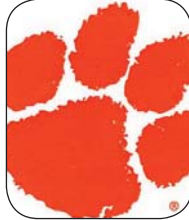
Miami Volleyball Looks to Rebound with Home Matches Against Clemson and Georgia Tech

Hurricanes Set to Host Clemson and Georgia Tech in ACC Showdowns...

The University of Miami Hurricanes look to rebound this weekend when hosting ACC powers Clemson and Georgia Tech to the James L. Knight Sports Complex. The Hurricanes defeated both teams at home last year for the first time in school history, enjoying a 3-1 record overall against the Tigers and Yellow Jackets, respectively, on the season. The lone loss was a setback in Clemson (Death Valley).

Miami comes into the weekend sporting a 1-2 ACC mark (8-5 overall), and looks to try and get above the .500 mark in league play for the first time this season. Senior outside hitter Genny Mayhew is expected to be back in the starting rotation after sitting out last weekend with an injury. Meanwhile, setter Katie Gallagher is expected to return as well. Freshman setter/right side hitter Nrithya Sundararaman suited up in place of Gallagher against Virginia and Virginia Tech.

Miami has dropped just two ACC home matches since the end of the 2007 season—last week

against Virginia Tech, and last season to Wake Forest. The home record for the Hurricanes has been incredible since the beginning of the 2008 year, registering a 17-3 mark overall.

The 'Canes are currently seventh in the ACC standings, while sophomore outside Hitter Lane Carico tops the conference in kills (177 / 3.69 kps). Senior libero Cassie Loessberg is atop the league in digs (256 / 5.33dps) and teammate Lici McGee is eighth in total blocks (52 / 1.08bps). Loessberg also ranks 13th nationally in digs per set.

The 'Canes are among the Top 5 in three categories as a team, including digs where they are the best with 734 (15.29 dps). Miami is ranked 39th nationally in blocks, as a team.

Quick Hits on Clemson...

The Clemson Tigers come into the weekend sporting a 10-4 overall record, and a 1-2 mark in ACC play. The Tigers are led by Lia Proctor with 187 kills, followed closely by Natalie Patzin with 153. Clemson had its one conference win so far against NC State last Sunday. Also playing well for the Tigers is setter Kelsey Murphy, ranked among the Top 3 in the league for assists, currently holding 538 (10.35 aps) on the year. The libero for the Tigers is Didem Ege with a team-leading 237 digs (4.56 dps).

Series Against Clemson...

Clemson leads the all-time series against the Hurricanes by an 8-3 margin. Until Miami's 3-2 victory over the Tigers last year in Coral Gables,

Clemson had previously rolled off six consecutive victories dating back to Sept. 30, 2005. Miami took the last meeting against the two foes, but has never won consecutive matches in the series.

Quick Hits on Georgia Tech...

The Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets are under the direction of first-year head coach Tonya Johnson, who ultimately has them rolling with a 9-4 record, and a perfect 3-0 mark in ACC play. Bailey Hunter leads the Yellow Jackets with a 176 kills, while teammates Monique Mead (151) and Chrissy DeMichelis (132) follow behind her. The setter for the Yellow Jackets is Mary Ashley Tippins, leading the charge with 546 assists. The libero is Jordan McCullers with 189 digs.

Series Against Georgia Tech...

Georgia Tech leads the series against Miami by the slimmest of margins, 5-4. Last year, the 'Canes swept the series against the Yellow Jackets for the first time ever, and it was just the second time they've collected back-to-back wins against the Yellow Jackets, the last coming in 2005 and 2006. Before UM took the series last year, Georgia Tech took the previous three meetings between the two schools.

Loessberg Takes the Top Spot...

With 20 kills in her last match versus Notre Dame, senior libero Cassie Loessberg became Miami's all-time leader in digs with 1,640. In the

process, she passed Jamie Grass (2001-04) for the all-time lead in the digs category.

Sundararaman Already Moving Up...

Freshman setter/right side hitter Nrithya Sundararaman stepped in for the injured Katie Gallagher last weekend, and she has already collected 195 assists on the year. That has allowed her to move into eighth place all-time at UM in assists.

Can It Be a Repeat?...

Last season at home, Miami swept both Georgia Tech and Clemson for the first time in school history in a back-to-back series set. The 'Canes got a great performance from Lane Carico and Genny Mayhew in those meetings, combining for over 65 kills in the two matches. Can the Hurricanes keep the momentum for a repeat performance this weekend?

Nicole Lantagne Welch

This season marks Nicole Lantagne Welch's ninth year at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in six

of the last eight seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

Last season, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.



Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by three seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her eight years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 18.9 wins per seasons with a career record of 151-87.

While new records were set during the 2007 campaign, the 2008 season saw even those records fall as Lantagne Welch and her staff assembled one of the best records in school history. Lantagne Welch led Miami to its best ACC record in school history. It was also the second-best record in school history on the Division I level of athletics.

Katie Gallagher moved in sole possession of second place all-time at UM for assists in a career during the 2008 season, while Cassie Loessberg placed herself in second place for digs in a career. In addition, Loessberg broke her own school record from a year ago for digs in a single-season, upping the new record to 554—besting her old school-record mark by two.

As for Gallagher, she etched her name once again as one of the Top 10 single-season assists leaders in school history. Already sitting at third place in school history from the 2007 season where she collected 1,243 assists, Gallagher added to that total with 1,202 in 2008—good enough for sixth place all-time in school history.

Freshman Lane Carico broke the freshman record for kills in a single-season for UM with 369, adding her name to 10th all-time for single-season kills. Meanwhile, Miami tied a school-record for hitting percentage in a five-set match, collecting a .329 percentage at Florida State on Nov. 26, 2008. The 'Canes would also collect the second-best single-set hitting mark in school history with a .615 clip against Boston College in the third set on Oct. 10, 2008.

Lantagne Welch would see two more student-athletes graduate following the 2008 season. Angelica Ellis and Bridget Bomhack both earned their Bachelor's Degree, while Ashley Woods completed her Master's Degree.

Woods placed her name eighth all-time in sets played (367), as well as eighth place all-time in total attacks (1,764). Ellis now ranks ninth in attacks (1,209), while also collecting the third-highest individual single-season hitting percentage (.350) from the 2008 campaign. Overall, Ellis is third in school history in career hitting percentage with a .275 clip through 318 sets and 1,209 attacks. Woods is tied for fifth in career hitting percentage, holding a .256 clip, sitting alongside Ciara Michel (2004-07).

The eighth-year head coach also coached three All-ACC Second Team members with

Lane Carico, Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. In addition, Carico and Ellis were each named as AVCA All-America honorable mention, while Carico was selected the 2008 AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico was also the true definition of "student-athlete" as she was named to the All-ACC Academic Team.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

Hurricanes VB Media Policy

KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

TELEPHONES

Telephone lines at the Knight Sports Complex are limited to home radio and the visiting teams' "official" sports administrator/media relations contact. All media wishing to file stories should contact Bryan J. Harvey prior to the conclusion of the game in order to make arrangements to be escorted back to the Sports Media Relations Office in order to work in a work-friendly environment. Any and all questions will be addressed in this designated area.

Senior Maria Andersson, used in a variety of ways on the back line for the 'Canes, stepped up in place of the injured Genny Mayhew last weekend, collecting 20 kills, 21 digs, six blocks and five service aces against Virginia and Virginia Tech last weekend. The young lady from Sweden certainly showed she's willing to come to the front of the line whenever necessary.

Mayhew Shooting for 1,000...

Senior outside hitter Genny Mayhew is closing in on 1,000 kills as she now has 997 kills in her career. If she cracks the 1,000-kill plateau, she will be just the fifth UM player all-time to have eclipsed that mark. Currently, she ranks fifth all-time at UM in career kills.

Mayhew Expected to Return to Lineup...

After sitting out last weekend with an injury, senior outside hitter Genny Mayhew is expected to return to the Hurricanes lineup this weekend. She still enters the weekend just three kills shy of 1,000 total kills for her career.

McGee Sitting on the Blocks...

Redshirt junior Lici McGee was noted to be a "player to watch" coming into the season for Miami, and that has proven true right from the spot. Not only does the Oklahoma native have a team-leading 42 blocks, but she also sits fourth on the team in kills with 81. McGee has collected five or more blocks in three matches this year, including seven in a 3-0 sweep of Albany (N.Y.).

Hurricanes Top the League in Digs...

Miami owns 594 digs as a team for an average of 15.23 digs per set. That is the best mark in the ACC to date. The average is high because of Loessberg supplying a league-leading 216 digs thus far. Clemson's Didem Ege sits second with 211 digs of her own.

On These Dates in History...

The Hurricanes hold a record of 2-5 all-time in matches played on Oct. 2, while being on the other end of the spectrum with a perfect 4-0 record in matches played on Oct. 4. The last match played on Oct. 4 was a 3-1 at Georgia Tech in 2008. Conversely, UM suffered a 3-2 setback against Georgia Tech on Oct. 2, 2005.

ACC In the Spotlight...

Non-conference wins for ACC teams during the 2009 regular season. The ACC boasts perfect records against 10 other conferences, and have .500 or better records against 22 of the 29 conferences its teams have faced this season.

UM Present on All-ACC Preseason Team...

Three student-athletes from Miami are on this year's Preseason All-ACC Team for head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch. Seniors Genny Mayhew and Cassie Loessberg headline the list for UM, while sophomore Lane Carico earns her first Preseason nod as well. For Mayhew, this is her second consecutive ACC Preseason accolade.

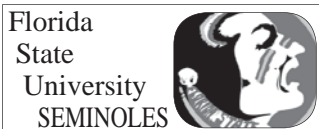
Duke takes in 116 of a possible 121 points, including seven of 12 first place votes. Coaches' votes for the predicted order of finish were tallied with 11 points being applied to a first-place vote, 10 points for a second-place vote, etc. Coaches were not permitted to predict their own team's order of finish.



Just 17 points separate the top-four teams as Florida State, Miami, and North Carolina also take in first-place votes. Florida State follows Duke in second place with 104 points and three first-place votes, while Miami is tabbed to finish in third with 101 points and one first-place vote. North Carolina lands in fourth with 99 points and one first-place vote.



Clemson is tabbed fifth with 75 points, and is followed by Virginia Tech (71), Virginia (62), Georgia Tech (49), Wake Forest (47), Maryland (33), NC State (21), and Boston College (14).



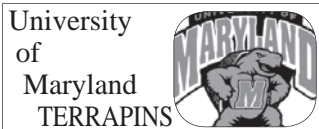

Last Time Out - vs. Virginia Tech (9/27/09)...

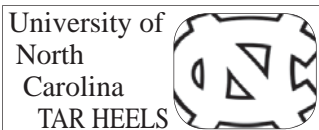
Justine Record had a match-high 19 kills to lead the Virginia Tech Hokies past the Miami Hurricanes, 3-2 (27-29, 25-21, 22-25, 29-27, 15-11), Sunday afternoon in an ACC volleyball matchup at the James L. Knight Sports Complex in Coral Gables, Fla.



Despite posting a season-high 15.5 blocks as a team, Miami (8-5, 1-2 ACC) was unable to get the timely blocks when needed to stop the Virginia Tech hitting attack. The Hokies rode Justine Record to the win as the California native posted a .229 clip on the day.



Virginia Tech (11-3, 1-2 ACC) rallied behind two kills from Kirsty Blue to pull ahead in the opening set, 15-14, before Record registered a kill to later move the Hokies up, 17-14. Virginia Tech stretched the lead to 18-14 following a service ace from Kirsten Higareda, who served seven consecutive points for the Hokies.



With UM trailing 20-15, the 'Canes battled back with help from Becker and Lane Carico, as well as a block assist from Ariell Cooke, moving ahead, 25-24, off a kill from Lici McGee.



With the opening set tied at 27-all, Miami used back-to-back Hokies errors, including blocks from McGee and setter Nrithya Sundararaman to take the win, 29-27.



In the second set, the teams settled in for the long haul as the frame saw 10 ties and six lead changes, most notably with UM battling back from a 9-8 deficit to surge out to a 12-9 advantage off consecutive Virginia Tech attack errors. Three-straight Miami errors allowed the Hokies to regain the lead, 13-12.



Virginia Tech never relinquished the lead down the stretch as Record posted four kills and the 'Canes were



forced into nine attack errors to allow the Hokies the second set win, 25-21. Carico and Becker both tallied three kills for the Hurricanes in the set, while Betsy Horowitz tied Record with four kills to the lead the Hokies.

The third set saw Virginia Tech outthit their counterparts, .308-to-.219, but the 'Canes used a big 5-0 run at the start off two Maria Andersson service aces to gain momentum—and never look back. UM stretched its lead to 10-3 when Carico added a service ace to the back line of the Hokies' defense.

The Hokies raced back into the set at 12-10 when Horowitz and Record combined for kills, but Miami quickly responded with Christine Williamson pounding one of her five kills on the day to stop the Hokies run, 13-10.

The 'Canes never trailed in the third set, eventually holding off the Hokies with three consecutive errors charged to Virginia Tech down the stretch—added a kill from Carico, to end the set, giving UM the win at 25-22.

In the fourth set, Miami raced out to a quick 9-3 advantage behind a service ace from freshman Lizzie Hale, as well as five Virginia Tech errors—including a block from McGee.

With UM holding a 19-17 advantage late in the set, Jennifer Wilker came back off the bench to register a two of her set-high 10 kills to bring the Hokies even at 19-19. Miami stepped back out to a 23-21 lead, but the Hokies were there to answer with Cara Baarendse and Wilker to knot the set, 25-25.

The set was tied again at 27-27 before Wilker and Record collected back-to-back kills to give Virginia Tech the set-win, 29-27.

With the match going to the decisive fifth set, Miami held a 4-1 lead when McGee, Carico and Cooke all stepped up for blocks at the net off an attack from the Hokies' Felicia Willoughby.

However, the Hokies were not going away quietly as they went on a 4-0 run to take an 8-6 advantage with Wilker blasting consecutive kills. Miami tied the set at 8-8 with the help of yet another block by sophomore Becker, as well as an assisted block from freshman Sundararaman.

Virginia Tech proved too much down the stretch, however, as Willoughby and Record each took kills to close the match, giving Virginia Tech the set, 15-11.

Miami was led in kills by Carico with 18, as she also tallied 16 digs and two blocks for her third-straight double-double performance. Behind her in double-figures for kills was Becker with 13, adding four digs and six assisted blocks.
