- Tight end Clive Walford and linebacker Denzel Perryman were both named Third Team All-Americans by the Associated Press. Perryman and Walford became Miami's first AP All-Americans since Kenny Phillips was recognized with third-team honors in 2007.
- RB Duke Johnson became the Hurricanes' all-time leading rusher in Miami's season finale against Pittsburgh.
- The Hurricanes faced the nation's ninth toughest schedule in 2014.
- QB Brad Kaaya set the single season all-time freshman record for passing yards, passing touchdowns and completions.

CANES MAKE 38TH BOWL APPEARANCE

- Miami's appearance in the 2014 Duck Commander Independence Bowl marked the 38th time the Hurricanes have competed in a bowl game.
- Following its loss to South Carolina, Miami dropped to 19-19 in its 38 bowl games.
- Miami's appearance in the Duck Commander Independence Bowl marked the second-consecutive season in which it has competed in the postseason.
- Miami's visit to the Duck Commander Independence Bowl marked the Canes' fifth trip to the state of Louisiana for a bowl game.
- Miami's matchup against South Carolina marked the first time the two teams have faced off against one another since 1987.

DUKE JOHNSON BECOMES CANES ALL-TIME LEADING RUSHER

- Junior running back Duke Johnson is Miami's all-time leading rusher with 3,519 yards.
- Johnson rushed for 1,652 yards on the year, which ranks second all-time for a single season. He finished just 101 yards shy of setting the program's single season rushing standard (Willis McGahee, 1,753 - 2002).
- Following the year, Johnson was named All-ACC First Team by the league's coaches and by the ACSMA.
- Johnson finished seventh in the nation in all-purpose yardage (159.46).
- Johnson has rushed for no fewer than 85 yards all year.
- He finished his career with 14 career 100-yard games, tying him for first all-time with Clinton Portis and Edgerrin James for the most 100-yard games in school history.
- Against Cincinnati, he became the Hurricanes' career leader in all-purpose yards as he passed former Miami receiver Santana Moss, who had held the record since 2000. He currently has 5,526 all-purpose yards.

JOHNSON BECOMES WINS PICCOLO AWARD

- Miami running back Duke Johnson was named the recipient of the Atlantic Coast Conference's 2014 Brian Piccolo Award on Dec. 4.
- The Piccolo Award is been given annually since 1970 in memory of the late Brian Piccolo to the "most courageous" football player in the ACC.
- Johnson suffered a fractured fibula and a dislocated ankle in the fourth quarter of Miami's game against Florida State in November of 2013. He underwent surgery two days later to repair his ankle, prematurely ending a stellar sophomore season in which he rushed for 920 yards in less than eight full games.

YIPPEE KAAYA

- Quarterback Brad Kaaya was named the Atlantic Coast Conference Offensive and Overall Rookie of the year following the 2014 regular season.
- Kaaya finished the year by throwing for 13 touchdowns and just three interceptions in the final seven weeks of the season.
- Kaaya was one of only 15 quarterbacks in the country to throw for over 3,000 yards, 26-or-more touchdowns and fewer than 12-or-less interceptions. He was the ONLY true freshman quarterback in the country to accomplish this feat.
- Kaaya threw a touchdown pass in every game during the 2014 campaign.
- Kaaya threw for over 200 yards in nine of the Canes' 13 games last season.
- Kaaya threw for a freshman record 359 yards at Nebraska (Sept. 20).
- Kaaya's 359 passing yards surpassed the previous school standard (342), which he posted the previous week in the Canes' victory over Arkansas State.

FIVE CANES ENROLL EARLY

- Miami Hurricanes Jaquan Johnson, Jahair Jones, Scott Patchan, Charles Perry and Jerome Washington all enrolled early this past January and were able to participate in spring camp.

EIGHT CANES HEAD TO NFL SCOUTING COMBINE

- Eight University of Miami football players traveled to Indianapolis, Ind. Feb. 17-23 to compete in the 2015 NFL Scouting Combine inside Lucas Oil Stadium.
- Defensive end Anthony Chickillo (Tampa, Fla.), wide receiver Phillip Dorsett (Ft. Lauderdale, Fla.), offensive lineman Jonathan Feliciano (Davie Fla.), offensive lineman Ereck Flowers (Miami, Fla.), cornerback Ladarius Gunter (Montgomery, Ala.), running back Duke Johnson (Miami, Fla.), linebacker Denzel Perryman (Coral Gables, Fla.) and tight end Clive Walford (Belle Glade, Fla.) were each invited to the league's primary scouting event.

DEFENSIVE MENTALITY

- Miami finished the year ranked No. 14 nationally in total defense, allowing just 329.6 yards per game. The Hurricanes also ranked No. 17 nationally in passing yards allowed, limiting opponents to



just 192.5 yards per game.

- Opposing quarterbacks have an average 117.24 rating against Miami this season, putting the Hurricanes 33rd-best nationally in that department.
- The defense ranked 41st nationally in turnovers gained with 23.
- Miami has recovered 13 fumbles and has intercepted 10 passes in 2014.
- The 13 fumbles Miami recovered ranked 18th nationally.

PERRYMAN AND WALFORD EARN AP ALL-AMERICA HONORS IN 2014

- Senior linebacker Denzel Perryman and senior tight end Clive Walford were among those recognized with third-team All-America honors from the Associated Press, it was announced on Dec. 16.
- Perryman, who was a finalist for the Butkus Award honoring the top linebacker in the country, earned the recognition following another impressive season where he led the team in tackles (102) and tackles for loss (8.5).
- Walford, a finalist for the Mackey Award, earned the recognition after he caught 44 passes for 676 yards with seven touchdowns in his final season. He also eclipsed the top career totals of any Hurricane tight end in program history.
- Perryman and Walford became Miami's first AP All-Americans since Kenny Phillips was recognized with third-team honors in 2007.

SUN LIFE STADIUM RENOVATIONS FOR 2015

- The modernization of Sun Life Stadium is moving ahead, and Miami Hurricanes football season ticket holders will experience a new game-day environment and amenities with the kickoff of the 2015 season.
- Sun Life Stadium will be remodeled and redesigned into a state-of-the-art sporting venue with enhanced comfort for fans, improved concessions and concourse areas, multiple premium seating areas, and new technology inside and outside of the stadium.
- The extensive renovations will significantly decrease the total number of seats at Sun Life Stadium and will impact all season ticket holder locations.

FIVE CANES EARN ACADEMIC ALL-ACC

- Miami Hurricanes Braxton Berrios, Anthony Chickillo, Nantambu Akil-Fentress, Calvin Heurtelou and Justin Vogel were among 65 players selected to the 2014 All-ACC Academic Football Team on Feb. 11.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- In 2014, 13 different Miami players have caught passes for the Hurricanes.
- Nine Miami pass catchers had 100 yards-or-more receiving this season.
- The Hurricanes were one of only four schools in the ACC to have nine pass catchers with 100 yards or more.
- Seven Hurricane receivers had 15-or-more receptions in 2014.

TOUGH SLEDDING

- Six of Miami's seven losses in 2014 came at night with the Hurricanes falling to Louisville, Nebraska, Georgia Tech, Florida State, Virginia and Pittsburgh. Four of those losses came on the road.
- The combined record of these seven teams at the end of the regular season was 60-32.
- The Hurricanes' 2014 opponents had a combined winning percentage of .597, which is the ninth toughest at the FBS level.
- Miami faced 11 bowl eligible teams in 2014.
- Miami's 2014 schedule featured eight night games.
- The Hurricanes were one of only three FBS teams that played all of their road games at night. LSU and San Diego State are the only other schools that played all of their road games at night.

THE 1-2 PUNCH

- Against North Carolina, the Miami rushing attack featured two running backs that surpassed 100 yards on the ground as Duke Johnson and Joe Yearby rushed for 177 and 104 yards, respectively.
- It marked just the 12th time since 1980 that Miami had two running backs surpass 100 yards rushing in the same game.
- Prior to this season, two running backs at Miami had not surpassed 100 yards rushing in the same game since Jarrett Payton (131) and Tyrone Moss (115) did so against Pittsburgh on Nov. 29, 2003.
- In its 30-6 victory over Virginia Tech, Johnson rushed for a Lane Stadium record 249 yards and sophomore Gus Edwards rumbled for 115 yards. Both rushing totals served as single game career highs.
- Prior to their game against Virginia Tech, the Hurricanes cruised to a 55-34 victory over Cincinnati. In that contest Johnson and Yearby rushed for 162 and 113 yards, respectively.

REDSHIRTS

- This past season, head coach Al Golden redshirted 16 players.
- The 16 redshirted freshman are the most Golden and his staff have redshirted since arriving on campus in 2011.
