STORY LINES

- Miami and Florida State will meet to determine the 2012 ACC champion
- UM will be looking to win its first ACC title in volleyball
- The Canes have taken the last two meetings, including a 3-1 victory on Sept. 7
- The first match this season was played in front of a record crowd at the Knight Sports Complex and national television audience (ESPNU)
- The teams have split the season series in each of the last two years, and have split the last 10 meetings (each team won at home in 2011) - UM last swept season series in 2008
- UM was the last visiting team to win at Tully Gym on Nov. 27, 2010
- Tying an ACC record, six UM players were named All-ACC Wednesday: Taylor Hollins, Alex Johnson, Alexis Mourning, Ryan Shaffer, Emani Sims, Nrithya Sundararaman - Nicole Lantagne Welch won Coach of the Year for the second time
- The match will be a homecoming for Tallahassee native Alex Johnson, who won ACC Player of the Week (16 kills, 16 digs) after the first meeting against FSU
- UM has used the same starting lineup for 23 of 29 matches
- The 17 ACC wins are the most in program history
- The Hurricanes won 10-straight ACC contests earlier this season, the most consecutive in school history
- The Canes will be looking to qualify for the NCAA Tournament for the fourthstraight season
- Miami finished a perfect 13-0 at home this season, winning the last 13 sets
- Nrithya Sundararaman was named ACC Player of the Week Monday, becoming the fifth different Cane to earn the honor this season - UM has had a winner in six of 13 weeks this season
- The team has been ranked five different weeks this season
- The Canes lead the ACC in opponent hitting percentage (.164), assists (13.31/set), kills (14.33/set) and blocks (2.92/set)
- Miami was predicted to finish fifth by the ACC coaches in a preseason poll

THE LAST TIME

SEPT. 7, 2012: UM 3, FSU 1

CORAL GABLES, Fla. - The University of Miami volleyball team knocked off No. 6 Florida State, 3-1, in front of a national television audience and a record crowd at the Knight Sports Complex on Friday. It was the first-ever win over a top-10 team for the program.

After dropping the first set 25-18, the Canes won the next three sets by the scores of 25-17, 25-22 and 25-18.

"We played at a very high level and served and passed very well tonight," 12th-year head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "Our offense was in great rhythm. We used a lot of our quickness and speed to beat them."

Junior Alex Johnson, a Tallahassee native, recorded a match-high 16 kills for Miami (7-1, 1-0 ACC) along with 16 digs for her fourth double-double of the season. Sophomore Alexis Mourning contributed 14 kills, as UM put together a hitting percentage of .228 compared to FSU's .155.

Defensively, junior libero Ryan Shaffer had a teamhigh 18 digs, while sophomore middle blocker Emani Sims collected six total blocks.

Senior setter Nryitha Sundararaman put up 50 assists to pace the offense, reaching that total for the second time this season.

The sixth-ranked Seminoles (6-1, 0-1 ACC) came out of the gates strong to take the opening set,

25-18, with a .306 hitting percentage. There were five ties and two lead changes in the set.

In the second, the teams split the first 12 points before UM won the next three to gain momentum. FSU brought the score to 11-10, but the Canes went on an 8-1 run to seize control. The lead grew to as much as 10, with Mourning spiking a kill to clinch the set.


Miami broke an 8-8 tie in the third and never lost the lead again to go up 2-1 in the match. Johnson registered five kills in the set.

With victory in sight, the Hurricanes once again broke through early and went up by as many as 21-13. Florida State called timeout, but UM closed it out on a kill from Mourning that sent the Knight Sports Complex into a frenzy. Members of the record crowd of 1,129 stormed the court to congratulate the Hurricanes on the historic win over a top-10 opponent.

The previous-best win over a ranked opponent came in the second round of the NCAA Tournament against No. 15 Wisconsin in 2002.

"Our program has been growing and is now known across the nation," Lantagne Welch continued. "A win like this is going to get everyone's attention that we are doing great things down here in Coral Gables."

2012 ACC COACH OF THE YEAR

Nicole Lantagne Welch is in her 12th season as head coach of the University of Miami volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in nine of the last 11 seasons, including ending the 2011 campaign ranked No. 15 in the Pablo rankings.

In 2012, Lantagne Welch earned ACC Coach of the Year, guiding the program to it most conference wins since joining the ACC.

Last season Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to a 26-5 overall record and a 16-4 league mark to finish second in the Atlantic Coast Conference. The Canes spent several weeks in the AVCA Top 25. UM qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the third-straight year, defeating Northern Illinois to advance to the Second Round of the Ames [lowa] Regional. At the end of the campaign, numerous players earned recognition, including Lane Carico becoming the first Hurricane to win ACC Player of the Year. The senior also earned AVCA All-America honors to cap one of the best careers in Miami history.

This past summer, Lantagne Welch traveled to Ohio to work with the A2 program as part of development for Team USA. In addition, two players associated with the program - Ciara Michel and Savanah Leaf - both competed in the Olympic Games for Team GB.

In 2010, Lantagne Welch helped guide the Canes to their second 20-win season in the last three years, and the second consecutive year in which UMiami advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Miami ended the season with a 23-9 overall mark (13-7 Atlantic Coast Conference) and finished third in the conference regular season standings. Along the way, the Hurricanes defeated NCAA Tournament participants Florida State, Middle Tennessee State, Georgia Southern, Wichita State and North Carolina. At the end of the year, Lantagne Welch saw her first-ever AVCA All-American honored in the form of Carico, collecting third team accolades following a record-breaking year. Carico became the first player in school history with 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in a career, as well as leading the ACC in double-doubles - and later being the only player in the league to amass at least 400 kills and 400 digs on the campaign. Carico and teammate Katie Gallagher each claimed AVCA All-East Region Team honors, while freshman libero Ryan Shaffer set a new school record for digs by a freshman (539 / 4.53 per set). As for Carico, she would also earn her third consecutive All-ACC Team nod and All-East Region honor.

In 2009, Lantagne Welch helped the Hurricanes to their second NCAA Tournament appearance, competing in the Gainesville [Fla.] Regional. UM earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after holding the 33rd toughest schedule in the nation according to the end-of-year RPI rankings. Earlier in the season, Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to the Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic championship. She would add to her growing list of All-Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes, as well as All-America honorable mention performers.

seeing senior libero Cassie Loessberg and sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico named to both lists. Carico and Loessberg each collected AVCA All-America Honorable Mention selections, while both were tabbed to the AVCA All-East Region Team. During the 2008 campaign, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference

(ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002.

During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama. The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco. Calif. For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the firstever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team. Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by four seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08, '10) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her 10 years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 19.2 wins per seasons with a career record of 192-109.

PIONEERING THE FIRST SEASON

On Feb. 28, 2000, then University of Miami Athletic Director Paul Dee proclaimed the return of women's volleyball as the Hurricanes newest fully funded varsity sport at UM. On Sept. 12, 2000, Dee took the next major step in the evolution of the program by announcing the hiring of Lantagne Welch as head coach of the Hurricanes.

A WINNING HISTORY

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland

from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a studentathlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans. Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking. Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

SUNDARARAMAN NAMED ACC PLAYER OF WEEK

CORAL GABLES, Fla. - Senior setter Nrithya Sundararaman of the 23rd-ranked University of Miami volleyball team has been named the Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Week, the league office announced Monday. She becomes the fifth different Hurricane to earn the honor, as UM has had a player recognized six times in 13 weeks this season.

"Nrithya had a great weekend to close out her home regular season career," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "She is a big reason we have been able to have such a balanced attack by spreading the ball around effectively to all of our offensive weapons. She has also improved her blocking this vear to help our team's defensive efforts.

Sundararaman, a native of Naperville, Ill., continued her strong season with 11.50 assists per set in two sweeps over the weekend. In addition to 34 assists against Boston College, the setter connected on a season-high five kills in seven attempts to go with seven digs.

Prior to the match versus Maryland, the program honored the lone senior on the roster with a ceremony with her family on the court. Sundararaman then went on to collect nine digs and 35 assists in the match to help the Hurricanes finish the regular season undefeated at home.

Sundararaman ranks third in program history with 2,257 career assists and leads the ACC with 10.68 assists per set this season. She has also excelled in the classroom with a 3.90 GPA as a neurobiology major, being named Capital One Academic All-District earlier this month.

The setter joins junior Taylor Hollins (Oct. 29), sophomore Emani Sims (Oct. 1, Oct. 22), sophomore Alexis Mourning (Oct. 8) and junior Alex Johnson (Sept. 10) as Hurricanes to win ACC Player of the Week this year. Miami has won the award more than any other team in the conference.

"I can't say enough about how much of a team we are this season and every player in our program is contributing to our team success," Lantagne Welch said.

NO. 24 VOLLEYBALL FINISHES PERFECT AT HOME CORAL GABLES, Fla. - No. 24 Miami volleyball put together another convincing performance Sunday to sweep Maryland, 3-0, to complete the regular season a perfect 13-0 at the Knight Sports Complex. The victory sets up a winner-takeall match for the Atlantic Coast Conference title on Friday at Florida State.

The Hurricanes improved to 25-4 and 17-2 in the league, winning by the scores of 25-18, 25-19 and 25-15 over the Terrapins. The 17 conference wins are the most in program history. beating last season's mark of 16.

Prior to the match, the program honored the contributions of senior setter Nrithya Sundararaman, who ranks third all-time in school history with 2,257 career assists. She picked up 35 on the day to orchestrate the offensive performance.

"Nrithya did a nice job of getting the ball to our hitters," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "It is great to have the team functioning so well on this day. Overall, I thought we were able to serve tough and handle our passing pretty well throughout the match. Nrithya put us in some good situations with her sets, which allowed us to be effective on offense. Also, we were able to pick up our defensive efforts as the match went on.'

Junior right side Alex Johnson led the Canes with 10 kills, reaching double-digits for the 13th time this season. Sophomores Alexis Mourning and Savanah Leaf added nine kills each, as Miami collected a .283 hitting percentage in the match.

Defensively, junior libero Ryan Shaffer had a match-high 21 digs to help hold the Terps to a .144 hitting percentage. She leads the team with 506 digs (4.77/set) on the season.

The victory was the 17th straight win at home and the 29th in the last 30. The only other season UM had a perfect home regular season was in 1980 (5-0). This year, the Hurricanes won 39 sets at home while dropping only seven.

"It is really hard to go undefeated at home and stay sharp every time out," Lantagne Welch said. "That is always one of goals and to sustain that throughout a season is special.'

The Canes came out strong with a 6-2 run to start the match, forcing a Maryland timeout after a combined block by Sundararaman and Mourning. From there, the Terps could get no closer than four, with the lead growing to as many as seven. A visitor ball handling error closed the opener in favor of the Canes.

The second set was tighter towards the end after Maryland won four straight points to make it 18-16. That would be the closest they would get, as Miami won the next two exchanges to reach 20. A 5-3 spurt from the hosts sent the Canes into intermission with a commanding 2-0 lead.

With the momentum in hand, the Hurricanes started the third up 11-2 to take complete control. The advantage went up to as much as 10, with freshmen Misty Ma'a, Eryn Croft and Kelsie Groot helping seal the set and match. It was the 13th straight set won at home.

The Canes collected seven aces in the match to go with nine total blocks to beat Maryland (16-15, 7-12) for the 10th consecutive time. The Canes also defeated the Terps in three sets on Oct. 12 at Comcast Pavilion.

The win now sets up a championship match Friday at Florida State, with the winner taking the ACC title. The contest will be start at 1 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN3. Miami defeated the Seminoles in four sets on Sept. 7 at home

"It is going to be fun - Florida State is a great team and we know that," Lantagne Welch said. "We had a great match with them earlier in the year and we are going to expect their best on Friday. In order to win, we will have to play at our very best. It is setting up for a great situation; everyone in our program is looking forward to it."

NO. 24 VOLLEYBALL CRUISES PAST BC, 3-0

CORAL GABLES, Fla. - Dominating from start to finish, No. 24 Miami volleyball rolled past Boston College in three sets on Friday at the Knight Sports Complex. The Hurricanes extended their home winning streak to 17, dating back to last

UM won by the scores of 25-15, 25-15 and 25-16 to improve to 24-4 on the season and 16-2 in the Atlantic Coast Conference, remaining in a tie for first place with Florida State. The Seminoles defeated Maryland, 3-0, at home on Friday.

"We are always working on getting off to strong starts," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "We also talked about coming out focused after the break and tonight we were able

Miami put up its best defensive effort of the season statistically, holding the Eagles to 46 points for the match, the least amount surrendered this year. The Canes recorded a .343 hitting percentage compared to BC's .127. Junior libero Ryan Shaffer led the charge with a match-high 17 digs in the back

"Their outside hitters had quite a bit of success against us the last time, so it was definitely a priority to make sure we did a better job defensively to slow them down," Lantagne Welch said. "I thought our blocking was solid and we made some plays to keep the ball alive."

Offensively, sophomore middle blocker Alexis Mourning paced the Hurricanes with 13 kills on the night, while junior outside hitter Taylor Hollins had 10.

Playing in her second to last match at home, senior setter Nrithya Sundararaman put up 34 assists, while slamming down a season-high five kills in seven attempts. She entered the weekend leading the ACC in assists per set (10.63).

In the first set, Miami won the first four points and 10 of the first 13 to establish early momentum. From there, Boston College could only get as close as five, with Miami going on a late 6-2 run to take the opener.

The second set also did not feature any ties or lead changes. as the Canes went up 10-5 on a block assist by junior right side Alex Johnson and sophomore middle blocker Emani Sims. A 7-2 spurt upped the lead to seven, and a kill from Sims at 24-15 gave UM the 2-0 lead heading to intermission.

The Eagles put up resistance in the third set, taking a 7-5 lead. However, Miami went on an 11-3 run after the score was knotted at nine to take a commanding 20-12 lead. Four straight points on serves by Mourning ended the match, with freshman outside hitter Kelsie Groot concluding the night on a kill. It was the 11th sweep for the Canes this season and sixth at home.

Boston College fell to 10-20 on the year and 4-14 in the league, as the Canes have now taken the last 10 in the series.

ACC RECORD SIX CANES NAMED TO ALL-ACC TEAM

GREENSBORO, N.C - Tying an Atlantic Coast Conference record, six University of Miami volleyball student-athletes have been selected to the All-ACC Team, as announced Wednesday by the league. The 18-member team was decided based on a vote of the league's 12 head coaches.

Miami was represented by six first-time All-ACC performers: junior outside hitter Taylor Hollins, junior right side Alex Johnson, sophomore middle blocker Alexis Mourning, junior libero Ryan Shaffer, sophomore middle blocker Emani Sims and senior setter Nrithya Sundararaman.

"We have had a tremendous season and to see so many players recognized is a great honor," head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch said. "It shows the incredible balance and how so many people have contributed so much to our team. This has been a special year and even the players who are not being recognized have meant so much to our success."

Hollins leads the Canes with 337 kills (3.18/set) this season after moving from the back row to outside hitter. Posting a team-leading 16 double-doubles, she earned ACC Co-Player of the Week on Oct. 29 following efficient performances against Virginia Tech and Virginia, where she hit at a .548 clip. Hollins set a career high with 20 kills against Oregon State and is currently second on the team with 320 digs (3.02/set). At Duke, she notched 19 kills and 20 digs, including three slammers in the final four points when the Canes trailed 14-12 in the fifth set.

"Taylor is a great all-around player and does so many great things on the court," Lantagne Welch said. "She has displayed her excellent ball-handling skills and the ability to score all season."

Johnson, who was also named Preseason All-ACC, has started every match in her career for the Hurricanes. She was selected ACC Player of the Week on Sept. 10 after recording 16 kills and 16 digs in the four-set win over No. 6 Florida State at home. Ranking second in the league with an average of 0.40 services aces per set (42), Johnson has eight double-doubles this season and was named Hurricane Invitational MVP at the season-opening tournament.

"Alex is a great offensive player for us on the right side and she is very effective and smart on the court," Lantagne Welch said. "She has made a big step this year as far as improving her blocking and is very strong allaround player. In addition, Alex has one of the best serves on our team to put the pressure on the opponent."

Playing in just 11 matches as a freshman, Mourning emerged this season as a force in the middle of the net for the Canes. She ranks second on the team with 292 kills (2.78/set) and 136 blocks (1.30/set). Also being third in the ACC in blocks, Mourning had 10 total blocks in a win over North Carolina to earn ACC Co-Player of the Week on Oct. 8. The middle blocker has tallied double-digit kills in 15 matches, with a minimum of five total blocks in 16 contests.

"Alexis has had a breakout season and has been a very consistent player for us," Lantagne Welch said. "She is strong not only attacking effectively in the middle, but also as a blocker. Alexis has done a very nice job of closing blocks and impacting our defense throughout the season."

In the back row as the libero, Shaffer is second in the conference with an average of 4.77 digs per set (506) this season. She has led the team in digs in 23 matches this

year, picking up a season-high 30 against both NC State and Boston College. Shaffer ranks fourth in program history with 1,529 digs and is 479 shy of the school record with another season of eligibility remaining.

"Ryan might actually be the most consistent player on our team," Lantagne Welch said. "She has had a great season in a position that often receives less recognition. Ryan has been a steadying force in the back row for us with her solid passing and defense. Ryan is a competitive kid that gives a winning effort every night."

Sims, who was also named Preseason All-ACC, is second in the league with 1.35 blocks per set (143). She has been named ACC Player of the Week on two occasions this season, first posting 32 kills on a .500 hitting percentage in home wins over Duke and Wake Forest. At Clemson, Sims broke a school record with 16 blocks to go with 16 kills in a thrilling five-set victory to win the league honor in addition to Collegiate Volleyball Update National Player of the Week. Having at least five blocks in 14 matches on the season, Sims leads the team with a .327 hitting percentage.

"Emani has had a very dynamic season out of the middle for us," Lantagne Welch said. "Her blocking has come on this season and her quickness on the court makes her a feared attacker and also a strong blocker."

The lone senior on the roster, Sundararaman has been very effective distributing the ball around the court for UM. She leads the ACC with 10.68 assists per set (1,100) and recently earned ACC Player of the Week Monday. The setter had 69 combined assists in sweeps over Boston College and Maryland, while also putting down five kills and seven digs against the Eagles. Sundararaman has had at least 33 assists in all but two matches, being third in school history with 2,257 assists in her career. The neurobiology major was also named to the Capital One Academic All-District, maintaining a 3.90 GPA.

"Nrithya is having the best year of her career and she has found a way to use all of our weapons and keep a balanced attack," Lantagne Welch said. "Her unpredictability as a setter this season has made us hard to defend."

Led by the six selections from Miami, nine different teams are represented on the All-ACC Team. The Hurricanes tie Clemson's 2007 team with the six award winners. UM had a five different players earn ACC Player of the Week six times this season.

LANTAGNE WELCH EARNS ACC COACH OF THE YEAR

GREENSBORO, N.C. - University of Miami head volleyball coach Nicole Lantagne Welch has been named the Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year, the league office announced Wednesday. It is the second time the veteran mentor has earned the honor (2008).

"As a team and a program we knew that we were a little bit underestimated this season," Lantagne Welch said. "We had a lot to prove and were not picked high since we lost a lot of people. However, what a lot of people didn't know was how ready we were to step out to the court and compete. It is a credit to all of the players in our program and the coaches on the staff to how hard we have worked this year to put ourselves in this position."

In her 12th season at the helm of the program she created, Lantagne Welch defied expectations this season to put the Hurricanes in contention to win their first ACC title. The team lost four starters from last year's roster, including three All-ACC selections. Miami was picked to finish in fifth place in a preseason poll of the league

coaches.

"I am very happy for Nicole and the program," interim Director of Athletics Blake James said. "This award is a tremendous recognition of the job that she has done not only this year, but during her time at the University of Miami."

With All-ACC selections also announced, Lantagne Welch put six players on the team, tying an ACC record. Miami is in the top four in the conference in all statistical categories, including leading in opponent hitting percentage (.148), assists (13.31/set), kills (14.33/set) and blocks (2.92/set).

UM has been ranked as high as No. 23 this season and has won its most league matches (17) since joining the conference in 2004. Five different Hurricanes have earned ACC Player of the Week honors on six occasions this season.

Lantagne Welch is the only head coach of the program since it re-started for the 2001 season. One win away from its first ACC title, Miami will also be looking to qualify for the NCAA Tournament for the fourth consecutive season. She is 243-188 (.673) overall and 110-71 (.607) in ACC play in 12 seasons after earning All-ACC status as a setter during her playing days at Maryland.






