Setting the Scene: The last non-conference game of the year for the Norfolk State men's basketball team finds the Spartans taking a break from their snow-covered homes to head down to Miami to take on the Hurricanes on Saturday. Tip-off at the BankUnited Center is at 4 p.m. It will mark the third of four straight games on the road for the Spartans.

Media Coverage: The contest against Miami will mark the second straight game, and the third time this season, that NSU will appear on an ESPN platform. Saturday's game will be broadcast on ESPN3, with Mike Levine and Drew Nicholas on the call. Fans can also view the contest online with WatchESPN. Live stats will be available at www.hurricanesports.com.

Series History: Miami and Norfolk State have met only one other time, a 76-58 Hurricane win on Jan. 2, 2005 at the Convocation Center in Coral Gables. Robert Hite and Guillermo Diaz combined for 40 points for Miami, while Karandick Ogunride and Chakowby Hicks totaled 16 and 15 points, respectively, for NSU.

About Miami: The Hurricanes own a 10-10 record on the season after dropping their past three games in ACC play against Duke and Syracuse at home and at Maryland on Wednesday. Miami, which advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 last season, is led by the play of Rion Brown. The senior averages 14.0 points and is second with 6.2 rebounds per game. No other player scores in double figures, with Garius Adams (9.7 points) and Donnavan Kirk (9.6 points, 6.3 rebounds) the next highest scorers for a team that averages 61.5 points per contest but also only gives up 60. Like NSU, Miami also defeated Savannah State earlier this year on the road, 68-51 on Dec. 19.

Last Time Out: Down by eight with six minutes left, NSU outscored Savannah State 17-2 to close out the game and defeat the Tigers, 56-49, last Monday in an ESPNU game at Tiger Arena. The Spartans went into the half up by two after SSU had gone nearly nine minutes without scoring a point in the first half. The Tigers closed out that first stanza on a 10-1 run and also went on a 13-2 run in the second half right before the Spartans finished the game by scoring 17 of the last 19. **Malcolm Hawkins** led all players with 16 points, while **Pendarvis Williams** added 13. **RaShid Gaston** added seven points and a game-high 13 boards for NSU, which shot 20-of-47 (42.6 percent) and outrebounded SSU, 40-29. Seven players took up all but three of the 200 total minutes in the game for NSU.

Frequent Flyer Miles: The Spartans have traveled approximately 9,818 miles (one way) through the air this year on its five trips to Houston, Boston, Seattle, Honolulu and Miami, as well as 1,686 miles on the ground (also one way) in road trips to Duke and Rutgers (NIT Season Tip-Off) as well as to Virginia, LIU Brooklyn, UMES/Delaware State and South Carolina State/Savannah State. After this weekend in Miami, NSU only has two trips out of the Hampton Roads area left (including the MEAC tournament): next Saturday at Morgan State and Feb. 22 and 24 at Coppin State and Howard.

Senior Leadership: NSU has scored 1,594 points this year, with 1,281 of those points (80.4 percent) coming from NSU's eight-player senior class.

Spartans in the MEAC: NSU is 6-2 this year in the MEAC and 35-5 (87.5 winning percentage) since the start of the 2011-12 season.

MEAC Standings: The Spartans sit in second in the MEAC standings at 6-2 behind league leader North Carolina Central (5-1). Hampton and Savannah State (5-2) and Morgan State (4-2) sit right behind the Spartans in the standings.

Back in the Fold: **RaShid Gaston** competed in his first game in nearly two months when he played 20 minutes at Delaware State on Jan. 13. He has scored 10.0 points per game over his last four contests and nearly tied his career high with 13 boards at Savannah State. Gaston missed 13 games total due to a torn meniscus and a partial tear of his ACL in his left knee suffered during practice on Nov. 17. He also suffered a sprained ankle two days before he was set to come back at UMES.

Ahead at the Half: The Spartans are 28-5 since the start of the 2012-13 season when leading or tied at the half and 48-6 dating back to the 2011-12 season.

Double-Double: **Brandon Goode** had his third double-double of the year and the first since Dec. 1 at LIU Brooklyn when he scored 19 points with 10 rebounds at S.C. State on Jan. 25.

Dominating the Inside: Norfolk State has outscored opponents 752-575 in points in the paint, an average of 8.4 points per game. Against Coppin State, the Spartans had a 46-16 edge, while NSU has also outscored East Carolina (50-16) and Stillman (62-26) by large margins. On the flip side, opponents have taken 127 more 3-pointers than NSU this year.

Hot Shooting: **Pendarvis Williams** is currently shooting 49.1 percent (113-of-230) from the floor this year, including 63.1 percent (77-of-122) from inside the arc. **Brandon Goode**, **Anell Alexis** and **RaShid Gaston** have combined to hit 202-of-354 (57.1 percent) from the floor this year. **Malcolm Hawkins**, meanwhile, is connecting on 42.4 percent from 3-point range.

As a team, the Spartans are shooting 48.2 percent from the floor and 34.7 percent from 3-point range this year, the best marks in a season since 1994-95 (49.5 percent) and 1998-99 (35.7 percent), respectively. They are also hitting 53.2 percent from inside the arc.

The Spartans have also shot at least 42 percent from the field in all but three games this year, including the first 12 games of the season. The Spartans have already topped 60 percent shooting twice this year, the fifth and sixth times during the D-I era they have done so, and have hit at least 50 percent in eight games.

Don't Foul 'Em: **Malcolm Hawkins** and **Pendarvis Williams** have been solid from the charity stripe lately. Williams has connected on 48-of-56 in the last 14 games, while Hawkins has hit 52-of-61 from the free throw line over his last 13 games. Hawkins had made 24 straight free throws before a miss at DSU.

As a team, the Spartans are connecting on 70.0 percent from the foul line this year. Only once in the previous 30 years has NSU hit better than 70 percent from the free throw line in a season (72.0 percent, 2003-04). The all-time program record is 72.3 percent set in 1968-69.

Hawkins (81.1 percent) and Williams (81.2) are chasing the program's individual Division I record of 83.3 set by Ryan Grier in 2003-04. The all-time NSU record is 85.6 percent set by David Donerlson in 1991-92.

Rare Company: **Pendarvis Williams** is one of five all-time NSU players with at least 1,400 points, 400 rebounds, 200 assists and 100 steals along with Ralph Tally, Barry Mitchell, Tony Murphy and Michael Deloach. Williams needs 29 more rebounds to reach 500 for his career, and should he reach that mark he will join Tally and Mitchell as the only players to reach 1,400 points, 500 rebounds, 200 assists and 100 steals.

The Hawk: Senior **Malcolm Hawkins** has scored in double figures in every full game he's played this year (He played only the second half at Delaware State). He had his sixth 20-point game of the year against Coppin State with 22 points. His 16.7 per-game average currently ranks as the seventh-best in the Division I era (1997-Present) behind three players - Michael Deloach, Damian Woolfolk and Tony Murphy - who each became 1,700 career point scorers at NSU.

Scoring Offense: NSU's is scoring 75.9 points per game this year, the highest scoring season since averaging 76.0 per game in 1999-2000, and almost 10 points more per game than last year (66.3).

Trending: Guard **Jamel Fuentes** has added 7.7 points, 5.9 assists and 3.7 rebounds in the last seven games. He has also had at least four assists in the last 13 games. After scoring just six points all year, **Kieyvyn Lila-St. Rose** added a career-high 13 points on 4-of-6 shooting at UMES when NSU was down to just nine active players. Lila-St. Rose is averaging 5.7 points on 13-of-27 shooting with 2.3 boards in the last six games, including starts in the last three.

RaShid Gaston has also gotten back into form, posting 10.0 points in the last four games. **Malcolm Hawkins** has shot 11-of-22 from the 3-point line in the last four games. Before a down game at South Carolina State, **Pendarvis Williams** had scored 16.0 points with 5.8 rebounds in his previous four games.

Brandon Goode has scored in double figures in 13 of the last 17 and is shooting 32-of-50 from the field over the last seven games, including a 19-point, 10-rebound effort at S.C. State. He scored in double figures in eight straight from Nov. 19-Dec. 19. During that time, he averaged 14.3 points, 8.4 rebounds and 2.8 blocks per game while shooting 50-of-79 (63.3 percent).

Nationally Ranked: The Spartans ranked 25th in the nation in field goal percentage at 48.2 prior. They also stand in the top 100 in scoring offense (72nd, 75.9), assists per game (73rd, 14.3) and blocks (89th, 4.4).

Jamel Fuentes ranks 31st in the nation in assist-turnover ratio at 2.79 and 33rd in assists at 5.6. **Brandon Goode** stands 41st in blocks per game at 2.48.

Pendarvis Williams also ranks 49th among active players in both career 3-pointers (192) and points (1,435). Goode also has a spot in the top 50, ranking 48th in career blocks with 132.

MEAC Rankings: Several NSU players rank in the top 5 in the MEAC, including **Jamel Fuentes**, who sits first in assist-turnover ratio at 2.8 and second in assists at 5.6. Other top 5 performers include **Malcolm Hawkins** (2nd - 42.4 3-point shooting percentage) and **Brandon Goode** (2nd - 60.7 field goal percentage; 4th - 2.6 offensive rebounds; 5th - 2.5 blocks).

As a team, NSU ranks first in scoring offense (75.9), field goal percentage (48.2), 3-point field goal percentage (34.7), opponent rebounding (32.8) and offensive rebound percentage (37.5). The Spartans also stand second in rebounding margin (+2.5), assists (14.3) and assist-turnover ratio (1.1) and third in scoring margin (+0.9).

Beginning the Climb: Sitting at No. 20 in the all-time scoring list at NSU with 1,435, **Pendarvis Williams** needs 101 points to reach the next person in line, Ray Epps (See table Page 3).

Jamel Fuentes now has 368 career assists, which ranks seventh all-time at NSU. He needs eight more to reach sixth place, a spot held by **Fuentes'** predecessor, Aleek Pauline.

With five blocks against Bethune-Cookman, **Brandon Goode** moved into sole possession of second place on the all-time list. He now has 132 career blocks. Of course, the best Goode can finish is second, as the all-time leader is Kyle O'Quinn, who had 283 in his four-year career. Goode had a career-high six blocks against Stillman, the most since O'Quinn had six on Feb. 15, 2012 against Delaware State.

Chasing Some Season Records: **Brandon Goode** has 52 blocks on the season, which ranks fourth in single-season records for Division I and eighth overall (including NSU's D-II days). **Jamel Fuentes** currently sits third in D-I records with 117 assists (See table Page 3).

Better as They Go: Opponents are scoring on average 6.7 more points in the second half than the first.

Injury Report: **Jordan Weathers** will be out for the year after tearing the ACL and meniscus in his right knee against Florida A&M on Dec. 5.

No Young Guns: According to research done by Joe Pott of the Southern Illinois athletics department, SIU and NSU are, unofficially, the only two programs in the country that do not have a freshman on the roster. The only two current newcomers on the Spartan squad right now are D-I transfers **Anell Alexis** and **Hefeng Sun**.

Rare Breed: **Hefeng Sun** is just one of two players on Division I rosters who hails from China. The other is Tao Xu of San Francisco.

Conference Win Streak: Morgan State's win on Jan. 18 broke NSU's nation-leading 23-game conference regular season win streak that dated back to a setback against Delaware State on Feb. 15, 2012 at Joseph Echols Hall.

The school's all-time record of consecutive regular season conference wins is 24, set from Dec. 7, 1970-Dec. 15, 1971 in the CIAA. The Spartans also won 22 in a row in the mid-1950's during their days in the EIAC.

Best D-I Start: With the win over Bethune-Cookman running its record to 7-3, NSU secured its best 10-game start to a season since going 9-1 to start the 1995-96 campaign, the program's next-to-last season in Division II.

Home, Sweet Home: Mount St. Mary's broke NSU's 16-game home win streak that stretched back to a loss to Delaware State on Feb. 15, 2012.

High Scoring: NSU has scored at least 90 points in a game four times this year and at least 100 points twice. The only other season in the Division I era the Spartans did so was in 1998-99, when they scored 90 in 11 games and 100 points in three games.

The Spartans tallied 90 or more in two straight against Newberry and Virginia Union this year, the first time accomplishing that since Feb. 1-6, 1999, when they had 104 and 99 in two straight. In fact, before this year NSU had not even scored 90 points in a regulation game since Feb. 28, 2009, a 90-68 win over Hampton.

NSU's 207 points against Newberry and Virginia Union were the most in a two-game stretch since posting 209 in wins against St. Augustine's (Feb. 16) and Elizabeth City State (Feb. 19) during the 1993-94 season.

Williams Named Player of the Week: *Pendarvis Williams* was named the MEAC Player of the Week on Dec. 16 after his 27-point performance at Boston University. It was the second time this year he won the award. He was named player of the week on Nov. 18 after tallying a career-high 38 points with seven rebounds and four assists against Newberry on Nov. 13 and following that up with 16 points, nine boards and three assists against Virginia Union on Nov. 15.

Goode Honored: *Brandon Goode* was named the MEAC Defensive Player of the Week in two straight weeks. He averaged 17.3 points on 23-of-35 shooting (65.7 percent) with 10.3 rebounds, 4.3 blocks and 1.3 steals in three games to earn the honor on Dec. 2, and 10.0 points, 8.5 rebounds and 3.5 blocks in two MEAC games to repeat on Dec. 9.

Good Defense: NSU held Bethune-Cookman to just 45 points on Dec. 7, the fewest the Spartans have given up since they defeated Savannah State 55-45 on Dec. 1, 2012.

Going to the Line: NSU broke school records for free throws and free throw attempts in the win over Florida A&M on Dec. 5. The Spartans hit 41-of-62, breaking the previous records of 38 and 58 set against West Virginia State on Nov. 30, 1991 at home. NSU's 41 free throws are tied for the fourth most in a Division I game this season, while its 62 attempts and FAMU's 43 fouls both rank as the second most this season and the most in a regulation game.

Malcolm Hawkins hit 13-of-14 from the foul line, the most free throws made in a game by an NSU player since Corey Lyons had 14 at Hampton on Jan. 31, 2009.

Join the Fun: Six different Spartans scored in double figures against Florida A&M, the first time the program has had six double-figure scorers in one game since Feb. 19, 1994 against Elizabeth City State.

Mistake-Free Ball: Only three times in their Division I history have the Spartans had a 2-1 or better assist-turnover ratio in a game, with two of those coming this season. Most recently, the Spartans had an 18-9 assist-turnover ratio at LIU Brooklyn.

NSU also posted a 19-4 assist-turnover ratio against UNC Asheville, the fewest turnovers and the best assist-turnover ratio in the D-I era. It marked the fewest turnovers since the Spartans had just one at Johnson C. Smith on Feb. 18, 1997. On Feb. 6, 1999, the Spartans had their first 2-1 or better assist-turnover game when they posted 19 and eight against Howard.

Lend a Helping Hand: NSU had 25 assists on 41 baskets in the win over Stillman, the most assists in the Division I era and the most helpers since the Spartans had 29 in a win over Knoxville on Jan. 29, 1996.

Dominating the Inside: NSU's 62 points in the paint against Stillman marked the second time this year the Spartans had 62 points around the basket. The Spartans also accomplished the feat against Newberry. Those two performances are tied for the most points NSU has scored since the 2002-03 season. The Spartans also had 62 points in the paint at Morgan State on Feb. 27, 2010.

More Stillman Fun Facts: NSU had 41 field goals against Stillman after also doing so in the win over Newberry earlier this year. Those stand as the most since the Spartans had 42 in a win over Troy State on Dec. 30, 1998.

NSU's 62.1 percent shooting clip (41-of-66) against Stillman was the best since hitting 23-of-35 (65.7 percent) in a win over Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 27, 2011.

Another Big Game: *Pendarvis Williams* had 32 points against Stillman, the second time this year he reached the 30-point plateau after scoring 38 against Newberry. He became the first player since Michael Deloach in 2009-10 to top 30 points in a game at least twice in one season.

Offense on the Go: The Spartans averaged 13.3 fastbreak points per game over a six-contest span from Nov. 13-26, and against Newberry and East Carolina had a combined 51 points off turnovers.

Scoring Binge vs. Newberry

*NSU's 115-point effort against Newberry marked the most points scored in the Division I era and the most since tallying 115 against Knoxville on Jan. 29, 1996.

* With 38 points - on his 22nd birthday no less - *Pendarvis Williams* posted the second-most points in a game in the D-I era, tying Darryl Towse, who also had 38 points on Jan. 19, 2002. Only Tony Murphy, who scored a D-I record 43 on Dec. 19, 2006, has had more in a game than Williams in NSU's 16 years as a D-I program.

* The 210 points scored by NSU and Newberry is the most since NSU defeated Coppin State 110-108 in double overtime on Jan. 31, 2011. It was the most combined points in a regulation game since NSU defeated Shaw 134-90 on Feb. 4, 1987.

* Williams' 14 field goals were the most since Michael Deloach had 14 on March 4, 2010 at North Carolina A&T.

* NSU's 64 second-half points were the most scored in a half since the Spartans had 69 in the second stanza in an 87-82 loss against Coppin State on Jan. 30, 2012.

Williams, Hawkins Form Nice Duo: *Pendarvis Williams*' 38-point effort came one game after *Malcolm Hawkins* had 31 points in the season opener at Texas Southern. It was the first time NSU had back-to-back 30-point performances since Kyle O'Quinn (32) and Michael Deloach (34) did it on Jan. 25 and 31, 2010, respectively.

Hawkins' 24 second-half points were the most since Kyle O'Quinn had 27 in the second half against Coppin State on Jan. 30, 2012. Hawkins hit 10-of-13 from the free throw line as well, the most free throws since O'Quinn had 10 against UMES on Jan. 7, 2012.

Dominating the Glass: The Spartans posted 21 offensive rebounds against Texas Southern, the most since grabbing 24 against Coppin State on Jan. 30, 2012.

NSU Signs 2: The Spartans picked up a pair of commitments in the early signing period in power forward *Jordan Butler* from Putnam Science Academy in Putnam, Conn., and small forward *Deven Dorsett* from Miller Grove High School in Lithonia, Ga. Butler averaged 16.6 points, 14.3 rebounds and 3.8 blocks during his senior year in 2012-13 at Glastonbury High. Dorsett's Miller Grove team has won five straight state titles.

O'Quinn's NBA Season: Kyle O'Quinn is back for his second season with the Orlando Magic after being drafted in the second round in 2012. NSU's first NBA player in 25 years, O'Quinn averaged 4.1 points and 3.7 rebounds per game during his rookie campaign in 2012-13. So far this year he's posted 4.1 points, 4.0 rebounds and 0.9 blocks. He had 15 points, eight boards and two blocks in a loss at Brooklyn on Jan. 21.

Williams Named Preseason Player of the Year: *Pendarvis Williams*, last year's MEAC Player of the Year, was voted this year's preseason player of the year as well. Along with his first-team all-conference designation, Williams was joined on the preseason all-conference teams by seniors Hawkins and Brandon Goode and sophomore RaShid Gaston, all of whom were voted to the third team.

Preseason Prognostications: After finishing No. 1 in the regular season standings last year, Norfolk State was picked to finish atop the MEAC again this year in the preseason predictions voted on by the league's coaches and sports information directors. NSU accumulated 14 of the 26 first-place votes to finish with 624 points, ahead of No. 2 Morgan State, which had 555 points and five first-place votes.

One More Honor for Williams: In addition to being named preseason conference player of the year, *Pendarvis Williams* was also tabbed to the 2013 Lou Henson Preseason All-America Team for mid-majors, as announced by Collegelinsider.com. He was one of 25 players, and the only one from the MEAC, to earn a spot on the team.

Jones the New Man in Charge: Interim head coach *Robert Jones* takes over the NSU basketball program this year after the departure of previous coach Anthony Evans. Jones spent six seasons as an assistant coach with the program under Evans before being elevated to the top spot this year. He will carry the interim tag for this season.

Along with the elevation of *Larry Vickers* to Associate Head Coach, the coaching staff also brought in two new faces, *Kevin DeVantier*

and **Raru Archer**, to serve as assistant coaches. Both arrived at NSU after successful stints at the junior college level.

Previewing This Season: Expectations are high and a sense of redemption is in the air for Norfolk State in 2013-14 after finishing undefeated in MEAC play last year but coming up short in overtime to Bethune-Cookman in the MEAC quarterfinals. The Spartans return four of five starters and 11 letterwinners from that squad. The only key losses were starting forward Rob Johnson and Kris Brown, a key reserve off the bench.

Among those back is **Pendarvis Williams**, who averaged 14.3 points per game while shooting better than 45 percent from the field, 40 percent from beyond the arc and 81 percent from the free throw line. **Malcolm Hawkins** also scored in double-figures with 11.4 points, while NSU's third returning starting guard, **Jamel Fuentes**, finished with 4.9 points and 4.9 assists.

Up front, **Brandon Goode** and **RaShid Gaston** formed a solid 1-2 punch, with Goode tallying 7.7 points and 5.3 rebounds as the team's regular starter center and Gaston contributing 8.3 points and 6.3 rebounds as a forward off the bench.

The Spartans have eight seniors altogether this year, including backup point guard **Marese Phelps**, 3-point specialist **Zieyik Estimé**, backup forward **Riley Maye**, defensive stopper **Jordan Weathers** and Marist transfer **Anell Alexis**. The latter is one of two newcomers along with Fresno State transfer **Hefeng Sun**, who could contribute right away at the forward spot.

Alexis and redshirt junior **Kievyn Lila-St. Rose** can both stretch a defense at the small forward position. NSU also returned backup center **Paulius Vinogradovas**, a junior this season.

Recapping Last Year: The Spartans made their second-straight and second-ever Division I postseason appearance after playing Virginia in the NIT last season. The Spartans earned the MEAC's automatic bid to the NIT after finishing 16-0, just the fourth time a MEAC program ran the table in the regular season. It also marked the fifth time NSU had a perfect regular season conference record and the first since going 19-0 in the CIAA in 1986-87. The Spartans were one of three schools nationally to go undefeated in conference play along with Gonzaga and Memphis.

NSU also had its second straight 20-win season for the first time since 1995-96, and the team's 15-game win streak was the longest since 1989-90, when the program won 19 straight. The Spartans won their first regular season conference title since finishing in a tie for first in the CIAA North in 1994-95 and the first outright title since 1986-87. NSU also ended the year 11-0 at home, the team's first unblemished home record (not counting postseason) since 1988-89.

In addition to **Pendarvis Williams** earning the MEAC Player of the Year award and Anthony Evans being named the MEAC Coach of the Year, both Rob Johnson and **RaShid Gaston** were named all-MEAC. Johnson was tabbed to the all-conference third team, while Gaston was an all-rookie selection.
