- Clemson is in search of a fifth straight ACC win, something that has not happened in Tigertown since the 1996-97 team started 5-0.
- The Tigers are in search of a third straight win over a top-25 team, something that has never been achieved in program history.
- Clemson welcomes one of the nation's hottest teams in Miami, winners in eight of its last nine games. The Hurricanes' only loss came at Virginia, a top-20 ranked team.

TIGER TRACKS

- Miami has won four of the last five in the series. Two of the wins came in 2012-13 as a top-10 team. The Hurricanes enter Saturday's matchup with a No. 8 ranking in the latest AP poll.
- Clemson knocked off sixth-ranked Duke in its most recent game, the program's first top-10 win since a victory over the Blue Devils in 2009.
- The win over Duke gave Clemson wins over ranked opponents in consecutive games for the first time since the 1988-89 season.
- Clemson rallied from a 12-point first half deficit against the Blue Devils, its largest deficit overcome in a victory over Duke since the 1995-96 season.
- Donte Grantham scored 16 points in the Tiger victory Wednesday, his highest point total in an ACC game since also posting 16 in a victory over Syracuse as a freshman. Clemson is 8-1 when Grantham makes at least three three-pointers.
- Landry Nnoko is coming off his second double-double (12 points, 13 rebounds) in the last three games. It was his second career double-double in a win over the Blue Devils.

HEAD COACH BRAD BROWNELL

- Named the 21st men's basketball head coach in Clemson history on April 13, 2010.
- Is coaching his 14th season in Division I, having previously coached four years each at UNC Wilmington and Wright State before coming to Clemson.
- Set Clemson records for total wins (22) and ACC wins (9) by a first-year head coach in 2010-11.
- Led Clemson to first NCAA Tournament win in 14 years when the Tigers topped UAB in the first round in 2011.
- Took the Tigers to the 2014 NIT semifinals after his team was predicted to finish near the bottom of the ACC standings (Clemson finished sixth).
- Clemson's 2013-14 defense led the ACC and was eighth nationally in blocks per game (6.1).
- Has taken three different schools to NCAA Tournaments, one of only a few select coaches in the country to accomplish the feat.
- Coached K.J. McDaniels to ACC Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2013-14; McDaniels went on to become Brownell's first player drafted into the NBA.
- Named Colonial Athletic Association Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2006. He coached CAA Player of the Year Brett Blizzard in 2002-03, his first season as a Division I head coach.
- Took over Wright State in 2006-07 and guided the school to a record 23 wins in his first season and an NCAA Tournament bid.
- Began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Evansville in 1991-92, helping that program to an NCAA berth.
- Served as an assistant coach to Jerry Wainwright at UNC Wilmington from 1994-2002.
- Played Division III ball at DePauw University in Greencastle, Ind.
- He and his wife, Paula, have two daughters, Abby (17) and Kate (15).

LITTLEJOHN UNDERGOING MAJOR RENOVATION

- Clemson Athletics made the decision to pursue a massive rebuild of Littlejohn Coliseum in its existing space.
- The \$63.5 million renovation began with the demolition stages shortly after the May 2015 graduation ceremonies.
- The new and improved Littlejohn is scheduled to open in November 2016 with the season opener against Georgia.
- The renovated Littlejohn will include new seating and concourse areas, as well as brand new operations areas for both the men's and women's programs.

TIGERS MAKE TEMPORARY HOME IN GREENVILLE

- Clemson is playing all 17 regular season home games for 2015-16 at Bon Secours Wellness Arena in Greenville.
- The Tiger program has played some games in the facility, though not since the 2004-05 season when it was still the Bi-Lo Center.
- Clemson first played in the arena in 1998, splitting games against Furman and Illinois.

THE INTERN

- Jordan Roper completed a 400-hour unpaid internship requirement toward his parks, recreation & tourism management degree this summer.
- The senior from Columbia, S.C., worked with Clemson's athletic communications office, focusing on digital and video content.
- Roper's final project for the internship was to film, edit and produce a five-minute feature on himself, focusing on the stroke he suffered following his freshman season at Clemson.

I'M YOUR CAPTAIN

- Jaron Blossomgame and Donte Grantham both attended the inaugural Captains Camp over the summer put on by Athletes in Action.
- The two players attended the camp May 14-17 in Xenia, Ohio, along with 20 leaders from various Division I teams.
- The players took part in classroom sessions, outdoor and experiential learning exercises, skill instruction and open gym competition.
- Featured guests at the camp included CBS basketball analyst Clark Kellogg and former Ohio State point guard Aaron Craft.

GAME NOTES & MISCELLANEOUS STATS

CLEMSON-MIAMI SERIES HISTORY

- The Tigers and Hurricanes have faced one another 22 times on the hardwood, with Clemson holding a slight edge all-time, 12-10.
- Miami has had the upper hand recently, winning four of the last five in the series over the Tigers. Three of the four wins have been in Coral Gables.
- A series that began in 1955-56, Clemson won each of the first five, but Miami returned the favor from 2001-06 by winning the next five.
- Since the Hurricanes joined the ACC in 2004-05, Miami holds a 9-7 lead in what has been one of the most competitive series.

LAST MEETING AGAINST MIAMI

- Clemson traveled to Coral Gables, Fla., on Feb. 8, 2015 and struggled in a 56-45 loss to the Hurricanes.
- The Tigers shot just 33 percent for the game and the team's two leading scorers were Donte Grantham and Jordan Roper with just 10 points apiece.
- Sheldon McClellan was the difference-maker for the 'Canes with 19 points on 6-8 shooting.

LAST TIME OUT

- Clemson took down Duke, the sixth-ranked team in the country according to the latest coaches' poll, on January 13 at Bon Secours Wellness Arena.
- The Tigers, trailing by as much as 12 in the first half, rallied to claim a 68-63 victory in front of a frenzied crowd at The Well.
- Clemson dominated the glass, owning a +12 margin, while shooting 92 percent at the free throw line.
- Jaron Blossomgame led three Tigers in double figures with 17 points, while Donte Grantham had 16 and Landry Nnoko posted 12.

MIAMI UPDATE

- The Hurricanes come into Saturday's tilt boasting one of the nation's top teams, with a 13-2 overall record and 2-1 ACC mark.
- Miami's eight-game winning streak was snapped last time out at Virginia, who defeated the 'Canes 66-58 in Charlottesville.
- Miami averages 81.1 points per game and shoots nearly 50 percent as a team, while knocking in 76 percent of its free throw attempts.

- Sheldon McClellan is the Hurricanes' leading scorer at 16.1 points per game, and shoots 53 percent from his two-guard position.

VETERANS VS. MIAMI

- *Jaron Blossomgame (*Jr.)* — Averaging 4.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game in two appearances.
- *Gabe DeVoe (So.)* — Did not appear in the 2015 meeting.
- *Sidy Djitte (Jr.)* — Averaging 1.5 rebounds per game in two appearances.
- *Donte Grantham (So.)* — Posted 10 points and seven rebounds in the 2015 meeting.
- *Landry Nnoko (Sr.)* — Averaging 2.0 points and 3.3 rebounds per game in four appearances.
- *Jordan Roper (Gr.)* — Averaging 10.3 points and 2.0 steals per game in four appearances; posted 19 points and four steals in the 2013 meeting in Clemson his freshman year.
- *Josh Smith (Sr.)* — Averaging 2.0 points and 0.8 rebounds pre game in four appearances.

TIGERS BEAT ANOTHER HALL OF FAME COACH

- Clemson coach Brad Brownell has guided the Tigers to wins over Hall of Fame coaches three straight seasons, including 2015-16.
- In 2013-14, his team defeated Duke by a score of 72-59. It was Clemson's first win over the Blue Devils in five seasons.
- In 2014-15, Brownell's Tigers took down Jim Boeheim and the Syracuse Orange in Littlejohn Coliseum, 66-53.
- Louisville coach Rick Pitino and Duke's Mike Krzyzewski were inducted in 2013 and 2001 respectively. Both lost at Clemson this past week.
- In its history, the Clemson program has 19 wins over coaches who have been inducted into the Hall of Fame. Brownell has five, tied with Bill Foster for most in Clemson history over Hall of Fame coaches.

BACK TO BACK TOP-25 WINS

- Clemson has knocked off top-25 opponents in consecutive games, a first for the program since March 1 and 4, 1989. It is only the fourth time in school history it has been achieved in back to back games.

WINS OVER DEFENDING NCAA TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS

• Clemson earned its seventh win over a defending NCAA Champion on January 13 when the Tigers knocked off Duke, 68-63.

• It was the program's first win over a defending national champion since an 83-64 win over North Carolina in 2009-10.

• It first took place in 1974-75 when the Tigers knocked off NC State, 92-70. The Wolfpack had ended UCLA's magical run of seven straight NCAA titles.

• Kentucky has been a victim twice as the defending NCAA Champion. The Tigers downed Rick Pitino's Wildcats in overtime, 79-71, to open the 1996-97 season.

TIGERS OVERCOME DOUBLE-DIGIT DEFICIT VS. DUKE

• Clemson defeated Duke in consecutive home games for the first time since winning three straight from 1995-97.

• In the win over Duke, it was the second straight home game against the Blue Devils where the Tigers won despite trailing by double digits in the first half.

• Clemson trailed 28-16, yet won the game. It was the largest deficit overcome in a win over Duke since 1995-96, when the Tigers rallied from a 15-point deficit.

LONGEST ACC WINNING STREAKS

• Clemson is in the midst of a four-game winning streak in conference play. During the stretch, the Tigers have defeated Florida State, Syracuse, Louisville and Duke.

• The accomplishment is one of only 10 times in 63 ACC seasons that Clemson has compiled a streak of four wins or more. But it is the second

straight season it has been achieved.

• The longest winning streak in program history came in 1966-67, when Bobby Roberts' team won seven in a row — all in February.

TIGERS ACHIEVE THE "DOME DOUBLE"

• Only six schools have defeated Syracuse in football and men's basketball in the Carrier Dome in the same academic year since the facility first opened in the fall of 1980.

• Clemson became the sixth school to accomplish the "Dome Double" on January 5 with a 74-73 overtime win over the Orange. Dabo Swinney's Tiger football team won 37-27 in Syracuse on Nov. 14, 2015.

• The previous schools to complete the football and men's basketball double were Boston College, Miami, Cincinnati, Pittsburgh and Duke.

• He became the fifth coach to achieve 100 wins at Clemson, joining Joe Davis, Bill Foster, Cliff Ellis and Oliver Purnell.

• Clemson coach Brad Brownell is the program's leader in career winning percentage versus ACC competition.

BLOSSOMGAME'S CONSISTENCY

• Jaron Blossomgame leads all Tigers with five 20-point games, despite entering his junior season with just two in his career. He is a big reason the Tigers are averaging 69.5 points per game, up seven points from last year's average.

• Blossomgame's consistency has been a major theme. He leads all Tigers

in double figure scoring games (14) and has averaged 15.8 points per game during Clemson's four-game ACC winning streak.

ROPER EARNS CLEMSON DEGREE

- Jordan Roper achieved a milestone on December 17 when he earned his undergraduate degree in parks, recreation & tourism management after just three and a half years.
- Roper is the first Tiger to play with a degree already in hand since 2011-12, when both Bryan Narcisse and Tanner Smith earned December degrees that season.

ROPER MAKES SEVEN THREE-POINT GOALS VS. FSU

- Jordan Roper had the top shooting performance of his career in the Tigers' ACC home opener against Florida State.
- He made 7-10 three-point goals in the win on January 2, helping the Tigers to an 84-75 victory over the Seminoles.
- Roper's seven threes matched Andre Young for the most by a Tiger in 180 games under coach Brad Brownell. Young previously did it as a senior in 2011-12 against Georgia Tech.

ROPER POSTS 10 ASSISTS AT SYRACUSE

- Jordan Roper had played 110 games in his Clemson career prior to the January 5 game at Syracuse, but never recorded more than seven assists.
- That changed quickly as the Tigers shot over 50 percent for the game, with Roper contributing a career-high 10 assists. He was just two shy of Clemson's ACC road game record of 12 set by Mike Eppley at Duke in 1981-82.
- As a team, Clemson posted 22 assists. It was the most by a Tiger team in an ACC road win since an 82-52 victory at Virginia in 2007-08.

ROPER SCORES CAREER-HIGH 25 POINTS

- Senior guard Jordan Roper posted one of the best offensive games of his career at Minnesota in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- The 6-0 Roper scored a career-high 25 points and did it with just 11 field goal attempts. He made five threes, one off his career high, while canning all six of his free throws.
- Roper's 25-point game was the most by a Tiger on the road since K.J. McDaniels posted 30 at Notre Dame in double overtime on Feb. 11, 2014. Overall, it was the fifth-highest individual point total by a Tiger in 59 road games under head coach Brad Brownell.

ROPER RATIO AMONG CLEMSON'S BEST

- The improved ball-handling displayed on the perimeter has been a key to success this season, and Jordan Roper's play exemplifies it.
- Roper has 73 assists compared to only 21 turnovers, a 3.5 assist-turnover ratio that ranks third-best in the ACC.
- If the season ended today, Roper's ratio would be the best in Clemson history. Grayson Marshall owns the mark with a 2.99 ratio in 1986-87.

GRANTHAM'S THREE-POINT SUCCESS LEADS TO WINS

- The Tigers are 8-1 in two seasons when Donte Grantham makes at least three shots from three-point distance in a game. Clemson is 5-1 this season under the scenario.
- Grantham has hit three or more in back to back wins over top-25 foes in

Louisville and Duke.

- On the season, he leads the Tigers with 33 three-point goals and is third on the team with a 37.1 percent clip outside the arc.
- Grantham is one of only two players in Clemson history 6-8 or taller (Andrius Jurkunas) to lead the Tigers in three-point goals over a season (he had 41 as a freshman).

HOLMES EMERGES AS THREE-POINT THREAT

- The wait was a long one for Avry Holmes, who transferred into the program after two seasons at San Francisco.
- After sitting out and redshirting the 2014-15 season, Holmes made his much anticipated debut November 13 against North Carolina Central.
- Holmes leads the team with a 40 percent accuracy from three, and is second with 32 three-pointers on the season. He has scored double figures in eight of Clemson's last 11 games.

NNOKO TWO DOUBLE-DOUBLES IN LAST THREE GAMES

- It can be argued that Landry Nnoko's 19-point, 10-rebound performance in leading Clemson to an overtime win at Syracuse was the best performance of his career.
- Nnoko's double-double was his first of the season, and first since the High Point game on Nov. 28, 2014. It was his fifth career double-double.
- He followed with a second such performance on January 13 in the win over Duke, posting 12 points and 13 rebounds. It was a season high in rebounds, and it was his second career double-double versus the Blue Devils.

NNOKO PROTECTING THE RIM

- Landry Nnoko has picked up where he left off from 2014-15. He has produced 41 blocked shots through Clemson's 17 games, putting him second among the ACC's leaders with 2.4 per game.
- Nnoko was third in the ACC in blocks per game the past two seasons, posting 63 in 2014-15.
- Nnoko has passed a pair of former Tiger shot-blocking greats on the Clemson career chart so far this season in Sharrod Ford and K.J. McDaniels. Last time out against Duke, he posted four swats to bring his total to 182, pushing him ahead of his former teammate McDaniels.
- Next on the list ahead of him is Jerai Grant, who had 197 from 2007-11.

DJITTE MUCH IMPROVED IN THE POST

- Sidy Djitte's improvement resulted in his first start of the season on December 13 against Alabama.
- The junior center responded by starting the final four games of Clemson's non-conference slate.
- Now coming off the bench, Djitte averages 5.6 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, second-most rebounds on the team despite an average of just 14.5 minutes per contest.

THOMAS JOINS TIGERS AS A TRANSFER

- Clemson added a big man to its 2015 class when former Texas A&M post player Elijah Thomas signed a financial aid agreement to transfer.
- Thomas enrolled in spring semester classes last week, and began working out with the team earlier this week.
- Thomas is a former top-50 ESPN prospect from Lancaster, Texas, and will join fellow transfers Shelton Mitchell and Marcquise Reed, as well as current high school senior Scott Spencer, on the Tigers' 2016-17 team.
- Thomas will not be eligible until after the fall 2016 semester.
