NEWS & NOTES

NATIONAL ATTENTION

The Hurricanes debuted at No. 18 in the Associated Press Preseason Poll, marking the sixth time in program history that the Canes have opened the season in the AP Top 25. In four of the prior five seasons, Miami finished the year in the AP Top 25, as well. Miami was one of six ACC teams to make an appearance in the poll: Louisville (No. 9), Florida State (No. 12), NC State (No. 14), Notre Dame (No. 16) and Syracuse (No. 21).

TOP-FIVE FINISH

Miami was picked fourth by league coaches (fifth by the Blue Ribbon Panel), sitting only behind Louisville, NC State and Florida State. The Canes went 2-2 against the top three teams in the ACC in 2018-19. This marks the fourth straight year that Miami has been selected in the top five.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Hurricanes have always succeeded when playing in front of the home crowd. Miami is just nine wins away from the 500-home win mark, sitting at 491-185 (.715) all-time at home. Under Katie Meier, the Canes have historically dominated teams in Coral Gables, boasting a .732 win percentage (184-67). Over the past five years, Miami has lost just 16 games when playing at home.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR

The 2019-20 roster has an international flavor to it with the addition of freshman Kenza Salgues and Moulayna Johnson Sidi Baba. Salgues is the first Frenchwoman to play under Katie Meier while Sidi Baba is the second Swedish player to sign with Miami during Meier's tenure. By adding Salgues to the team, players from 10 different countries have played at Miami since Meier took over in 2005.

PRESEASON HONORS

Beatrice Mompremier has already picked up some preseason accolades, not only earning ACC Preseason Player but she was also tabbed an Associated Press All-American. As a team, Miami was picked 18th in ESPNW's Preseason Top-25.

the matchup

• Miami hosts North Florida for Elementary School Day at the Watsco Center on Wednesday, November 13. The matinee is set to tipoff at 11 a.m. and will air on ACC Network Extra with Joe and Megan Perry on the broadcast call. Fans can also listen to the game on WVUM 90.5 FM.

• The Hurricanes and the Ospreys have squared-off four times in program history with Miami emerging on the winning end on all four occasions. The four games between the teams have all taken place in Miami and the Hurricanes have defeated the Ospreys by a scoring margin average of 41.3 points per game. The most recent outing between the teams came on Nov. 21, 2014 when the Hurricanes posted an 81-53 win over the Ospreys.

last time out

• The Hurricanes tipped off the 2019-20 campaign with a win on Sunday, defeating Jackson State, 83-68, in the season opener at the Watsco Center. The game marked head coach Katie Meier's 450th game at the helm of Miami women's basketball team.

• The Canes found a majority of their shooting success from beyond the arc, knocking down 45.8 percent (11-of-24) of their 3-point shots. Six different Canes recorded a 3-point basket in the game, led by junior Kelsey Marshall, who went 4-for-7 from distance. Marshall, along with fellow junior guard Mykea Gray, combined for five threes in the first quarter alone.

• Along with Marshall's game-high 18 points, three other Hurricanes posted double-digit efforts – Beatrice Mompremier (16 points), Mykea Gray (12 points) and Endia Banks (11 points). Mompremier also hauled in 11 rebounds for her first double-double of 2019-20.

scouting the ospreys

• North Florida enters Wednesday's contest eyeing its second win of the season after downing Wagner, 110-46, on November 9. The Ospreys only loss of the season came at the hands of the Wisconsin Badgers, a 75-62 defeat in Madison to open the season.

• Six Ospreys are currently averaging double-digits: Janesha Green (15.0), Adrienne Jackson (13.0), Jazz Bond (13.0), Tiffany Tolbert (12.5), Rhetta Moore (11.0) and Alexis Gordon (10.0). Jackson and Bond are also averaging nine-plus rebounds per game, anchoring the Ospreys on defense.

#QueenBea

• Beatrice Mompremier returns for her redshirt senior season in 2019-20. Ahead of the season, Mompremier was named not only the 2019 ACC Preseason Player of the Year, but also an Associated Press All-American. She is just the second Hurricane in program history to earn both honors, following in the footsteps of Miami great Shenise Johnson, who received the honor as a senior in 2011-12.

KM's coaching tree

• Head coach Katie Meier has developed quite the coaching tree over the last few years and she'll come face-to-face with one of the branches on Wednesday, when North Florida head coach Darrick Gibbs takes the court at the Watsco Center.

• A long-time assistant coach for Meier, Gibbs worked with Meier for two years at Charlotte, before following Meier to Miami in 2005. Gibbs spent 10 years at Miami, until 2015 when the North Florida head coaching job came open.

• During Gibbs' 10 years at The U, the Canes boasted a 193-134 record and made seven postseason appearances (four – NCAA, three – WNIT). Gibbs also coached a trio of All-Americans: Tamara Jones, Shenise Johnson and Riquana Williams.

field trip!

• The Canes will open the Watsco Center doors to more than 3500 elementary school students for the sixth annual Elementary School Day. Over 16,000 participants from the Miami area have taken part in Elementary School Day in the last five years, and the event continues to grow.

• Miami has played in seven Elementary School Day games over the last five years, playing two games in both 2017-18 and 2018-19. The Canes are 5-2 overall in school day games and 5-0 in games played in November.

• Junior guard Mykea Gray has been particularly efficient in school day games, averaging 18.8 points per game. As a team, the Hurricanes are outscoring Elementary School Day opponents by an average of 13.7 points per game.

ciao dall'italia

• The Canes spent 10 days abroad this summer, visiting cities all across Italy. Miami played a trio of games while in Italy, posting a 2-1 record against foreign opponents.

• The Hurricanes began their trip in Rome before venturing north to Florence and then over to Venice. The trip was a mix of basketball and sightseeing as several of the Canes were abroad for the first time in their lives.

• One of the highlights of the trip was the opportunity to play against recent Miami graduates Emese Hof and Laura Cornelius, as the duo were playing for the Netherlands national team.

fab five

• The Hurricanes welcome five new freshman to the team for the 2019-20 campaign. All five freshman hail from different states/countries, including two international players in Moulayna Johnson Sidi Baba and Kenza Salgues.

• The freshman class is a diverse player group featuring two guards (Salgues, Chang), a guard/forward (Johnson Sidi Baba) and a pair of forwards (Jackson, Roby).

• The talent is evident in the class as Jackson and Roby are both Top-100 recruits according to espnW HoopGurlz, while Johnson Sidi Baba and Salgues are four-star international prospects.

acc ranking

• Miami was picked to finish fourth in the ACC this year by the league coaches and fifth by the Blue Ribbon Panel.

• This marks the fourth straight year that the Hurricanes were picked in the top-five by at least one of the two groups. Miami has appeared in the top six on both lists in four of the last five years.

USA basketball

• USA Basketball was full of the Canes this summer as Beatrice Mompremier represented Miami at the Pan American Games in Lima, Peru. Mompremier was one of 12 players on the U.S. team and the only ACC representative.

• The U.S. took home the silver medal from Lima after posting a 4-1 record during the competition, falling to Brazil in the gold medal game, 79-73. Mompremier started all five games, averaging 12.2 points and 7.6 rebounds across the five outings.

• Mompremier and junior Mykea Gray also had the opportunity to train with USA Basketball during their training camp in Coral Gables ahead of the AmeriCup in Puerto Rico. Training camp attendees included Sue Bird, Diana Taurasi and Tina Charles.

meier's miami

• In 14 seasons at Miami, Katie Meier has led the team to a 277-172 mark, including a 205-88 mark since 2010-11. She is one of only two coaches in Hurricane program history with over 250 career wins.

• On June 14, 2019, UM Director of Athletics Blake James announced a one-year contract extension for Katie Meier through the 2024-25 season.

Watsco has provided funding to Miami since the 1990s through its "Watsco's Kids" program, giving children in the community free access to performance arts, sports and other events at UM.

• The Miami basketball facility has undergone a multimillion-dollar renovation over the past two-plus years. The project featured upgrades to the locker rooms, student-athlete lounges, office spaces, weight room, practice facility hallways and concourse.

• Also on display are large-scale images of UM's ProCanes, as well as the newest Miami adidas gear. The players' lounge has a gaming center with couches and televisions. The walls of the practice facility show photos of celebrity Canes fans throwing up the U.

Katie Meier completed her 14th season at the helm of the Hurricanes' women's basketball program in 2018-19. A well-known and respected figure in women's basketball with 18 years of head coaching experience, Meier has worked tirelessly to put her mark on Miami's program and to build a winning tradition.

In 2018-19, Meier guided her team to a 10th consecutive postseason appearance, including an eighth trip to the NCAA Tournament in the last nine years and fifth straight NCAA Tournament bid. Miami also reached 20-plus wins for the ninth time in 10 years and double-digit ACC victories for the seventh time in nine years.

Through the 2017-18 campaign, Meier has a career record of 353-217, including a 277-172 mark at Miami.

Honors and Accolades

Meier has been recognized for her coaching success numerous times throughout her career. From being named a co-recipient of the 2013 USA Basketball National Coach of the Year award following a 9-0 record and gold medal at the 2013 FIBA U19 World Championship, to being inducted into the University of Miami Sports Hall of Fame in 2017, Meier's name has become synonymous with elite basketball.

One of the most prestigious honors bestowed on Meier came at the conclusion of the 2010-11 season when she was named the Associated Press National Coach of the Year - sharing the award with Connecticut's Geno Auriemma and Stanford's Tara VanDerveer. That season, Meier led the Hurricanes into the NCAA tournament for the first time since 2004 and coached the Canes to their first NCAA Tournament win since 1993.

The Canes entered the 2010-11 season with high internal expectations, but were picked eighth in the Preseason ACC Poll. Miami exceeded all outside expectations posting a perfect 20-0 record inside BankUnited Center and finished conference play with a 12-2 record, earning their first regular season conference title since joining the league in 2004. As a result, Meier was named the ACC Coach of the Year and later would be selected as the WBCA/RUSSELL ATHLETIC Region 2 Coach of the Year, as voted on by her peers.

During the 2011-12 season, Meier coached the Canes to their highest ranking in program history at No. 5. Miami went undefeated at home for the second consecutive season, pushing the home win streak to 40 games.

Five people who have been assistants for Meier during her head coaching career have gone on to earn Division I head coaching positions: Lynn Bria (Stetson), Amanda Butler (Florida and Clemson), Darrick Gibbs (North Florida), Carolyn Kieger (Marquette) and Stephanie McCormick (Western Carolina). Additionally, 22 of Meier's players at Miami have gone on to play professionally after their college careers.

A New Era

Hired April 19, 2005, Meier was appointed by then-Miami AD Paul Dee in front of national and local media, fans, alumni and support staff, signifying the beginning of a new era.

Following an unprecedented career as one of the greatest athletes to ever play in the Atlantic Coast Conference, Meier quickly established herself in the coaching ranks. Following an impressive four-year tenure as the head coach at Charlotte where she helped bring the 49er program into national prominence, Meier made it clear that her goal was to make Miami one of the premier women's basketball programs in the country.

Creating a Winning Program

In her first season, Meier wasted little time in making the first steps towards those goals. After receiving little attention in the ACC preseason polls, the Hurricanes posted an impressive overall record of 17-13. Under Meier, Miami earned a berth into the second round of the 2006 Women's National Invitation Tournament and standout Tamara James produced one of the greatest seasons ever seen by a UM player, becoming Miami's all-time leading scorer. James was selected with the eighth overall pick in the 2006 WNBA Draft by the Washington Mystics.

Over the next two years, the Hurricanes continued to develop under Meier's direction. Miami's Renee Taylor emerged as the ACC's leading scorer in 2006-07, while Maurita Reid finished the 2007-08 campaign with 110 steals, good for second in the ACC and fifth in the NCAA.

With the No. 21-ranked incoming recruiting class, Meier and the Hurricanes saw significant improvement during the 2008-09 season. The freshman class was highlighted by McDonald's All-American Shenise Johnson of Henrietta, N.Y., and Riquna Williams from nearby Pahokee, Fla. Under Meier's guidance, Johnson was named the ACC Rookie of the Week on three occasions and was named to the ACC All-Freshmen team as well as ACC Honorable Mention. The

versatile guard/forward also led the U19 USA team to a gold medal finish in the 2009 World Championships in Bangkok, Thailand.

The 2009-10 season was one of the most successful in program history. Under Meier's vision, the Hurricanes advanced to the WNIT Championship game. Miami posted a 22-14 overall record - the first 20-win campaign since the 2002-03 season and just the eighth all-time in history. In her sophomore season, Johnson was named first team

All-ACC, while a healthy Riquna Williams garnered second-team honors. The tandem led Miami to a 5-1 WNIT record - the deepest postseason run in team history, with both earning all-tournament honors along the way.

Following the success of the 2009-10 campaign, Meier signed a contract extension through 2015 and the Hurricanes continued their rise in the ACC. Miami earned a conference regular season title in 2010-11 and returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in seven seasons. Johnson was named to four different All-America squads and became the second player in program history to be named the conference player of the year (Frances Savage - BIG EAST - 1992). Williams, along with Johnson, was named First Team All-ACC and was the conference scoring leader, posting 21.7 points per game.

Miami's dominance continued into the 2011-12 season. The Canes finished second in the conference standings with a record of 14-2 and were 26-6 overall, earning a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. UM also defeated the eventual conference tournament champion, Maryland, both times they played in the regular season.

Seniors Shenise Johnson and Riquna Williams continued to shine in the ACC as the duo were second and third in the league in scoring and each were again named First Team All-ACC. Johnson was also named to the All-ACC Defensive Team for the third consecutive season and earned a place on five different All-America teams, including the WBCA squad for the second straight year. Williams earned AP All-America third team recognition in her final collegiate campaign as well.

The Hurricanes went to a school record third straight NCAA Tournament in 2012-13, earning a No. 8 seed. Meier's Hurricanes defeated two top-10 opponents during the season, besting No. 6/7 Penn State and knocking off No. 5/4 Duke on senior day, marking the first win over a team in the top four of either poll in program history and the school's first win over the Blue Devils, who went 20-1 against ACC opponents that season, including winning the ACC Tournament.

After reaching the WNIT in 2014, Meier guided the Hurricanes back to the NCAA Tournament in 2015 and the 11th-seeded Hurricanes defeated No. 6 seed Washington in the first round, before dropping their second round matchup against third-seeded Iowa, the host school.

Earlier in the 2014-15 season, Meier also led the Hurricanes to the program's first win over a team in the top four of the AP Poll. They defeated No. 4/4 Notre Dame, 78-63, the Fighting Irish's only loss in their first two years in the ACC. Sophomore guard Adrienne Motley went on to be named a consensus First Team All-ACC pick after averaging 16.9 points on 49.2 percent shooting. Meier also earned her 250th career win during the season.

In 2015-16, Meier led Miami to a 24-9 record to tie for the fifth-most wins in a season in program history. Miami received a No. 5 seed the NCAA Tournament and made its fifth appearance in the field in the past six years. The 2015-16 campaign also saw the Hurricanes beat both Duke and North Carolina in the same year for the first time. The victory at North Carolina was good for the 200th of Meier's tenure at Miami. Adrienne Motley was also tabbed as a consensus First Team All-ACC honoree for the second straight year, in addition to garnering WBCA All-America Team Honorable Mention recognition.

In 2016-17, Meier guided the Hurricanes to a second straight 24-9 record. In the quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament, Miami again defeated a Florida State team ranked in the top 10, downing the No. 8/12 Seminoles, 56-54, to earn back-to-back semifinal appearances for the first time. The Hurricanes beat four top-25 teams, defeating three ranked teams – two of which were in the top 10 – away from home for the first time in the ACC era. Miami earned a No. 4 seed in the NCAA Tournament, hosting the first two rounds of play, and reached the second round for the fourth time in seven years.

Adrienne Motley and Jessica Thomas were both Second Team All-ACC picks in 2016-17, with Motley becoming Miami's fifth WNBA Draft pick. In addition, Motley, Thomas and Keyona Hayes formed the second Miami teammate trio to all reach 1,000 points and each signed a WNBA contract, the first time three Hurricanes in the same class did so.

Despite losing many talented players to graduation and injuries, Meier led the Hurricanes to a 21-11 finish in 2017-18 and surpassed 250 wins in her tenure with the program. Erykah Davenport, a Second Team All-ACC honoree, and Keyanna Harris became the first Miami seniors to make four straight NCAA Tournaments. Miami had two freshman all-league honorees for the first time since 1992-93 in the BIG EAST, as Mykea Gray and Kelsey Marshall both made the cut.

Establishing Her Legacy as a Player

Meier's success as a coach is a direct reflection of her playing career as a standout at Duke University. A four-year letter winner for the Blue Devils under head coach Debbie Leonard from 1986-90, Meier's name is scattered throughout the Duke record books.

She currently ranks among the school's all-time career leaders in scoring average (16.2 points per game), steals (232), free throws made (447) and free throws attempted (624). She is also listed among Duke's leaders in career points (1,761), field goals made (653), field goals attempted (1,283), assists (409) and rebounding average (6.1 rebounds per game).

Meier wasted no time making her mark at Duke, earning ACC Rookie of the Year and Basketball Yearbook Freshman All-America honors in 1986. Meier injured her knee in 1988 during her junior season and ultimately missed the entire 1988-89 campaign while recovering.

Meier returned to Duke for her senior season in 1990 without missing a beat, earning Kodak/WBCA District 2 All-America and All-ACC first team accolades while being named the Blue Devils' most valuable player.

In 2002, Meier was honored by Duke for her efforts as a player when she was named to the inaugural induction class in the Blue Devils' Hall of Honor. That same year, Meier was named to the ACC's 50th Anniversary Team. In 2006, she was once again honored by the conference when she was named an ACC Legend at the 2006 ACC Women's Basketball Tournament.

Meier's success on the court was only outdone by her accomplishments in the classroom. She was named to the Dean's List from 1986-88. In 1988 she also earned GTE Academic All-America Second Team honors.

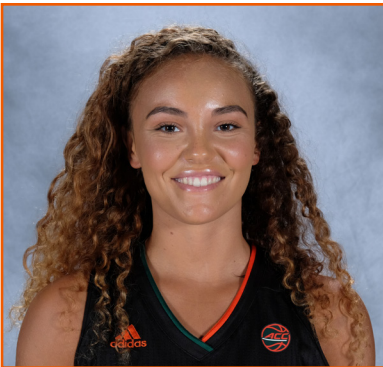
After receiving a bachelor's degree in English literature with cum laude honors in 1989, Meier went on to earn a master's degree in teaching English from Duke in 1990.

Following her career at Duke, Meier moved overseas to play three seasons with BBC Mini-Flat Waregem in Belgium from 1990-93. There, she helped lead her team to three First Division regular season titles and one Belgian Cup Championship. While in Belgium, Meier also spent time teaching classes of conversational English while coaching teams of 15- to 17-year-olds.

A native of Wheaton, Ill., Meier graduated from Wheaton Central High School in 1985 and in October 2009 was inducted into her high school's athletic hall of fame.

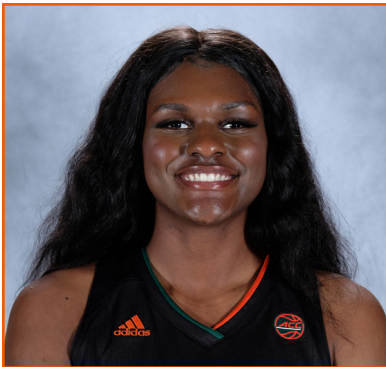

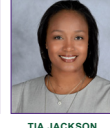
