PACK TRACKS

- NC State fell to No. 6 Louisville, 77-57, on Saturday afternoon to drop its third consecutive game
- Senior guard C.J. Bryce led the Pack with 15 points. He scored 13 of 15 points in the second half. Bryce is averaging a team-best 13.2 points per game this season, but was averaging 16.1 points per game prior to missing four games because of a concussion. Prior to his 15 points against the Cardinals, Bryce hadn't scored in the last two games for NC State.
- Devon Daniels (12 points) and D.J. Funderburk (11 points) also reached doubles figures for the Pack. Markell Johnson added a team-high five assists and tied his career-high with four steals in the loss.
- Senior guard Markell Johnson has nine steals in his last three games and now has 146 for his career. He needs three more steals to tie former Pack great - and current Indiana Pacers head coach - Nate McMillan for 13th on the program's all-time steals chart. Johnson ranks third in the ACC in steals this season, averaging 1.95 a game.
- Junior guard Devon Daniels has scored in double figures in five of the last six games and is averaging 12.7 points, 5.5 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game over the last six outings.
- Freshman forward Manny Bates leads the ACC and ranks 9th in the NCAA with an average of 2.95 blocks per game. Bates broke the program record for most blocked shots by a freshman in just 15 games.

Head Coach Kevin Keatts

■ Hired by NC State on March 17, 2017 as the 20th head coach in program history



■ Has a record of 45-24 (.652) in two seasons as head coach of NC State

■ His NC State teams have averaged over 80 points per game in both seasons he has been with the Pack. Prior to Keatts first team at NC State, the Pack hadn't had a team average over 80 points since the 1995-96 season

■ Led NC State back to the NCAA Tournament in his first season with the program and took the team to the NIT quarterfinals in his second season

■ Compiled a record of 72-28 (.720) in three seasons as head coach at UNC-Wilmington, including a 41-13 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play

■ Led Seahawks to three-straight regular season conference titles and was named the CAA Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2016

■ Coached UNCW to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2016 and 2017

■ Served as an assistant coach at Louisville for three seasons, helping lead the Cardinals to a 96-21 (.821) record from 2011-14

■ Prior to Louisville, Keatts served as the head coach at Hargrave Military Academy for 10 seasons

■ With two separate stints at Hargrave (1999-2001, 2003-2011), he compiled a 263-17 (.939) record with two national prep championships (2004, 2008), three runner-up finishes (2005, 2006, 2009) and two other appearances among the final four prep teams (2007, 2010)

■ Coached 14 players that have gone on to the NBA

■ Three Sweet 16 appearances, two Final Four berths and one National Championship as a coach.

■ Keatts and his wife Georgette have two sons, K.J. and Kaden

NOTING NC STATE

- NC State returns six of its top-seven scorers from last season.
- The Pack will only have 10 scholarship players in uniform in the 2019-20 season. Junior guard Thomas Allen is sitting out the season after transferring from Nebraska. Freshman guard Dereon Seabron is sitting out as an academic redshirt and junior guard Blake Harris left the program in late October.
- The game against Memphis on Nov. 28 marked the first time this season NC State played more than eight scholarship players in a game. Nine scholarship players saw action against the Tigers. NC State has only had more than eight scholarship players dress in uniform for a game six times this season. Markell Johnson missed the first game (injury). D.J. Funderburk missed the first two games (suspension). A.J. Taylor has not dressed out for a game since the season-opener against Georgia Tech (injury), Danny Dixon has missed time while dealing with a knee injury, C.J. Bryce has missed four games with a concussion, Manny Bates has missed two games with a concussion and Pat Andree has missed three games with an ankle injury.
- Redshirt freshman Manny Bates made his NC State debut on Nov. 5 against Georgia Tech. The Fayetteville native missed his senior season of high school with a shoulder injury and sat out last season after having preseason shoulder surgery. Bates' appearance against Georgia Tech was his first game representing his school since his junior season of high school wrapped up on Feb. 24, 2017 - that is a span of 985 days.
- For the third consecutive season, Keatts has added two grad transfers to the roster (2017-18 - Allerik Freeman (Baylor) and Sam Hunt (North Carolina A&T); 2018-19 - Eric Lockett (FIU) and Wyatt Walker (Samford). This year, the Pack has added Pat Andree and Danny Dixon. Andree comes to NC State from Lehigh. One of the top-shooters in the Patriot League, Andree averaged 12.9 points and 6.2 rebounds per game last season. Dixon averaged 7.5 points and 3.6 rebounds per game last season at UMKC.

WEDNESDAY STORYLINES

- In his first two seasons at NC State, head coach Kevin Keatts' teams averaged over 80 points both seasons. Prior to Keatts arrival, NC State hadn't averaged over 80 points per game in a season since the 1995-96 team averaged 81.2 points per game. In the first 84 games of the Kevin Keatts era, NC State only scored less than 60 points five times. In the last seven games, NC State has failed to reach 60 points four times. The highest point total for NC State in the last seven games was an 80-point effort in the win over Miami on Jan. 15.
- The Pack is shooting 44.3% to rank fifth in the ACC this season, but is shooting just 38.7% in the last seven games, including just 25.7% from three-point range.
- After Blake Harris left the team in October and sophomore forward A.J. Taylor aggravated a previous knee injury in the season-opener, NC State only has nine scholarship players available this season. For most of ACC play, the Pack has had fewer than nine scholarship players dressed in uniform as NC State has only had all nine scholarship players available for three of its 11 conference games. The lack of depth has hurt the Pack's bench scoring. Last season, NC State had the most prolific scoring bench in the ACC, averaging to score 29.0 points per game and outscored the opponent's bench by 469 points. This season, NC State's bench was averaging 27.9 points per game through the first 17 games of the season and had outscored the opponent's bench 15 times in 17 games. Over the last five games, NC State's bench is only averaging 7.4 points per game and has been outscored in five consecutive outings, including Saturday's loss to Louisville where the Cardinals bench outscored NC State's bench, 43-5.
- Junior forward D.J. Funderburk has scored in double figures in 11 of the last 12 games. The Cleveland, Ohio native is the team's leading scorer (14.2) and rebounder (7.4) in conference play. He has shot over 50 percent in 15 of 2- games this season. Funderburk needs just six more made field goals to qualify for NC State's single-season field goal percentage list. His current shooting percentage of 61.8% would rank as the second-best single-season shooting percentage in program history.
- NC State held the Hurricanes offense to just three assists in the win earlier this season. The three assists are the lowest for an opponent in the Kevin Keatts era.
- NC State only committed seven turnovers in the win over Miami on Jan. 15 and forced the Hurricanes into 15 turnovers. The Pack is 11-4 this season when it wins the turnover battle and 3-4 when it has more turnovers than its opponent.

NC STATE - MIAMI SERIES

- NC State leads the all-time series with Miami, 13-11. The Pack has a 12-11 record since the Hurricanes joined the ACC prior to the 2004-05 season.
- NC State has a 5-5 record against the Hurricanes in Coral Gables.
- Last time Out: The Pack defeated Miami, 80-63, on Jan. 15. D.J. Funderburk led four NC State players in double figures with 19 points.
- Last time in the Watsco Center: NC State battled back to win at Miami, 87-82, on 1/3/19. The Pack trailed by 10 points with under 10 minutes to go, but went on a 13-0 run to take the lead and never trailed again.

FUNDERBURK 2ND ON CAREER FG%: CLOSING IN ON SINGLE SEASON

- NC State junior forward D.J. Funderburk ranks second on NC State's career field goal percentage chart and is six made field goals away
- Entering the Miami game on Wednesday, Funderburk needs six more made field goals to rank on the program's single-season field goal percentage list.
- The Cleveland, Ohio native's career field goal percentage of 58.1% currently ranks second in NC State history. His season FG percentage this season of 61.8% is just 0.6% behind the current record-holder Kevin Thompson's 62.4%.
- Funderburk is shooting 55.7% in 11 conference games. His overall shooting percentage of 61.8% would lead the conference, but he does not meet the 5.0 field goals made per game average to be ranked. He averages 4.7 made field goals per game this season.

MANNY BATES EMERGING AS ONE OF NATION'S TOP SHOT BLOCKERS

- 20 games into his NC State career, Manny Bates is making his mark on the NC State record book. He currently leads the ACC and ranks 9th in the NCAA with an average of 2.95 blocks per game.
- Bates had multiple blocked shots in 18 of the 20 games he's played in this season, including the first 17 of the season.
- The Fayetteville, N.C., native had a season-best seven blocked shots in NC State's win over Detroit Mercy on Nov. 10. The seven blocked shots tied for the sixth-most in a single-game in NC State history and ranks as the second-most in a game in the 20-year history of PNC Arena.
- Bates broke the NC State record for most blocked shots in a season by a freshman in his 15th game of the season.
- Bates leads the NCAA in block percentage in Ken Pomeroy's ratings. KenPom calculates block percentage as the percentage of opponents' two-point shots that are blocked by the player while he is on the court. Bates has a 16.6 block percentage meaning the Fayetteville native blocks nearly 1-in-5 two-point shot attempts when he is on the floor.

MARKELL JOHNSON NAMED ACC CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Senior guard Markell Johnson was named ACC Co-Player of the week on Monday, Dec. 23. The Cleveland, Ohio native posted a double-double with 17 points and 10 assists in a loss to #12 Auburn before returning home and registering a triple-double in the win over The Citadel. It was the first triple-double of Johnson's career as he finished with 11 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists. It is the fourth triple-double in NC State history and Johnson becomes the third player in program history to record a triple-double (Julius Hodge and Dennis Smith, Jr. (2x)). It is the second ACC Player of the Week honor of Johnson's career.

JOHNSON CLIMBING PROGRAM'S ASSIST CHART

■ Senior guard Markell Johnson entered his senior season ranked 10th in program history in career assists with 397. The Cleveland, Ohio passed out 10 assists in his season-debut against Detroit Mercy on Nov. 10, passing Nate McMillan and Cat Barber to move into eighth place and has since moved up another four spots to rank in fourth place currently. Johnson led the ACC in assists in his sophomore season with a 7.3 average per game. ■ Junior guard Braxton Beverly and senior guard Markell Johnson both currently rank in NC State's top-10 for career assist-to-turnover ratio. Beverly ranks fourth with a career ratio of 2.41 (239-to-99), while Johnson ranks seventh with a ratio of 2.10 (531-to-253).
 ■ Johnson ranks fifth in the ACC this season with a 2.06 assist-to-turnover ratio.

JOHNSON JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB AT NC STATE

■ Senior guard Markell Johnson became the 53rd member of the 1,000-point club, eclipsing 1,000 points with a lay-up in the first half of the Pack's game at Georgia Tech on Jan. 25. He is the fourth player in program history to score 1,000 career points, pass out 500 assists and register 125 steals.

PACK INKS SIGNING CLASS THAT CURRENTLY RANKS FIFTH IN NATION

■ NC State has signed five Class of 2020 prospects - Ebenezer Dowuona, Nick Farrar, Josh Hall, Cam Hayes and Shakeel Moore - to National Letters of Intent to join the Wolfpack Basketball Program starting next season.
 ■ NC State's five-man recruiting class is currently ranked as the fifth-best class in the team recruiting rankings by 247Sports and Rivals.
 ■ Four of the five signees are North Carolina natives. Josh Hall (Durham, NC) is a five-star prospect and a consensus top-50 recruit in the Class of 2020 and Cam Hayes (Greensboro, NC) is also a consensus top-50 recruit and a four-star prospect.

DEFENSIVE PRESSURE UNDER KEATTS

■ The Pack has led the ACC in forcing opponent turnovers in both of head coach Kevin Keatts seasons. In his first season with NC State in 2017-18, the Pack forced 487 opponent turnovers, an average of 14.8 per game. Last season, NC State forced 560 turnovers, an average of 15.6 per game. The 560 opponent turnovers are the third-most forced turnovers in program history. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 34-13 (72.3%) when it forces an opponent into 15 or more turnovers.

PACK HAS FINISHED SECOND IN TURNOVER MARGIN LAST TWO SEASONS

■ NC State has finished second in the ACC in turnover margin in both seasons with Kevin Keatts as head coach. The Pack had a +2.64 turnover margin in 2017-18 and a +3.08 turnover margin last season. In the Kevin Keatts era, NC State is 48-19 (71.6%) when it has the same or fewer turnovers than its opponent and just 11-13 when it has more turnovers than its opponent.

PACK COMING OFF OF BEST REBOUNDING SEASON FOR PROGRAM IN YEARS

■ NC State finished the season with a +4.31 rebounding margin last season. It's the best rebounding margin for an NC State team since the 1998-99 team had a +5.9 rebounding margin. The Pack was 16-4 last season when it outrebounded its opponent and just 8-8 if it tied or lost the rebounding battle.

CELEBRATING 20 YEARS OF PNC ARENA

This year marks the 20th year of PNC Arena. NC State played its first game inside PNC Arena on Nov. 19, 1999, a 67-63 win over Georgia. NC State has an all-time record of 243-100 (.708) in PNC Arena. Kevin Keatts teams have a record of 37-10 (.787) inside PNC Arena.

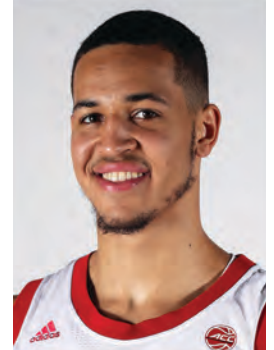
