- The Canes return home after a four-game road trip that ended with a loss at Duke (3-0). Miami continues its series with the North Carolina Triangle as it hosts NC State and North Carolina, this weekend.
- UM has at least one player in the top 10 of the ACC in every major category (hitting percentage, kills, assists, blocks and digs).
- The Canes rank fourth in the ACC with 15.55 digs/set.
- Savanah Leaf is third in the conference in kills (3.86/set) and sixth in service aces (0.34/set).
- Emani Sims is fourth in the ACC with a .361 hitting percentage in conference matches.
- Ryan Shaffer has had at least 15 digs in 13 matches this season. She
 is third in the conference with 4.58 digs/set.
- Miami is 47-27 all-time against teams from the Tar Heel state.
- Savanah Leaf came up one block short of a triple-double against Boston College on Sept. 28 (17 kills, 12 digs and nine blocks).
- Alexis Mouring set a school record with 17 blocks against Boston College on Sept. 28.
- Alex Johnson and Ryan Shaffer played in their 100th career matches against LSU. Johnson reached the mark on Sept. 13, while Shaffer accomplished the feat on Sept. 14.
- Caitilin Donahoe recorded a career-high 64 assists against Long Beach State, which is the most in a single match by any ACC player this season
- Alex Johnson, Alexis Mourning, Ryan Shaffer and Emani Sims were named preseason All-ACC. Sims was named third-team AVCA All-American in 2012.
