QUICK HITS

- The Hurricanes return home to take to begin their second trip around the ACC this weekend
- Emani Sims (27 kills, 23 blocks last weekend) was named ACC Player of the Week for the second time this season and Collegiate Volleyball Update National Player of the Week
- The Canes beat Virginia and lost to Virginia Tech on the road earlier this season
- The Hurricanes will try to avenge their loss to Virginia Tech on Friday; the Canes are 18-16 in ACC play when trying to avoid the second loss and have done so their last six times dating back to Nov. 12, 2010
- UM is 4-0 in second matches of the year vs. VT when losing to the Hokies in the first meeting
- Miami also started off 18-3 last year, going all the way to 23-3
- UM has won its last 20 Friday matches dating back to Dec. 3, 2010 and the last 23 in the regular season
- The Hurricanes stayed in the AVCA Coaches Poll on Monday at No. 24 (No. 17 in NCAA RPI)
- The Canes are 12-5 as a ranked team since entering the polls in 2002
- Miami has won its last 14 at home and 25 of the last 26 at the Knight Sports Complex
- Entering the week, the Hurricanes are one of only three ACC teams and one of only 32 NCAA Division I teams that remain unbeaten on their home court
- Last weekend, UM defeated Clemson in five sets behind a UM record-setting 16 block performance by Emani Sims, as the team also set a school record with 23 total blocks
- UM swept Georgia Tech 3-0 on RSN last Sunday to extend its winning streak to eight matches
- It was the first time Miami has ever swept the Clemson-Georgia Tech road trip in program history
- The Hurricanes are 23-14 (.622) all-time against teams from the commonwealth of Virginia
- Earlier in the year, UM beat Maryland which was the 100th career ACC win for Nicole Lantagne Welch
- UM swept its last four-match homestand, including ending NC State's 10-match winning streak
- Alexis Mourning was named ACC Co-Player of the Week and a Collegiate Volleyball Update Top Performer after posting 22 kills and 16 total blocks against NC State and North Carolina
- Miami ranks in the top 20 nationally in blocks (seventh, 3.08/set), kills (19th, 14.33/set), and assists (20th, 13.38/set)
- UM is ranked first in the ACC in assists (13.38/set) and blocks (3.08/set), while being second in kills (14.33/set) and opponent hitting percentage (.157)
- This is the sixth of 10 straight weekends in conference play, as the team went 8-2 against non-conference opponents
- Emani Sims was named ACC Player of the Week on Oct. 1 after recording 32 kills on a .500 hitting percentage against Duke and Wake Forest
- The Canes started ACC play with arguably the best regular season win in program history over then-No. 6 Florida State, the highest ranked team it has ever defeated - the match set a new attendance record (1,129) at the Knight Sports Complex and was televised nationally on ESPNU
- The win over FSU was the 400th in program history
- Alex Johnson was named the ACC Player of the Week on Sept. 10 after posting 16 kills and 16 digs in the 3-1 win over FSU - she was also honored nationally as a Top Performer by the Collegiate Volleyball Update
- Taylor Hollins has 15 double-doubles in 21 matches this season
- The Hurricanes have won their last 14 neutral site contests, and are 5-3 in true road contests this season (UM went 10-4 on the road in 2011)
- Miami started the season winning all four matches at the Hurricane Invitational, including coming back to defeat Ole Miss after trailing 2-0
- Alex Johnson won MVP at the Hurricane Invitational after racking up 48 kills on a .421 hitting percentage; Taylor Hollins and Alexis Mourning were named all-tournament
- Miami was predicted to finish fifth by the ACC coaches in a preseason poll
- Alex Johnson and Emani Sims were selected Preseason All-ACC
- The recruiting class was ranked No. 27 in the nation according to PrepVolleyball.com

THE LAST TIME

SEPT. 23, 2012: VT 3, UM 0

BLACKSBURG, Va. - The University of Miami volleyball team suffered its first conference loss of the season on Sunday, falling at Virginia Tech, 3-0, inside Cassell Coliseum. Coming into the match, the Canes had won the previous eight meetings against the Hokies.

VT won all three sets by the count of 25-22 to improve to 9-4 overall and 2-1 in the Atlantic Coast Conference, while Miami dropped to 10-3 and 2-1 for the season.

On Sunday, junior right side Alex Johnson led the Hurricanes with a match-high 12 kills on a .346 hitting percentage. Sophomore Savanah Leaf also hit double-digit slammers with 10 on the afternoon.

Junior libero Ryan Shaffer had 11 digs as UM outdug VT by the count of 48-46. However, the Hokies had a hitting percentage of .256 compared to .181 by Miami.

Jordan Fish had 38 assists to pace the Virginia Tech attack.

SEPT. 21, 2012: UM 3, UVA 0

CHARLOTTESVILLE, Va. - In its first road conference match of the season, the University of Miami volleyball team pushed past Virginia, 3-0, on Friday at Memorial Gymnasium. The Canes have now swept the last three meeting against the Cavaliers.

UM won by the set scores of 25-22, 25-19 and 27-25 to improve to 10-2 and 2-0 in the Atlantic Coast Conference, while UVA dropped to 5-7 and 0-2 this season.

“Every win is important in the ACC race and getting those on the road are challenging,” head coach

Nicole Lantagne Welch said. “Tonight was a team effort and I felt like we blocked very well. We also had players come in and make a difference for us - a theme for us this season - particularly Caiti [Donahoe], Blair [Fuentes] and Savanah [Leaf]. They provided a great spark to help us to victory.”

Freshman setter Caitilin Donahoe put up six kills on seven attempts (.857 hitting percentage) to go with 27 assists and seven digs in her first career start. Leading the Canes in kills was junior outside hitter Taylor Hollins, who posted her 11th double-double in 12 matches with 12 kills and 10 digs on the night. Sophomore Savanah Leaf had eight kills and six digs in her first match back after competing internationally for her home country, Great Britain.

Miami picked up 16 more digs than UVA (55-39) to hold the hosts to a .130 hitting percentage, with junior libero Ryan Shaffer registering a match-high 15 digs. On the front line, sophomore middle blockers Emani Sims and Alexis Mourning combined for 12 total blocks.

After a late rally to pull away in the first set and a balanced attack in the second, Miami held off a furious Virginia rally to spoil one set point and tie the score at 25 in the third. The Cavaliers then committed an attack error and Hollins knocked in a kill on a blocking error to give UM the win.

Natalie Bausback picked up 12 digs to lead the Cavaliers

Nicole Lantagne Welch is in her 12th season as head coach of the University of Miami volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in nine of the last 11 seasons, including ending the 2011 campaign ranked No. 15 in the Pablo rankings.

Last season Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to a 26-5 overall record and a 16-4 league mark to finish second in the Atlantic Coast Conference. The Canes spent several weeks in the AVCA Top 25. UM qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the third-straight year, defeating Northern Illinois to advance to the Second Round of the Ames [Iowa] Regional. At the end of the campaign, numerous players earned recognition, including Lane Carico becoming the first Hurricane to win ACC Player of the Year. The senior also earned AVCA All-America honors to cap one of the best careers in Miami history.

This past summer, Lantagne Welch traveled to Ohio to work with the A2 program as part of development for Team USA. In addition, two players associated with the program - Ciara Michel and Savannah Leaf - both competed in the Olympic Games for Team GB.

In 2010, Lantagne Welch helped guide the Canes to their second 20-win season in the last three years, and the second consecutive year in which UMiami advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Miami ended the season with a 23-9 overall mark (13-7 Atlantic Coast Conference) and finished third in the conference regular season standings. Along the way, the Hurricanes defeated NCAA Tournament participants Florida State, Middle Tennessee State, Georgia Southern, Wichita State and North Carolina. At the end of the year, Lantagne Welch saw her first-ever AVCA All-American honored in the form of Carico, collecting third team accolades following a record-breaking year. Carico became the first player in school history with 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in a career, as well as leading the ACC in double-doubles - and later being the only player in the league to amass at least 400 kills and 400 digs on the campaign. Carico and teammate Katie Gallagher each claimed AVCA All-East Region Team honors, while freshman libero Ryan Shaffer set a new school record for digs by a freshman (539 / 4.53 per set). As for Carico, she would also earn her third consecutive All-ACC Team nod and All-East Region honor.

In 2009, Lantagne Welch helped the Hurricanes to their second NCAA Tournament appearance, competing in the Gainesville [Fla.] Regional. UM earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after holding the 33rd toughest schedule in the nation according to the end-of-year RPI rankings. Earlier in the season, Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to the Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic championship. She would add to her growing list of All-Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes, as well as All-America honorable mention performers, seeing senior libero Cassie Loessberg and sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico named to both lists. Carico and Loessberg each collected AVCA All-America Hon-

orable Mention selections, while both were tabbed to the AVCA All-East Region Team. During the 2008 campaign, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002.

During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama. The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif. For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team. Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by four seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08, '10) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her 10 years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 19.2 wins per seasons with a career record of 192-109.

PIONEERING THE FIRST SEASON

On Feb. 28, 2000, then University of Miami Athletic Director Paul Dee proclaimed the return of women's volleyball as the Hurricanes newest fully funded varsity sport at UM. On Sept. 12, 2000, Dee took the next major step in the evolution of the program by announcing the hiring of Lantagne Welch as head coach of the Hurricanes.

A WINNING HISTORY

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever At-

lantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans. Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking. Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

SIMS NAMED CVU.COM NATIONAL POW

CORAL GABLES, Fla. - A day after being named Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Week, sophomore middle blocker Emani Sims of the nationally-ranked University of Miami volleyball team has been named Collegiate Volleyball Update (CVU.com) National Player of the Week. She becomes the third Hurricane in program history to earn the honor.

Totalling 27 kills and 23 total blocks in two matches, her weekend was highlighted by a record-setting blocking performance at Clemson. The sophomore set a new school record with 16 total blocks in the match, eclipsing the mark set by Lici McGee (13) in 2009. Sims also put down 16 kills against the Tigers for her first career double-double.

"Emani stepped it up this week on the road with great attacking and incredible blocking," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "She really helped, along with our team's great defense, to frustrate our opponents. She was also very difficult to stop offensively."

The sophomore continued her impressive play on Sunday with 11 kills and seven total blocks at Georgia Tech. Sims did not commit an error in 16 attempts for a .688 hitting percentage. For the weekend, the middle blocker hit for a .460 clip.

Sims leads the ACC with 72 blocks (1.76/set) in conference matches, while totaling a team-high 103 in 21 outings this season. In addition, she ranks 28th in the nation in overall blocks per set (1.39), as the Hurricanes are seventh out of 328 NCAA Division I programs with 3.08 blocks per set as a team.

Miami (18-3, 10-1) swept the road trip to Clemson and Georgia Tech for the first time in program history and currently sits atop the league standings. The Hurricanes stayed at No. 24 in the AVCA Poll released Monday, while moving up to No. 17 in the NCAA RPI.

Sims joins Katie Gallagher (2010) and Lane Carico (2009) as Miami winners of the CVU.com National Player of the Week.

CANES SWEEP GEORGIA TECH

ATLANTA - No. 24 Miami volleyball extended its winning streak to eight matches after defeating Georgia Tech in three sets on Sunday at O'Keefe Gymnasium in a match televised by RSN. It was the seventh sweep of the season for the Hurricanes.

UM won by the scores of 25-22, 28-26 and 25-15 to improve to 18-3 overall and 10-1 in the Atlantic Coast Conference. Having played every team in the league once, the 10-1 conference mark is the best in program history through 11 matches.

"It was really a complete effort today and it started with our passing and defense," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "We were able to handle the ball really well and all of our attackers hit over .300, which is amazing. I think we were able to frustrate them with our defense and the ability to side-out. It was another great team win."

Junior outside hitter Taylor Hollins picked up her team-leading 15th double-double of the season with 16 digs and 11 kills, while sophomore outside hitter Savannah Leaf had a team-high 12 kills to spark the Canes. Sophomore middle blocker Emani Sims backed her record-setting performance at Clemson with 11 kills and seven total blocks.

Orchestrating the offense, senior setter Nrithya Sundararaman had 38 assists.

Playing in a hostile environment, Miami took the first set behind five kills apiece from Hollins and Leaf, with Sundararaman collecting 17 assists. After the teams split the first 22 points, the Canes went on a 5-1 run to take a lead it would not relinquish. Georgia Tech brought it to within 24-22, but Sims put down a kill to give the visitors the opener. UM has taken the first set in 14 of 21 matches this season.

The Yellow Jackets responded in the second with a rally to overcome a late four-point deficit. Miami had first chance at the set with a 24-23 lead, but Georgia Tech won the next two exchanges for a set point of their own. After UM fended that off, the hosts once again had an opportunity to tie the match, but sophomore middle blocker Alexis Mourning put down two kills and combined with Sundararaman on a block to push the match lead to 2-0.

Looking to close it out on the road, UM ran out to a 16-9 lead in the third and never looked back to clinch the win and sweep the four-match road trip. A block by Mourning and Sundararaman

ended the day, as the Canes put down 14.0 total team blocks. In addition, Miami hit at a clip of .406 for the match.

Defensively, Miami collected 50 digs compared to 34 by Georgia Tech. Hollins and junior libero Ryan Shaffer combined for 31 digs.

The Yellow Jackets suffered only their second home loss of the season, falling to 15-7 on the season and 6-5 in the league. Monique Mead and Annie Czarnecki each had 12 kills for GT.

Coupled with the five-set win at Clemson on Friday night, it marked the first time Miami had ever won both matches on the CU-GT road trip.

"I think we took a big step up this week in our road performance and being able to rise to the challenge," Lantagne Welch said. "We have to keep improving as the season continues and working hard to move up the ladder."

SIMS BLOCKS UM PAST CLEMSON

CLEMSON, S.C. - Behind one of the most impressive performances in program history by sophomore middle blocker Emani Sims, No. 24 Miami volleyball held off upset-minded Clemson in five sets on Friday inside Jervey Gym. Sims recorded her first career double-double with 16 kills and a school-record 16 total blocks.

"We knew it was going to be a great test and we knew that Clemson is a great team," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "We were able to stay together and put together a great team effort."

The ACC-leading Canes (17-3, 9-1 ACC) extended their winning streak to seven by the scores of 25-23, 21-25, 25-20, 23-25 and 15-11. Clemson dropped to 14-7 overall and 5-5 in the conference, suffering only its second home defeat of the year.

The Hurricanes, who entered the weekend ranked first in the ACC in blocks, tallied a program-record 23.0 total team blocks against the Tigers. The previous best was 21.0 set against Florida State in 2005.

Sims, who won ACC Player of the Week on Oct. 1 and was named Preseason All-ACC, accounted for 25.0 points on the night, including nine kills and four blocks in the fourth set. Junior right side Alex Johnson (15 kills, 20 digs), junior outside hitter Taylor Hollins (14 kills, 14 digs) and sophomore Savannah Leaf (11 kills, 12 digs) also notched double-doubles in the match.

"Emani was just incredible at the net tonight," Lantagne Welch said. "They have some fantastic hitters on the other side and it was impressive how she was able to shut them down. It was a big statement because they are such a great blocking team and we were able to out-block them."

Senior setter Nrithya Sundararaman totaled a season-high 55 assists for the UM.

Miami took the first set behind five kills and nine digs from Hollins, with Leaf also adding five kills of her own. After the teams split the first 22 points, the Canes took three of the next four points to go up 15-12 and never lost the advantage from there. The lead grew to as much as 19-14 to force the Tigers to take a timeout. Following, UM held off the hosts with Leaf slamming a kill to end it and give Miami the 1-0 lead.

However, Clemson responded in the second set with a late run to even the match at one heading into intermission.

In the third, Miami jumped out to a 15-8 lead to pull the momentum back and force a Clemson timeout. The Tigers could only get to as close as four points, as a kill by Johnson off a free ball put UM up 2-1.

It looked as though the Canes would take the fourth set after reaching 20 first at 20-18, but Clemson rallied to win seven of the next 10 points to send UM to its third five-set match of the season. It was the second-straight time Miami had gone the distance, defeating Boston College on Oct. 14.

In the deciding fifth set, the teams went back and forth to bring the count to six apiece. From there, the Hurricanes won the next three points on a kill and block by sophomore middle blocker Alexis Mourning and a bad CU set. After Lantagne Welch took a timeout with a lead of 9-8, UM sealed the win with a 6-3 run. Leaf put down a kill to give the Canes their first win at Jervey Gym since 2010.

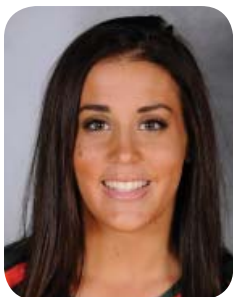
