THE FACTS

The University of Miami enters this weekend's Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational with a perfect 7-0 overall record. They enter with wins over three (3) teams that ventured into the 2007 NCAA Tournament, including Alabama, Sacramento State and Texas State. The Hurricanes have now matched the second-best start in school history, and are riding a ninematch winning streak dating to the final two matches of the 2007 campaign. The 2002 squad that advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament started their season 15-0 -- the best mark in school history. In fact, the Hurricanes won 26 consecutive matches from the end of 2001 to the middle of the 2002 campaign to mark the longest winning streak in UM history.

Miami is led by the play of four players, and it's hard to spotlight just one. Leading things off is junior outside hitter and Preseason All-ACC selection Genny Mayhew. The Clovis, Calif. native has a team-best 73 kills (3.17 kps) and has 59 digs with nine blocks (eight assists). Beside her is setter Katie Gallagher who ""quarterbacks" the offense with a team-best 200 assists. Junior libero/defensive specialist Cassie Loessberg leads the defensive charge with an ACC (Atlantic Coast Conference) high mark of 112 digs (4.87 dps). Also playing well is freshman Lane Carico who is second on the team in two categories ... kills (59) and digs (79).

AGAINST THIS WEEKEND'S FIELD

This will be the first-ever meeting between the Hurricanes and San Francisco Dons. This is the third meeting between the 'Canes and Hornets, with the second coming earlier this season, while the series is tied 1-1. Finally, this is the third meeting between the 'Canes and Villanova Wildcats. Miami leads that series, 2-1. The last time these teams met was on Sept. 2, 2006 with the Wildcats winning, 3-2. The last UM victory over Villanova came back on Oct. 12, 2003 with a 3-0 decision in Coral gables when both teams were a part of the Big East Conference.

SCOUTING SACRAMENTO STATE [Hornets]

Sacramento State is beginning a nine-match stretch away from the friendly confines of Sacramento State's home gym. The Hornets sit at 2-5 on the year, and are making their second appearance against the Hurricanes this season. Miami downed the Hornets earlier this year, 3-0 in the opening match of the *Century Tel Premier Tournament* in San Marcos, Texas.

First-year head coach Ruben Volta leans on the play of Desiree Hoyum (60 kills / 2.54 kps) and Maddison Thivierge (60 kills / 2.31 kps) to lead the offense. However, the Hornets are hitting just .179 as a team this year, and have hit better than .250 in just eight (8) of the team's 26 sets this season.

SCOUTING SAN FRANCISCO [Dons]

The Dons of the University of San Francisco are 4-2 entering the weekend, and they have defeated some very formidable foes in the form of Missouri State, UC Santa Barbara and Utah State. The Dons are powered by Sarah Mandala with a team-high 80 kills (3.64 kps) and 12 blocks (assisted). Also playing well for the Dons is libero/defensive specialist Haley Carroll with 96 digs (4.36 dps), and uses setters Darcy Carroll and Alaina Sully to set-up the offense. They also have a 4-0 record at home this year, making them tough to defeat inside War Memorial Gym.

SCOUTING VILLANOVA [Wildcats]

The Villanova Wildcats enter this weekend's tournament after collecting a sweep of Maryland-Baltimore County on Tuesday evening in Baltimore,

Head Coach ... Nicole Lantagne Welch



Nicole Lantagne Welch enters her eighth season at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in five of the last seven seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In the 2006 season-opener, Lantagne Welch recorded her 100th career win with a 3-2 victory over Alabama. In 2007, UM finished 14-17 overall and 8-14 in ACC play, pushing Lantagne Welch's career

record to 125-81 overall in seven seasons as a head coach, all at Miami.

Her career at UM is highlighted by two consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins (2003 & 2004) and a trip to the Sweet 16 in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her seven seasons at the helm, the Hurricanes have averaged 17.8 wins per season.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. As a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered first-team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and 1993, and earned second-team honors in 1991. She was also named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

As team captain her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career at Maryland, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7th, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

HURRICANES VB MEDIA POLICY

KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Betweengame and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Information Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volley-ball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

TELEPHONES

Telephone lines at the Knight Sports Complex are limited to home radio and the visiting teams' "official" sports administrator/Media relations contact. All media wishing to files stories should contact Bryan J. Harvey prior to the conclusion of the game in order to make arrangements to be escorted back to the Sports Media Relations Office in order to work in a work-friendly environment. Any and all questions will be addressed in this designated area.

Md. Villanova holds an overall record of 4-3 coming into the weekend. The Wildcats look towards Morgan Petkovich for offense as she leads the squad with 74 kills (3.36 kps) and owns a hitting percentage of .266 on the year. Dana Tartasky sits just behind her with 72 kills (3.27 kps) and 47 digs (2.14 dps). Amy Gulyas charges the defense (73 digs) while Chelsea Graman sets the offense with 199 assists.

MIAMI WINS SECOND TOURNAMENT OF THE YEAR

For the second time in as many years, the University of Miami Hurricanes won the Hurricane Invitational last weekend over opponents from South Dakota State, Virginia Commonwealth University and Alabama. The 'Canes have lost just two (2) sets this season in 21 overall sets. The Hurricanes' setter Katie Gallagher swept MVP honors while the freshmen duo of Ali Becker (Katy, Texas) and Lane Carico (Manhattan Beach, Calif.) were also named to the All-Tournament Team. This was the second consecutive tournament the 'Canes had won this season after winning the *Century Tel Premier Tournament* two weeks ago in San Marcos, Texas.

FRESHMEN STORMING INTO ROTATION FOR HURRICANES

Freshmen duo Lane Carico and Ali Becker are storming into the starting lineup for the Hurricanes after tremendous play in their first two tournaments of the season. Carico is second on the team with 59 kills, and Becker sits in a tie atop the team list for blocks (15) with senior Ashley Woods. Carico is also second on the squad in digs (79).

HURRICANES IN THE ACC RANKINGS

In the latest statistical rankings/charts, the University of Miami is first in attack percentage (.287), opponent hitting percentage (.112), service aces (50), second in kills (301) and tops in digs (379). Individually, Cassie Loessberg is first in the ACC in digs (112) and teammate Maria Andersson is second in service aces (18 / 0.61 saps). Loessberg is ranked 34th nationally in digs per set, while the team as a whole is 15th nationally in the same category.

MAYHEW NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC TEAM

Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew was named to the Preseason All-ACC Team as voted on by head coaches around the Atlantic Coast Conference. Mayhew, a 5-foot-11 junior from Clovis, Calif. (Clovis HS), finished ninth in the conference in both kills (428) and points (465) a year ago. She also finished fourth on the squad in digs (224) and tied for fifth in blocks (43) alongside teammate Ariell Cooke while playing in 111 games for the 'Canes.

KNIGHT COMPLEX UNDERGOES RENOVATION

The Knight Sports Complex, home to Miami Hurricanes volleyball, underwent a few renovations over the off-season including new bleachers and a new playing surface. There was also extensive paint work done to the walls with green and orange added to the press row side of the arena. The lights are certainly on in the Knight for the 'Canes in 2008.

CLEMSON PREDICTED TO WIN ACC ... AGAIN

After finishing atop the league last season, the Clemson Tigers have been predicted to repeat as conference champs after collecting 11 of a possible 12 first place votes.
