CANES OPEN SEASON IN PRIMETIME AT MARYLAND

- ▶ The University of Miami football team will open its regular season schedule when it travels to College Park to play Maryland in a conference match-up on Labor Day night, Monday, Sept. 27 at 8 p.m. at Byrd Stadium. The game will be televised live on ESPN and ESPN3D.
- ▶ Miami opens its 86th season of college football with its 17th game all-time against Maryland. The Hurricanes and the Terrapins have faced each other just twice in Atlantic Coast Conference play, with both teams winning one game.
- ▶ Both the Hurricanes and the Terrapins begin their seasons with new head coaches. Miami's Al Golden comes to the program after spending the last five seasons as the head coach of Temple, while Maryland is led by Randy Edsall, who spent the last 12 seasons as the head coach at Connecticut.
- ▶ The Hurricanes finished second in the ACC Coastal Division last season and were invited to the Hyundai Sun Bowl where they faced Notre Dame, falling 33-17. The Terrapins finished second in the ACC Atlantic Division a year ago and were rewarded with a match-up against ECU in the Military Bowl. Maryland won the contest, 51-20.
- ▶ Miami is 58-26-1 in season-opening games, including a 39-14-1 mark at home and a 19-12 mark on the road.
- ▶ The Hurricanes' offense is coming off one of its most impressive seasons in UM history, tallying 5,493 total yards - the second most in school history. The 936 total plays in 2010 was a school record and the 288 total first downs equaled the 1984 mark for the most in program history.
- ▶ The highly touted Miami rushing attack features junior Mike James and sophomore Lamar Miller. Miller carried the ball 108 times for 669 yards (6.0 yards per rush), while James recorded 70 carries for 398 yards (5.7 yards per rush). Along with the graduated Damien Berry, Miller and James keyed a rushing attack that totaled 2,388 yards in 2010 - the third-most in Miami history and the most since 1957.
- ▶ A number of newcomers are expected to contribute this year for the Canes, with senior cornerback Mike Williams, junior defensive tackle Darius Smith, sophomore punter Dalton Botts, freshman defensive end Anthony Chickillo, freshman wide receiver Phillip Dorsett and freshman cornerback Thomas Finnie among those who could see action early on.

COACHES SHOW

UM's coaches show, "Hurricane Game Day with Al Golden" airs twice weekly on CSS, at 5:30 p.m. Thursdays and 10 a.m. Saturdays. The show is hosted by Joe Zagacki and Don Bailey Jr. and features Hurricanes players as coach Golden's guests.

HURRICANE HOTLINE

Hurricane Hotline is a weekly two-hour show hosted by Joe Zagacki and Don Bailey, Jr. that airs from 7-9 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday nights during the season from Monty's (2550 South Bayshore Drive Coconut Grove, Florida 33133). Hurricane Hotline features interviews with UM head football coach Al Golden, players, coaches and other UM personnel as well as other featured guests. Fans are encouraged to listen on 560 WQAM or view the show in-person at Monty's in Coconut Grove.

The MIAMI-MARYLAND SERIES

- ▶ The Canes are 8-8 all-time versus Maryland, beating the Terrapins 26-20 in Miami last season.
- ▶ Monday's meeting will be just the third between the two teams since Miami joined the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2004. Maryland defeated Miami 14-13 in 2006.

A CANES WIN OVER THE TERRAPINS WOULD...

- ▶ Give Al Golden his first win as head coach of the program.
- ▶ Give Miami its fifth-consecutive season-opening victory.
- ▶ Give UM its third-straight win in an ACC opener.

The COACHES

- ▶ Both the Hurricanes and the Terrapins begin their seasons with new head coaches. Miami's Al Golden comes to the program after spending the last five seasons as the head coach of Temple, while Maryland is led by Randy Edsall, who spent the last 12 seasons as the head coach of Connecticut.

Scouting THE TERRAPINS

- ▶ Maryland sophomore quarterback Danny O'Brien - The 2010 ACC Rookie of the Year - was named to the preseason watch lists for the Archie Manning and Davey O'Brien Awards, which are each given annually to the nation's top quarterback. In 2010, O'Brien enjoyed one of the top seasons by a freshman signal caller in ACC history. The Kernersville, N.C. native ended the year ranked fifth nationally among all freshmen quarterbacks in passing efficiency (134.5) and third in touchdown passes (22). He threw 22 touchdown passes with only 8 interceptions, ranking fourth in the ACC in pass efficiency, sixth in passing yards and seventh in total offense. O'Brien finished 2010 with the sixth-best ACC single season in passing yards for a freshman and the eighth-best in total offense. The 22 touchdown passes gave him the third-best total as an ACC rookie.
- ▶ Senior running back Davin Meggett ranks third in the ACC in active career rushing yards. Only Boston College's Montel Harris (3,600 yds.) and Florida State's Jermaine Thomas (1,804 yds.) have gained more on the ground than Meggett.
- ▶ Four freshman top the depth chart for Maryland, including fullback Tyler Cierski, cornerback Jeremiah Johnson, holder Michael Tart and place kicker Justus Pickett.
- ▶ On Aug. 22 Maryland unveiled its new football uniforms. In all, 16 different jersey and helmet combinations were displayed. The Terps will have plenty of options to choose from this season with jerseys and pants in red, black, white and gold, along with two helmets.

Streak CONTINUES

- ▶ The University of Miami's impressive streak of former players scoring touchdowns in the NFL continued throughout the 2010 season. In week 17, Jimmy Graham scored a first quarter touchdown for the Saints against the Buccaneers.
- ▶ At least one former 'Cane has now scored a touchdown every NFL week since Week 15 of the 2002 season - a span of 139 straight weeks.

Canes TO OPEN NEW ERA UNDER HEAD COACH AL GOLDEN

- ▶ Al Golden - the University of Miami's 22nd head coach in its storied history - will embark on his first season as the Hurricanes' head coach when Miami opens its 2011 season at Maryland on Sept. 5.
- ▶ Golden arrived in Coral Gables after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at Temple University. Over five seasons at Temple, Golden took the Owls to unprecedented heights. Before his arrival, TU had just two winning seasons over its previous 26 years and had only won 22 percent of its games over the previous 30 years. Quickly, Golden made the Owls a contender, leading the team to a combined record of 17-8 his last two years there. The 2009 season marked Temple's first winning season since 1990, and Golden was rewarded with MAC Coach of the Year honors.

GAME DAY PRESS POLICIES

Only working press will be admitted to the Sun Life Stadium press box. Seats will be issued according to the following criteria:

1. State newspapers by circulation, wire services, national publications, newspapers from opponent's area, and student newspapers from UM and opponent's schools.
2. Other daily newspapers, with preference to those that regularly cover UM.
3. Radio and television personnel not broadcasting, but considered reporting.
4. Non-daily newspapers, with preference to those which regularly cover UM.
5. Scouts. Freelance and/or non-daily writers may be asked to produce copies of actual publications in which their work has appeared. In some cases, these materials will be required as verification of the writers' status.

Canes SCHEDULE AMONG THE TOUGHEST

- ▶ According to Phil Steele's College Football Preview, Miami will face the 10th-toughest schedule of any FBS school this upcoming season. Only Colorado, Iowa State, Baylor, Oregon State, LSU, Boston College, USC, Washington and Auburn face a tougher road ahead according to the publication.
- ▶ After traveling to Maryland for the season-opener, the Canes will return home to host non-conference foes Ohio State and Kansas State in back-to-back weeks at Sun Life Stadium. A few weeks later, Miami will face a pair of difficult tests on the road in consecutive trips to Virginia Tech (Oct. 8) and North Carolina (Oct. 15). The yearly rivalry game with Florida State will also come on the road, as the Canes will travel to Tallahassee to face the Seminoles on Nov. 12.

Miami FOOTBALL RANKED EIGHTH NATIONALLY IN APR

▶ When the NCAA's Academic Progress Report (APR) was announced in May, the Canes' football program headlined an outstanding academic showing by the University of Miami this past school year. The football team (along with baseball, men's basketball and men's tennis) improved upon its APR score for an impressive seventh straight season. In fact, the UM football program's APR score (978) ranked eighth among all FBS schools.

Miami AND OHIO STATE TO PLAY IN PRIMETIME

- ▶ The University of Miami's home game against Ohio State on Sept. 17 has been designated as either a 7:30 p.m. or 8 p.m. kickoff on either ABC or ESPN, Atlantic Coast Conference Commissioner John Swofford announced at the conference's annual spring meetings in May.
- ▶ Last season, Ohio State came away with a 36-24 win over Miami in Columbus on Sept. 1. OSU owns a 3-1 advantage in the all-time series between the two schools. This year's game will mark the first ever played between Canes and the Buckeyes in South Florida.

Miller SHINES IN SPRING GAME

- ▶ Sophomore running back Lamar Miller was the star of Miami's first spring game under head coach Al Golden. Miller, who carried the ball 10 times for 166 yards, scored three touchdowns - including runs of 70 and 64 yards - to lead his Green team past the Orange squad, 30-17.
- ▶ Held on April 16 at Lockhart Stadium in Ft. Lauderdale, the game also featured a halftime celebration of the 2001 national championship team, with most members of the squad - including Rose Bowl MVPs Ken Dorsey and Andre Johnson - in attendance.

Eight CANES GO IN 2011 NFL DRAFT

- ▶ The University of Miami's success in the NFL Draft continued this past spring, as eight Canes were selected in 2011. Orlando Franklin (2nd round to Denver), Brandon Harris (2nd round to Houston), Leonard Hankerson (3rd round to Washington), DeMarcus Van Dyke (3rd round to Oakland), Allen Bailey (3rd round to Kansas City), Colin McCarthy (4th round to Tennessee), Richard Gordon (6th round to Oakland) and Matt Boshier (6th round to Atlanta) were all taken off the board in the Top 200 picks.
- ▶ Miami's eight draftees trailed only USC (9) and North Carolina (9) for the most in the country in 2011.
- ▶ Since 2000, only Ohio State (78) and USC (77) have had more players drafted than the Canes (75).
- ▶ Miami continues to comfortably lead the nation in first round draft picks in recent years, as 26 Canes have been selected in the first round since 2000. Ohio State (17) remains a distant second.

Brotherly LOVE?

- ▶ Miami redshirt sophomore Jared Wheeler will have some bragging rights on the line in Monday's season-opener. That's because the backup guard's younger brother Jake is an offense lineman for the Terrapins.
- ▶ The brothers teamed up for American Heritage High School in Hollywood, Fla., anchoring the offensive line. Both Jared and Jake also played defense for the Patriots.

Nine CANES SUSPENDED FOR SEASON OPENER

- ▶ Eight University of Miami football student-athletes must miss competition and repay benefits as a condition of becoming eligible to play again, according to a decision by the NCAA student-athlete reinstatement staff. The student-athletes received varying levels of recruiting inducements and extra benefits from university booster Nevin Shapiro and athletics personnel, according to the facts of the case.
- ▶ DL Marcus Forston, LB Sean Spence, DL Adewale Ojomo, WR Travis Benjamin and QB Jacory Harris will serve their one-game suspension during the Maryland contest. DB Ray-Ray Armstrong and TE Dyron Dye will serve four game suspensions, while DL Olivier Vernon will be required to sit out six games.
- ▶ WR Aldarius Johnson has been suspended indefinitely for a violation of team rules.
