THE FACTS...

The University of Miami and Florida State open up this weekend's Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) match-ups with a highly-anticipated contest in Coral Gables, Fla. The Hurricanes are entering ACC play undefeated for the first time ever. In fact, UM is riding the second-best start to a season ever ... with the best being a 15-0 start to the 2002 campaign. That same year, under the direction of head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch, the 'Canes advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament.

Miami is 2-2 in ACC openers since joining the league back in 2004. The last two season-openers have been against the Seminoles, and have ended with losses. FSU took the 2007 opener, 3-0 while doing the same with a 3-2 count in 2006.

Miami enters the contest having won the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif. last weekend. For the second time this season, junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew was named as Tournament MVP. She also registered tournament top honors on the opening weekend at the *Century Tel Premier Tournament* in San Marcos, Texas.

ON FLORIDA STATE...

The Seminoles of Florida State University come into this weekend's contest with an 8-2 overall record. However, the 'Noles are fresh off winning the Raider Challenge in Dayton, Ohio.

Florida State is 3-3 in matches played in Coral Gables and 4-4 against the Hurricanes since they joined the ACC in July of 2004. This season Miami brings an undefeated 10-0 record to Friday night, with a slight lead over the Noles in team attack percentage (.280), kills (459) and digs (514). FSU is attacking at .277 with 452 kills, 458 digs and tops the Canes with 99.5 total blocks to 81.5 and 416 assists to 405.

MIAMI VS. FLORIDA STATE SERIES...

In the series between the only two Florida schools of the ACC, Florida State leads the all-time series by the slimmest of margins, 5-4. The 'Noles have won three of the last four meetings, with the last UM victory coming on Oct. 17, 2006 in Tallahassee. UM took the match, 3-2.

LOESSBERG SURPASSES 1,000-DIGS MARK...

Junior libero/defensive specialist Cassie Loessberg (Sacramento, Calif.) surpassed the 1,000-digs mark last weekend at the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational. Loessberg now sits at second place all-time in the digs category with 1,060 total. She is now 561 digs behind Jamie Grass for the top honors in school history.

AND A FRESHMAN SHALL LEAD THEM...

Freshman Lane Carico has stepped onto the scene immediately and made her name known for the Orange and Green. She is now second on the team in kills (82), first in service aces (13), second in digs (121) and fourth in blocks (17). The Manhattan Beach, Calif. native is trying to follow in the footsteps of another UM great to hail from the Manhattan Beach area -- Jamie Grass (2001-04). Carico has tallied a team-best three double-doubles this year, including a season-high 19 digs with 10 kills in her last match against San Francisco.

MIAMI WINS THIRD TOURNAMENT OF THE YEAR...

Following their three victories last weekend, the 'Canes have now won three consecutive tournaments to start the season. Mayhew has collected two MVP awards while teammate Katie Gallagher collected the MVP award during the Hurricane Invitational. The Hurricanes haven't won

Head Coach ... Nicole Lantagne Welch



Nicole Lantagne Welch enters her eighth season at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in five of the last seven seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In the 2006 season-opener, Lantagne Welch recorded her 100th career win with a 3-2 victory over Alabama. In 2007, UM finished 14-17 overall and 8-14 in ACC play, pushing Lantagne Welch's career

record to 125-81 overall in seven seasons as a head coach, all at Miami.

Her career at UM is highlighted by two consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins (2003 & 2004) and a trip to the Sweet 16 in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her seven seasons at the helm, the Hurricanes have averaged 17.8 wins per season.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. As a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered first-team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and 1993, and earned second-team honors in 1991. She was also named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

As team captain her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career at Maryland, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7th, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

HURRICANES VB MEDIA POLICY**KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX**

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Information Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

three tournaments in a season since 2002 when they won three consecutive tournaments before falling in the second round of the Big East Tournament, though entering as the heavy favorite.

HURRICANES SWEEPING TO YOUR TOWN...

Miami has never been afraid of taking the "show" on the road, and that's exactly where the Hurricanes will have to go following their one (1) home match on Friday night with the FSU Seminoles. The 'Canes will hit the road for five (5) consecutive contests beginning Saturday, Sept. 20 at nearby Florida Atlantic. In fact, UM will travel to ACC foes Duke, Wake Forest, Clemson and Georgia Tech in straight road matches.

FRESHMEN STORMING INTO ROTATION FOR HURRICANES...

Freshmen duo Lane Carico and Ali Becker are storming into the starting lineup for the Hurricanes after tremendous play in their first two tournaments of the season. Carico is second on the team with 59 kills, and Becker sits in a tie atop the team list for blocks (15) with senior Ashley Woods. Carico is also second on the squad in digs (79).

HURRICANES IN THE ACC RANKINGS...

In the latest statistical rankings/charts, the University of Miami is first in attack percentage (.287), opponent hitting percentage (.112), service aces (50), second in kills (301) and tops in digs (379). Individually, Cassie Loessberg is first in the ACC in digs (112) and teammate Maria Andersson is second in service aces (18 / 0.61 saps). Loessberg is ranked 34th nationally in digs per set, while the team as a whole is 15th nationally in the same category.

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE 'NOLES...

The last time the Seminoles and Hurricanes hooked up was back on Oct. 23, 2007 with FSU taking a 3-1 victory over the Orange and Green in Coral Gables. Ciara Michel led the way on offense for the 'Canes as she tallied 12 kills and two solo blocks. Behind her was Genny Mayhew (11) and Bridget Bomhack (10) with double-digit kills themselves. The Seminoles of FSU were paced by a pair of players with 17 kills apiece, respectively, in the form of Mira Djuric and Brianna Barry. Line scores of that match were as follows ... 28-30, 24-30, 30-25, 23-30.

MAYHEW NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC TEAM...

Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew was named to the Preseason All-ACC Team as voted on by head coaches around the Atlantic Coast Conference. Mayhew, a 5-foot-11 junior from Clovis, Calif. (Clovis HS), finished ninth in the conference in both kills (428) and points (465) a year ago. She also finished fourth on the squad in digs (224) and tied for fifth in blocks (43) alongside teammate Ariell Cooke while playing in 111 games for the 'Canes.

KNIGHT COMPLEX UNDERGOES RENOVATION...

The Knight Sports Complex, home to Miami Hurricanes volleyball, underwent a few renovations over the off-season including new bleachers and a new playing surface. There was also extensive paint work done to the walls with green and orange added to the press row side of the arena. The lights are certainly on in the Knight for the 'Canes in 2008.

CLEMSON PREDICTED TO WIN ACC ... AGAIN...

After finishing atop the league last season, the Clemson Tigers have been predicted to repeat as conference champs after collecting 11 of a possible 12 first place votes. Georgia Tech received the other first place vote while being predicted to finish second. Duke and North Carolina were third and fourth, while Florida State and Virginia tied for fifth, respectively.
