No. 23 Miami Back Home to Host Clemson, Georgia Tech...

The 23rd-ranked University of Miami returns home this weekend to host the Clemson Tigers (Oct. 14) and Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets (Oct. 16) at the James L. Knight Sports Complex.

The Hurricanes (14-2, 5-2 Atlantic Coast Conference) hold a 5-0 record at home this year, and ride a 10-match home winning streak into the weekend. Miami played in two exciting five-set thrillers last weekend at NC State and UNC. UM came back from a 2-1 deficit against the Wolfpack to win the match, and almost pulled off an incredible comeback against UNC after trailing in the match, 2-0. The Canes defeated the Pack, but fell to the Tar Heels.

Miami is led by four players with 100-plus kills on the season, including Preseason All-ACC selection Lane Carico (Manhattan Beach, Calif.) with 186 (3.44 k/s). Behind her is sophomore outside hitter Alex Johnson (Tallahassee, Fla.) with 159 (2.84 k/s). Senior middle blocker Ali Becker (Katy, Texas) owns 161 kills (2.88 k/s) and redshirt senior outside hitter Christine Williamson has 118 kills (2.19 k/s).

The Hurricanes come into the weekend tied with Clemson for third in the ACC with a 5-2 league record. The Canes are looking to keep pace with UNC who is second at 6-1, while Florida State tops the league unbeaten at 7-0.

Scouting Clemson...

Clemson has played five set matches in four of their last five outings, going 2-2 in those matches. The Tigers have won three straight matches overall, and are coming off a weekend sweep of Boston College and Maryland in Clemson. The Tigers put up 72 kills against the Terps, which was the most for a Clemson team in the 25-point format, and the most overall since 2007. The Tigers have won nine of 11 overall.

Sandra Adeleye leads Clemson offensively at 3.17 kills per set, and Serenat Yaz, who is also averaging more than three kills per set in ACC play. Junior Alexa Rand leads the league in hitting at .387, and is second in the ACC and seventh nationally in blocking at 1.51 per set.

The Tigers rank 15th nationally at 2.75 blocks per set, while ranking second in the ACC in opponent hitting percentage.

Series against the Tigers...

Clemson holds a 10-5 advantage in the all-time series between the two schools. However, a season ago Miami took both matches against

the Tigers for the first time in the series history. In fact, UMiami has won three of the last five matches.

Scouting Georgia Tech...

Georgia Tech (10-7, 3-4 ACC) will first travel to Florida State before coming down to Coral Gables. The Yellow Jackets use the power of Monique Mead for kills as the senior outside hitter leads the ACC in kills per set and is third in the nation at 4.98. Mead is also averaging 2.60 digs per set and 0.89 blocks.

The Jackets have a dual threat at the setter position as Freshman Ali Santi is third in the ACC dishing out 10.89 assists per set. Her 60 assists against NC State was good enough for second most in a game in the ACC this season and also improved her assists/set in league play to 11.00, good enough for third. She has five double-doubles this season.

Series against the Yellow Jackets...

Georgia Tech leads the series against the Hurricanes by the slimmest of margins, 7-6. After winning four matches in a row from 2008-09, Georgia Tech took both matches last year against UMiami. The Yellow Jackets won the first contest in a five-set thriller before taking a 3-1 decision in the second match of the year between the two foes.

Carico Named Lowe's Senior CLASS Finalist...

Lane Carico of the University of Miami has been selected as one of 10 finalists for this year's Lowe's Senior CLASS Award for volleyball. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition.

Carico, an outside hitter from Manhattan Beach, Calif., became Miami's all-time leader in kills during the second set of the Hurricanes' 3-0 win over Duke on Sunday, Oct. 2. The 2010 AVCA Third Team All-America player currently has 1,532 kills throughout her career. She also ranks second all-time in points (1,733), third in kills per set (3.75), third in digs (1,505), fourth in service aces (109) and eighth in sets played (409).

On the campaign, Carico has helped the Hurricanes to their first-ever regular season ranking with the Canes getting as high as No. 20 in Week Five. Carico is fourth in the Atlantic

Nicole Lantagne Welch is in her 11th season as head coach of the University of Miami volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in eight of the last 10 seasons,

including ending the 2010 campaign ranked No. 26 in the RPI polls and No. 28 in the Pabo rankings.

Last season, Lantagne Welch helped guide the Canes to their second 20-win season in the last three years, and the second consecutive year in which UMiami advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Miami ended the season with a 23-9 overall mark (13-7 Atlantic Coast Conference) and finished third in the conference regular season standings. Along the way, the Hurricanes defeated NCAA Tournament participants Florida State, Middle Tennessee State, Georgia Southern, Wichita State and North Carolina.

At the end of the year, Lantagne Welch saw her first-ever AVCA All-American honored in the form of Lane Carico, collecting third team accolades following a record-breaking year. Carico became the first player in school history with 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in a career, as well as leading the ACC in double-doubles – and later being the only player in the league to amass at least 400 kills and 400 digs on the campaign.

Carico and teammate Katie Gallagher each claimed AVCA All-East Region Team honors, while freshman libero Ryan Shaffer set a new school record for digs by a freshman (539 / 4.53 per set). As for Carico, she would also earn her



third consecutive All-ACC Team nod and All-East Region honor.

In 2009, Lantagne Welch helped the Hurricanes to their second NCAA Tournament appearance, competing in the Gainesville [Fla.] Regional. UM earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after holding the 33rd toughest schedule in the nation according to the end-of-year RPI rankings. Earlier in the season, Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to the Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic championship.

She would add to her growing list of All-Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes, as well as All-America honorable mention performers, seeing senior libero Cassie Loessberg and sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico named to both lists. Carico and Loessberg each collected AVCA All-America Honorable Mention selections, while both were tabbed to the AVCA All-East Region Team.

During the 2008 campaign, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by four seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08, '10) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her 10 years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 19.2 wins per seasons with a career record of 192-109.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a

major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Coral Gables.

Hurricanes VB Media Policy

KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, in-between the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Alex Rodriguez Park, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Office of Athletic Communications. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-set and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post match notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Athletic Communications Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Office of Athletic Communications at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

Telephone lines at the Knight Sports Complex are limited to home radio and the visiting teams' "official" sports administrator/media relations contact. Lane Carico Earns Third ACC Weekly Honor...

For the third time this year, Lane Carico picked up ACC Player of the Week honors after a stellar performance against Wake Forest and Duke last weekend.

Carico helped Miami extend its winning streak to four matches and its home court winning streak to 10 straight as she registered 5.50 kills per set and 3.67 digs per set in wins over Wake Forest and Duke, respectively. The native of Manhattan Beach, Calif. hit .389 over the weekend and put down a team-high 33 kills against just five errors on 72 swings for the Canes.

She helped Miami sweep Duke and break a three-match losing skid to the Blue Devils, recording the first win over Duke since a 3-0 decision in 2008. Additionally, Carico became the school's all-time leader in kills with 1,495, surpassing Karla Johnson for the top honor. In both matches on the weekend, Carico picked up double-doubles to extend her streak to four and increase her total to nine on the year.

Life In the Fast Lane...

Senior outside hitter Lane Carico's fourth kill of the match versus Duke on October 2 allowed her to etch her name as the school's all-time leader in kills, surpassing Karla Johnson (2002-05) atop the list. Currently, Carico has 1,495 career kills.

Home Is Where the Heart Is...

With two wins coming inside the James L. Knight Sports Complex against league foes Wake Forest and Duke, the University of Miami extended its home winning streak to 10 matches dating back to last year. The last home loss was a 3-2 decision against the Blue Devils of Duke on Oct. 22, 2010.

Since 2008, UMiami is 39-10 at home, including a 5-0 mark this year.

Coaching Milestone Achieved...

UMiami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch collected her 200th career win following the Hurricanes 3-0 win over Auburn. Lantagne Welch is already the winningest coach in UM volleyball history, and has served as the only coach since the program was brought back in 2001.

Miami on the National Stage...

When Miami travelled to Florida State for a nationally televised game on ESPN on Sept. 14, and that was the first nationally televised contest for the Hurricanes in school history. UMiami will host Virginia Tech in another televised match on Oct. 30.

Miami Storms Through Commonwealth State...

Last weekend, the No. 21 Hurricanes swept through the state of Virginia defeating both Virginia Tech and Virginia with 3-0 decisions. For UMiami, it was the first time since 2007 it had beaten the Cavaliers of UVa on the road.

Miami Takes Hurricane Invitational Title...

With wins against FAMU, Auburn and nationally ranked Oklahoma, the Hurricanes collected their second consecutive Hurricane

The win over No. 18 Oklahoma was the first win for the Hurricanes over a ranked team since Dec. 7, 2002 when they defeated No. 15 Wisconsin in the Madison [Wis.] Regional of the NCAA Tournament.

Carico Repeats as ACC Player of the Week...

University of Miami senior outside hitter Lane Carico was once again selected as ACC Player of the Week (Sept. 12-18). This marked the second straight week Carico picked up conference player of the week accolades.

The Manhattan Beach, Calif. native compiled 30 kills on a .258 hitting percentage for 3.75 kills per set and had 32 digs in eight sets. She also had five blocks and four service aces. Carico came up huge in the win over No. 18 Oklahoma with 19 kills and 16 digs to help pull off the come-from-behind upset. It was the first victory over a ranked opponent for the Hurricanes since December 7, 2002, when Miami beat No. 15 Wisconsin in the NCAA Tournament.

Carico, Gallagher, Johnson All-Tournament...

Lane Carico, Katie Gallagher and Alex Johnson were all named to the Hurricane Invitational All-Tournament Team after helping UMiami to the tournament title. Carico picked

up Hurricane Invitational MVP honors in staking a season-high 19 kills and posting 16 digs in the championship match win over the Sooners.

Gallagher Moves Into Record Books...

During the Hurricane Invitational, redshirt senior setter Katie Gallagher became just the second player in UMiami volleyball history to post at least 4,000 assists and 1,000 digs in a career. She joins Jill Robinson (2003-06) as the only other Hurricanes player to do so.

Lane Carico Wins ACC Player of the Week...

Lane Carico was named as the Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Week (Sept. 4-10) after turning in 3.10 kills per set and 5.00 digs per set in three matches at the *Pepperdine Asics Classic* in Malibu, Calif. The Canes won the tournament with a 3-1 decision against the host Pepperdine Waves.

For the tournament, Johnson amassed a team-high 39 kills (3.55 k/s) and a team second-best 43 digs (3.91 d/s). She was also second on the team in blocks (11).

Carico and Gallagher Named Preseason All-ACC...

Senior outside hitter Lane Carico and redshirt senior Katie Gallagher were named to the Preseason All-ACC Team announced Tuesday by the ACC Office.

Carico has been named to the All-ACC Team the last two years and the All-ACC Freshman Team in 2008.

Miami Predicted to Finish Fourth in ACC Preseason Poll...

The Canes have been predicted to finish fourth in the Preseason ACC Poll voted on by head coaches from around the league.

UMiami was predicted to finish fourth last season before ending the year third in the final standings.

Recapping the Last Match - at UNC (Oct. 9)...

No. 21 University of Miami battled back from an 0-2 deficit, but was unable to complete the comeback on Sunday, falling to North Carolina by a 3-2 decision inside Carmichael Arena in a classic ACC volleyball match. The Canes fell on scores of 31-29, 25-23, 19-25, 25-27, 15-11.

Trailing 17-14 in the fourth frame – and down 2-1 in the match, senior middle blocker Ali Becker began the comeback with back-to-back kills, followed by another from sophomore outside hitter Taylor Hollins to knot the set at 17-all. UM would take the lead at 19-18 on a kill from senior All-America outside hitter Lane Carico.

UNC would not go away quietly in the frame as outside hitter Kayla Berringer stamped one of her five kills in the set to tie things up again, 25-25. The Hurricanes used the seventh kill of the set from Becker and the sixth from Hollins to secure the win, 27-25.

In the fifth set, Miami took a 3-1 lead after an attack error by Carolina's Chaniel Nelson. But it would be the Tar Heels scoring the next five points – three from Berringer – in order to surge out in front, 7-3. After falling behind, 8-5, UM's

Hollins and freshman middle blocker Emani Sims stamped kills to bring the Hurricanes to within one at 8-7.

UNC would use a kill and a service ace from Emily McGee to take an all-important 13-9 edge late in the match. Despite a kill from Becker and Carico, Berringer put down the final kill of the match for the 15-11 edge in favor of the Tar Heels.

The Hurricanes were led in the match by four players in double figures for kills, using a career-high 22 kills from Becker and a season-high 22 from Carico. Becker hit .476 in the match with a career-high six digs and two blocks. Carico added her sixth double-double in a row with a season-best 23 digs.

Hollins also had a career day with a career-high 13 kills and career-high 19 digs for her first-ever double-double. Redshirt senior setter Katie Gallagher added a double-double of her own with a season-high 60 assists and season-high 19 digs.

Sophomore libero Ryan Shaffer collected a career-high matching 32 digs, and freshman middle blocker Alexis Mourning put down a season-high 12 kills and four blocks (three assisted). Sophomore Lizzie Hale added a season-high tying 13 digs as well.

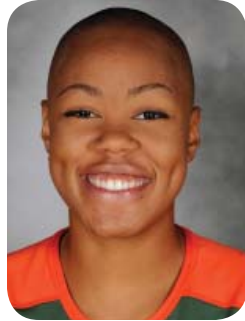
