**Miami Set for Road Trip at Georgia Tech and Clemson...**

The University of Miami takes to the road this weekend in what is perennially, one of its toughest ACC road stretches each season. The 'Canes will be facing ACC powers Georgia Tech (November 13) and Clemson (November 14) in their last ACC road trip of the season. Miami is just 5-4 on the road this year, and 4-3 in ACC matches away from home.

The Hurricanes come into the weekend sitting sixth in the Atlantic Coast Conference, while opponents Georgia Tech and Clemson are third and fourth, respectively. Miami will need a sweep this weekend in order to gain a share of fourth place. Ninth-year head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch is just one win shy of claiming her 80th ACC win.

Miami has never swept the road trip they are set to embark upon. In fact, the Hurricanes have never won at Clemson. The closest Miami has come to winning at Clemson was a 3-2 setback on Nov. 5, 2005. One day prior, the Hurricanes collected a 3-0 sweep of the Yellow Jackets in Atlanta.

Against ACC schools, sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico has staked a team-leading 280 kills, and classmate Christine Williamson has produced a second-best 128 kills.

Overall, Carico and senior libero Cassie Loessberg continue to lead the ACC in kills and digs. Carico has produced a league-best 411 kills on the campaign, averaging 4.42 kills per set. Meanwhile, Loessberg charges the UM defense with a league-leading 5.05 digs per set average (470 digs total). Freshman setter Nrithya Sundararaman is ninth in the ACC for assists with 701 (7.54 assists per set).

Quick Hits on Georgia Tech...

The Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets are under the direction of first-year head coach Tonya Johnson, who ultimately has them rolling with an 18-7 record, and an equally impressive 12-3 mark in the ACC, with one of those losses coming at the hands of the Hurricanes. Bailey Hunter leads the Yellow Jackets with 309 kills, while teammates Monique Mead (286) and Chrissy DeMichelis (275) follow just behind her, offensively. The setter for the Yellow Jackets is Mary Ashley Tippins, leading the charge with 1,063 assists, ranking her near the top of the league in the assists category. The libero is Jordan McCullers with a team-best 372 digs.

Series Against Georgia Tech...

By virtue of Miami's thrilling win in Coral Gables earlier this season, the series between the Yellow Jackets and Hurricanes is tied, 5-5. Last year, the

'Canes swept the series against the Yellow Jackets for the first time ever, and it was just the second time they've collected back-to-back wins against the Yellow Jackets, the last coming in 2005 and 2006. In fact, Miami has now won the last three meetings between the two teams.

Quick Hits on Clemson...

The Clemson Tigers come into the weekend sporting a 20-7 overall record, while holding a 10-5 mark in ACC play. The Tigers are led by Lia Proctor with 378 kills, followed by a trio of players above 200 kills—Natalie Patzin (260), Alexa Rand (207) and Sandra Adeleye (206). Setter Kelsey Murphy, ranked among tops in the league for assists, currently holding 1,067 (10.46 aps) on the year. The libero for the Tigers is Didem Ege with a team-leading 505 digs (4.95 dps).

Series Against Clemson...

Clemson leads the all-time series against the Hurricanes by an 9-3 margin. Until Miami's 3-2 victory over the Tigers last year in Coral Gables, Clemson had previously rolled off six consecutive victories dating back to Sept. 30, 2005. Clemson took this year's earlier meeting, 3-2, in an instant classic at Coral Gables.

Last Time vs. Georgia Tech (10/4/09)...

Sophomore Lane Carico tallied a match-high 30 kills to help lead the University of Miami past visiting Georgia Tech, 3-2 (25-22, 24-26, 31-29, 25-27, 15-9).

Miami was paced by Carico's 30 kills, now giving her back-to-back matches with at least 30 kills. She becomes just the second player in UM history to eclipse 30 kills in two or more matches in her career, joining Karla Johnson in that feat. Carico also had 16 digs for her seventh double-double of the year—and her fifth consecutive. Sophomore Christine Williamson registered a career-high 14 kills and one solo block. Also hitting double-digits in kills was McGee with 12. McGee would add six blocks (five assists) in the process.

Last Time vs. Clemson (10/2/09)...

Lane Carico established a new school record for kills (36) in a match Friday evening as the University of Miami volleyball team dropped a 3-2 heartbreaker (25-23, 25-22, 21-25, 22-25, 13-15) to Clemson University. Miami was led by Carico's record-setting performance of 36 kills and 17 digs. Also touching double-digits was Christine Williamson

# Nicole Lantagne Welch

**Head Coach**  
**Ninth Year at Miami**  
**Maryland, 1994**  
**Record at Miami: 166-97**  
**Overall Record: Same**



This season marks Nicole Lantagne Welch's ninth year at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in six

of the last eight seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

Last season, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.



Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by three seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her eight years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 18.9 wins per seasons with a career record of 151-87.

While new records were set during the 2007 campaign, the 2008 season saw even those records fall as Lantagne Welch and her staff assembled one of the best records in school history. Lantagne Welch led Miami to its best ACC record in school history. It was also the second-best record in school history on the Division I level of athletics.

Katie Gallagher moved in sole possession of second place all-time at UM for assists in a career during the 2008 season, while Cassie Loessberg placed herself in second place for digs in a career. In addition, Loessberg broke her own school record from a year ago for digs in a single-season, upping the new record to 554—besting her old school-record mark by two.

As for Gallagher, she etched her name once again as one of the Top 10 single-season assists leaders in school history. Already sitting at third place in school history from the 2007 season where she collected 1,243 assists, Gallagher added to that total with 1,202 in 2008—good enough for sixth place all-time in school history.

Freshman Lane Carico broke the freshman record for kills in a single-season for UM with 369, adding her name to 10th all-time for single-season kills. Meanwhile, Miami tied a school-record for hitting percentage in a five-set match, collecting a .329 percentage at Florida State on Nov. 26, 2008. The 'Canes would also collect the second-best single-set hitting mark in school history with a .615 clip against Boston College in the third set on Oct. 10, 2008.

Lantagne Welch would see two more student-athletes graduate following the 2008 season. Angelica Ellis and Bridget Bomhach both earned their Bachelor's Degree, while Ashley Woods completed her Master's Degree.

Woods placed her name eighth all-time in sets played (367), as well as eighth place all-time in total attacks (1,764). Ellis now ranks ninth in attacks (1,209), while also collecting the third-highest individual single-season hitting percentage (.350) from the 2008 campaign. Overall, Ellis is third in school history in career hitting percentage with a .275 clip through 318 sets and 1,209 attacks. Woods is tied for fifth in career hitting percentage, holding a .256 clip, sitting alongside Ciara Michel (2004-07).

The eighth-year head coach also coached three All-ACC Second Team members with

Lane Carico, Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. In addition, Carico and Ellis were each named as AVCA All-America honorable mention, while Carico was selected the 2008 AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico was also the true definition of "student-athlete" as she was named to the All-ACC Academic Team.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

## Hurricanes VB Media Policy

### KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

### MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

### MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

### WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

### INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

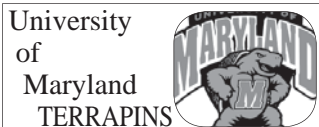

Miami trailed just 7-5 in the beginning until a kill from the Blue Devils' Sophia Dunworth began a 13-3 Duke run which widened its lead at 20-8. The run was eventually stopped on the strength of a Christine Williamson kill.



Duke Predicted to Win ACC Regular Season...

The Duke University volleyball team is predicted to win the 2009 Atlantic Coast Conference championship and headlines a list of 18 student-athletes selected to the 2009 Preseason All-ACC volleyball team, as announced today by Commissioner John D. Swofford.

Miami got three kills from sophomore Ali Becker in the first set, as she also chipped in with two blocks.



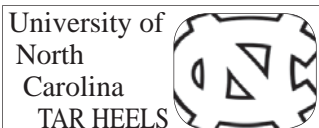
Duke takes in 116 of a possible 121 points, including seven of 12 first place votes. Coaches' votes for the predicted order of finish were tallied with 11 points being applied to a first-place vote, 10 points for a second-place vote, etc. Coaches were not permitted to predict their own team's order of finish.

In the second set, UM was forced into six attack errors while Duke countered with a .483 clip (14-0-29) in the frame to collect the 25-12 victory. Rachael Moss posted four of her 11 kills in the match for the Blue Devils in the set, while teammate Amanda Robertson added four of her own. For UM, the 'Canes were unable to find the hitting touch in the second set, but two kills from Carico and Williamson provided the highlights.



Just 17 points separate the top-four teams as Florida State, Miami, and North Carolina also take in first-place votes. Florida State follows Duke in second place with 104 points and three first-place votes, while Miami is tabbed to finish in third with 101 points and one first-place vote. North Carolina lands in fourth with 99 points and one first-place vote.

The third set saw nine ties and two lead changes as the Hurricanes returned from the intermission with renewed confidence and vigor. Carico stamped seven kills in the set while libero Cassie Loessberg reeled in five digs to keep Miami close throughout.



Clemson is tabbed fifth with 75 points, and is followed by Virginia Tech (71), Virginia (62), Georgia Tech (49), Wake Forest (47), Maryland (33), NC State (21), and Boston College (14).

With the score sitting at 14-14, Duke's Moss placed a kill to begin a 3-0 run that was just enough to give her team an edge Miami was unable to battle back from. Blocks from Catanach and Dunworth ended the set, 25-18, allowing the Blue Devils the road victory.
