other active coach (AP poll only)

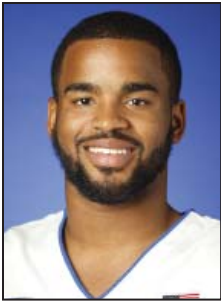
