THINGS TO KNOW

- Miami is the only ACC team with five players averaging in double-figure scoring.
- Ebuka Izundu ranks second in the ACC in field-goal percentage (.685) and sixth in rebounding (9.0/game).
- DJ Vasiljevic has hit at least one 3-pointer in 23 straight games the longest current streak in the ACC and sixth-longest in program history.
- Chris Lykes is ninth in the ACC in scoring (16.6).
- Deng Gak will miss the rest of the season with a leftknee injury, suffered during the Yale game.
- Junior forward Dewan Hernandez has been withheld from competition thus far as the University and NCAA review his eligibility.

MIAMI-FAU SERIES

Miami is 22-1 all-time against FAU, including 14-0 at home. UM has won seven straight in the series.

The programs last played on Dec. 16, 2016, a 76-56 UM win at the Watsco Center.

Jim Larrañaga is 3-0 against FAU, including 2-0 at Miami.

FAU's lone win in the series was a 74-73 overtime win on Dec. 3, 2002, in Boca Raton.

LAST MEETING: UM 76. FAU 56 (12/16/16)

Davon Reed scored 21 points to lead Miami to a 76-56 victory over Florida Atlantic on Dec. 16, 2016.

Miami took the lead for good after a 12-2 run during a 4:36 stretch midway through the first half. Anthony Lawrence keved the surge with two 3-pointers.

Bruce Brown scored 14 points and finished with eight rebounds. Anthony Lawrence finished with 13 points and made all three of his 3-pointers.

Current Canes who played in that game: Dewan Hernandez (9 pts, 10 reb), Lawrence (13 pts, 6 rebs, 3-3 3FG), DJ Vasiljevic (2 pts), Ebuka Izundu (2 pts, 6 mins), Rodney Miller (3 mins)

PLAYING SHORT-HANDED

With Dewan Hernandez unavailable, Miami has primarily played with a rotation of seven to eight players for the first 10 games.

UM currently has seven scholarship studentathletes available.

Anthony Lawrence (33.8), Chris Lykes (33.2), DJ Vasiljevic (32.2) and Zach Johnson (30.5) are averaging 30-plus minutes per game. Each ranks among the ACC's top 20 in minutes played.

The rotation was shortened to seven when Deng Gak went down with a season-ending knee injury on Dec. 1.

BALANCE ON OFFENSE

Five Miami players are averaging at least 12.3 points per game.

The Canes are the lone ACC team with five players averaging in double-figure scoring.

The five: Chris Lykes (16.6), Zach Johnson (13.2), DJ Vasiljevic (13.1), Anthony Lawrence (13.1) and Ebuka Izundu (12.3).

IZUNDU BATTLES INSIDE

Ebuka Izundu has stepped into a starting role this season and produced, averaging 12.3 ppg and a team-high 9.0 rebounds per game.

He is second in the ACC in field-goal percentage (.685), third in offensive rebounds (3.6/game), fourth in blocks (2.1/game) and sixth in rebounds per game.

Izundu has produced three double-doubles (Stephen F. Austin, Rutgers, Houston Baptist).

With 22 points and 19 rebounds against SFA, he fell one rebound shy of the first 20-rebound performance by a UM player since Reggie Johnson's 20-rebound effort against FAU on March 16, 2011.





LYKES PACES OFFENSE

Chris Lykes has led Miami is scoring four times in 10 games and is averaging 16.6 ppg. As of Friday, he ranks ninth in the ACC in scoring.

He scored 20 or more points in each of the first three games this season, becoming the first UM player since Joe Wylie in 1989 to do so to begin a season.

He was the first UM player to record three straight 20-point efforts since Shane Larkin put up 20 or more points in consecutive games against Boston College, NC State and UNC in winning the 2013 ACC Tournament.

JOHNSON MAKES INSTANT IMPACT

With 1,476 career points (1,344 at Florida Gulf Coast, 132 at UM), Zach Johnson is 35th nationally in career scoring among active Division I players. He is averaging 13.2 ppg this season.

Johnson had three strong games at the Wooden Legacy, averaging a team-high 18.0 ppg en route to all-tournament team honors.

He scored a season-high 24 points in the semifinal win over Fresno State. His putback dunk with 0.6 seconds remaining provided the winning basket.

He made his first UM start against Seton Hall, scoring 18 points in the championship game.

VASILJEVIC AMONG ACC 3-PT LEADERS

DJ Vasiljevic is off to a strong start, going 31-for-71 (43.7%) from 3-point range and averaging 13.1 ppg. He leads the league in 3-pointers per game (3.1), is tied for the ACC lead in 3-pointers made and is seventh in 3-point field goal percentage.

He has hit at least one 3-pointer in 23 consecutive games (tied with Pitt's Jared Wilson-Frame for the longest current streak in ACC).

He also is 20-for-20 at the free-throw stripe this year, more than his total all of last season in 32 games (16).

Vasiljevic led the ACC in 3-point field goal percentage last season (41.1%), becoming the fifth Hurricane to top the conference in 3-point shooting (first since Malcolm Grant in 2011).

NOTING THE HBU GAME

- Head coach Jim Larrañaga coached in his 250th career game at Miami.
- UM snapped a four-game losing streak, its longest in eight seasons under Jim Larrañaga and the team's first since a four-game stretch from Jan. 19-30, 2011.
- Miami hit 11 3-pointers, tied for its second most this season.
- Miami hit eight 3-pointers in the first half, more than it hit in any of its five previous games.
- Zach Johnson scored nine points and now has 1,476 career points (1,344 at Florida Gulf Coast, 132 at Miami).
- While playing a career-high 34 minutes, Ebuka Izundu recorded his fourth career double-double, including his third this season, with 15 points and 11 rebounds. He also matched a career high with four blocked shots.
- Anthony Mack set career highs in points (6), rebounds (4), assists (2) and minutes (17).

THE WATSCO ADVANTAGE

Miami has defended its home turf well in recent years, winning 42 of its last 48 games at the Watsco Center. The Canes are 92-26 (.780) at home under Jim Larrañaga.

Miami had its 19-game home non-conference win streak snapped on Nov. 28 in a 57-54 defeat to Rutgers. The streak dated to a 78-77 loss to Northeastern on Nov. 27, 2015.

In its 17th year at the Watsco Center (formerly BankUnited Center), Miami is 185-70 (.725) on its home court

In eight years under Larrañaga, Miami is 44-18 in ACC action at home and 48-8 in non-conference play.

GAK OUT FOR SEASON

Redshirt freshman forward Deng Gak will miss the remainder of the season after suffering a left-knee injury on Dec. 1 against Yale.

He had surgery Tuesday to repair the injured knee. He averaged 2.5 ppg and 4.1 rpg in eight games. He made his first career start against Yale and played a season-high 19 minutes in that contest.

SUCCESS AT 70 POINTS

Miami has eclipsed the 70-point plateau in nine of 10 games this season. While UM has historically been extremely strong when scoring 70-plus under Jim Larrañaga, the Canes are 6-3 in those games this year.

UM went 16-3 when scoring 70-plus points last season. The Canes are 111-18 when scoring 70 or more points under Larrañaga and 48-3 when breaking the 80-point barrier.

CANES TO VISIT ITALY IN AUGUST

The UM men's basketball team will head abroad next summer as the Canes will take a foreign tour of Italy from August 9-18, 2019.

The 10-day tour will include visits to Rome, Florence and Como. The Canes are scheduled to play four exhibition games, with at least one at each stop on the trip. The opponents are yet to be determined.

Once every four years, college basketball programs are permitted to embark on a foreign tour and given 10 extra summer practices to prepare. Miami's last foreign tour was to Spain in 2014.

CANES START SEASON AGAINST LEAGUE FAVORITES

Miami opened its season with three straight games against teams that were picked to win their respective conferences.

Lehigh was chosen as the preseason favorites in the Patriot League. Stephen F. Austin was picked to repeat as the Southland Conference champion, while Bethune-Cookman was selected as the preseason MEAC favorite.

MILLER JR. TO REDSHIRT

Junior center Rodney Miller Jr. will redshirt the 2018-19 season.

Miller lost 25 pounds during the offseason. He averaged 1.1 points in 3.6 minutes per game in 30 games during his first two seasons.

EXPERIENCED GROUP RETURNS

Miami's roster features seven upperclassmen – three seniors and four juniors.

They have played in a combined 530 games (average of 75 per player), and each has played in at least one NCAA tournament.

WHO'S DEPARTED

Miami lost three players from its 2017-18 squad, each of whom started at least 18 games: Lonnie Walker IV, Bruce Brown Jr. and Ja'Quan Newton.

Walker was an Honorable Mention All-ACC pick and ACC All-Freshman Team honoree last year. He was selected 18th overall in the NBA Draft by the San Antonio Spurs.

Brown started 19 games before missing the remainder of the season with a foot injury. He was picked 42nd overall in the NBA Draft by Detroit.

Newton played in 127 career games (seventh most in program history) and finished with 1,134 career points (28th in program history).

NOTING THE SCHEDULE

Miami's schedule features 14 games against teams that played in the 2018 NCAA Tournament.

The non-conference schedule features games against Stephen F. Austin and Penn, each of whom played in the NCAA Tournament last year.

The Canes' challenging conference schedule includes 11 games against teams that competed in the 2018 NCAA Tournament, including home-and-homes with Florida State, North Carolina and Virginia Tech.

CANES LOOK TO TOP ACC EXPECTATIONS ONCE AGAIN

Miami was picked 10th in the Operation Basketball 2018-19 Preseason Poll, released Oct. 25 following a vote of the league's media.

In each of Jim Larrañaga's first seven seasons, Miami finished the year in a standing that exceeded its preseason ACC ranking.

UM was picked fourth in the preseason ACC coaches' poll last season (behind Duke, UNC, ND) but concluded the season in a third-place tie.

HUELL BECOMES HERNANDEZ

The name is unfamiliar, but Dewan Hernandez remains a familiar face for the Canes. Formerly Dewan Huell, Hernandez legally changed his last name in the offseason.

The switch was made to honor his mother, Christina Hernandez, and was officially finalized in mid-October.

HERNANDEZ LOOKS TO BUILD ON BREAKOUT SOPHOMORE SEASON

Dewan Hernandez is looking to take another step in his junior season. Last season, Hernandez more than doubled his numbers in scoring and rebounding from his freshman campaign.

Hernandez entered his name in the NBA Draft following the season but withdrew following consultations with NBA officials.

He finished second on the team in scoring at 11.4 ppg (5.6 as frosh) last year and also averaged 6.6 rebounds per game (3.1 as frosh).

HIGH SCHOOL TEAMMATES REUNITE

With the transfers of Zach Johnson and Anthony Mack, Miami now has two pairs of high school teammates on its roster this season.

Johnson reunites with Dewan Hernandez, with whom he played two seasons and won two state championships at Norland High School.

Hernandez, Lawrence and Vasiljevic are team captains for the second straight season.

SELLING OUT THE WATSCO CENTER

Miami sold out its season ticket allotment for all home games at the Watsco Center for each of the last three seasons.

Fans bought over 5,500 season tickets for each of the last three years, more than doubling the total number of season tickets sold in Jim Larrañaga's first season in Coral Gables.

A 6-foot-6 guard, Proctor played at Bishop Gorman High School in Las Vegas, where he won a pair of state championships.

He was the the 14th-ranked player in Nevada in 2017 according to 24/7 Sports and the 103rd-ranked shooting guard in the nation per 24/7.

CANES SIGN TWO TO 2019-20 NLI

Miami announced Nov. 14 the signing of Anthony Walker and Isaiah Wong to National Letters of Intent for the 2019-20 school year.

Walker and Wong each are four-star recruits who are rated among the top 100 players nationally in the latest Rivals recruiting rankings. Walker is a 6-foot-9, 210-pound power forward from Nottingham, Md., and Wong is a 6-foot-3, 170-pound guard from Trenton, N.J.

ANOTHER 20-WIN CAMPAIGN UNDER LARRAÑAGA

Miami recorded 22 wins last season, its sixth 20win campaign in seven years under Jim Larrañaga, and tied for the 10th most wins in a season in school history.

He is the first coach in program history to post six 20-win seasons. Bruce Hale (1954-67) recorded five 20-win campaigns from 1954-67.

SOLID 2017-18 SEASON IN ACC

Miami finished with 11 ACC wins last season, its third-most conference wins since joining the league in 2004-05.

UM earned the No. 3 seed in the ACC Tournament after finishing in a four-way tie with Clemson, North Carolina and NC State in the regular-season standings.

Miami scored 10 or more league victories in five of Larrañaga's first seven years, including four straight seasons. The Canes join Virginia, Duke and UNC as the lone teams to win 10 or more ACC games each of the last four years.

Prior to Larrañaga's arrival, Miami never had won 10 ACC games in a season.

LARRAÑAGA 11TH IN WINS AMONG ACTIVE D-I NCAA COACHES

Entering the season, Jim Larrañaga ranked 11th in career wins among active Division I coaches with 631. Of those 11, four are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, including three from the Atlantic Coast Conference.

Now in his 35th season as a head coach, Larrañaga ranks 44th in all-time NCAA victories among Division I head coaches.

In his career, Larrañaga won 27 games at American International, 170 at Bowling Green and 273 at George Mason, and he now has 162 at Miami. He is one of 15 coaches all-time with 100 or more wins at three D-I schools, four of whom are actively coaching.




