Miami Set for First Home Matches of the Year with Hurricane Invitational...

The University of Miami will open its home season this week/weekend hosting the annual Hurricane Invitational at the James L. Knight Sports Complex. The Canes welcome teams from Florida A&M, Auburn and Oklahoma to this year's event.

Miami enters the tournament unbeaten at 6-0 and is the reigning Hurricane Invitational champion from 2010. This is the first time UMiami has started the year 6-0 since the 2008 campaign when the team began the year 13-0.

What's at Stake This Weekend...

If the University of Miami can collect three wins this weekend, including a win over 18th-ranked Oklahoma, the Hurricanes could jump into the AVCA Top 25 poll for the first time since 2002.

Hurricane Invitational History...

Dating back to 2001, the Hurricanes are 24-5 all-time in the Hurricane Invitational. The Canes have won three of the last four Hurricane Invitational titles.

Scouting Florida A&M...

The Florida A&M Rattlers enter the Hurricane Invitational with an overall record of 0-4. They come in having won only one set this season against Jacksonville University. The Rattlers are led by Katherine Huanec and her 41 kills on the campaign. Maria Ceccarelli has also played well with 33 kills.

Series Against the Rattlers...

FAMU leads the all-time series against the Canes by a count of 3-0. The last time these two teams met was back on Sept. 15, 2006 with the Rattlers claiming a tough 3-2 decision.

Scouting Auburn...

The Auburn Tigers currently have a record of 5-2 on the year. The Tigers are led by senior Kelly Fidero. She leads the team with 70 kills, tallying 46 of them last weekend at the Blue Raider Bash hosted by Middle Tennessee State. Sophomore Camila Jersonsky was also named to the Blue Raider Bash All-Tournament Team with a .493 hitting percentage on the slate.

Series Against the Tigers...

Miami holds a 3-0 record all-time against Auburn, including a sweep of the Tigers last year

in the Blue Raider Bash Tournament hosted by Middle Tennessee State University.

Scouting Oklahoma...

Oklahoma is currently ranked No. 18 in the AVCA Coaches Poll Top 25. The Sooners currently have a record of 6-1, with their lone loss coming against Cincinnati. They are led by the trio of Brianne Barker, Sallie McLaurin, and Suzy Boulavsky who were all named to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team. Barker and Boulavsky earned all-tournament team honors already this year at the North Texas Invitational. McLaurin has also been named the most valuable player of the Nike Invitational.

Series Against the Sooners...

The University of Oklahoma leads the series against the University of Miami by a 2-1 count. The Sooners took the last match-up with the Hurricanes on a 3-1 count a season ago in the championship match of the *Sooner Legends/Nike Invitational* hosted by OU.

Hurricanes Blow Away Malibu...

The University of Miami swept UC Santa Barbara and Georgia before defeating Pepperdine in four sets last weekend at the *Pepperdine Asics Classic* in Malibu, Calif. This was Miami's second tournament title in the last three years on the west coast, winning the 2008 *Coca-Cola/Asics Invitational* in San Francisco.

Lane Carico Wins ACC Player of the Week...

Lane Carico was named as this week's Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Week after turning in 3.10 kills per set and 5.00 digs per set in three matches. On the year, Carico owns three double-doubles and ranks third on the team with 53 kills (2.52 k/s). She is second on the squad in digs (88) and fourth in blocks (11).

Carico Takes Top Honors...

Senior All-America outside hitter Lane Carico finished as the top offensive performer at the *Pepperdine Asics Classic* last weekend. She was named the Tournament MVP after helping Miami to the tournament title.

Canes Take Tiger Classic Title...

UMiami took down LSU in the title match of the Tiger Classic last weekend inside the Maravich Center in Baton Rouge, La.

For the Canes, it marked the fourth consecutive year they have won a regular season

Nicole Lantagne Welch is in her 11th season as head coach of the University of Miami volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in eight of the last 10 seasons,

including ending the 2010 campaign ranked No. 26 in the RPI polls and No. 28 in the Pablo rankings.

Last season, Lantagne Welch helped guide the Canes to their second 20-win season in the last three years, and the second consecutive year in which UMiami advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Miami ended the season with a 23-9 overall mark (13-7 Atlantic Coast Conference) and finished third in the conference regular season standings. Along the way, the Hurricanes defeated NCAA Tournament participants Florida State, Middle Tennessee State, Georgia Southern, Wichita State and North Carolina.

At the end of the year, Lantagne Welch saw her first-ever AVCA All-American honored in the form of Lane Carico, collecting third team accolades following a record-breaking year. Carico became the first player in school history with 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in a career, as well as leading the ACC in double-doubles – and later being the only player in the league to amass at least 400 kills and 400 digs on the campaign.

Carico and teammate Katie Gallagher each claimed AVCA All-East Region Team honors, while freshman libero Ryan Shaffer set a new school record for digs by a freshman (539 / 4.53 per set). As for Carico, she would also earn her



third consecutive All-ACC Team nod and All-East Region honor.

In 2009, Lantagne Welch helped the Hurricanes to their second NCAA Tournament appearance, competing in the Gainesville [Fla.] Regional. UM earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after holding the 33rd toughest schedule in the nation according to the end-of-year RPI rankings. Earlier in the season, Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to the Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic championship.

She would add to her growing list of All-Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes, as well as All-America honorable mention performers, seeing senior libero Cassie Loessberg and sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico named to both lists. Carico and Loessberg each collected AVCA All-America Honorable Mention selections, while both were tabbed to the AVCA All-East Region Team.

During the 2008 campaign, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by four seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08, '10) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her 10 years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 19.2 wins per seasons with a career record of 192-109.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a

major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Coral Gables.

Hurricanes VB Media Policy

KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, in-between the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Alex Rodriguez Park, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-set and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post match notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Office of Sports Media Relations at (305) 284-3244.

Miami Picking Up Votes...

The Hurricanes continued to earn votes in the latest AVCA Coaches Poll Top 25 this week. The Canes just missed out on the Top 25, coming in this week at No. 26. UMiami is ranked No. 25 in the Rich Kern poll.

A.J. Is MVP...

After recording a career-best 17 kills against Louisiana-Lafayette, sophomore right side hitter Alex Johnson went on to earn MVP honors of the Tiger Classic as UMiami defeated LSU in the title match.

On the week, Johnson amassed a team-high 39 kills (3.55 k/s) and a team second-best 43 digs (3.91 d/s). She was also second on the team in blocks (11).

What a Difference a Year Makes...

Johnson that provided big plays for Miami (6-0) whenever needed. The Tallahassee, Fla. native staked a team-best .395 attack percentage on her way to a career night.

Similar to UMIami, the Pepperdine Waves (3-2) garnered votes in this week's AVCA Coaches Poll Top 25 leading into the weekend. Both teams entered Saturday night's match 2-0 on the weekend.

The Waves opened the match with a 25-18 win as they hit .271 as a team with 17 kills. In the process, the Canes were limited to just .106 hitting in the opener. Miami bounced back in the second frame to take a see-saw battle that ended with Carico putting down two of her 13 kills in the match to even the set courtesy a 25-23 win.

With Miami up a set late in the fourth, the Waves erased a 22-19 deficit behind a Kim Hill service ace and a Kellie Woolever kill to knot the set at 22-all. A kill from UM senior outside hitter Christine Williamson put the Canes back up a point before a service error tied the set for just the second time. In the end, the Hurricanes stood tall with blocks by senior Ali Becker and Carico – added a kill from Johnson – and Miami walked away with its second regular season tournament title on the campaign with the 25-23 fourth-set victory.

Pepperdine was led on the night by three players in double figures for kills, topped by Lilla Frederick with a team-high 17. She would go on to corral 16 digs for a double-double, also adding three blocks.

For UM, it was Johnson's match-high 21-kill performance leading the way offensively, including seven in the all-important fourth set. She would go on to record 14 digs for her third double-double effort on the campaign. Carico added 13 kills and 20 digs for her third double-double of the year, also staking three blocks.

Becker led all players with a match-high six blocks, the second time this season the Katy, Texas native has put down six blocks in a match. Senior setter Katie Gallagher setup the offense with a match-high 51 assists and sophomore libero Ryan Shaffer sprawled out for 26 digs.

Johnson, Carico, Gallagher and Shaffer were all selected to the Pepperdine Asics Classic All-Tournament Team, while Shaffer claimed the Most Valuable Libero award. As mentioned earlier, Carico was named Tournament MVP.

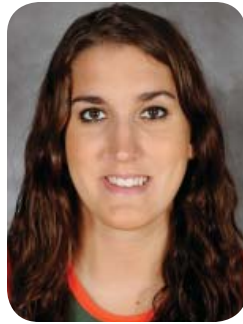

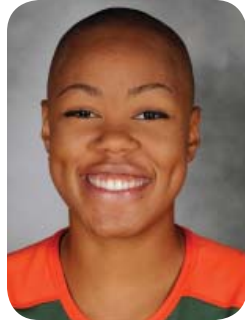
