LAST TIME OUT - Charlotte lost to cross-county rival Davidson, 109-74, at home. Ridell Camidge (14 pts.) and Curran Scott (10 pts.) recorded double-figure scoring games off the bench. Bernard Sullivan tallied his first career 20-point scoring game with 20 against Davidson (December 1).

LEADING SCORER - The 49ers had six different players lead the team in scoring in each of the first seven games. Ridell Camidge scored 18 points against Elon, Andrien White scored 21 points against East Carolina and Curran Scott scored 21 points against Furman. Joseph Uchebo led the 49ers with 16 points against Syracuse. Jon Davis recorded his first career double-figure scoring game with 14 points against Washington. Bernard Sullivan scored 20 points and grabbed seven rebounds against Davidson (December 1).

CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARDS - Joseph Uchebo recorded two double-figure rebounds game and nearly a third double-figure rebounds game in the Battle 4 Atlantis. He recorded his first career double-double with 16 points and 12 rebounds against Syracuse. Then, he grabbed nine rebounds against Michigan. Uchebo recorded a team season-high 18 rebounds against Washington. Uchebo averaged 13 rebounds per game during the Battle 4 Atlantis.

MILESTONE WINS - Charlotte's 77-68 win over Furman (November 19) marked the 49ers' 800th all-time win. The 49ers held their opponent to 68 points in the program's 500th,, 600th, 700th and 800th victories.

RECORD OF HEAD COACH IN FIRST

GAME AT CHARLOTTE - Charlotte's game with Elon marks the 49ers coaching debut of Mark Price. Charlotte head coaches are 6-4 all-time in their first games at the helm of the 49ers men's basketball program. After losing to Elon in their season opener, Price is the fourth 49ers coach to loss their debut.

OVERTIME - Last season, the 49ers played a school-record seven overtime games. The 49ers had a record of 3-4 in those overtime games. With a 3-4 record in overtime games last season, the 49ers are now 30-38 all-time in overtime games. Charlotte has now played an overtime game in five of the last seven seasons.

REACHING THE CENTURY MARK - Last

season, Charlotte scored 106 points against Penn State (November 20, 2014) in their first game in the Charleston Classic which marked the first time that the 49ers have scored a 100 points in a game since scoring 100 (W, 100-80) in a victory over Youngstown State, December 21, 2008. Charlotte is 56-2 all-time when they scored at least 100 points. In the 1974-75 season, the 49ers scored at least 100 points nine times. The school-record is 124 points scored by the 49ers twice vs.

Tusculum, February 10, 1973 and Baptist, February 19, 1976.

CONFERENCE USA HISTORY - The

49ers, who were an original member of Conference USA from 1995-2005, are in their third year back in Conference USA after spending eight years in the Atlantic 10. During the 49ers time in Conference

USA, Charlotte captured two Conference USA Tournament titles (1999 and 2001) and a share of the 2004 Conference USA regular-season title. During the 49ers 13 years in Conference USA, Charlotte has made seven trips to the NCAA Tournament and one trip to the NIT. The 49ers have compiled an overall record of 214-139 and a Conference USA record of 108-67 during their 13 years in Conference USA. Six times the 49ers have won 20 games while a member of Conference USA. Two former 49ers standouts (DeMarco Johnson - 1998 and Eddie Basden -2005) were named Conference USA Player of the Year. Former 49ers coach Melvin Watkins was named Conference USA Coach of the Year in 1997. Basden earned Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year honors twice (2004 and 2005). Rodney White was the 2001 Conference USA Freshman of the Year and Torin Dorn was 2015 Conference USA Freshman of the Year. Seven different 49ers earned first-team All-Conference USA honors. Galen Young was named Conference USA Tournament MVP in 1999 and Rodney White was named Conference USA Tournament MVP in 2001.

2015-16 RECRUITS - Head coach Mark Price has announced the signing of six-foot-three point guard Quentin Jackson Jr. for the 2015-2016 recruiting class. A Cary, North Carolina native, Jackson is playing his senior year at Cape Fear Christian Academy.

Jackson is ranked as the seventh best player in the state of North Carolina and the third best point guard, according to ESPN.com. An athletic combo guard, Jackson is also considered the 23rd best shooting guard in the country on Scout.com. Rivals.com ranks Jackson as a three-star prospect. The Charlotte Observer ranked him as the 12th best player in the state of North Carolina. As a sophomore, Jackson led Raleigh's Word of God Academy to an 18-9 record in 2013-2014. He starred for Martinsville, Virginia's Carlisle School as a junior, leading his team to a 22-13 record. Jackson averaged 14.7 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 3.2 assists for Carlisle. His stellar play earned him second team all-state honors by the Virginia Independent Schools Athletic Association. Last summer, Jackson played his AAU ball for SEBL, leading his team to the CP3 Live 17U championship as the tournament's co-MVP. Jackson has a notable sports background. His great-grandfather Wendell Scott is in the NAS-CAR Hall of Fame, and his father, also named Quentin Jackson, played under Jim Valvano at NC State from 1985 to 1988 as the starting point



First Season

Mark Price became the tenth head coach in Charlotte 49ers history, March 26, 2015. Price was an assistant coach with the Charlotte Hornets for the last two years.

"I'm extremely excited about joining the Charlotte 49ers as the new basketball coach," Price said. "I'm excited to get to know the current players as we move forward and start a new era. I'm looking forward to putting a team on the court that plays an exciting brand of basketball that our students and fans will enjoy watching."

Price spent the last seven years coaching in the NBA. For the last two years, he has been an assistant coach on the Charlotte Hornets staff under head coach Steve Clifford. As a collegiate player at Georgia Tech he helped the Yellow Jackets move from last place to ACC champions. As a player with the Cleveland Cavaliers, he helped the team to seven playoff bids over his final eight years. As

a coach in the NBA, he has helped four of his last six teams reach the NBA playoffs.

"We have taken an important step in strengthening our program by welcoming a coach who has experienced incredible success at the collegiate and professional levels. Mark is known as a person who makes those around him better," said UNC Charlotte Chancellor Philip Dubois. "The players will take great inspiration from his personal example, and learn the game from someone with deep knowledge about it."

He played an integral role, for instance, in helping Charlotte Hornets standout Michael Kidd-Gilchrist's well-documented improvement in his shooting percentage. In 2014, Charlotte reached the Eastern Conference playoffs. In 2012, he was a player development coach for the NBA playoff-bound Orlando Magic. He has served as a shooting coach on several NBA coaching staffs (Golden State Warriors in 2011, NBA playoff representative Atlanta Hawks in 2009, 2010 and the Memphis Grizzlies in 2008). While in Atlanta, he helped the Hawks to two of their current seven straight playoff appearances.

"He's experienced basketball at every level. He's taught basketball at every level. And he's shown a pattern of success at every level," said Charlotte 49ers Director of Athletics Judy Rose. "He's eager to bring that same work ethic to our program. He's eager to develop our players. And he's eager to be our head coach."

Price spent the 1999-2000 season as an assistant coach on Bobby Cremins staff at his alma mater, Georgia Tech.

Prior to going into coaching, Price enjoyed a stellar 12-year NBA career. He finished his career as one of the greatest shooters in NBA history; he ranks second on the NBA's all-time career free-throw percentage list (.904) and 29th in three-point field goal percentage (.402). He is also the NBA's all-time leader in playoff free-throw percentage (.944). Price led the NBA in free throw percentage three times during his career and he ranked in the league's top 10 four other times.

Price was the 25th overall pick in the 1986 NBA Draft and played in 772 regularseason games for the Cleveland Cavaliers, Washington Bullets, Golden State Warriors and Orlando Magic. He averaged 15.2 points and 6.7 assists in his career. Price, who played nine seasons for the Cavaliers is second in franchise history for career assists (4,206), was named first-team All-NBA in 1992-93 and third-team All-NBA three times (1988-89, 1991-92 and 1993-94). He played in four NBA All-Star games and captured the 1993 and 1994 NBA three-point shootout titles. Price was also a member of Dream Team II, which won the gold medal at the 1994 FIBA World Championship. The Cleveland Cavaliers have retired his #25 jersey.

Price enjoyed a stellar four-year collegiate career at Georgia Tech. Price is one of four players to ever be named first or second team All-ACC in each of his four seasons. He earned second-team Associated Press (AP) All-American honors in 1985 and third-team AP All-American honors in 1986. In 1985, he was named ACC Tournament MVP after helping lead Georgia Tech to the first ACC Tournament title in school history. Price also led Georgia Tech to its first ACC regular-season title in 1985. During his career at Georgia Tech, the Ramblin' Wreck made two NCAA Tournament appearances. In 1985, Georgia Tech lost to No. 1 Georgetown in the East Regional Finals of the NCAA Tournament. Price has had his #25 jersey retired by Georgia Tech as well.

Price and his wife Laura, have four children: Brittany, Caroline, Hudson and Josh. Price's brother Brent enjoyed a 10-year NBA career.

First Season

Houston Fancher is in his first season as an assistant coach with the Charlotte 49ers. Fancher has 12 years' experience as a college head coach including nine years as Appalachian State's head coach.

Fancher brings more than 26 years of collegiate coaching experience to the 49ers coaching staff, including 12 seasons as a head coach at North Greenville College (three years) and Appalachian State (nine years).

Fancher won 181 games in his 12 years as a head coach at North Greenville and at Appalachian State. During his time at Appalachian State, the Mountaineers captured Southern Conference North Division championships in 2003, 2007 and 2008. He earned Southern Conference Coach of the Year honors in 2003. In 2007, he was a finalist for the mid-major national coach of the year award after guiding Appalachian State to a school-record 25 wins, the San Juan Shootout title and a berth in the NIT.

After leaving Appalachian State in 2009, he joined the staff at the University of Tennessee. He worked with head coaches Bruce Pearl and Cuonzo Martin. He was Martin's Director of Basketball Operations from 2011-13. He spent the 2013-14 season as an assistant coach under Buzz Peterson at UNC Wilmington.

Fancher began his collegiate coaching career as an assistant at Division III Maryville (Tenn.) College from 1988-92. He then took over as head coach at North Greenville from 1993-95 before taking a position as an assistant coach at Vanderbilt for the 1995-96 season.

From 1996-2000, Fancher worked as an assistant coach (1996-98) and associate head coach (1998-2000) at Appalachian State.

A native of Newport, Tennessee, he earned an undergraduate degree in Physical Education in 1988 from Middle Tennessee and a Master's Degree in Educational Administration and Supervision from Lincoln Memorial University in 1990.

Fancher and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Hayden and Ethan and a daughter Cameron.



Chris Ferguson

Assistant Coach

First Season

Chris Ferguson is in his first season as an assistant coach with the Charlotte 49ers. Ferguson, who has 28-years of collegiatecoaching experience, joins the 49ers coaching staff after spending the last eight years a member of the Oklahoma State coaching staff. In 2007, Ferguson joined the Oklahoma State coaching staff and he played an integral role in helping Oklahoma State make five trips to the NCAA Tournament in his eight seasons in Stillwater. In 2009, he played an integral role in helping Oklahoma State sign one of the top recruiting classes in the country, which was ranked as high as fourth by HoopScoopOnline.com. He recruited Oklahoma State standouts 2014 NBA Lottery pick Marcus Smart as well as Brooklyn Nets rookie Markel Brown.

Prior to his time at Oklahoma State, Ferguson spent two seasons at East Carolina (2005-07). He was the associate head coach at East Carolina in 2007. Ferguson came to East Carolina after spending eight years as an assistant coach for the Tennessee Volunteers (1997-05). He was part of Jerry Green's staff for the first four years and then the last four years he was part of Buzz Peterson's staff.

He was the associate head coach for his final two years at Tennessee (2003-05).

During his time at Tennessee, the Volunteers made six consecutive postseason tournament appearances including four-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances (1998-2001). Tennessee advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 1999 and the Sweet 16 in 2000. The Volunteers also captured two SEC Eastern Division titles and one overall SEC title during his time.

Before his time at Tennessee, Ferguson spent six seasons on Bill Foster's staff at Virginia Tech (1991-97). In 1996, the Hokies went 23-6 and earned a bid to the NCAA Tournament. In 1995, Virginia Tech won a school-record 25 games and captured the NIT title.

Before going to Virginia Tech, he spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Appalachian State. Ferguson first collegiate coaching job was an assistant under Jerry Green at UNC Asheville (1986-87).

Ferguson began his coaching career in 1982, with a four-year stint as an assistant coach at Morganton, North Carolina's Freedom High School.

The Hendersonville, North Carolina native played two years of college basketball at Central Wesleyan (S.C.) College and two years at Cumberland (Ky.) College. He helped both teams earn bids to the NAIA National Tournament. Ferguson earned a bachelor's degree in Physical Education and Health from Cumberland in 1981. Ferguson and his wife Mary, have a family of six: Brian, who is an assistant men's basketball coach at Winthrop, Crystal, Lathon, Torey, Anna and Delaney.



Andre Gray Assistant Coach

First Season

Andre Gray is in his first season as an assistant coach with the Charlotte 49ers. Gray, who has 14 years of college coaching experience, comes to Charlotte after spending last season as an assistant coach at Winston-Salem State. Last season, he helped Winston-Salem State win 18 games and reach the championship game of the CIAA Tournament.

Prior to joining the Winston-Salem State coaching staff, Gray spent three seasons as assistant coach at UNC Wilmington (2011-14) on Buzz Peterson's staff. Gray and fellow Charlotte assistant coach Houston Fancher were on the UNC Wilmington's staff together for the 2013-14 season.

Prior to UNC Wilmington, Gray spent three years (2008-11) as assistant coach at Western Carolina. During his time at Western Carolina, the Catamounts posted three consecutive winning seasons and two Southern Conference North Division titles working

for head coach Larry Hunter. He came to Western Carolina, after spending the 2007-08 season as an assistant coach at Gardner-Webb, which posted a 16-16 record that season including a victory at nationally-ranked Kentucky.

Then, Gray spent four years as an assistant coach at Wingate University (2003-07). During his time at Wingate, the Bulldogs earned bids to the 2006 and 2007 NCAA Division II Tournaments after capturing the South Atlantic Conference (SAC) championship both seasons. In 2007, Wingate advanced to the NCAA Division II Elite Eight, capturing the South Atlantic Region crown.

Gray began his coaching career as the head boys' basketball coach at Clayton Middle School in Clayton, North Carolina. He also served as an assistant coach at J.F. Webb High School in Oxford, N.C before beginning his collegiate coaching experience as an assistant coach for two years at his alma-mater Methodist College. During his time on the Methodist coaching staff, he helped lead the team to a USA South Conference Championship and a 22-6 league record over those two years.

The Elizabethtown, North Carolina native earned a Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education from Methodist College in 1998. Gray played basketball at Methodist from 1995-97. As a senior, he helped Methodist advance to the 1997 Division III Elite Eight. Gray is married to the former Tarius Williams.


