MIAMI AND BETHUNE-COOKMAN SET TO MEET FOR FIRST TIME

- ▶ The Miami Hurricanes will play their last of three straight home games when they face Bethune-Cookman at Sun Life Stadium on Saturday, Oct. 1. The game will be televised live on ESPNU.
- ▶ Miami is 16-8 in games at Sun Life Stadium and Al Golden is 28-36 overall and 1-2 at Miami following the 28-24 loss to Kansas State on Sept. 24, 2011.
- ▶ Saturday's game against Bethune-Cookman will mark the second straight game that Miami will face a team for the first time in program history. The Canes and Kansas State met for the first time last weekend.
- ▶ UM collected 139 yards on the ground and 272 yards through the air against K-State. Entering the game, Kansas State possessed the nation's No. 1 overall defense, allowing an average of 100 yards through the air and a scant 64 yards on the ground.
- ▶ Lamar Miller has rushed for more than 1,000 career yards in just the 14th game of his career. Miller collected 646 yards in 2010 and now has 409 yards through the first three games of this season. In just 13 career games, only Clinton Portis reached the 1,000-yard plateau faster than Miller, as he recorded his 1,000th yard with a 14yard performance against Louisiana Tech in 2000.
- ▶ Of the 23 players listed as starters on UM's current depth chart, 17 of them are from the state of Florida. That includes all four defensive linemen and five of the offensive skill players.
- ▶ Junior WR Tommy Streeter made his first-career start against Kansas State. In the third quarter, he scored the Hurricanes' first touchdown with a four-yard reception, the second TD of Streeter's career. He ended the night with four catches for 31 yards.
- ▶ CollegePressBox.com, the official media website of ACC football, will provide updated media information throughout the season. Media Information includes game notes, statistics, media guides and high-resolution headshots and logos, as well as weekly news conference transcripts. The site also includes a complete media archive for all 12 schools, dating back to 2005. Information will be updated continuously throughout the season, including postseason, bowl games, final season statistics, bios and photos leading up to the NFL Draft.

COACHES SHOW

UM's coaches show, "Hurricane Game Day with Al Golden" airs twice weekly on CSS, at 5:30 p.m. Thursdays and 10 a.m. Saturdays. The show is hosted by Joe Zagacki and Don Bailey Jr. and features Hurricanes players as coach Golden's guests.

HURRICANE HOTLINE

Hurricane Hotline is a weekly two-hour show hosted by Joe Zagacki and Don Bailey Jr. that airs from 7-9 p.m. Tuesday or Wednesday nights during the season from Monty's (2550 South Bayshore Drive Coconut Grove, Florida 33133). Hurricane Hotline features interviews with UM head football coach Al Golden, players, coaches and other UM personnel as well as other featured guests. Fans are encouraged to listen on 560 WQAM or view the show in-person at Monty's in Coconut Grove.

The MIAMI-BETHUNE-COOKMAN SERIES

- ▶ This will be the first-ever meeting between Miami and Bethune-Cookman.
- ▶ Florida A&M is the only other member of the MEAC the Canes have played against, going 8-1, winning the last eight meetings.
- ▶ The Canes are undefeated at home against MEAC opponents, outscoring them 400-49, an average of 50 points per game.
- ▶ This is the first time the Wildcats have faced a BCS program this season.

A CANES WIN OVER THE WILDCATS WOULD...

- ▶ Give Al Golden and the Canes their second home victory of the season.
- ▶ Give Miami its first ever victory against Bethune-Cookman.
- ▶ Be the ninth straight win over a MEAC team.
- ▶ Give Miami a 2-1 season record at home and a 17-7 overall record at Sun Life Stadium.

The COACHES

▶ Al Golden is in his first year as Miami's head coach and owns an overall record of 28-36. Wildcats' head coach Brian Jenkins recorded a 10-2 record in his first year at the helm, leading B-CU to a FCS Playoff berth for the first time since 2003 while earning MEAC Coach of the Year Honors.

Scouting THE WILDCATS

- ▶ The Wildcats avoided a second loss of the season last week against Hampton on a controversial last second touchdown that was overturned by the officials.
- ▶ Preseason All-MEAC nominee linebacker Reggie Sandilands is the team's leading tackler with 21 takedowns so far this season, including two fumble recoveries and an interception.
- ▶ Quarterback Jamarr Robinson has twin targets on offense in Maurice Francois and Eddie Poole, who have reigned in 16 and 12 passes respectively for a combined 381 yards and three scores.
- ▶ Bethune-Cookman enters the matchup sporting a plus-three turnover differential, with their defense averaging two picks and two forced fumbles per game.

Up **NEXT...**

▶ The Hurricanes hit the road for the next two weeks. First making a trip to Blacksburg, Va. to take on their former Big East rivals in the Hokies (10/1), followed by a clash with the Tar Heels in Chapel Hill, N.C. (10/8).

Streak **CONTINUES**

- ▶ Former Hurricanes and current proCanes Willis McGahee (Denver), Jimmy Graham (New Orleans) and Greg Olsen (Carolina) all scored touchdowns in Week 3 of the NFL season.
- ▶ At least one former Cane has now scored a touchdown every NFL week since Week 15 of the 2002 season a span of 142 straight weeks.

Canes OPEN NEW ERA UNDER HEAD COACH AL GOLDEN

- ▶ First-year head coach Al Golden won his first game as a Hurricane when Miami defeated then No. 17/16 Ohio State, 24-6, at Sun Life Stadium in UM's home opener on Sept. 17.
- ▶ Golden owns an overall record of 28-36 and is in his sixth season as a head coach.
- ▶ Golden arrived in Coral Gables after spending the last five seasons as the head coach at Temple University. Over five seasons at Temple, Golden took the Owls to unprecedented heights. Before his arrival, TU had just two winning seasons over its previous 26 years and had only won 22 percent of its games over the previous 30 years. Quickly, Golden made the Owls a contender, leading the team to a combined record of 17-8 his last two years there. The 2009 season marked Temple's first winning season since 1990, and Golden was rewarded with MAC Coach of the Year honors.

Only working press will be admitted to the Sun Life Stadium press box. Seats will be issued according to the following criteria:

- 1. State newspapers by circulation, wire services, national publications, newspapers from opponent's area, and student newspapers from UM and opponent's schools.
- 2. Other daily newspapers, with preference to those that regularly cover UM.
- 3. Radio and television personnel not broadcasting, but considered reporting.
- **4.** Non-daily newspapers, with preference to those which regularly cover UM.
- **5.** Scouts. Freelance and/or non-daily writers may be asked to produce copies of actual publications in which their work has appeared. In some cases, these materials will be required as verification of the writers' status.

- ▶ Miller leads the ACC in rushing, averaging 136.3 yards per game. He leads the next leading rusher by 7.1 yards per game.
- ▶ Miller ranks fifth nationally in rushing yards per game with an average of 136, trailing only Denard Robinson (Michigan), LaMichael James (Oregon), Marcus Lattimore (South Carolina) and Ronnie Hillman (SDSU).
- ▶ Miller is also seventh nationally in all-purpose yards (rush + receptions + kick returns) with an average of 188.7 per game.
- ▶ Youth prevails as three of the top-five rushers nationally are sophomores, including Miller.

Spence NAMED HONORABLE MENTION LB OF THE WEEK

- ▶ Senior linebacker Sean Spence has been named a College Football Performance Awards Honorable Mention Linebacker of the Week after his performance against Kansas State.
- ▶ Spence tied a career-high with 14 total tackles (eight solo, six assists) in UM's loss to the Wildcats. The Miami native was the best defender on the field in the Canes' second home game, as he added one sack, 2.5 tackles for loss and a forced fumble to his game-high tackles total.

A GAME OF FIRSTS

- ▶ Several individual firsts took place in Miami's game against Kansas State on Sept. 24.
- ▶ Junior WR Tommy Streeter made his first-career start. In the third quarter he scored the Hurricanes' first touchdown with a four-yard reception, the second TD of Streeter's career. He ended the night with four catches for 31 yards.
- ▶ Rashawn Scott recorded his first-career catch, a two-yard reception in the first quarter.
- ▶ Senior LB Jordan Futch posted his first career sack in the third quarter, an eight-yard loss for the Wildcats.
- ▶ Futch, DL Marcus Forston and LB Spence each recorded their first sacks of the season.
- ▶ In the second half, Miami's Ramon Buchanan blocked a Wildcats field goal attempt. It was the first block of the season and the first since Dec. 31, 2004 against Florida.

Four FOOTBALL PLAYERS TO ENTER UM HALL OF FAME

▶ The University of Miami Sports Hall of Fame announced on Sept. 22 that four former Hurricane football players will be among those to be enshrined in its Class of 2012. Current Baltimore Ravens Ed Reed and Bryant McKinnie as well as Rich Mercier and Ray Bellamy - the university's first African-American football player - will be enshrined into the hall on March 29, 2012.

▶ Ed Reed (1998-2001)

Consensus First Team All-America and All-BIG EAST selection in 2000 and 2001... Set UM career records for interceptions (21) and interception return yards (389)... His nine interceptions in 2001 is the second-highest single-season total in UM history... Recorded eight interceptions in 2000 (third-best in UM history).

▶ Bryant McKinnie (2000-2001)

Outland Trophy winner as college football's outstanding interior lineman in 2001... Named a First Team All-American by *The Football News* in 2000 and a consensus first team All-American by every national service in 2001, including the Associated Press, Football Writers Association, *The Football News*, *The Sporting News* and the Walter Camp and the National Football Foundations... The 2001 National Player of the Year by CNNSI.com... The 2001 College Football Offensive Player of the Year by The Football News... Did not allow a quarterback sack during his entire UM career.

▶ Ray Bellamy (1967-1970)

Miami's first African-American football player... Endured hardships and led the way for future African-American athletes... In 1968, had 37 receptions for 549 yards and two touchdowns... Had eight receptions for 121 yards vs. Auburn in 1968... In 1969, caught 45 passes for 712 yards... Near-fatal auto accident limited his career... Was voted Miami's first African-American student body president in 1971.

▶ Rich Mercier (1995-1999)

First Team All-America selection by *The Sporting News* in 1999... Two-time All-BIG EAST First Team selection (1998-99)... Team leader in pancake blocks in both his junior and senior seasons... Tied Mike Sullivan for the UM record in career starts (48)... Invited to play in the Senior Bowl, Hula Bowl, East-West Shrine Game and Florida Citrus All Star Gridiron Classic.

The **BUCK STOPS HERE**

- ▶ Coming into the Sept. 17 game, Ohio State had not allowed a sack in any of its last 90 pass attempts, the third-longest active FBS streak. The Hurricanes ended that streak at 95, as Canes defensive lineman Darius Smith sacked OSU QB Braxton Miller to end the first quarter, then freshmen defensive end Anthony Chickillo recorded his first career sack in the second half.
- ▶ The UM defense held the Ohio State quarterbacks to 4-for-18 passing, marking the lowest number of completed passes against a UM defense since the Canes held Wake Forest to just three completions in 2008. Ohio State had only four passing yards in the first half and ended the night with 35 yards.
- ▶ The Hurricanes didn't allow Ohio State to score a touchdown in the game, a feat last accomplished by Penn State in 2008

UM LEADS STATE & NO. 38 IN U.S. NEWS & WORLD REPORT RANKINGS

- ▶ In the 2012 edition of the *U.S. News & World Report's* annual "Best Colleges" issue, released today, the University of Miami has risen to number 38 up from 47 last year, a nine point rise. UM remains the highest ranked school in the state of Florida.
- ▶ In an impressive ascent, UM has moved up 29 slots in the last 10 years, making it one of the fastest-rising institutions among national universities in recent times. UM is the only school currently in the top 50 to move up nine spots in one year and 29 spots in the past 10 years.

Home SWEET SUNSHINE STATE HOME

- ▶ Miami's game on September 5 in College Park, Md., was the first of only three games that the Canes will play outside of the Sunshine State this season.

J12 AMONG THE BEST

- ▶ Quarterback Jacory Harris entered the season ranked among Miami's top signal callers as he appears in six different career records categories.
- ▶ Harris is ranked third all-time in pass attempts, passing yardage and total offense, second in touchdown passes thrown and sixth in pass completions percentage. Harris is on track to upend Ken Dorsey in two categories, needing to complete 124 passes and attempt 230 passes to surpass Dorsey as the record holder. Last season he connected on 148 passes and attempted 270.
- ▶ He moved into sole possession of second place all-time in career passing TDs on Oct. 23, 2010 when he threw touchdown passes to LaRon Byrd, Travis Benjamin and Leonard Hankerson against the Tar Heels.
- ▶ With his two TD passes against Ohio State, Harris moved into sole possession of 17th place on the ACC's Career TD passes list with 52. The senior added two more against Kansas state and is now just one touchdown pass shy of tying Ben Bennett (Duke 1980-83) and Shawn Moore (Virginia 1987-90). NC State's Phillip Rivers is the all-time leader with 95
- ▶ Harris passed Virginia's Shawn Moore (1987-90; 6,629), with his 272-yard performance against Kasnas State, for 25th place on the ACC's career passing yardage stats, as he now has 6,735 career passing yards.

Canes SCHEDULE AMONG THE TOUGHEST

- ▶ According to Phil Steele's College Football Preview, Miami will face the 10th-toughest schedule of any FBS school this season. Only Colorado, Iowa State, Baylor, Oregon State, LSU, Boston College, USC, Washington and Auburn face a tougher road according to the publication.
- ▶ After traveling to Maryland for the season-opener, the Canes returned home to host non-conference foes Ohio State and Kansas State in back-to-back weeks at Sun Life Stadium. In the coming weeks, Miami will face a pair of difficult tests on the road in consecutive trips to Virginia Tech (Oct. 8) and North Carolina (Oct. 15). The yearly rivalry game with Florida State will also come on the road, as the Canes will travel to Tallahassee to face the Seminoles on Nov. 12.
- ▶ UM is only one of six FBS programs to play its first three games against BCS-conference opponents. The others are USC. FAU, Rice, Notre Dame and BYU.

Eight CANES GO IN 2011 NFL DRAFT

- ▶ The University of Miami's success in the NFL Draft continued this past spring, as eight Canes were selected in 2011. Orlando Franklin (2nd round to Denver), Brandon Harris (2nd round to Houston), Leonard Hankerson (3rd round to Washington), DeMarcus Van Dyke (3rd round to Oakland), Allen Bailey (3rd round to Kansas City), Colin McCarthy (4th round to Tennessee), Richard Gordon (6th round to Oakland) and Matt Bosher (6th round to Atlanta) were all taken off the board in the Top 200 picks.
- ▶ Miami's eight draftees trailed only USC (9) and North Carolina (9) for the most in the country in 2011.
- ▶ Since 2000, only Ohio State (78) and USC (77) have had more players drafted than the Canes (75).
- ▶ Miami continues to comfortably lead the nation in first round draft picks in recent years, as 26 Canes have been selected in the first round since 2000. Ohio State (17) remains a distant second.

Honoring A LEGEND

- ▶ UM honored Russell Maryland in an on-field ceremony in the Sept. 17 contest against Ohio State to commemorate the defensive tackle's upcoming induction into the College Football Hall of Fame in December.
- ▶ Maryland finished his college career with 279 tackles, 25 tackles for losses and 20.5 quarterback sacks. He was the Jack Harding Most Valuable Player Award winner in 1990 and led the Hurricanes to four consecutive bowl berths, two national championships and an overall record of 45-3 during his career.




