SECOND UM-PRINCETON GAME IN LAST THREE YEARS

Miami and Princeton have played three times previously, but just once since 1948. The Hurricanes hold a 2-1 lead in the series.

The programs faced off on Dec. 29, 2015, in Coral Gables, with UM posting a 76-64 win.

The other two meetings came on Dec. 28 and 29, 1948, in Coral Gables, with UM winning the first game, 37-35, and Princeton taking the second, 62-55 in double overtime. Jim Larrañaga is 1-0 in his career against Princeton.

HURRICANES AT AAA

Miami owns a 3-2 record at AmericanAirlines Arena, which opened in 1999.

After playing four games in the arena from 2001-04, Miami returned last year, winning 74-57 against Wofford in the Hoophall Miami Invitational.

OUSTIDE THE FRIENDLY CONFINES

Under Jim Larrañaga, Miami is 64-47 (.576) away from home, including 24-15 in neutral-site contests.

UM is 2-0 away from the Watsco Center this season. The Canes play six of their seven games in December away from home (four neutral, two road) and currently

are in a stretch with just one home game in 42 days. Miami was 7-10 (4-6 road/3-4 neutral) away from home last season, just the second time in Larrañaga's

first six seasons that the Hurricanes posted a road/ neutral record under .500 (2011-12 was the other).

SEARCHING FOR 7-0

Miami is seeking its second 7-0 start under Jim Larrañaga. The 2014-15 squad started 8-0.

This is the fourth straight year the Hurricanes have started at least 4-0 and the fifth time in seven years under Larrañaga.

As of Friday, Miami was one of 17 remaining unbeaten teams in Division I.

DEFENSE SOLID THROUGH SIX GAMES

Miami's defense has come out of the gates strong, limiting its opponents to 58.5 points per game (second in ACC/seventh in NCAA) and 36.5 percent shooting (fourth in ACC/16th in NCAA).

The Hurricanes are limiting their opponents to 25.5 percent shooting from 3-point range (second in ACC, 14th nationally), including holding La Salle to 0-for-15 3-point shooting last Wednesday.

UM's defense has recorded three scoreless stretches of five-plus minutes, including two in the opener against Gardner-Webb and one versus Florida A&M.

BALANCE ON OFFENSE

Miami put at least five players in double figures in scoring in five of its first six games. The Hurricanes had three such games in 33 contests in the entire 2016-17 season.

Eight Miami players are averaging at least 6.3 points per game, while the Hurricanes are shooting 50.1 percent as a team.

Dewan Huell (15.0 ppg) is the lone Hurricane to hit for double figures in each of the first five contests, while Ja'Quan Newton (11.7) has reached double figures in five of six.

AS A RANKED TEAM

The Hurricanes are ranked No. 10 in the Associated Press Poll and No. 13 in the USA TODAY Coaches Poll, each released Monday. As a ranked team under Jim Larrañaga, Miami is 48-18.

Miami has been ranked in five of Larrañaga's seven seasons at The U, topping out at No. 2 in both polls on Feb. 18, 2013.

Miami is the only school with both its men's basketball and football teams currently in the top 10.
With Mark Richt earning ACC Coach of the Year honors Monday, Miami's current football, baseball and men's and women's basketball coaches all have earned ACC Coach of the Year laurels during their careers.

Angel Rodriguez scored 14 points and No. 13 Miami withstood an upset bid, beating Princeton 76-64 on Dec. 28, 2015, in Coral Gables.

Davon Reed finished with 13 points and Ja'Quan Newton scored all of his 13 in the second half for UM.

Rodriguez's two free throws and 3-pointer during a 1-minute stretch late in the second half put the Hurricanes ahead for good. His 3-pointer with 5:02 left gave Miami a 62-58 lead.

Princeton held a 30-27 halftime lead.

Newton and Anthony Lawrence were the lone current Canes to play in that game. Newton played 22 minutes off the bench, while Lawrence was scoreless in 10 minutes off the bench.

HOLDING OPPONENTS UNDER 60

Miami limited four straight opponents to fewer than 60 points to open the season. That marked the second time that has happened in the Jim Larrañaga era.

The other was a six-game stretch from Dec. 25, 2012 to Jan. 16, 2013.

UM is 72-9 in seven seasons under Larrañaga when limiting its opponents to fewer than 60 points.

PLAYING WITH THE LEAD

Miami has played with a lead for the vast majority of the first six games.

The Hurricanes have led for 201 minutes, 54 seconds of the 240 minutes thus far (84 percent). UM has trailed for just 20:46.

Miami led for all but 2:01 at Minnesota. Miami has yet to trail in the second half this season.

HUELL OFF TO BIG START IN THE POST

Sophomore center Dewan Huell has started the season well and leads the team in scoring at 15.0 points per game. He averaged 5.8 per game last year.

He scored a career-best 23 points on 10-of-16 shooting Wednesday at Minnesota La Salle and ranks second in the ACC and 10th nationally in field-goal percentage (.691).

Huell scored in double figures in each of the first six games and recorded his first career double-double on Nov. 12, matching a career high with 10 boards.

He is averaging 6.3 boards per game (3.1 last year) and has at least five rebounds in all but one game this year.

NOTING THE YOUTH MOVEMENT

Miami features a young group this season. Seven of the Hurricanes' 10 active scholarship players are underclassmen.

Ja'Quan Newton is the lone scholarship senior. Miami's starting lineup this year has featured Newton, Anthony Lawrence (junior) and sophomores Bruce Brown, Dewaxn Huell and Dejan Vasiljevic.

LYKES PROVIDES SPARK

Chris Lykes has given UM a big boost off the bench, particulary Wednesday at Minnesota.

The rookie guard scored 10 points and added a season-best three steals in 19 minutes off the bench.

Lykes was inserted to start the second half, and Miami responded by going on a 9-2 run to break a 36-all halftime deadlock.

NOTING THE MINNESOTA GAME

• Miami is 6-5 all-time in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge, including four straight wins.

- UM is now 5-2 in road openers under Jim Larrañaga.
- UM is 36-1 under Larrañaga when scoring 80 points.
- Miami turned the ball over a season-low eight times

and had a 17-5 advantage in points off turnovers. • Miami was out-rebounded for the first time this season.

• Ja'Quan Newton matched a career high with nine assists. He had only one turnover.

• Bruce Brown Jr. scored a season-high 16 points and fell one rebound shy of a double-double. He also recorded five assists.

• Anthony Lawrence scored eight of Miami's first 10 points in the game.

• Lawrence and Brown combined for 15 of Miami's first 17 points.

WAARDENBURG MAKES FIRST APPEARANCE

After redshirting last season and missing the first three games this year with a back injury, forward Sam Waardenburg made his college debut last week.

He scored seven points in 13 minutes against La Salle and followed it up by scoring nine points and grabbing six boards in 16 minutes against North Florida.

The 6-foot-10 New Zealand native has added about 15 pounds to his frame since arriving at UM.

LUCKY SEVENS FROM LONG RANGE

Miami has connected on at least seven shots from long range in 125 of Larrañaga's 214 games at UM, including three of five games in 2017-18. The Canes are 97-28 when making at least seven from 3-point range. Last season, Miami was 11-5 when hitting seven from behind the arc.

Previous seasons: 2015-16: 17-3; 2014-15: 18-5; 2013-14: 9-6; 2012-13: 19-3; 2011-12: 19-6.

Miami is averaging 7.7 3-pointers per game this season.

CANES LOOK FOR 70 POINTS

- Miami has eclipsed the 70-point plateau in five of its six games this year.
- Last season Miami was 17-1 overall and 8-1 in ACC play when scoring 70+ points.

UM is 60-11 when scoring 70 or more points under Jim Larrañaga.

BROWN JOINS ELITE TRIPLE-DOUBLE COMPANY

Bruce Brown Jr. started off his sophomore season with a great all-around performance against Gardner-Webb, recording his second career triple-double, the third in school history and the 31st in ACC history.

Brown became just the sixth player in the league's storied history to earn a pair of triple-doubles.

He reached the status at the 5:36 mark of the second half with a field goal for his ninth and 10th points.

As part of the opener, Brown matched his career high in assists and fell one shy of his high in rebounds.

MORE HONORS FOR BROWN

Bruce Brown, Jr. added a pair of early-season honors in the recently, as he was named to the watch list John L. Wooden Award as well as the Citizen Naismith Trophy Top 50.

In the preseason, Brown was named to the Preseason All-ACC Second Team. He aslo was lauded nationally on the watch lists for the Citizen Naismith Trophy, Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award, Lute Olson National Player of the Year Award and the Oscar Robertson Trophy.

THE WATSCO ADVANTAGE

Miami has defended its home turf well in recent years, winning 31 of its last 33 games at the Watsco Center. The Hurricanes went 14-2 at home last year and are 81-22 (.786) under Jim Larrañaga.

In the first 16 years at the Watsco Center (formerly BankUnited Center), Miami is 176-66 (.727).

In seven seasons under Larrañaga, Miami is 43-7 in non-conference play and 38-15 in ACC action at home. In both 2012-13 and 2015-16, the Canes had just one loss at Watsco Center.

Miami has won 15 straight home non-conference games, dating to a 78-77 loss to Northeastern on Nov. 27, 2015.

WHO'S BACK

The Hurricanes welcome back 10 players from their 2017 NCAA Tournament squad, including starters Bruce Brown, Jr., Anthony Lawrence II and Ja'Quan Newton. In all, Miami returns six players who averaged double-figure minutes.

Newton averaged 13.5 points and 31.4 minutes per game last years. After a standout rookie season, Brown (11.8 ppg, 5.6 rpg, 31.9 mpg) is back, as is Lawrence (6.8 ppg, 3.8 rpg, 26 mpg).

Miami also returns Dejan Vasiljevic, Ebuka Izundu and Dewan Huell, each of whom averaged at least 13 minutes per game last year. Izundu and Huell are the Canes' top returning post threats, while Vasiljevic averaged six points in 17 minutes per game off the bench.

CANES WELCOME STRONG CLASS OF ROOKIES

Miami added three high-touted newcomers this year in Deng Gak, Chris Lykes and Lonnie Walker IV. Each was an ESPN Top 100 recruit last season.

A 2017 McDonald's All-American and consensus top-20 recruit, Walker IV was among 20 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2018 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award.

Walker recently was tabbed the "most exciting freshman in America" by ESPN.com's Myron Medcalf.

Lykes was ESPN's No. 45 recruit, while Gak was rated No. 91. Gak is expected to redshirt this season.

BEST PRESEASON RANKING IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Ranked in the preseason polls for the first time since 2008-09, Miami was No. 13 in the preseason Associated Press poll. It marked the highest preseason AP ranking in program history. Miami also was No. 12 in the USA Today Coaches poll.

It is the third time Miami is among the top 25 teams to start the season. The Canes were ranked No. 25 prior to the 1999-2000 campaign and No. 17 heading into the 2008-09 season.

ACC PRESEASON POLL

Miami is ranked fourth in the 2017-18 ACC Coaches Preseason Poll, the Hurricanes' highest standing in the poll in Jim Larrañaga's seven years at the helm and matching their highest at any point during their 14 years in the ACC (fourth in 2008-09).

In each of Larrañaga's first six seasons, Miami finished the year in a higher standing than their preseason rank.

Miami followed Duke, North Carolina and Notre Dame in the preseason poll.

2017-18 ROSTER HAS SIX TOP-100 RECRUITS

Miami signed three ESPN Top 100 recruits for the class of 2017, including No. 18 Lonnie Walker from Reading, Pa., No. 46 Chris Lykes from Mitchellville, Md., and No. 92 Deng Gak from Blairstown, N.J.

The trio joins former ESPN Top 100 Hurricanes Bruce Brown (No. 26 in 2016), Dewan Huell (No. 28 in 2016) and Ja'Quan Newton (No. 58 in 2014) in the fall of 2017. In just seven seasons at The U, Larrañaga has recruited six of Miami's 11 ESPN Top 100 players since 2007.

MIAMI EARNS HIGH GSR NUMBERS

Miami's men's basketball team posted an exemplary Graduation Success Rate (GSR), in the latest numbers released on Nov. 8 by the NCAA. Miami recorded a 92 percent GSR, which is based on the four entering classes from 2007-08 through 2010-11.

In addition, the Miami football (83 percent), women's basketball (92 percent) and baseball (83 percent) programs all posted GSR totals above the NCAA average.

The NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was developed in response to college and university presidents suggesting that graduation data more accurately reflect the mobility among college students today. The GSR measures graduation rates at Division I institutions and includes students transferring into the institutions. The GSR also allows institutions to subtract student-athletes who leave their institutions prior to graduation as long as they would have been academically eligible to compete had they remained.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

Miami lost a pair of 2016-17 starters to graduation guard Davon Reed and forward Kamari Murphy.

A 2017 Third-Team All-ACC honoree, Reed led the Hurricanes in scoring at 14.9 points per game while averaging a team-high 35.3 minutes per game. Reed was selected No. 32 overall by the Phoenix Suns in the second round of the 2017 NBA Draft, the 20th player in program history to be drafted.

Playing in 131 career games (99 starts), Reed scored 1,343 points, good for No. 16 on the Hurricanes' alltime scoring list.

The 6-foot-8, 220-pound Murphy was a force in the middle, averaging 7.1 points and 7.3 rebounds per game.

BROWN, WALKER EARN PLAUDITS FROM ESPN.COM

In October, ESPN.com listed Brown as the best college shooting guard draft prospect for the 2018 NBA Draft. Lonnie Walker was tabbed second best. They were the lone teammates on the 10-man list.

Brown and Walker were listed 12th and 13th, respectively on ESPN's top 100 draft prospects for 2018, as Miami was one of 13 college teams to have multiple players on the list.

VASILJEVIC LOOKS TO BUILD ON BIG SUMMER

Sophomore guard Dejan Vasiljevic had a strong summer playing internationally with Australia's Emerging Boomers at the World University Games in Taipei.

The Melbourne native averaged 21.5 points a game on 45.3 percent shooting from the field in eight games in the tournament.

Vasiljevic scored 20-plus points and led the team in scoring in five of the eight games as the Emerging Boomers finished ninth in the field.

He closed out play with a 28-point performance in a 101-96 win over Canada.

Miami's assistant coaching staff is set up in a coordinator system. Jamal Brunt serves as the offensive coordinator, while Chris Caputo handles the defense. Adam Fisher manages the scout for every opponent.

SCHEDULE NOTES

Miami has a dozen games scheduled against eight programs that competed in the 2017 NCAA Tournament, with potential matchups with four more in the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic.

Miami traveled to face Minnesota in the Big Ten-ACC Challenge Wednesday before coming back to play Princeton in the Hoophall Miami Invitational on Saturday at AmericanAirlines Arena.

Miami plays six ACC opponents (10 games total) that competed in 2017 NCAA Tournament, including reigning national champion North Carolina.

Miami competes in the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic Dec. 22-25, opening with the host, Hawaii. The 2017 edition of the classic features a great field with five NCAA tournament participants from the past season in Miami, Middle Tennessee, New Mexico State, Princeton and Southern California.

MILES WILSON JOINS MIAMI PROGRAM

Jim Larrañaga added Miles Wilson to the Hurricanes' incoming class of 2017. A 6-foot-5-inch transfer from Mount St. Mary's, Wilson will sit out the 2017-18 season because of NCAA transfer rules, then have three years of eligibility with the Hurricanes.

Wilson averaged 11.8 points per game and 3.9 rebounds in 28.9 minutes per game and was named to the Northeast Conference All-Rookie Team.

In the NCAA Tournament's First Four. Wilson scored 17 points and grabbed 11 rebounds in a 67-66 win over New Orleans before recording a game-high 22 points with seven rebounds against top-seeded Villanova.

SELLING OUT THE WATSCO CENTER

Miami sold out its season ticket allotment for all home games last year at the Watsco Center. This marked the second consecutive year the Hurricanes sold out their season ticket allotment, reaching 5.750 in sales.

UM has fewer than 200 season tickets remaining for this season.

For three straight years now, fans have bought over 5,500 season tickets, more than doubling the total number of season tickets sold in Jim Larrañaga's first season in Coral Gables. When Larrañaga began his reign in Miami, fans bought 2,251 season tickets for the 2011-12 campaign.

CANES SEEK ANOTHER 20-WIN CAMPAIGN

Jim Larrañaga has posted five 20-win seasons in his first six years at The U and 11 career 20-win seasons. The 21-win campaign in 2016-17 was Miami's eighth 20-win season since joining the ACC for the 2004-05 campaign. Larrañaga is just the second coach in Miami history with five 20-win seasons, joining Bruce Hale (1954-67).

The Canes won seven or more ACC games in each of Larrañaga's first six seasons and have had 10 or more league victories in four years. Prior to Larrañaga's arrival, Miami had never won 10 ACC games in a season.

LARRAÑAGA 12TH IN WINS AMONG ACTIVE **DIVISION I NCAA COACHES**

Entering the 2017-18 season, Jim Larrañaga ranks 12th in career wins among active Division I coaches with 609. Of those 12, five are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, including four from the Atlantic Coast Conference.

Now in his 34th season as a head coach. Larrañaga ranks 47th in all-time NCAA victories.

In his career, Larrañaga won 27 games at American International, 170 at Bowling Green, 273 at George Mason and 139 at Miami. He is one of 15 coaches alltime with 100 or more wins at three D-I schools, four of whom are actively coaching.

Caputo helped the 2006 GMU team to the NCAA Final Four and has made five total NCAA Tournament appearances with Larrañaga.

Both Caputo and Larrañaga attended Archbishop Molloy (N.Y.) High School and played for legendary head coach Jack Curran.

SUCCESS FOR BOTH MIAMI BASKETBALL TEAMS

The Miami men's and women's basketball teams both landed in the NCAA Tournament for the second straight season in 2017, the first time both Miami basketball teams play in The Dance in consecutive years.

Miami was one of seven schools, four of which are in the ACC, with both its men's and women's basketball teams ranked in the preseason USA TODAY Coaches Poll. The others on the list were Baylor, Duke, Louisville, Notre Dame, UCLA and West Virginia.
