## Miami Welcomes a Pair of Old North State Foes...

The University of Miami volleyball team welcomes teams from the Old North State this weekend as the University of North Carolina Tar Heels and NC State Wolfpack come to the James L. Knight Sports Complex for a pair of matches. The Canes play UNC on Friday, Nov. 4 (6 p.m.), followed by the Wolfpack on Sunday, Nov. 6 (1 p.m.).

Miami enters the weekend having won four consecutive Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) matches and holds an 8-1 record at home on the campaign. Dating back to last season, the Canes have won 13 of their last 14 at home.

The Hurricanes come into the weekend with a record of 19-3 overall and an ACC record of 10-3, sitting third place in the league right now.

## Scouting North Carolina...

The North Carolina Tar Heels enter the weekend as one of the hottest teams in the ACC with a record of 19-5 overall and 11-2 in the ACC.

Four Tar Heels have tallied at least 205 kills on a .218 attack percentage or better: Emily McGee (334/.270), Kayla Berringer (232/.218), Chaniel Nelson (209/.240) and Tia Gaffen (205/.304).

UNC is also stout defensively, ranking fifth in the conference in blocks per set (2.29). Chaniel Nelson and Cameron Van Noy lead the way for the Tar Heels up front, averaging 0.85 and 1.20 blocks per frame respectively. As a team, Carolina is holding its opponents to a .178 attack efficiency, the third-best mark in the conference. Carolina also ranks fourth in the league in digs per set (16.05). Gibson leads the Tar Heels with 372 digs, followed by McGee (262) and freshman Ece Taner (133).

## Series against the Tar Heels...

The Canes hold a slight 11-10 edge in the all-time series against the Tar Heels, but it's been UNC dominating of late, winning four of the last five meetings between the two schools. Earlier this year, UM dropped a tough 3-2 decision in Chapel Hill, while it was UMIami take the match against the Heels last season in Coral Gables.

## Scouting NC State...

An NC State team that has played considerably well this year comes to Florida with a 15-8 record (3-7 ACC). Senior middle blocker Margaret Salata recorded a career-high 19 kills last weekend against Boston College.

Salata leads the Wolfpack with a career-high

283 kills this season, and her 3.04 kills per set ranks ninth in the ACC. She has recorded 845 kills in her four seasons with the Pack. Her 373 career blocks ranks seventh in school history. She also ranks fourth in the ACC with 117 blocks and eighth in the league with a .334 hitting percentage.

Senior libero Kelly Wood is one of two ironmen for the Wolfpack this season. She and junior setter Megan Cyr are the only two players on the roster who have played in all 97 sets this season.

## Series against the Wolfpack...

Miami leads the all-time series against the Wolfpack with a commanding 13-1 edge. The Wolfpack took their first win against the Hurricanes last season on the heels of a 3-0 decision in Raleigh, N.C. However, UMIami claimed a tough 3-2 decision against the Pack earlier this year in a classic thriller played in Raleigh on Oct. 7.

## The Road to 20...

With its next win, the University of Miami will capture its fifth 20-win season in school history, and the third in the last four seasons (also doing so in 2008 and 2010).

## Dig Pink a Success...

The Hurricanes enjoyed their fourth consecutive year of success in helping raise money for the Susan G. Komen Foundation in support of Breast Cancer Awareness. This year, UMIami raised a considerable amount of money last weekend for its annual Dig Pink match against the University of Virginia on Friday, Oct. 28.

## Lucky Number 21...

Senior middle blocker Ali Becker has surged onto the scene this year for the Hurricanes. The Katy, Texas native leads the league in hitting percentage and ranks 10th nationally in that category as she hits at a .401 clip. Becker also has a team second-best 231 kills (3.00 k/s).

## Poll Position...

The University of Miami is No. 26, respectively, this week in the AVCA Coaches Poll. In the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI), UM is No. 25 this week and is second amongst ACC schools in this week's RPI, trailing only Florida State (No. 11). North Carolina is No. 29.

# Nicole Lantagne Welch

Head Coach

11th Year at Miami

Nicole Lantagne Welch is in her 11th season as head coach of the University of Miami volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in eight of the last 10 seasons,

including ending the 2010 campaign ranked No. 26 in the RPI polls and No. 28 in the Pablo rankings.

Last season, Lantagne Welch helped guide the Canes to their second 20-win season in the last three years, and the second consecutive year in which UMiami advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Miami ended the season with a 23-9 overall mark (13-7 Atlantic Coast Conference) and finished third in the conference regular season standings. Along the way, the Hurricanes defeated NCAA Tournament participants Florida State, Middle Tennessee State, Georgia Southern, Wichita State and North Carolina.

At the end of the year, Lantagne Welch saw her first-ever AVCA All-American honored in the form of Lane Carico, collecting third team accolades following a record-breaking year. Carico became the first player in school history with 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in a career, as well as leading the ACC in double-doubles – and later being the only player in the league to amass at least 400 kills and 400 digs on the campaign.

Carico and teammate Katie Gallagher each claimed AVCA All-East Region Team honors, while freshman libero Ryan Shaffer set a new school record for digs by a freshman (539 / 4.53 per set). As for Carico, she would also earn her



third consecutive All-ACC Team nod and All-East Region honor.

In 2009, Lantagne Welch helped the Hurricanes to their second NCAA Tournament appearance, competing in the Gainesville [Fla.] Regional. UM earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after holding the 33rd toughest schedule in the nation according to the end-of-year RPI rankings. Earlier in the season, Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to the Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic championship.

She would add to her growing list of All-Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes, as well as All-America honorable mention performers, seeing senior libero Cassie Loessberg and sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico named to both lists. Carico and Loessberg each collected AVCA All-America Honorable Mention selections, while both were tabbed to the AVCA All-East Region Team.

During the 2008 campaign, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by four seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08, '10) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her 10 years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 19.2 wins per seasons with a career record of 192-109.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a

major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duval, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Coral Gables.

## Hurricanes VB Media Policy

### KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, in-between the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Alex Rodriguez Park, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

### MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Office of Athletic Communications. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

### MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-set and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post match notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Athletic Communications Director Bryan J. Harvey.

### WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Office of Athletic Communications at (305) 284-3244.

### INTERVIEWS

### Gallagher Chasing the Mark...

Redshirt senior setter Katie Gallagher is chasing the all-time mark for career assists, now in second place with a total of 4,780. She needs just 158 more to surpass Jill Robinson (2003-06) on the list. Gallagher is also chasing the school's all-time list for service aces, now in third place with 124. She needs just 10 more to pass Cassie LOessberg (2006-09) for the all-time lead.

### Carico Named Lowe's Senior CLASS Finalist...

Lane Carico of the University of Miami has been selected as one of 10 finalists for this year's Lowe's Senior CLASS Award for volleyball. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition.

Carico, an outside hitter from Manhattan Beach, Calif., became Miami's all-time leader in kills during the second set of the Hurricanes' 3-0 win over Duke on Sunday, Oct. 2. The 2010 AVCA Third Team All-America player currently has 1,532 kills throughout her career. She also ranks second all-time in points (1,733), third in kills per set (3.75), third in digs (1,505), fourth in service aces (109) and eighth in sets played (409).

On the campaign, Carico has helped the Hurricanes to their first-ever regular season ranking with the Canes getting as high as No. 20 in Week Five. Carico is fourth in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) in kills with 186 (3.44 per set), fifth in digs with 233 (4.31 per set) and fourth in points with 212.5 (3.94 per set). She's also second on the team with 15 service aces.

### Carico Sets School Record for Kills...

Senior outside hitter Lane Carico's fourth kill of the match versus Duke on October 2 allowed her to etch her name as the school's all-time leader in kills, surpassing Karla Johnson (2002-05) atop the list. Currently, Carico has 1,589 career kills.

### Coaching Milestone Achieved...

UMiami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch collected her 200th career win following the Hurricanes 3-0 win over Auburn. Lantagne Welch is already the winningest coach in UM volleyball history, and has served as the only coach since the program was brought back in 2001.

### Miami on the National Stage...

In a pair of nationally televised games this year, UM went 1-1 against Florida State and Virginia Tech, respectively. The Canes dropped a tough decision at FSU on ESPNU, while bouncing back to sweep Virginia Tech last weekend on Fox Sports at home in Coral Gables.

### Lane Carico Earns Third ACC Weekly Honor...

For the third time this year, Lane Carico picked up ACC Player of the Week honors after a stellar performance against Wake Forest (Sept. 30) and Duke (Oct. 2).

Carico helped Miami extend its winning streak to four matches and its home court winning streak to 10 straight as she registered 5.50 kills per set and 3.67 digs per set in wins over Wake Forest and Duke, respectively. The native of Manhattan Beach, Calif. hit .389 over the weekend and put down a team-high 33 kills against just five errors

She helped Miami sweep Duke and break a three-match losing skid to the Blue Devils, recording the first win over Duke since a 3-0 decision in 2008. Additionally, Carico became the school's all-time leader in kills with 1,495, surpassing Karla Johnson for the top honor. In both matches on the weekend, Carico picked up double-doubles to extend her streak to four and increase her total to nine on the year.

### Miami Takes Hurricane Invitational Title...

With wins against FAMU, Auburn and nationally ranked Oklahoma, the Hurricanes collected their second consecutive Hurricane Invite title inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex. Overall, the Canes have won four of the last five Hurricane Invitational titles. The win over No. 18 Oklahoma was the first win for the Hurricanes over a ranked team since Dec. 7, 2002 when they defeated No. 15 Wisconsin in the Madison [Wis.] Regional of the NCAA Tournament.

### Carico Repeats as ACC Player of the Week...

University of Miami senior outside hitter Lane Carico was once again selected as ACC Player of the Week (Sept. 12-18). This marked the second straight week Carico picked up conference player of the week accolades.

The Manhattan Beach, Calif. native compiled 30 kills on a .258 hitting percentage for 3.75 kills per set and had 32 digs in eight

sets. She also had five blocks and four service aces. Carico came up huge in the win over No. 18 Oklahoma with 19 kills and 16 digs to help pull off the come-from-behind upset. It was the first victory over a ranked opponent for the Hurricanes since December 7, 2002, when Miami beat No. 15 Wisconsin in the NCAA Tournament.

### Carico, Gallagher, Johnson All-Tournament...

Lane Carico, Katie Gallagher and Alex Johnson were all named to the Hurricane Invitational All-Tournament Team after helping UMIAMI to the tournament title. Carico picked up Hurricane Invitational MVP honors in staking a season-high 19 kills and posting 16 digs in the championship match win over the Sooners.

### Gallagher Moves Into Record Books...

During the Hurricane Invitational, redshirt senior setter Katie Gallagher became just the second player in UMIAMI volleyball history to post at least 4,000 assists and 1,000 digs in a career. She joins Jill Robinson (2003-06) as the only other Hurricanes player to do so.

### Lane Carico Wins ACC Player of the Week...

Lane Carico was named as the Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Week (Sept. 4-10) after turning in 3.10 kills per set and 5.00 digs per set in three matches at the *Pepperdine Asics Classic* in Malibu, Calif. The Canes won the tournament with a 3-1 decision against the host Pepperdine Waves.

UMiami took down LSU in the title match of the Tiger Classic to begin the 2011 regular season inside the Maravich Center in Baton Rouge, La.

For the Canes, it marked the fourth consecutive year they have won a regular season tournament on the road.

### Carico and Gallagher Named Preseason All-ACC...

Senior outside hitter **Lane Carico** and redshirt senior **Katie Gallagher** were named to the Preseason All-ACC Team announced Tuesday by the ACC Office.

Carico has been named to the All-ACC Team the last two years and the All-ACC Freshman Team in 2008.

### Last Time Out - vs. Virginia Tech (Oct. 30)...

The University of Miami rode redshirt senior Katie Gallagher's error-free performance to a

3-0 victory over visiting Virginia Tech on Sunday inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex. The Hurricanes took down the Hokies in a match televised on Fox Sports.

The 25-23, 25-16, 25-19 victory gave the Hurricanes sole possession of third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference and improved Miami to 19-3 overall and 9-3 in league action. The Hokies' loss dropped Virginia Tech to 13-11 on the season and 6-7 in ACC play.

Gallagher, a setter from Winter Park, Fla., hammered out seven kills on 10 swings to hit a career-high .700 in the match, while notching a match-high 39 assists and adding eight digs. Senior middle blocker Ali Becker, ranked 16th nationally in hitting percentage and leading the ACC in that department, recorded a match-high tying 13 kills and hit .545 to bolster the offense, while redshirt freshman middle blocker Emani Sims joined them with a .500 clip as she staked nine kills on 16 swings and collected two blocks.

As a whole, the Hurricanes hit .359 in the match, marking the sixth time on the year UMiami has eclipsed the .350 plateau. The Hokies hit .279 in the match behind the efforts of Cara Baarendse with a match-high tying 13 kills without committing an error in 30 attempts to give the senior a .433 hitting percentage.

Senior All-America outside hitter Lane Carico

added 12 digs on the afternoon to go along with her 12 kills to give her a fourth consecutive double-double and the 16th overall for the season. Sophomore right side Alex Johnson added a team-high 14 digs and five assists.

Becker has hit above .300 in the last 14 matches consecutively, while hitting .500 or better in seven matches – the last two consecutive.

After trailing late in the first, Miami put together a 7-3 run that erased a 20-18 deficit. The run was started by Carico's kill off the block of the Hokies' Samantha Gostling. Johnson recorded one of her six kills on the day to tie the set at 20. After an attack error charged to the Canes allowed the set to become tied again at 23, UM used consecutive errors by the Hokies to take the first set win.

Miami came out of the gate hot in the second set as the Canes jumped out to a 15-8 lead. UM never trailed en route to the 25-16 win. In the third frame, two lead changes and two ties occurred early before the Hurricanes used a 9-4 run that allowed them to put distance between their counterparts from Blacksburg, Va. at 14-8. Sims registered the final kill of the match down the middle to give the Canes their eighth home win of the year.

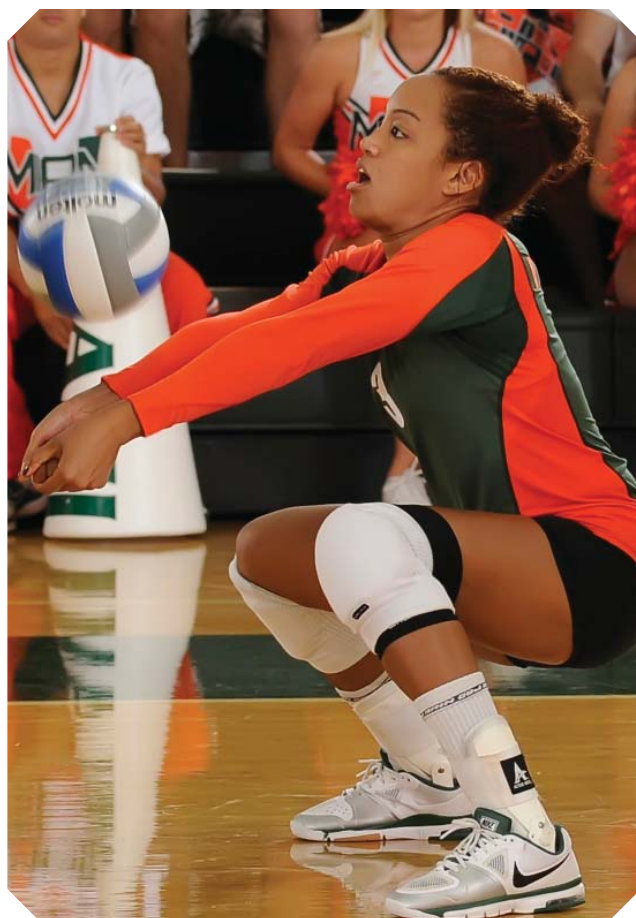
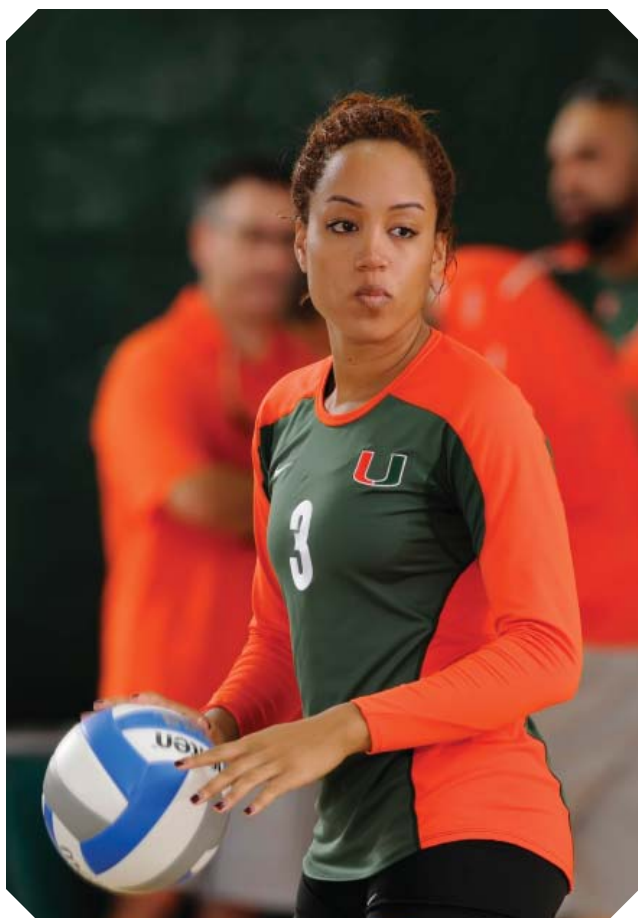
