#### DEACS FACE ANOTHER RANKED FOE AT MIAMI

- Wake Forest looks to snap its three-game losing streak as it visits No. 15 Miami
- The Deacs are playing their second of three consecutive games against ranked opponents (Wake Forest hosts No. 13 Virginia on Tuesday)
- Wake is looking for its first win in the state of Florida since 2011 (def. Texas Tech in the Old Spice Classic in Orlando)

#### SERIES HISTORY

- Wake Forest leads the all-time series 10-7, but the Hurricanes have won five of the seven previous meetings in Coral Gables
- Since Miami joined the ACC, the home team has won 11 of the 14 regular season matchups
- The Deacs won last year's contest 72-70 in Winston-Salem
- Wake Forest has lost four straight at the BankUnited Center, with the Deacs' last win in Coral Gables coming in 2006-07

#### AGAINST RANKED FOES

- The Deacons are 1-5 against ranked opponents this season, defeating Indiana and losing to Vanderbilt, Xavier, Louisville, Duke and North Carolina
- Wake Forest's three non-conference games against ranked foes were its most since 2004-05
- A win tonight would mark the first time Wake Forest defeated two ranked teams away from home in the same season since 2009-10 (Gonzaga, UNC)

#### ROAD, SWEET ROAD

- Wake Forest is 5-4 away from home this season and has already more than doubled its road/neutral win total of last season (two)
- Wake is the only ACC team with a winning percentage this year away from home that is equal or better than at home
- The Deacons' three true non-conference road wins led the ACC
- Wake Forest had five non-conference road/neutral wins for the first time since winning six in 2008-09 as the Deacs climbed to No. 1 in the nation
- A win tonight would mark the Deacs' fourth true road win of the season, their most since 2009-10 (six)

#### SPREADING THE WEALTH

- Wake has had 11 different players record a double-figure scoring game this season, its most since 11 players accomplished the feat in 1982-83
- The Deacons lead the ACC in that category (Miami is second with 10)
- Of the 11 players, nine have had a double-figure game in ACC play (no other team in the league has more than seven)

### INTERVIEWS & POLICIES

#### POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

**Head Coaches:** Both head coaches will appear in the media room following brief cool-down periods. In most cases, the visiting head coach will appear first, followed by Wake Forest head coach Danny Manning.

**Wake Forest Players:** Requested players will be available in the media room following both head coaches' press conferences. The Wake Forest locker room is closed to the media.

**Opponent Players:** Please see the visiting SID. If that team's locker room is closed to the media, interviews are usually held outside in the hallway near the entrance to the visitors' locker room.

#### ACC WEEKLY TELECONFERENCE

The 15 ACC basketball head coaches will be featured on a weekly teleconference each Monday beginning at 10:30 a.m. The teleconferences will begin on Jan. 4, 2016, and conclude on Feb. 29, 2016. Each coach will have 10 minutes to answer questions.

#### MID-WEEK INTERVIEWS

All interviews with head coach Danny Manning and/or Demon Deacon players should be arranged through Steve Kirkland in the Athletic Communications Office. Interview requests should be made at least 24 hours in advance.

Interviews will be arranged to accommodate players' academic and basketball schedules. Players will not do interviews on gameday, except for postgame interviews.

#### THE DANNY MANNING SHOW

Every Thursday (team schedule permitting) from 7-8 p.m., Wake Forest head coach Danny Manning and the Voice of the Deacons, Stan Cotten, host The Danny Manning Show. The one hour-long show originates from the IMG College Studios in Winston-Salem. The show airs locally on 98.1 WBRF-FM and on the Internet at WakeForestSports.com.

### MEDIA CREDENTIALS

Media credentials for Wake Forest home games should be requested by contacting Steve Kirkland in the Wake Forest Athletic Communications Office. Please make your requests in writing or via email, at least 48 hours prior to tip-off.

Priority is given to daily newspapers, radio/TV sports directors and other media who cover the Demon Deacons and their opponents on a regular basis, in addition to national print and electronic media. Spouses, non-workers and anyone 16 years-of-age or younger are not permitted in any working media area.

Credentials will not be mailed if credential request is received one week or less prior to the game. Credentials can be shipped overnight if a FedEx shipping number is provided.

### MEDIA WILL CALL

The media entrance to the Coliseum is located at the rear of the facility in close proximity to the media parking area. Media members can enter here and follow the hallway to the media workroom. This also serves as the primary exit for media staying to file stories.

The main media parking lot is located off of Deacon Boulevard in the Deacon Tower Lot. The secondary media lot is located off Deacon Boulevard in the BB&T Field Gold Lot. Only media with valid parking passes will be allowed to park in these areas.

There is a "will call" desk for media credentials located at the media entrance.

### PHOTOGRAPHERS

Photographers are restricted to either baseline area and are not permitted along courtside during game activity. Photographers will be assigned areas on the baseline.

The facility is lighted by mercury-vapor lamps (32 at 1000 watts each) with a vertical illumination of 90 footcandles and a horizontal illumination of 160 footcandles 36 inches above the playing surface.

Use of strobe lights can be purchased at the cost of \$50 per set, per game. To purchase, contact Steve Kirkland in the Wake Forest Athletic Communications Office.

### MEDIA SERVICES

Pre-game statistics, game notes and roster cards are provided prior to tip-off. Final stats, play-by-play and postgame quotes will be available in the media workroom.

Statistical monitors will be provided for live TV and the home and visiting team radio crews.

Live stats can also be accessed by the media via the Internet. See a member of the Wake Forest Athletic Communications staff for the web address.

Wireless internet access is available in the media workroom and on press row. For user name and password information, check the posted signs in the workroom or ask a member of the Wake Forest Athletic Communications staff.

# 2015-16 WAKE FOREST MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

## LAST TIME OUT

- The Deacons suffered an 83-68 loss at No. 2 North Carolina on Wednesday night
- Bryant Crawford (18 points) and Devin Thomas (17 points) led the Deacs, who suffered their third consecutive loss

## NOTHING IS OVER UNTIL WE DECIDE IT IS!

- Wake has rallied from down double-digits in two of its 10 wins this year
- The Deacs trailed by 13 in the first half and by 11 at the half in their 90-82 victory at Bucknell on Nov. 15
- Wake came back from 12 down in the second half of the 69-68 win at Rutgers in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge on Nov. 30
- It is the first time the Deacs have rallied from at least 12 points down to win twice in a season since 2012-13 and just third time in history they have accomplished the feat twice on the road in the same season (2006-07, 1981-82)

## THOMAS DOMINATING INSIDE

- Devin Thomas has 10 double-doubles this season, including a pair of games with at least 20 points and 15 rebounds
- Thomas had 21 points and 17 rebounds vs. UMBC and 23 points and 17 rebounds at Rutgers
- Thomas' three career 20-and-15 games tie him with Travis McKie and Al-Farouq Aminu for the most by a Deacon in the post-Tim Duncan era
- Thomas' five 20-and-10 games this season lead the ACC (no one else has more than two) and are the most by a Deacon in a season since Al-Farouq Aminu had eight in 2009-10
- Thomas is the only ACC player to be averaging a double-double both overall and in conference play this season
- Thomas' 10 double-doubles this season rank in the top 15 nationally this season

## THOMAS CRASHES THE BOARDS

- Devin Thomas is the ACC's active leader in career rebounds (953), career double-doubles (31) and career double-figure rebounding games (40)
- He is the second-leading rebounder in the ACC this season, averaging 10.4 rebounds per game
- His 953 career rebounds rank fourth in school history
- If Thomas leads the team in rebounding this season, he would join Tim Duncan, Rod Griffin and Dickie Hemric as the only Deacons to lead the squad in rebounding for four consecutive seasons

## GET IT TO THE GREEK

- Dinos Mitoglou has three double-doubles this season, already eclipsing his total from his freshman season (one)
- His 10-point, 10-rebound performance at Louisville on Jan. 3 was his first career ACC double-double
- Mitoglou leads the team with 31 three-pointers this season

## CODI'S BACK

- Senior guard Codi Miller-McIntyre made his season debut against UNCG after missing the first eight games of the season due to a foot fracture suffered in mid-October
- Miller-McIntyre has posted 20-point games in two of the last five contests and leads the team with 21 career 20-point games
- At LSU, he recorded a career-high 12 rebounds in his first start of the season
- Miller-McIntyre has led the Demon Deacons in scoring each of the past two seasons

## CRAWFORD MAKES AN IMPACT

- Freshman guard Bryant Crawford has made an immediate impact during his rookie season
- Crawford is second on the team in scoring at 12.8 points per game and has led the Deacs in scoring eight times this year
- He was the first Deacon freshman to have two 20-point games among his first three collegiate games since Rodney Rogers in 1990-91
- Crawford is the first Wake freshman with consecutive 20-point games since Travis McKie in 2010-11
- Crawford has a pair of nine-assist games this season (Arkansas, Coastal Carolina), the most assists in a game by a Wake freshman since Ish Smith in 2006-07
- Crawford is averaging 4.5 assists per game and is the only freshman to rank among the ACC's top 10 in assists

## WILBEKIN THE SHARP-SHOOTER

- Mitchell Wilbekin tied his career high with four 3-pointers against both UCLA and Rutgers
- Wilbekin is second on the team with 30 3-pointers this year
- In Wake's 10 wins this season, Wilbekin is shooting 42.6 percent (23-54) from behind the arc

## NEWCOMERS MAKING THEIR MARK

- The Demon Deacon freshman trio of Bryant Crawford, John Collins and Doral Moore has combined for 22.5 points, 8.8 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game this season
- Crawford is second on the team in scoring (12.8) and leads the team in assists (4.5)
- Freshman forward John Collins is averaging 7.8 points per game, scoring in double figures in nine games
- Collins leads the team in field goal percentage at 58.6 percent (51-87) (min. 50 attempts)
- Freshman center Doral Moore is averaging 2.8 points per game and scored 10 points vs. Syracuse

## PRODUCTION OFF THE BENCH

- The Demon Deacons are averaging 20.2 points per game off the bench this season
- Wake has 18 double-figure scoring performances from reserves this season, compared to just 11 through 18 games last year

## WATSON STEPS UP

- Rondale Watson has increased his role in recent games and is averaging 3.7 points and 2.0 assists per game in ACC play
- Watson had his first-career double-figure game with 11 points at Virginia Tech, outscoring his total points from his first eight career ACC games combined (nine)
- He recorded a career-high five assists in the ACC opener at Louisville

## GET TO THE LINE

- The Deacs rank in the top-20 nationally in free throw attempts per game at 27.3 FTAs per game
- The 27.3 average is Wake's highest since 1968-69 (30.9)
- Devin Thomas' 144 free throw attempts this season rank him in the top-15 nationally

## HOT AND COLD FROM LONG DISTANCE

- The Deacs have been cold from 3-point range in the past two games, shooting 10.5 percent (4-38) from behind the arc
- The 2-20 performance vs. Syracuse and the 2-18 effort at North Carolina followed the Deacs' season-best 13-24 (54.2 percent) long-range shooting at Virginia Tech
