

ACC BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP: STORYLINES & NEWS

- No. 7 seed Miami opens its postseason at the 2017 ACC Baseball Championship on May 22 at Durham Bulls Athletic Park.
- UM is joined in Pool B by No. 2 seed Clemson & No. 11 seed Notre Dame; Miami won its 2018 regular season series vs. both.
- Miami is in its 25th and final season under the direction of **Jim Morris**, who has the fifth-most wins in Division I history.
- The Hurricanes are riding the nation's second-longest active winning streak into Tuesday night, having won 10 in a row.
- Junior righthander **Andrew Cabezas** (6-4, 4.12 ERA) will start Tuesday versus Notre Dame's **Scott Tully**. (5-1, 4.40 ERA).
- The University of Miami is the only school with a 10-game win streak in football, men's basketball and baseball in 2017-18.
- UM is 21-20 all-time in the ACC Championship, and advanced to last year's semifinal round at Louisville Slugger Field.
- Miami has one ACC Championship (2008) all-time and has made two Championship Game appearances (2008, 2012).
- Miami has qualified for the College World Series **25 times** - the second-most of any program nationwide, trailing only Texas (35). The Hurricanes' **four national championships** (1982, 1985, 1999, 2001) are tied for fifth-most all-time.

It doesn't matter if his roster is full of rookies or veterans, University of Miami head coach Jim Morris continues to produce some of college baseball's most consistent and dominant teams entering his 25th and final season in Coral Gables. With a talented staff around him, Morris' Hurricanes are continually the class of collegiate baseball, having won national titles in 1999 and 2001 and the ACC Baseball Regular Season Championship in 2008, 2014 and 2016.

In his 24-season tenure at Miami, no program has qualified for the College World Series as much as Morris and his Hurricanes. Miami, which has qualified for the NCAA Tournament on 45 occasions, has made it to Omaha in 13 of Morris' 24 seasons in Coral Gables - including most recently in 2016, when Miami was awarded the No. 3 national seed for the NCAA postseason.

Morris set an NCAA record for guiding a program to the CWS in each of his first six years at UM. In addition, Morris has won 17 of 23 NCAA Regional appearances at UM, including a record 13 straight to start his tenure in Coral Gables. His teams qualified for NCAA Regionals for a streak of 32 straight years, beginning with his final nine seasons (1985-1993) at Georgia Tech and his first 23 seasons at Miami (1994-2016).

A three-time national coach of the year and 2008 Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year, Morris has directed the Hurricanes to a 1,089-468-3 (.703) mark since arriving in 1994. Including his 12 seasons at Georgia Tech (1982-93), Morris has forged a 1,593-713-4 (.693) Division I record in 36 years as a head coach. Overall, Morris has been the head coach at the collegiate level for 40-plus seasons, spending the first four at DeKalb (Ga.) C.C. from 1976-79, and has recorded a 1,724-751-4 (.698) mark.

In addition to carrying on Miami's great baseball reputation in the last 24 years, Morris personally led the charge in the construction of Alex Rodriguez Park, and logged hundreds of hours raising funds for the stadium's renovation prior to its reopening in 2009.

Two Hurricanes were selected in the 2017 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft; junior outfielder Carl Chester was selected in the 12th round by Tampa Bay and junior righthander Jesse Lepore was drafted in the 24th round by Colorado. The Hurricanes finished sixth in the overall ACC standings in 2017 and advanced to the semifinals of the ACC Championship in Louisville, Ky.

Morris reached two coaching milestones in 2016, as he led the program to its 25th College World Series appearance in history, its third straight ACC Coastal Division title and the program's second ACC Regular Season Championship in a three-year span.

Morris became just the sixth coach in the history of Division I baseball to reach the 1,500-win plateau when Miami topped Louisville 8-4 in dramatic fashion on March 18, 2016. Eight days later, Miami topped Clemson 5-4 in 11 innings - also in walk-off fashion - to send Morris to his 1,000th win at the helm of the Hurricanes.

Under his direction, the Hurricanes set the program record for fielding percentage with a sparkling .983 mark in 2016, a figure that ranked best nationwide. Seven Hurricanes were selected in the 2016 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, including the program's first first-round selection since 2010 in catcher Zack Collins (No. 10, Chicago



White Sox). Morris also helped guide two Hurricanes to a pair of major awards: Collins became the first Hurricane to win the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher in 2016, while Bryan Garcia set the program saves record and became the first Hurricane to win the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award.

Morris entered 2015 as among the winningest active coaches in Division I baseball with 1,435 wins. He wasted little time in moving up the record books, moving into sole possession of eighth place in all-time wins (1,439) on Feb. 15 with a 25-4 win over Rutgers and then seventh place with a 9-5 win over Louisville on March 7 (1,445).

Miami captured the 2014 ACC Regular Season Championship under his watch, recording 24 wins in conference play for the first time in program history. Morris reached two coaching milestones in the first half of the 2014 season. He became just the eighth Division I coach to reach 1,400 wins in a 5-2 win over Boston College on March 8, and won his 900th game at Miami in a 7-1 upset of No. 3 Virginia on March 22.

Among the players Morris coached at Miami that have gone on to play in the Major Leagues are Andrew Suarez (San Francisco), Peter O'Brien (Kansas City), Chris Hermann (Arizona), Yasmani Grandal (Los Angeles Dodgers), Jemile Weeks (Boston), Danny Valencia (Oakland), Jon Jay (Chicago), Yonder Alonso (Oakland), Ryan Braun (Milwaukee), Ryan Jackson (St. Louis), Pat Burrell (Philadelphia), Alex Cora (New York Mets), Bobby Hill (San Diego), Aubrey Huff (Detroit), Chris Perez (Cleveland), Cesar Carrillo (San Diego), Brian Barton (St. Louis), Gaby Sanchez (Florida), Charlton Jimerson (Houston), Jay Tessmer (New York Yankees), Danny Graves (Cincinnati) and Jason Michaels (Houston), among many others.

ACC BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP NEWS & NOTES

RED-HOT HURRICANES OPEN ACC TOURNEY

- The Miami Hurricanes will look to continue their winning ways at the 2018 ACC Baseball Championship in Durham, N.C., from May 22 - May 27. No. 7 seed Miami is joined in Pool B by No. 2 seed Clemson and No. 11 seed Notre Dame.
- The Hurricanes are riding a season-long 10-game winning streak into Tuesday's ACC Championship opener against the Fighting Irish on Tuesday, May 22. First pitch for the contest is slated for 7 p.m.
- Miami won regular season series against both teams in Pool B, capturing two of three games against Notre Dame from March 9-10 and taking two of three on the road at Clemson from April 13-14.
- The Hurricanes' current 10-game winning streak is the second longest active streak in the country; only Stetson (11) is riding a long streak heading into the conference tournament week nationwide.
- Junior righthander **Andrew Cabezas** (6-4, 4.12 ERA) will toe the rubber Tuesday against Notre Dame while senior southpaw **Jeb Bargfeldt** (4-4, 3.20 ERA) is slated to throw Thursday vs. Clemson.

MORRIS HONORED IN REGULAR SEASON FINALE

- Head coach **Jim Morris** - the fifth-winningest coach in the history of Division I baseball and second-winningest active coach - is in his 25th and final season at the helm in Coral Gables in 2018. This season marks Morris' 41st as a head coach in the college baseball ranks.

- The "Jim Morris Final Season" logo was painted behind home plate for all home games at The Light, and a jersey patch with the logo adorns every one of the Hurricanes' uniform combos.

WEEKEND REWIND: MIAMI WINS A PAIR VS. BC

- The Miami Hurricanes earned their third straight weekend sweep from May 17-18, capturing a pair of games against Boston College. The series finale on May 19 was cancelled due to rain.
- Thanks to a complete game shutout from senior lefthander **Jeb Bargfeldt**, Miami cruised to a 3-0 win in the series opener. Bargfeldt was named ACC Pitcher of the Week for his dominant performance.
- Sophomore righthander **Evan McKendry** struck out 11 batters - one shy of his career high - in a 4-3 win in Friday's Game 2. Junior **Frankie Bartow** tossed the final two innings to earn his fourth save.
- Head coach **Jim Morris** was honored during pregame ceremonies May 19, but the game was cancelled in the third inning due to rain.

BATS CATCHING FIRE IN FINAL MONTH OF 2018

- The University of Miami is riding a season-long 10-game win streak into Tuesday's ACC Championship opener thanks to an offensive outburst during the late-season push.
- Miami batted .344 in its series sweep of Virginia Tech from May 11-13, and is batting .313 as a team over the season-long winning streak. Both **Danny Reyes** (.405) and **Romy Gonzalez** (.405) are batting over .400 during the streak.
- The Hurricanes are reaching base at a .429 clip over the win streak and are slugging .437 over that same stretch.

ACC BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP NEWS & NOTES

CABEZAS RETURNS TO DURHAM, ACC TOURNEY

- In the series finale against Duke on March 18 at Durham Bulls Athletic Park, junior righthander **Andrew Cabezas** made his first start since a 2016 NCAA Super Regional game against Boston College.
- The results were impressive - Cabezas tossed six shutout innings for Miami and struck out five batters. He has been a mainstay in the rotation ever since, and will start Tuesday once again in Durham.
- More recently, Cabezas earned the first ACC Pitcher of the Week honors of his career for a dominant performance vs. Pitt on April 21.
- When his May 6 start against Bethune-Cookman was cancelled due to rain, Cabezas was moved to the midweek role in preparation to start the ACC Championship opener.
- Cabezas delivered the highlight of Miami's trip to the ACC Championship in Louisville, Ky., last season, tossing 6.1 scoreless innings of relief in an eventual 13-inning win over Georgia Tech. Cabezas struck out 10 batters and walked two in the lengthy stint.
- The fiery righthander has been one of Miami's top pitchers in the ACC Championship. In three career appearances spanning 9.0 innings in the tournament, Cabezas has not allowed a run.

ZAMORA A FROSH ALL-AMERICA CANDIDATE

- Freshman shortstop **Freddy Zamora** has been one of UM's top players in his first year and has started all 52 games for the Canes - the only player to do so. He was named to the ACC All-Freshman Team.
- Of players who have played in more than 25 games, Zamora ranks first or is at least tied for first on Miami in hits (63), at bats (203), doubles (12), triples (four), total bases (86) and slugging percentage (.424). He is second in runs (32), hit by pitch (six), on-base percentage (.395), steals (20) and attempts (23).
- Zamora has the fewest strikeouts (18) of any starter this year.

YOUNGSTERS LEADING THE WAY FOR MIAMI

- Miami has started 10 different true freshman and one redshirt freshman this season and the results have been impressive. The Hurricanes also battled early injuries to some top contributors.
- Miami freshmen combined for 25 hits in the Hurricanes' most recent three-game sweep at Virginia Tech from May 11-13.
- **Freddy Zamora** is among the UM leaders with a .310 average, and behind him is **Isaac Quinones** (.299). Freshman **Willy Escala** has started 51 of 52 games this year, while freshman **Daniel Federman** has one of the lowest ERAs on the team at 2.25. He has totaled 60.0 innings on the hill this season - fourth most on Miami.

FEDERMAN DOING IT ALL IN FIRST SEASON

- Freshman **Daniel Federman** has been impressive in many roles, including a midweek starter, despite picking up a loss in his last start.
- Federman's 2.25 ERA is lowest among all pitchers with at least 50.0 innings and second-lowest mark among any Miami pitcher.
- On March 28 against FGCU, Federman was a hard-luck loser in a 1-0 loss vs. the Eagles (March 28). Federman allowed just four hits and had a career-high seven strikeouts against the Eagles. The one run he allowed was unearned, as Miami fell in a pitchers' duel.
- Federman is holding opponents to a paltry .203 batting average this season. He has made four starts and totaled 23 appearances.

McKENDRY TOPS "CROQUETA" CENTURY MARK

- Sophomore RHP **Evan McKendry** has been one of Miami's brightest stars this season, emerging as the top strikeout pitcher on staff in a breakthrough year. He was named to the All-ACC third team.
- McKendry's 114 strikeouts were the second-most in the ACC entering the week and his 11.8 strikeouts-per-nine ranking was the second-best in the ACC, behind only **Griffin Roberts** of Wake Forest.
- The Pembroke Pines, Fla., native, who spent time as midweek starter in his first year, became the first Miami Hurricane pitcher to top 100 strikeouts in a season since lefthander **Bryan Radziewski** did it in 2014. He had 11 "croquetas" last time out vs. Boston College (May 18).
- McKendry tossed the first complete game of his career in a dominant effort at #8 Clemson on April 14, and followed that up with a nine-strikeout performance in 6.2 innings vs. Pitt on April 21.
- McKendry was also named ACC Pitcher of the Week Feb. 26 after helping Miami hand No. 1 Florida its first loss of the season on Feb. 25.

'FAB-5' A BIG PART OF MIAMI INFIELD IN 2018

- Four true freshmen and one redshirt freshman comprised the University of Miami's starting infield during the opening weekend against Rutgers, marking the first time in Jim Morris' 25 years that such a young group started in the field.
- 1B **Alex Toral**, 2B **Willy Escala**, SS **Freddy Zamora**, 3B **Raymond Gil** and C **Michael Amditis** all started in each of the three games against Rutgers. C **Isaac Quinones** emerged as starting catcher in Amditis' absence. Gil has switched across the diamond to first base and junior **Romy Gonzalez** has started at third for most of the spring.

FRESHMEN SEEING KEY ROLES IN FIRST YEARS

- Three of Miami's top-four hitters by average - **Freddy Zamora** (.310), **Isaac Quinones** (.299) and **Dylan Cloonan** (.283) - are all true freshmen at The U, and not far behind is infielder **Willy Escala** (.270).
- Of Miami's 14 players who have started 14 or more games, eight are freshmen - players above, as well as **Tony Jenkins** (23), **Raymond Gil** (32), **Alex Toral** (28) & **Gabe Rivera** (14).

JEB! SOUTHPAW DELIVERING ON FRIDAYS

- Senior lefthander **Jeb Bargfeldt**, an All-ACC Second Team selection a season ago, picked up where he left off in 2018; he has allowed two or fewer earned runs in nine of 14 starts.
- In 29 career starts at Miami, Bargfeldt has allowed two or fewer earned runs in 21, including vs. Rutgers, Maine, Notre Dame, Virginia, Pittsburgh, Florida State, Bethune-Cookman, Virginia Tech and Boston College this season.

TORAL, RIVERA IN ELITE COMPANY WITH HRs

- Freshman 1B **Alex Toral** joined elite company when he swatted his first hit as a Hurricane over the fence for a three-run home run in a 7-5 win over Rutgers on Sat., Feb. 17.
- Toral became the first Hurricane to connect on a home run for his first collegiate hit since Chicago White Sox' first-round draft pick **Zack Collins** did so in 2014. The last player before Collins did it was Cleveland Indians' All-Star slugger Yonder Alonso in 2006.
- Freshman **Gabe Rivera** managed the same feat in a game against Georgia Tech on March 30, crushing a two-run homer. Rivera

• Lefthander **Andrew Suarez** (2012-2015) became the 54th Hurricane to make it to MLB when he made his San Francisco debut in a start on April 11 and picked up his first win on May 6.

REYES ANOTHER IMPACT NEWCOMER

• Junior outfielder **Danny Reyes** was another key addition to the Hurricanes this offseason after transferring in from Broward College.
 • A power bat from Mater Academy and a native of Miami Springs, Fla., Reyes missed 25 games with a torn ligament in his thumb. Despite that, he leads the Hurricanes in home runs, with four.

THE DESTINATION IS THE SAME: OMAHA

• Miami made its second straight trip to the **College World Series in 2016**, marking the program's 25th all-time trip to Omaha, Neb.
 • Miami's **25** College World Series trips are the **second-most of any program** in the country. The Hurricanes have won **48 games** in the College World Series, the **fourth-most** of any program; Miami's **four national championships** rank **fifth-most**.
 • Since the NCAA began award national seeds prior to 1999, Miami has been **among the top eight seven times**.




