PACK TRACKS

■ NC State dropped a road contest to Virginia Tech, 72-58, on Saturday afternoon. The Pack was led by D.J. Funderburk who scored 18 points and grabbed nine rebounds. Pat Andree was the only other NC State player to reach double figures with 11 points. NC State shot a season-low 31.9% from the field. It was only the second time in 16 games this season, the Pack shot under 40% from the field.

■ D.J. Funderburk is averaging 17.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game over his last four outings while shooting 63.4% from the field. The Cleveland, Ohio native has shot over 50 percent in 12 of the 14 games he's played in this season. He is shooting 64.7% from the field on the season and would lead the ACC in field goal percentage, but just misses out on qualifying to be ranked. (Funderburk averages 4.71 field goals per game and to be ranked a player needs to average 5.0 field goals per game).

■ Freshman Manny Bates broke the NC State single-season blocks record for a freshman in the win last week over Notre Dame, surpassing J.J. Hickson (47) and BeeJay Anya (46). At his current pace of 3.13 blocks per game, Bates would finish the regular season with 97 blocks which would break the program's single-season record of 95, which was done by Thurl Bailey during the 1982-83 National Championship season.

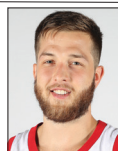

Head Coach Kevin Keatts

■ Hired by NC State on March 17, 2017 as the 20th head coach in program history



■ Has a record of 45-24 (.652) in two seasons as head coach of NC State

■ His NC State teams have averaged over 80 points per game in both seasons he has been with the Pack. Prior to Keatts first team at NC State, the Pack hadn't had a team average over 80 points since the 1995-96 season

■ Led NC State back to the NCAA Tournament in his first season with the program and took the team to the NIT quarterfinals in his second season

■ Compiled a record of 72-28 (.720) in three seasons as head coach at UNC-Wilmington, including a 41-13 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play

■ Led Seahawks to three-straight regular season conference titles and was named the CAA Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2016

■ Coached UNCW to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2016 and 2017

■ Served as an assistant coach at Louisville for three seasons, helping lead the Cardinals to a 96-21 (.821) record from 2011-14

■ Prior to Louisville, Keatts served as the head coach at Hargrave Military Academy for 10 seasons

■ With two separate stints at Hargrave (1999-2001, 2003-2011), he compiled a 263-17 (.939) record with two national prep championships (2004, 2008), three runner-up finishes (2005, 2006, 2009) and two other appearances among the final four prep teams (2007, 2010)

■ Coached 14 players that have gone on to the NBA

■ Three Sweet 16 appearances, two Final Four berths and one National Championship as a coach.

■ Keatts and his wife Georgette have two sons, K.J. and Kaden

NOTING NC STATE

- NC State returns six of its top-seven scorers from last season.
- The Pack will only have 10 scholarship players in uniform in the 2019-20 season. Junior guard Thomas Allen is sitting out the season after transferring from Nebraska. Freshman guard Dereon Seaborn is sitting out as an academic redshirt and junior guard Blake Harris left the program in late October.
- The game against Memphis on Nov. 28 marked the first time this season NC State played more than eight scholarship players in a game. Nine scholarship players saw action against the Tigers. NC State has only had more than eight scholarship players dress in uniform for a game five times this season. Markell Johnson missed the first game (injury). D.J. Funderburk missed the first two games (suspension). A.J. Taylor has not dressed out for a game since the season-opener against Georgia Tech (injury), Danny Dixon has missed time while dealing with a knee injury and C.J. Bryce has missed the last four games with a concussion.
- Redshirt freshman Manny Bates made his NC State debut on Nov. 5 against Georgia Tech. The Fayetteville native missed his senior season of high school with a shoulder injury and sat out last season after having preseason shoulder surgery. Bates' appearance against Georgia Tech was his first game representing his school since his junior season of high school wrapped up on Feb. 24, 2017 - that is a span of 985 days.
- For the third consecutive season, Keatts has added two grad transfers to the roster (2017-18 - Allerik Freeman (Baylor) and Sam Hunt (North Carolina A&T); 2018-19 - Eric Lockett (FIU) and Wyatt Walker (Samford). This year, the Pack has added Pat Andree and Danny Dixon. Andree comes to NC State from Lehigh. One of the top-shooters in the Patriot League, Andree averaged 12.9 points and 6.2 rebounds per game last season. Dixon averaged 7.5 points and 3.6 rebounds per game last season at UMKC.

WEDNESDAY STORYLINES

- With C.J. Bryce missing the last four games, NC State has only had three guards dressed out to play. The lack of depth has caused NC State to hold back on the typical full court pressure NC State has used under Kevin Keatts. Over the last four games, NC State has only forced opponents into 41 turnovers. The 41 forced turnovers are the fewest over a four-game stretch in the Kevin Keatts era at NC State.
- Through The Citadel game on Dec. 22, NC State was forcing its opponents into an average of 16 turnovers per game which ranked in the top-50 in the NCAA. Four games later, NC State is now averaging to force opponents into 14.63 turnovers per game which ranks 128th in the NCAA.
- In the first 82 games Kevin Keatts coached at NC State, only once did NC State play fewer than eight players in a game (7 against UNCG on 12/16/17). With the short bench the last two weeks, NC State has played just seven players in two of the last three games. Only two times this season (Memphis and The Citadel) has NC State played more than eight scholarship players in a game.
- Miami is third in the ACC and 16th in the NCAA in fewest turnovers per game at 11.1. Last season, Miami had just seven turnovers in the Pack's win. The seven turnovers tied for the fewest forced in the Kevin Keatts era. This marks the third consecutive game NC State has played a team ranked in the top-20 in the NCAA in fewest turnovers. Notre Dame and Virginia Tech were both ranked 1st in the NCAA in fewest turnovers per game when the Pack faced them last week. NC State forced Notre Dame into 14 turnovers in a 73-68 win, but Virginia Tech had just eight turnovers (season-low for an NC State opponent) in a 72-58 loss for the Pack.
- Junior forward D.J. Funderburk has been hitting the offensive glass in the last four games. The Cleveland, Ohio native had 20 offensive rebounds in the first 10 games of the season, but has 16 in the last four games. He ranks 10th in the ACC in offensive rebounds per game at 2.57 per game. Miami enters Wednesday's contest last in the ACC in rebounding margin at -6.1 per game.
- Get Devon Daniels Going: In 11 wins this season, Devon Daniels is averaging 12.4 points on 52.9% shooting and 5.1 rebounds per game. In the five losses, Daniels is averaging 7.6 points on 35.9% shooting and 4.0 rebounds per game. Over the last three games, Daniels is averaging 6.7 points and shooting 33.3% from the field.
- Manny Bates has had multiple blocked shots in every game this season, but Saturday was the first time this season he didn't lead NC State in blocks in a game. Devon Daniels led the Pack with three blocked shots. Bates' 50 blocked shots on the year tie for the sixth-most in the NCAA.

NC STATE - MIAMI SERIES

- NC State leads the all-time series with Miami, 12-11. The two teams have an even 11-11 record since the Hurricanes joined the ACC prior to the 2004-05 season.
- NC State has a 5-4 record against Miami at PNC Arena, but the Hurricanes have won two straight in Raleigh. The Pack's last win at home against Miami was 86-59 on Jan. 30, 2016.
- Last season against Miami: NC State battled back to win at Miami, 87-82. The Pack trailed by 10 points with under 10 minutes to go, but went on a 13-0 run to take the lead and never trailed again. Markell Johnson scored 17 of his team-high 20 points in the second half. Devon Daniels added 19 points on 7-of-10 shooting.

SENIOR BRYCE TAKING CONTROL

■ NC State senior guard C.J. Bryce is making his final season count. The Charlotte native is currently leading the team in scoring (16.1 ppg.) and rebounding (6.8 rpg.) while ranking second on the team (and third in the ACC) in steals (21). He also ranks fourth in the ACC in field goal percentage 52.9%.
 ■ In his second season playing for the Pack, Bryce has seen improvement across the board in every statistical category.

■ Bryce has three double-doubles this season, all of the 20+ point, 10+ rebound variety.
 ■ Bryce has played for Kevin Keatts for his entire collegiate career. He signed with UNCW out of high school and played for Keatts for two seasons. After Keatts became head coach at NC State, Bryce announced his intention to transfer, ultimately selecting NC State and has been on all three of Keatts' Wolfpack teams.

BENCH PRODUCTION

■ NC State's bench is averaging 27.1 points per game this season and is outscoring the opponent's bench by 154 points, 433-279. NC State's bench scored a season-best 45 points in the win over The Citadel.
 ■ The Pack's bench has had at least one player score in double-digits off-the-bench in every game but two this season. D.J. Funderburk (11), Devon Daniels (4), Pat Andree (3), C.J. Bryce (3) and Jeri-cole Hellems (1) have all had double-digit scoring performances after not starting this season.
 ■ Last season, NC State had the most prolific scoring bench in the ACC, averaging to score 29.0 points per game and outscoring the opponent's bench by 469 points.

MANNY BATES EMERGING AS ONE OF NATION'S TOP SHOT BLOCKERS

■ Just 16 games into his NC State career, Manny Bates is already making his mark on the NC State record book. He currently leads the ACC and ranks seventh in the NCAA with an average of 3.13 blocks per game.
 ■ Bates has had multiple blocked shots in all 16 games this season. He had five blocked shots in his NC State debut against Georgia Tech on Nov. 5.
 ■ The Fayetteville, N.C., native had a season-best seven blocked shots in NC State's win over Detroit Mercy on Nov. 10. The seven blocked shots tied for the sixth-most in a single-game in NC State history and ranks as the second-most in a game in the 20-year history of PNC Arena.
 ■ Bates broke the NC State record for most blocked shots in a season by a freshman in his 15th game of the season. At his current pace (3.13 blocks per game), Bates would finish the regular season with 97 blocked shots which would break the current single season record of 95 by Thurl Bailey in the 1982-83 National Championship season.
 ■ Bates ranks second in the NCAA in block percentage in Ken Pomeroy's ratings. KenPom calculates block percentage as the percentage of opponents' two-point shots that are blocked by the player while he is on the court. Bates has a 16.7 block percentage meaning the Fayetteville native blocks nearly 1-in-5 two-point shot attempts when he is on the floor.

MARKELL JOHNSON NAMED ACC CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK

■ Senior guard Markell Johnson was named ACC Co-Player of the week on Monday, Dec. 23. The Cleveland, Ohio native posted a double-double with 17 points and 10 assists in a loss to #12 Auburn before returning home and registering a triple-double in the win over The Citadel. It was the first triple-double of Johnson's career as he finished with 11 points, a then career-high 10 rebounds and 10 assists. It is the fourth triple-double in NC State history and Johnson becomes the third player in program history to record a triple-double (Julius Hodge and Dennis Smith, Jr. (2x)). It is the second ACC Player of the Week honor of Johnson's career.

PACK SCORING PLENTY UNDER KEATTS

The NC State men's basketball team has averaged over 80 points per game in both of the seasons Kevin Keatts has been head coach of the Pack. Prior to Keatts arriving at NC State, the Pack hadn't averaged over 80 points per game in a season since the 1995-96 team averaged 81.2 points per game last season. Last year's team set a program-record for most points scored in a single season with 2,882 points. NC State has scored over 80 points in eight of 13 games in the 2019-20 season and currently ranks second in the ACC in scoring offense at 79.7 points per game.

- Junior guard Braxton Beverly ranks 12th in program history for career three-pointers made. Beverly led the team with 76 three-pointers last season and hit 136 three-pointers in his first two seasons at NC State which are the most for any player in program history through their sophomore season.

■ Senior guard Markell Johnson entered his senior season ranked 10th in program history in career assists with 397. The Cleveland, Ohio passed out 10 assists in his season-debut against Detroit Mercy on Nov. 10, passing Nate McMillan and Cat Barber to move into eighth place and has since moved up another four spots to rank in fourth place currently. Johnson led the ACC in assists in his sophomore season with a 7.3 average per game. ■ Junior guard Braxton Beverly and senior guard Markell Johnson both currently rank in NC State's top-10 for career assist-to-turnover ratio. Beverly ranks fourth with a career ratio of 2.43 (236-to-97), while Johnson ranks seventh with a ratio of 2.08 (502-to-241).
 ■ Johnson ranks ninth in the ACC this season with a 2.0 assist-to-turnover ratio.

PACK INKS SIGNING CLASS THAT CURRENTLY RANKS FIFTH IN NATION

■ NC State has signed five Class of 2020 prospects - Ebenezer Dowuona, Nick Farrar, Josh Hall, Cam Hayes and Shakeel Moore - to National Letters of Intent to join the Wolfpack Basketball Program starting next season.
 ■ NC State's five-man recruiting class is currently ranked as the fifth-best class in the team recruiting rankings by 247Sports and Rivals.
 ■ Four of the five signees are North Carolina natives. Josh Hall (Durham, NC) is a five-star prospect and a consensus top-50 recruit in the Class of 2020 and Cam Hayes (Greensboro, NC) is also a consensus top-50 recruit and a four-star prospect.

DEFENSIVE PRESSURE UNDER KEATTS

■ The Pack has led the ACC in forcing opponent turnovers in both of head coach Kevin Keatts seasons. In his first season with NC State in 2017-18, the Pack forced 487 opponent turnovers, an average of 14.8 per game. Last season, NC State forced 560 turnovers, an average of 15.6 per game. The 560 opponent turnovers are the third-most forced turnovers in program history. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 33-12 (73.3%) when it forces an opponent into 15 or more turnovers.

PACK HAS FINISHED SECOND IN TURNOVER MARGIN LAST TWO SEASONS

■ NC State has finished second in the ACC in turnover margin in both seasons with Kevin Keatts as head coach. The Pack had a +2.64 turnover margin in 2017-18 and a +3.08 turnover margin last season. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 46-17 (73%) when it has the same or fewer turnovers than its opponent and just 10-12 when it has more turnovers than its opponent.

PACK COMING OFF OF BEST REBOUNDING SEASON FOR PROGRAM IN YEARS

■ NC State finished the season with a +4.31 rebounding margin last season. It's the best rebounding margin for an NC State team since the 1998-99 team had a +5.9 rebounding margin. The Pack was 16-4 last season when it outrebounded its opponent and just 8-8 if it tied or lost the rebounding battle.

NC STATE LED ACC IN OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING IN 2018-19

■ The Pack averaged 13.56 offensive rebounds per game last season to lead the ACC. NC State had more offensive rebounds than its opponent in 25 games last season.

CELEBRATING 20 YEARS OF PNC ARENA

This year marks the 20th year of PNC Arena. NC State played its first game inside PNC Arena on Nov. 19, 1999, a 67-63 win over Georgia. NC State has an all-time record of 241-98 (.711) in PNC Arena. Kevin Keatts teams have a record of 35-8 (.814) inside PNC Arena.

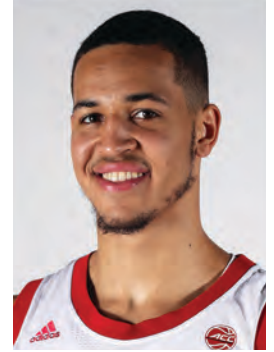
