Hurricanes Conclude Regular Season with ACC Rival Seminoles...

The University of Miami will conclude the 2009 regular season Wednesday with a showdown at home against ACC and in-state rival Florida State at the James L. Knight Sports Complex in Coral Gables, Fla. The match is set to begin at 1 p.m.

Miami (18-11, 11-8 ACC) enters the match with a two-match winning streak after sweeping Maryland and Boston College last weekend. The match also marks the last home match for seniors Maria Andersson, Cassie Loessberg, Genny Mayhew and Griffin Udelson. The seniors were honored over the weekend prior to the match against Boston College.

This year's meeting marks the second time in as many years that Miami will close-out the regular season with FSU (27-2, 18-1 ACC). Last year, the two met a day before Thanksgiving in a five-set thriller—one that saw the Hurricanes take a 3-2 victory over the 'Noles, ending the year at 26-6 for UM.

This is just the second time that Miami is facing FSU while the Seminoles are ranked. UM fell, 3-0, to the 'Noles earlier this year in Tallahassee with the Seminoles ranked No. 19 nationally in the AVCA poll. The 'Noles are ranked 14th in this week's poll. The matchup marks the highest ranked team faced by the 'Canes since meeting Duke, ranked No. 14 on both occasions, during the 2007 campaign. UM fell in both matches on 3-0 decisions.

Quick Hits on Florida State...

Florida State has already wrapped up the 2009 Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) title, and moved up a spot to No. 14 this week after being tied for 15th last week in the AVCA poll. The Seminoles high-powered offense is geared around five players with more than 200 kills. Leading the pack is this week's ACC Player of the Week Mira Djuric with a team-high 276 kills, while Brianna Barry sits behind her 257. Stephanie Neville has 249 kills.

The Seminoles use a two-setter system, which is something that has caused trouble for the Hurricanes in recent years. Leading the group is Nikki Baker with a team-best 646 assists, and Duygu Duzceler is just behind her with 589 assists. The defense for the Seminoles is provided by Jenna Romanelli with 306 digs, and teammate Fatma Yildirim is second on the squad with 289 digs.

Series Against Florida State...

In a series that dates back to 1978 between these

two "Sunshine State" rivals, Florida State used a victory earlier in the season to step in front in the all-time series by a count of 17-16-1. Miami swept last year's series with wins in Coral Gables and Tallahassee—the latter being a five-set thriller with UM earning a come-from-behind win. However, FSU took this year's earlier meeting in Tallahassee, 3-0. Since joining the ACC, UM holds a slight 6-5 advantage in the series, including wins in three of the last five contests.

Last Time vs. Florida State (11/18/09)...

Three Miami players each registered five kills, but it wasn't enough as No. 19 Florida State took down the University of Miami in volleyball, 3-0 (25-20, 25-15, 25-17), Friday evening in the ACC-opener for both clubs at Tully Gym in Tallahassee, Fla.

Miami (7-3, 0-1 ACC) was unable to get the shots on Friday evening, hitting a season-low .044 clip (28-24-91) as a team against a tough FSU opponent. Miami did battle back for its best hitting output in the third set, scoring a .233 mark behind four kills from Christine Williamson.

Florida State (9-1, 1-0 ACC), ranked no. 19 in the latest AVCA coaches poll, hit above .300 twice – in the second and third set, respectively. As a team, FSU hit .217 (40-17-106) in the match.

Ali Becker, Lici McGee and Williamson each scored five kills for UM on the night, but Florida State's blocking

proved to be the difference in the contest. The Seminoles racked up 13 team blocks while Miami committed 24 attack errors.

UM senior Genny Mayhew supplied defense for the 'Canes with a team-best 10 digs, while Becker posted three blocks (two assisted). Setter Katie Gallagher setup the UM offense with 25 assists, and Cassie Loessberg got low for eight digs of her own out of her libero position.

The Hurricanes also used seven kills from Lane Carico as she fell just short of a double-double with eight digs.

Seeing Double...

Sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico posted her league-leading 18th double-double of the season with a match-high 14 kills and 11 digs in against Boston College (Nov. 22). The Manhattan Beach, Calif.,

Nicole Lantagne Welch

This season marks Nicole Lantagne Welch's ninth year at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in six

of the last eight seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

Last season, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.



Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by three seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her eight years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 18.9 wins per seasons with a career record of 151-87.

While new records were set during the 2007 campaign, the 2008 season saw even those records fall as Lantagne Welch and her staff assembled one of the best records in school history. Lantagne Welch led Miami to its best ACC record in school history. It was also the second-best record in school history on the Division I level of athletics.

Katie Gallagher moved in sole possession of second place all-time at UM for assists in a career during the 2008 season, while Cassie Loessberg placed herself in second place for digs in a career. In addition, Loessberg broke her own school record from a year ago for digs in a single-season, upping the new record to 554—besting her old school-record mark by two.

As for Gallagher, she etched her name once again as one of the Top 10 single-season assists leaders in school history. Already sitting at third place in school history from the 2007 season where she collected 1,243 assists, Gallagher added to that total with 1,202 in 2008—good enough for sixth place all-time in school history.

Freshman Lane Carico broke the freshman record for kills in a single-season for UM with 369, adding her name to 10th all-time for single-season kills. Meanwhile, Miami tied a school-record for hitting percentage in a five-set match, collecting a .329 percentage at Florida State on Nov. 26, 2008. The 'Canes would also collect the second-best single-set hitting mark in school history with a .615 clip against Boston College in the third set on Oct. 10, 2008.

Lantagne Welch would see two more student-athletes graduate following the 2008 season. Angelica Ellis and Bridget Bomhach both earned their Bachelor's Degree, while Ashley Woods completed her Master's Degree.

Woods placed her name eighth all-time in sets played (367), as well as eighth place all-time in total attacks (1,764). Ellis now ranks ninth in attacks (1,209), while also collecting the third-highest individual single-season hitting percentage (.350) from the 2008 campaign. Overall, Ellis is third in school history in career hitting percentage with a .275 clip through 318 sets and 1,209 attacks. Woods is tied for fifth in career hitting percentage, holding a .256 clip, sitting alongside Ciara Michel (2004-07).

The eighth-year head coach also coached three All-ACC Second Team members with

Lane Carico, Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. In addition, Carico and Ellis were each named as AVCA All-America honorable mention, while Carico was selected the 2008 AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico was also the true definition of "student-athlete" as she was named to the All-ACC Academic Team.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

Hurricanes VB Media Policy

KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

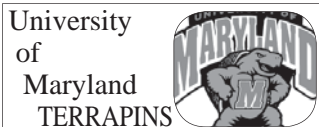

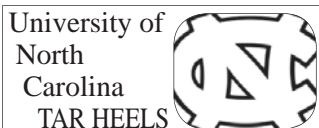
Florida State Clinches ACC Title...

The 14th-ranked (American Volleyball Coaches Association) Florida State Seminoles clinched an outright ACC regular-season championship with a 3-0 win over Maryland (Nov. 22) to earn the conferences' automatic qualifying bid to the 2009 NCAA Championship. The Seminoles' title is the first regular-season crown in school history.



Last Time Out - vs. Boston College (11/22/09)...

The University of Miami volleyball team used three players in double digits for kills en route to a 3-0 victory (25-13, 25-22, 25-14) over visiting Boston College in ACC action inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex on Sunday in Coral Gables, Fla.



Prior to the start of Sunday's match, Miami (18-11, 11-8 ACC) honored four senior student-athletes for "Senior Appreciation Day", paying tribute to players Maria Andersson, Cassie Loessberg, Genny Mayhew and Griffin Udelson. Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch also presented Boston College senior Taylor Williams with a set of flowers, honoring the Long Beach, Calif. native.



When the match started, however, it was the play of three sophomores that sparked Miami past a resilient Boston College (12-18, 2-17 ACC) squad.



Lane Carico, Ali Becker and Christine Williamson each registered double-digit kills in the match, helping Miami whenever the Hurricanes needed a kill, or a block.



With Miami hitting a match-high .355 clip (14-3-31) in the opening set, the 'Canes cruised to a 25-13 set-victory over the Eagles. The 'Canes rode three kills from senior outside hitter Mayhew, while classmate and outside hitter Andersson tacked on three service aces and two kills.



Miami was seemingly on its way to an easy afternoon, but the visitors from Chestnut Hill, Mass., had other ideas.

UM led 9-3 in the second set before Tsvetelina Dureva collected her only kill of the frame to begin a 4-0 Eagles run which included three attack errors by the 'Canes, finished off with block assists from BC's Krystle Higgins and Krissy Mussenden.

Two kills from Williamson and another from Becker ended the BC rally and edged the UM lead out to 12-7.

With UM leading 22-16 following another Williamson kill—one of five in the set for the Tampa native, Boston College got blocks from Higgins and Mussenden, as well as a kill from senior Taylor Williams to pull within 23-21.

But the homestanding Hurricanes got timely kills from Williamson and Carico to close-out the set, 25-22, holding a 2-0 advantage in the match heading into the intermission.

In the third set, Miami ran out to a quick 9-4 advantage behind three kills from Carico and two from junior middle blocker Lici McGee. A service ace from freshman setter Nrithya Sundararaman and a kill from Becker, and Miami led, 11-4.

Carico continued to swing a hot hand in the final frame as she grabbed seven kills and four digs to go along with Becker and Williamson each staking four kills apiece, as the Hurricanes cruised to the 25-14 set- and match-win.

As a team, the 'Canes hit .336 in the match, using 53 kills on 116 swings, while also collecting four blocks and 52 digs. They also served up six aces, collectively.

Boston College was led in the match by Williams with eight kills and four digs. Mussenden added four blocks (three assisted), and Melanie Cimino gave the Eagles six kills in a starting effort.

Miami was led by Carico's 14 kills and 11 digs giving the Manhattan Beach, Calif., native her 18th double-double effort of the year. She also added two assists and a service ace.

Also touching double digits in kills were classmates Becker and Williamson with 11 kills apiece, as Becker added an assisted block, and Williamson went low for two digs.

McGee helped UM with seven kills and three blocks (two assisted), and senior libero Loessberg finished the afternoon with a match-high 20 digs, adding an assist and a service ace.
