THE FACTS...

The University of Miami volleyball team takes to the road for the second and third matches of their current five-match road swing this week, taking on Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) foes Duke University and Wake Forest University. The Hurricanes are 1-0 in the league for just the second time in the last four years after defeating in-state conference rival Florida State last Friday night at home in Coral Gables.

Miami is riding the second-longest winning streak (14 matches) in school history dating back to the end of the 2001 campaign stretching into 2002. At that time, the 'Canes were not eligible for the NCAA Tournament in 2001 due to just bringing back the program after a 20-year hiatus. In 2002, the 'Canes started the season 15-0. However, this week's matches will certainly test the young Hurricanes as their next four road matches include play at Duke (9-3), Wake Forest (9-3), Clemson (8-4, 0-1 ACC) and Georgia Tech (9-2, 1-0 ACC).

UM travels to Duke first on Thursday night, a place in which the Hurricanes have never tasted victory. The Orange and Green is 0-2 in Durham, and that stretch of famous "Tobacco Road" has been home to 3-0 wins in favor of the Blue Devils. The 'Canes have been defeated by 3-0 scores in four of six matches against Duke since joining the ACC.

Against Wake Forest, the Hurricanes are 5-2 all-time, and have won five of the last six matches against the Demon Deacons. In Winston-Salem, the 'Canes are 2-0 since joining the ACC. The two teams split a pair of games last season, with the road team taking advantage each time.

The Hurricanes received other votes into his week's AVCA poll for the first time this season. They received seven votes, and are one of just seven teams in NCAA Division I volleyball that are peeking at an unblemished record to date. ON DUKE...

Duke University is 9-3 on the season and opens their ACC season against the Hurricanes on Thursday night. The Blue Devils only losses this year have come against nationally ranked opponents Purdue (19), Kansas State (17) and Middle Tennessee (23). The Devils are also 4-0 at home this year with wins against Seton Hall, Colgate, Georgia and Delaware.

Duke is led by a trip of players including senior outside hitter Rachael Moss. She leads the team with 150 kills and holds an attack percentage of 28 percent (.282). She also has a team second-best 127 digs and 19 blocks. Behind her is Becci Burling with 114 kills and 71 digs. The setter for the Blue Devils is Kellie Catanach with 440 assists under her belt.

ON WAKE FOREST...

The Deacons have started the season with a 9-3 record and have claimed three invitational titles. Wake opened the season with a win at the Deacon Invitational, then claimed the Black & Gold Challenge on Sept. 13 before winning the Appalachian State Inv. last weekend.

A large reason for the Deacs' success this year has been the play of middle blocker Natalie Mullikin and setter Kelsey Jones. Both players picked up tournament MVP honors this season; Mullikin at the Deacon Inv. and Jones at the Black & Gold Challenge.

Mullikin tops the team with 134 kills and 47 total blocks. She is also averaging 3.19 kills per set and is hitting at a .363 clip. Both her hitting percentage and kills per set rank ninth in the ACC.

CARICO PICKS UP ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK...

Freshman Lane Carico was named as this week's ACC Player of the Week following her help in keeping the Hurricanes undefeated in two wins last week against FSU and FAU, respectively. On Friday against arch

Head Coach ... Nicole Lantagne Welch



Nicole Lantagne Welch enters her eighth season at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in five of the last seven seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In the 2006 season-opener, Lantagne Welch recorded her 100th career win with a 3-2 victory over Alabama. In 2007, UM finished 14-17 overall and 8-14 in ACC play, pushing Lantagne Welch's career

record to 125-81 overall in seven seasons as a head coach, all at Miami.

Her career at UM is highlighted by two consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins (2003 & 2004) and a trip to the Sweet 16 in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her seven seasons at the helm, the Hurricanes have averaged 17.8 wins per season.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. As a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered first-team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and 1993, and earned second-team honors in 1991. She was also named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

As team captain her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career at Maryland, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7th, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

HURRICANES VB MEDIA POLICY**KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX**

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Information Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

rival Florida State, Carico tallied 16 kills on 39 attempts with only three errors. She coupled that with 13 digs and a service ace to lead Miami to a 3-1 victory over the Seminoles. A day later on Saturday, Carico had 12 kills on 20 attempts with four errors in a 3-0 victory over local foe Florida Atlantic. She also tallied 13 digs for her third consecutive double-double and fifth of the season.

MIAMI VS. DUKE SERIES...

Miami trails the all-time series with the Blue Devils by a count of 7-1. Their lone win came back on Nov. 6, 2002 in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament in Madison, Wisconsin. The Hurricanes took the match, 3-0 (30-25, 30-18, 30-20) en route to their only Sweet 16 appearance in school history. Duke has won the last five meetings consecutively, including two in Durham, North Carolina.

MIAMI VS. WAKE FOREST SERIES...

The Hurricanes lead the all-time series, 5-2 against Wake Forest. The triad area of NC has been good to the Orange and Green as they are 2-0 in Winston-Salem since joining the league. The 'Canes have taken four of the last five matches, but WFU did win last year's meeting in Coral Gables (Sept. 28) with a 3-0 decision.

TRACKING LOESSBERG AND THE DIGS...

Junior libero Cassie Loessberg continues to jump up the charts this season as she now has 196 digs on the campaign, upping her career total to 1,066. That sets Loessberg at second place all-time in UM history behind Jamie Grass (2001-04) with 1,621 digs under her belt. Throughout the year, we will continue to track Loessberg in her goal to become the all-time leading digs collector at UM.

OPPONENTS HELD IN CHECK FOR HITTING...

Miami has held its opponents to under .200 hitting as a team in 10 of the first 12 matches on the campaign. That includes negative hitting percentages in a match against Louisiana-Monroe. They held opponents Sacramento State (twice), VCU and Florida Atlantic to under .100 hitting. Meanwhile, the 'Canes have collected a .275 attack percentage on the year, while opponents are hitting just .136 altogether.

HURRICANES SWEEPING TO YOUR TOWN...

Miami has never been afraid of taking the "show" on the road, and that's exactly where the Hurricanes will have to go through five consecutive contests beginning Saturday, Sept. 20 at nearby Florida Atlantic. In fact, UM will travel to ACC foes Duke, Wake Forest, Clemson and Georgia Tech in straight road matches.

MAYHEW NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC TEAM...

She also finished fourth on the squad in digs (224) and tied for fifth in blocks (43) alongside teammate Ariell Cooke while playing in 111 games for the 'Canes.

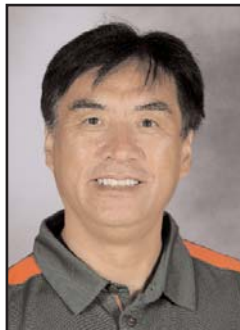
