Rivalry Renewed...

The Hurricanes make their return to Tallahassee for a three-game series against the second-ranked Seminoles of Florida State that could have major implications on postseason play. FSU, who took two of three games in last season's series on the road in Coral Gables, has racked up an impressive 16-2 record through their first 18 conference games.

The Seminoles serve as the leaders of the Atlantic Division, while the Hurricanes are tied atop the Coastal with North Carolina at 12-6.

Two of the Game's Best...

The two teams squaring off at Dick Howser Stadium bring some of the most influential leaders in college baseball history to the diamond. The Hurricanes, under the direction of Jim Morris (19th season), are 121-140-4 all-time against the Seminoles, under the guidance of Mike Martin (33rd season).

Midweek Warriors

The Hurricanes, facing many talented in-state competitors in their midweek matchups, improved their record to 8-2 record in games taking place on either Tuesday or Wednesday with their recent win over Stetson University. Their eight wins include a 3-0 victory at Florida Gulf Coast, home and away wins against the Owls of Florida Atlantic, a 3-2 win at No. 12 UCF in a tense environment and an 11-4 drubbing of Saint Thomas University (Fla.)

Last Time Out...

The Hurricanes salvaged a home series against the Seminoles by taking the series finale at Alex Rodriguez Park by a final score of 5-1. Former starter E.J. Encinosa pitched six strong innings in the Sunday matinee, striking out nine batters and allowing zero runs.

Miami was powered offensively by a 3-for-5, two-RBI performance from Rony Rodriguez and a 2-for-4 showing from outfielder Dale Carey. The Canes pounded out ten hits against Florida State pitchers on the day (May 1), improving to 16-7 in the ACC with the win.

Scouting the Competition: Florida State...

The Seminoles have put together another impressive campaign through their first 37 games of 2012, boasting a 30-7 overall record and a 16-2 mark in conference play. The Noles are ranked in the Top-5 of nearly every major collegiate baseball poll.

Two unlikely stars for the Noles have emerged in freshmen starters Brandon Leibrandt and Mike Compton, who have earned spots as No. 1 and No. 2 in the weekend rotation. Leibrandt has a 2.68 ERA through nine starts, while Compton boasts a perfect 6-0 record through his first nine.

Offensively, Florida State has been led by junior Jayce Boyd (.393 average, 39 RBI's), senior James Ramsey (.391 average, nine homeruns) and junior Devon Travis (.347 average, 23 RBI's).

UNIVERSITY OF MIAMI HEAD COACH JIM MORRIS - 19TH SEASON

2001, 1999, & 1994 National Coach of the Year • 2008 ACC COACH OF THE YEAR



In his 19th season at Miami, no other program nor head coach, has qualified for the College World Series as much as Morris and his Hurricanes. Miami, which has qualified for the NCAA Tournament a NCAA-record 39 consecutive years, has made it to Omaha in 11 of Morris' 18 seasons in Coral Gables. Morris set an NCAA record for guiding a program to the CWS in each of his first six years at UM. In addition, Morris won a record 13 consecutive NCAA Regionals from 1994-2006. His teams have qualified for NCAA Regionals for the last 27 years, 18 at Miami and nine at Georgia Tech.

Morris has directed the Hurricanes to a 840-332-3 (.716) mark since arriving in 1994. Including his 12 seasons at Georgia Tech (1982-93), Morris has forged a 1,344-576-4 (.700) Division I record in 30 years as a head coach. Overall, Morris has been the head coach at the collegiate level for 33 seasons, spending the first four at DeKalb (Ga.) C.C. (now Georgia Perimeter College) from 1976-79, and has recorded a 1,475-617-4 (.705) mark

In addition to carrying on Miami's great baseball reputation in the last 19 years, Morris has personally led the charge in the construction of Alex Rodriguez Park, and has logged hundreds of hours raising funds for the stadium project.

MORRIS IS A REGIONAL REGULAR

Jim Morris earned his 27th consecutive NCAA regional bid in 2011 when he guided the 'Canes to the NCAA Gainesville Regional. He has led Miami to a regional in each of his 18 seasons (1994-2011), winning 15 of his last 18 appearances. The 13 consecutive regional championships (94-06) was an NCAA record. He also went to nine straight regionals from 1985-93 with Georgia Tech. Additionally, Miami has advanced to nine Super Regionals under Morris.

Affectionately known as "3" by those surrounding the UM program, Morris led the 2011 Hurricanes to their 39th-straight NCAA Tournament. Three players from the 2011 team were selected in last year's Major League Baseball Draft. In 2008, the Canes reached the College World Series after winning the Atlantic Coast Conference, widely considered one of the toughest - if not the toughest - collegiate baseball conferences in the country.

MORRIS IN HIS 34TH SEASON AS A COLLEGE COACH

Morris currently has a 1,344-576-4 (.700) record at the Division I level. As a head coach overall, he has compiled a 1,475-617-4 (.705) record over 30-plus years.

Jim Morris notched his milestone 1,000th win against his former school, Georgia Tech, with a 16-13 win on April 4, 2004. Thirteen days later, he notched win No. 500 at Miami with a 7-3 win against Florida State on April 17. Morris' 1,000th win as a head coach, including four years at DeKalb Junior College, came in a 5-3 win over Northeastern on March 23, 2001.

Prior to his 18 seasons in Coral Gables, Morris went 504-244-1 at Georgia Tech from 1982-1993. In his first stint as a head coach, he guided DeKalb Junior College to a 131-41 mark from 1976-79.

JIM MORRIS MAKING HISTORY

- Guided the Miami Hurricanes to College World Series National Championship in 1999 and 2001.
- The only coach in NCAA history to take a school to the College World Series in each of his first six years at a program. Morris has gone to Omaha with Miami in 11 of 18 seasons and led the Canes to 13 straight NCAA Regional Championships, an NCAA record.
- Named National Coach of the Year five times while at Miami by Baseball America in 1994 and by the ABCA and Collegiate Baseball in 1999 and

2001.

- Sent 150 players to the professional ranks, including Yonder Alonso (Cincinnati Reds), Pat Burrell (Rays), Ryan Braun (Brewers), Danny Graves (Astros), Alex Cora (Mets), Nomar Garciaparra (Dodgers), Jon Jay (St. Louis Cardinals), Gabby Sanchez (Florida Marlins), Danny Valencia (Minnesota Twins) and Jason Varitek (Red Sox).
- Has served three stints with the U.S. National Team: Assistant Coach for 1987 Pan American Games (Silver), Head Coach for 1989 Presidential Cup (Silver) and Head Coach for 1990 Goodwill Games (Bronze).

SHORTSTOPS AND JIM MORRIS

Morris, who played shortstop during college at Elon and then in the Boston Red Sox organization, has had great success developing the position while a head coach. Over the last decade, Morris has taught prominent shortstops such as Nomar Garciaparra at Georgia Tech and Bobby Hill and Alex Cora at Miami.

Morris worked with Javy Rodriguez, who entered 2002 as a preseason All-American. Rodriguez led UM in just about every category as a junior in 2001, including a national-high 66 stolen bases.

Morris coached Hill, who played for the San Diego Padres, from 1997-99. Before Hill, it was Cora and Mike Metcalfe. Both players went on to play at the Major League level with the Los Angeles Dodgers. Cora is currently with the Mets. Garciaparra played under Morris during the coaches' final two seasons in Atlanta and went on to become an All-Star with the Red Sox and played for the Oakland A's in 2009.

Return of the Mack...

Since the team's series opener with then-No. 3 North Carolina, no player has had more sizable of an impact than junior outfielder Chantz Mack. The Homestead, Fla. native, who has started all eight games since, has recorded team-highs of 12 hits and 10 RBI over that span, hitting a team-best .375 (12-for-32).

Mack singled in two runs in the top of the ninth in the series finale against the Hokies to give the Hurricanes their first lead of the game, and also recorded two RBI's in the series opener. He has risen his average over 40 points in the process, from .242 to his current .287. Mack is also riding a five-game hitting streak into Tallahassee.

Extra. Extra!...

Junior infielder Stephen Perez has had a key impact for the Hurricanes this season since returning from an arm injury that limited his playing time earlier in the year. The Miami native, who has played both second and shortstop, has an impressive .509 slugging percentage through his 32 starts. That figure is good for second-best on the team.

14 of Perez' 30 hits have gone for extra-bases (47%), including a team-best four triples and second-best four homeruns. His 21 RBI's are second-most on the team despite missing games earlier in the season to rehab. His eight-game hitting streak in March is the third-longest of any player this season, and he finished the weekend in Virginia Tech with a team-best five hits.

Veterans Stepping Up..

The Canes received a big boost in the offseason when transfer catcher Peter O'Brien and graduate student lefthander Eric Erickson were both declared eligible by the NCAA. True to their elections, the team's two captains for the 2012 season have played key roles through the team's first half of the season.

O'Brien is currently the team leader in a number of key hitting categories: batting average (.354), runs (31), hits (45), doubles (11), homeruns (10), slugging percentage (.677) and on-base percentage (.465).

Through his first eight starts of the season, Erickson (6-3) is ranked in the conference Top-25 for ERA (2.91, No. 14) and innings pitched (58.2, seventh). He has a staff-best 44:5 K:BB ratio. The weekend in Tallahassee will mark the homecoming of the veteran southpaw, who is 6-0 all-time against FSU (including a win in the '08 CWS)

Weekly Highlights...

The Hurricanes finished last week only 1-3, dropping their midweek game against FGCU and two of three on the road in Blacksburg.

◆ *Chantz Mack* finished the weekend with team-highs of five hits and four RBI. Since being inserted into the starting lineup, he has raised his average over 40 points to its current .286.

◆ *Eric Erickson* earned his staff-best sixth win of the season with another impressive showing on Friday night against the Hokies. The veteran southpaw pitched 6.2 strong innings, allowing only two runs in the team's 6-4 victory.

◆ *Stephen Perez* also had an impressive weekend at the plate, finishing 5-for-10 (.500) with two stolen bases. The junior is now second on the team with seven thefts on the year.

Conference Is The Key

Juniors Chantz Mack and Stephen Perez, alongside freshman Jarred Mederos, are the three Hurricanes with a .300 clip or better through 18 conference games this season. Mack leads the way with a .359 average (in 8 starts), while Perez (.327), and Mederos (.304) follow behind him. Perez leads the team with a .435 on-base percentage and .558 slugging percentage in conference play.

Sophomore Standout

Though he often flies under the radar, sophomore infielder Brad Fieger has become one of the key cogs in Head Coach Jim Morris' lineup. Fieger, one of only three Hurricanes to start all 36 games so far this season, has been switched around in the lineup and made the midseason shift from first base to third base with clear success. Entering the team's weekend match-up with FSU, Fieger has the second most hits on the team (45) and has the second-highest batting average (.317). He is one of only two players on the team hitting above .300 (Peter O'Brien, .354) for the season.

You're the Best Around!

For his incredible accomplishments at the plate over a five-game stretch in March, senior catcher Peter O'Brien was named ACC Player of the Week on 3/19.

The Miami Gardens, Fla. native finished the week batting .529, with three homeruns and nine RBI over the team's five-game stretch. He also connected for three multi-hit games, including three doubles and 21 total bases.

History in the Making

The Hurricanes became the first team to face the Miami Marlins in the brand new Marlins Park, as they helped open the stadium with an exhibition. The Canes, who earned the victory in the 2011 rendition of the series, fell on a walk-off hit in the ninth inning against the MLB club. Freshman lefthander Andrew Suarez pitched three scoreless innings in his starting debut against the Marlins.

Miami Predicted to Finish Third In Coastal Division

Miami baseball was predicted to finish third in the Coastal Division of the Atlantic Coast Conference Coaches Preseason Poll. The poll is voted on by the league's 12 head coaches. Capturing a 19-10 league record in 2011, the Hurricanes finished the year fourth in the Coastal Division. Miami posted a 38-23 overall record en route to their 39th consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance in the Gainesville Regional.

Opening Series Sweep

The University of Miami opened the season against Rutgers for the fourth time in as many years, and marked the beginning of its 2012 campaign with a sweep of the Scarlet Knights. It was the second time in four tries the Canes have swept Rutgers to begin their season.

Encinosa Returns to the Bullpen

Junior right-hander E.J. Encinosa, who served as a starter for the 2011 season, has returned to the bullpen for the 2012 campaign. The righty earned *Louisville Slugger* Freshman All-America honors for his work in the pen in 2010, where he posted an impressive ERA of 2.20 in 29 appearances on the hill. Encinosa recorded the first save of his season in the series finale against Rutgers, pitching a scoreless ninth inning.

The flamethrower recorded two saves in the team's opening conference series against visiting Boston College, and also closed out a 3-2 game in impressive fashion at No. 19 UCF. He recorded saves in series' against Duke and Maryland, and currently sits fourth in the conference with seven saves. His most recent

Over the last four years, Miami has produced an impressive four first round MLB draft picks. The last first rounder, Yasmani Grandal, was selected in the first round in 2010. In 2011, the Canes had three players drafted: Harold Martinez (Philadelphia Phillies, third round), Zeke DeVoss (Chicago Cubs, third round) and Danny Miranda (St. Louis Cardinals, eighth round).

Catcher Peter O'Brien and righthander Eric Whaley were both named to the *Louisville Slugger* Preseason All-American Baseball teams in late December. O'Brien headlined the second team at catcher, while Whaley earned third team accolades after an impressive sophomore campaign.

ALEX RODRIGUEZ PARK INFORMATION

Renovations to Alex Rodriguez Park are thanks in large part to a \$3.9 million contribution by New York Yankees third baseman and 11-time MLB All-Star Alex Rodriguez. The gift - the largest ever to the University of Miami baseball program - has assisted the program in continuing to develop first-class facilities. The official announcement of his gift was made on Oct. 10, 2002.

Alex Rodriguez Park has taken form in a three-phase process:

- Phase I called for seating modifications, new dugouts, new stadium lighting and utility infrastructure and new rest rooms.
- Phase II entailed renovating below the grand stand area in addition to adding new concession areas.
- The final phase included adding a new clubhouse, weight room, training room, meeting room, video room and academic area. In addition, a new press box – along with four VIP suites – have been built atop the grandstand. This past offseason, addition seating was added down both lines while a new scoreboard was constructed in left field.
