- Clemson is coming off its fourth straight win, 62-56 on the road over Florida State on Wednesday.
- A win Sunday would be Clemson's fourth on the road, making the 2014-15 Tigers only the sixth team in school history to secure at least four ACC road wins.
- The Tigers are in search of their first win in Miami since the 2010-11 season, Brad Brownell's first at Clemson.

**QUICK HITS**

- Sunday's game is the 15th meeting between Brad Brownell and Jim Larrañaga as head coaches, dating to their days leading UNC Wilmington and George Mason, respectively.
- Clemson's "revenge" win over Florida State — a win over an ACC team that had previously beaten the Tigers at home — was only the eighth in school history, but second straight in Tallahassee.
- For the second straight season, Clemson earned its sixth ACC win on Feb. 4.
- Clemson's four-game ACC winning streak is its longest since the 1996-97 season, Rick Barnes' third season as head coach of the Tigers.
- The Tiger defense has held four straight ACC opponents below 40 percent shooting from the field — a first since Feb. 25 through March 5, 1964.
- In four games as a starter, Jordan Roper is averaging 16.8 points per game, up 12.6 from his average coming off the bench.
- Josh Smith set a career high with eight points at Florida State, while Austin Ajukwa matched his with seven — all in the opening half.

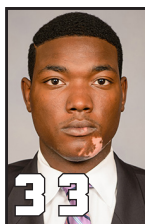

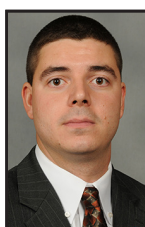

## HEAD COACH BRAD BROWNELL

- Named the 21st men's basketball head coach in Clemson history on April 13, 2010.
- Is coaching his 13th season in Division I, having previously coached four years each at UNC Wilmington and Wright State before coming to Clemson.
- Set Clemson records for total wins (22) and ACC wins (9) by a first-year head coach in 2010-11.
- Led Clemson to first NCAA Tournament win in 14 years when the Tigers topped UAB in the first round in 2011.
- Took the Tigers to the 2014 NIT semifinals after his team was predicted to finish near the bottom of the ACC standings (Clemson finished sixth).
- All 12 of his teams have ranked in the top 50 of the NCAA in scoring defense, including his first team at Clemson that led the ACC and was 24th nationally in scoring defense (61.4). Clemson's 2013-14 defense led the ACC and was eighth nationally in blocks per game (6.1).
- Has taken three different teams to NCAA Tournaments, one of only a few select coaches in the country to accomplish the feat.
- Coached K.J. McDaniels to ACC Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2013-14; McDaniels went on to become Brownell's first player drafted into the NBA.
- Named Colonial Athletic Association Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2006. He coached CAA Player of the Year Brett Blizzard in 2002-03.
- Took over Wright State in 2006-07 and guided the school to a record 23 wins in his first season and an NCAA Tournament bid.
- Began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Evansville in 1991-92, helping that program to an NCAA berth.
- Served as an assistant coach to Jerry Wainwright at UNC Wilmington from 1994-2002.
- Played Division III ball at DePauw University in Greencastle, Ind.
- He and his wife, Paula, have two daughters, Abby (16) and Kate (14).

## CLEMSON, BROWNELL AGREE TO SIX-YEAR DEAL

- Head coach Brad Brownell and Clemson agreed to terms on a new six-year deal that will keep the coach in Tigertown through 2020.
- Brownell took the 2013-14 team to the semifinals of the NIT, and improved Clemson's overall record by 10 wins over the previous season.

## TIGER BASKETBALL UNDER BROWNELL

- First Clemson coach to guide the Tigers to at least nine ACC wins in two of his first four seasons.
- Has taken the Tigers to 32 ACC wins over his first four seasons, more than any other Clemson coach in his first four seasons.
- His teams own the top four Clemson scoring defenses in the ACC era (1953-present).
- The Tigers have had three All-ACC selections, including 2014 first-teamer K.J. McDaniels.
- The Tigers have had at least one All-ACC Defensive Team performer in three of four seasons, led by 2014 Defensive Player of the Year McDaniels.
- McDaniels was the first underclassman drafted from Clemson into the NBA since 2001.

## #PROTIGERS

- Two of Clemson's most exciting players in recent history are currently playing well with their respective NBA teams, Trevor Booker with the Utah Jazz and K.J. McDaniels with the Philadelphia 76ers.
- McDaniels ranks second among NBA rookies with 1.3 blocked shots per game and leads all players 6-foot-6 or shorter.
- McDaniels is third in scoring (9.3), and eighth in steals (0.9) and rebounds per game (3.7) among first-year players.
- Booker is averaging 7.0 points and 4.5 rebounds per game. He scored a season-high 17 in a win over Golden State on Jan. 30.
- In all, 16 former Tigers are competing professionally. Cliff Hammonds leads the European cast with ALBA Berlin, who knocked off the defending world champion San Antonio Spurs in October.



# GAME NOTES & MISCELLANEOUS STATISTICS

## CLEMSON VS. MIAMI SERIES HISTORY

- In a series that dates to the 1950s, Clemson holds a 12-9 all-time edge.
- Since the two became ACC rivals in 2004-05, however, Miami has held an 8-7 lead in the overall series.
- Both teams have compiled five-game winning streaks in the series, most recently Clemson from 2007-08 through 2010-11.
- Clemson owns three wins in Miami — 1995-96, 2008-09 and 2010-11.

## BROWNELL, LARRAÑAGA OLD RIVALS

- Clemson's Brad Brownell and Miami's Jim Larrañaga have faced off 14 times on opposite benches, dating to their time heading up a pair of programs in the Colonial Athletic Association.
- Larrañaga had a 6-4 advantage as George Mason's coach, when Brownell was at UNC Wilmington. In 2005-06, both coaches had their teams at 15-3 in the regular season. But UNC Wilmington won the CAA Tournament to earn the automatic NCAA Tournament bid.
- The four meetings between the two as ACC rivals have been close games. In 2011-12, Larrañaga's team was victorious 76-73. The next season, his squad won by two at Clemson and by 13 in Coral Gables.
- Last season, Brownell coached the Tigers to a 58-54 win over the Hurricanes, following a quick two-day turnaround.

## LAST SEASON IN CLEMSON

- Playing just 48 hours after a double overtime win over Maryland, the Tigers returned to the court March 4, 2014, and beat Miami, 58-54.
- Both teams shot exceptionally well and did not turn the ball over. Miami had five miscues, while Clemson had just nine.
- Clemson rode a balanced attack, featuring 14 points and six assists from point guard Rod Hall, and 12 apiece from Damarcus Harrison and K.J. McDaniels.

## TIGERS RIDING FOUR-GAME ACC WINNING STREAK

only Louisville can claim heading into the weekend of Feb. 7-8.

- For the Tiger program, it is the first four-game winning streak in ACC play since the 1996-97 season, when Rick Barnes was the head coach.
- The accomplishment is one of only nine times in 61 ACC seasons that Clemson has compiled a streak of four wins or more.
- The longest winning streak in

program history came in 1966-67, when Bobby Roberts' team won seven in a row — all in February.

## CLEMSON WINS "REVENGE" GAME OVER FSU

- For the second straight season, the Tigers dropped a home ACC game to Florida State only to return the favor and later win in Tallahassee.
- The "revenge" win on Feb. 4 was only the eighth time in school history that Clemson had won an ACC road game over a team that had beaten it in Clemson earlier in the season.
- Prior to the win over FSU last season under that scenario, Clemson's most recent "revenge" win came in 2005-06 when it won in Blacksburg after Virginia Tech had already won in Littlejohn that year.
- It is interesting to note all eight wins were by six points or less.

# GAME NOTES

## DEFENSE CARRYING TIGERS IN ACC PLAY

Clemson has been its usual solid self in terms of scoring defense, ranking third behind Virginia and Louisville overall at 60.5 points per game. But the Tigers have been even better in conference play.

The Tigers lead the league in field goal percentage defense (.382) and are second in scoring defense (59.0) and three-point percentage defense (.320) in conference games.

Clemson has held each of its last four opponents under 40 percent shooting. This is the first time the feat has been accomplished by the

program since Feb. 25-March 5, 1964, when the Tigers held South Carolina, Maryland (twice) and Virginia below 40 percent.

## TIGERS WIN ON TOBACCO ROAD

Clemson's Jan. 28 win over NC State was only the program's 18th win over a team in the Research Triangle (Duke, North Carolina, NC State). Fourteen of the wins have come over the Wolfpack.

PNC Arena has been one of the most successful venues for the Tigers in recent years. Clemson is 5-6 all-time in the Wolfpack's home since 1999-2000.

The win over NC State was only the fifth double-digit win on Tobacco Road in 180 games.

## TIGERS DENY TWO STRAIGHT IN BID FOR 100TH WINS OVER CLEMSON

Clemson stopped two longtime ACC foes who were bidding for their respective program's 100th win over the Tigers.

Wake Forest led the all-time series 99-57, but the Tigers defeated the Demon Deacons in the final seconds of the Jan. 25 matchup.

Four days later, Clemson beat NC State, who held a 99-59 lead all-time in the series.

## TIGER BENCH PROVIDING A SPARK

Clemson's success this season has largely hinged on the performance of its bench. The Tigers are 8-1 when winning the bench points category.

Through nine ACC games, the Tiger bench has outscored the opposition six times. Clemson is 5-1 in those games, with its lone loss at Louisville.

## CLEMSON WINS IN DRAMATIC FASHION VS. WAKE FOREST

The Tigers beat the Wake Forest Demon Deacons on Jan. 24 on a Josh Smith putback with 0.5 seconds left to break a 57-57 tie.

Smith's shot was the first game-winner inside the final second for Clemson since Sharrod Ford scored on a dunk at the buzzer in 2005 vs. Virginia Tech.

The Tigers overcame a 12-point deficit for the win, the eighth time under Brad Brownell that Clemson rallied for victory after trailing by 10 or more points.

## TIGERS POST FIFTH STRAIGHT HOME WIN OVER WAKE

Clemson's win over Wake Forest on Jan. 24 was the Tiger program's fifth straight at home against the Deacons.

## TIGERS OWN FIVE WINS OVER TOP-100 RPI TEAMS

Clemson has posted five wins this season over teams currently in the top 100 of the official RPI according to NCAAAsports.com.

Arkansas is No. 24 and LSU is No. 51 in the latest RPI. The Tigers beat both teams by three. In ACC play, the Tigers own wins over No. 60 NC State, No. 65 Pittsburgh and No. 72 Syracuse.

## SATURDAY AFTERNOON'S ALRIGHT FOR WINNING

On four consecutive Saturday afternoons, Clemson has posted ACC wins.

On Jan. 10, the Tigers broke Pitt's six-game win streak with a convincing 71-62 victory at Petersen Events Center.

One week later on Jan. 17, Clemson knocked off Syracuse 66-53 at home to break the Orange's seven-game streak.

The Tigers followed Jan. 24 with the comeback win over Wake Forest and added a 15-point victory over Boston College to finish out the month.

## TIGERS GO 3-1 AGAINST SEC TEAMS

Clemson finished non-conference play 3-1 against the SEC, with wins over LSU, Arkansas and Auburn. The Tigers' three victories over SEC teams are the most in a season since 2007-08.

With the 68-65 win over Arkansas, Clemson has beaten every team currently in the SEC alignment.

Just how unusual was Clemson's win over No. 18 Arkansas on Dec. 7? It was only the second win at home in program history over a top-25 non-conference team.

Prior to the win over the Razorbacks, Clemson's only previous win over a non-conference ranked team was in 1997 over No. 6 South Carolina, 62-57.

## HISTORIC WIN AT PITTSBURGH

On Jan. 10, Clemson won its first ACC game on the road at Pittsburgh, 71-62. The win was the Tigers' first in the series over the Panthers.

The win was a rare one, as Pitt lost only for the 28th time in 228 career games at Petersen Events Center.

It marked the sixth time since 2000 that a Clemson team started 0-2 ACC play, but won its third conference game.

## TIGERS RECORD +17 REBOUND MARGIN AT PITT

One of the primary reasons for Clemson's 71-62 win at Pittsburgh on Jan. 10 was a +17 rebound margin.

The advantage was the biggest against Pitt under Jamie Dixon and over the Panther program since Georgetown also achieved a +17 mark in 1999.

It was the largest rebound margin by a Tiger team against an ACC opponent since Jan. 15, 2000, when Clemson owned a +18 advantage over Virginia.

## 50 POINTS OR LESS

With the Jan. 31 win over Boston College by a score of 64-49, Clemson improved to 3-0 on the season and 31-2 overall in Brad Brownell's tenure when holding the opponent to 50 points or less (see chart on left).

## BROWNELL'S PROGRAM EARNED FOURTH TOP-25 WIN

- The Dec. 7 win over Arkansas was Clemson's fourth over a ranked foe since Brad Brownell became head coach in 2010.
