THE SETUP

- For the 2nd time in the past 4 seasons, Florida and Miami will link up in holiday tournament action, last meeting in the 3rd place game of the Advocare Invitational in Orlando in Nov. 2016.
- The Gators look to build on Thursday's gut-check win. After leading by as many as 18 in the 1st half, Florida had to play the final 18:30 without Kerry Blackshear, who was ejected. Saint Joseph's crept within 2 points in the final minute, but the Gators got stops and made free throws down the stretch to secure the victory.
- Keyontae Johnson is coming off his 5th career double-double, posting a career-high 22 points along with 12 rebounds in the victory to lead the way for Florida.

2019-20 AT A GLANCE

- Florida has been outstanding defensively, holding all 5 opponents to this season to 63 or fewer points. The Gators' defense ranks 22rd nationally in KenPom defensive efficiency.
- The defensive effort is keeping the Gators competitive as the team's outside shooting has not hit its stride yet, shooting .257 from 3-point range and making just 5.2 3-pointers per game.
- The Gators look to extend their current streak of three straight NCAA Tournament bids, which is already the third-longest streak in Florida history.
- UF has once again lined up one of the most challenging schedules in the nation and will play no fewer than 12 of its 31 regular season games against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams.
- The Gators' rotation includes 5 freshmen and 3 sophomores, along with grad transfer Kerry Blackshear Jr. and a pair of junior post reserves. The 212 combined Florida games by this roster entering the season are the fewest since 2007-08.
- The trio of returning starters put up elite numbers during their freshman season, as Andrew Nembhard's 194 assists ranked fourth-most in UF history, Noah Locke hit a Florida freshman record 81 3-pointers and Keyontae Johnson's 229 rebounds were fifth-most by a UF freshman.
- The Gators bring in the seventh-ranked recruiting class in the country, according to 247sports. During the early signing period, Florida signed two McDonald's All-Americans in Scottie Lewis and Tre Mann, along with top-50 big man Omar Payne. In the spring signing period, Florida added point guard Ques Glover and 6-foot-11 post Jason Jitoboh. Florida also added the services of shooting guard Alex Klatsky.
- UF returns post players Dontay Bassett and Gorjok Gak, who figure to provide depth behind Blackshear. Bassett averaged 2.7 points and 2.3 rebounds per game in a reserve role last season. Gak missed the 2018-19 campaign while recovering from knee surgery, but averaged 2.2 points and 2.4 rebounds in 2017-18.
- Florida also added a pair of sit-out transfers in forward Anthony Duruji from Louisiana Tech and point guard Tyree Appleby from Cleveland State. Duruji averaged 12.2 points and 6.2 rebounds last season, while Appleby scored 17.2 points per game at CSU.
- The Gators enjoy continuity on their staff as coaches Al Pinkins, Jordan Mincy and Darris Nichols all return, along with director of basketball operations Jonathan Blake and director of scouting Bryce Douglas.

Florida's 3-point defense was on point against Saint Joseph's, limiting the Hawks to 3 made 3-pointers. SJU entered the game hitting 11.5 per game, but shot 3-for-23 (.130) against the Florida defense.

- Kerry Blackshear Jr. posted a double-double in each of his first 3 games with the Gators after posting 13 during his Virginia Tech.
- Blackshear is the 1st Gator since Dorian Finney-Smith to post 3 consecutive double-doubles.

GATORS FACE A GAUNTLET

- Florida has a minimum of 12 games against 2019 NCAA Tournament opponents, including 3 non-conference contests (Florida State, Utah State, Baylor) with the potential of adding a 4th if UF faces Buffalo in the Charleston Classic.
- The SEC slate includes 2 games against Kentucky, LSU and Ole Miss, along with home games vs. Auburn and Mississippi State and a visit to Tennessee.
- UF's schedule has rated among KenPom's top 20 toughest in each of Mike White's first 4 seasons with the Gators, and it figures to land there again in 2019-20.

STARTING EARLY

- Scottie Lewis and Tre Mann started together for the 1st time in the Gators' win vs. Towson. The Gators have started multiple freshmen in a game at least once in each of the past 3 seasons.
- Last season, Andrew Nembhard started alongside Noah Locke and/or Keyontae Johnson 32 times. In the 2017-18 season, Dontay Bassett and Mike Okauru started together once (2/24/18 vs. Auburn).

FRESH FACES

- Florida entered the season with just 5 players who have played in a game for UF. The group enters the season with 212 total appearances and 86 combined games started with the Gators.
- This marks the fewest Florida appearances on the Gators' opening day roster since the 2007-08 season and the fewest games started since 2014-15.
- However, this year's roster boasts a weapon those prior teams with comparable inexperience lacked: All-ACC graduate transfer Kerry Blackshear, whose 72 starts in 103 appearances at Virginia Tech nearly match the returning players' total starts for Florida.

MEDIA INFORMATION

The University of Florida appreciates the media coverage from all local, regional and national outlets. The Communications Office believes in developing mutually beneficial relationships with the media and we emphasize a positive and professional working environment with all entities. The ultimate goal of the Communications Office is to provide accurate and timely information about our athletic teams and to ensure that we assist the media to the best of our abilities while they cover our program.

MEDIA COVERAGE

CREDENTIALS: Requests for credentials will be taken online and reviewed by Denver Parler. To access the credential request form, please visit www.sportssystem.com/florida. Once you have submitted your credential request, you will receive an automated email from the Communications Department acknowledging your request was received and is being reviewed. Once a decision on your request is made, you will receive an email with further information. Requests must be made by the day prior to a game (noon for afternoon games or 4:30 p.m. for evening games).

CREDENTIAL PICK-UP: Credentials will be mailed up until 10 days prior to the event or held at the Press Will Call window at Gate One of the O'Connell Center, which opens for pick-up 90 minutes prior to each game. Credentials can be overnighted at the expense of the media organization within 10 days of the event (by request).

PARKING: A limited number of parking spaces exist and can be requested online with your credential application. Please note that if you request to pick up your credentials at Press Will Call, we will be unable to provide a parking pass as you will have to park before visiting Press Will Call. Free parking is available in the deck next to the O'Connell Center and is generally still available 75-90 minutes before the game.

MEDIA ROOM/INTERVIEW AREA: Located between Gates 1 & 4 in the Orange & Blue room near the loading dock, the media room includes work space, necessary electrical outlets, a television and wireless internet. A pre-game meal, snacks and soft drinks are also available in the media room. The pre-game meal begins 1:15 before tip. Post-game coach and player press conferences are also conducted in this area.

FLORIDA LOCKER ROOM: The Gator locker room is closed to the media with the exception of the SEC and NCAA Tournaments. Coach White and selected players will be available to the media following games in the media room/interview area. At Florida home games, players are available first while Coach White will follow with a post-game press conference in the Orange & Blue Room. If the visiting team chooses to utilize the media room, they will do so either directly before or after Florida players. Coach White will typically go last.

VISITOR LOCKER ROOM: Interview policies and procedures will be determined by visiting Sports Information Directors and coaches. Those procedures will be announced on game days.

GENERAL GAME DAY MEDIA SERVICES: Game program/scorecard, game notes, play-by-play, complete halftime and final statistics, coaches' & player quote sheets and post-game notes are all regular services on game days.

SEATING: Press seating is assigned, and all media members are asked to utilize their assigned seat. Press seating is located in the corner nearest the Florida bench. Photographers are restricted to two baseline locations closest to the team benches.

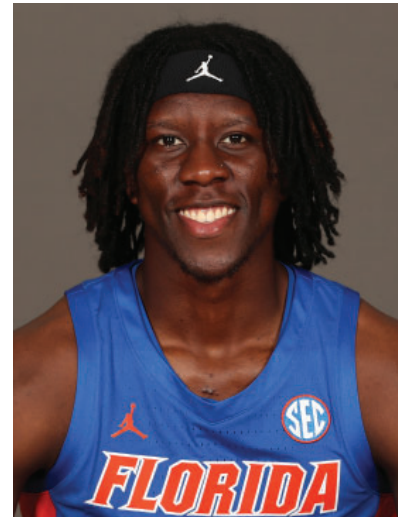
