MIDWEEK STORY LINES & NEWS

- Miami will wrap up the regular season with a **four-game homestand** beginning Tuesday, May 16 vs. FGCU at 7 p.m.
- The Canes lead the all-time series by a commanding **16-4** margin, but FGCU won the first two games of the season series.
- Freshman righthander **Evan McKendry** (3-2, 3.68 ERA) will start Tuesday opposite FGCU's **Peyton Gray** (3-2, 4.71 ERA).
- UM ends the year with a series against **Virginia Tech** (May 18-20) before traveling to the ACC Baseball Championship.
- Sophomore **Romy Gonzalez** leads the Hurricanes with 14 multi-hit games, 11 multi-RBI games, 11 home runs and 35 RBI.
- Junior **Jeb Bargfeldt** lowered his ERA to a team-best 2.28 with a complete game three-hitter at No. 10 Virginia (May 13).
- Head coach **Jim Morris** has the **fifth-most wins** in Division I history (1,560), the **third-most** wins among active coaches, a **.695** winning percentage (**sixth** among active coaches), and **183** more wins than the next active coach - Mike Fox of UNC.
- The Hurricanes had four different players earn Preseason All-America recognition; **Michael Mediavilla**, **Jesse Lepore** and **Johnny Ruiz** were recognized by *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper* while **Carl Chester** was honored by Baseball America.
- The Hurricanes made their **25th trip to the College World Series in 2016**, finishing with a 50-14 record and a 21-9 mark in ACC play. Miami was the No. 3 national seed for the postseason, and won the **2016 ACC Regular Season Championship**.
- The Canes had **seven** players selected in the 2016 MLB Draft, including Chicago White Sox' first-round pick **Zack Collins**.

3 JIM MORRIS HEAD COACH

THE HURRICANES SKIPPER

It doesn't matter if his roster is full of rookies or veterans, University of Miami head coach Jim Morris continues to produce some of college baseball's most consistent and dominant teams entering his 24th season in Coral Gables. With a talented staff around him, Morris' Hurricanes are continually the class of collegiate baseball, having won national titles in 1999 and 2001 and the ACC Baseball Regular Season Championship in 2008, 2014 and 2016.

In his 23-season tenure at Miami, no program has qualified for the College World Series as much as Morris and his Hurricanes. Miami, which has qualified for the NCAA Tournament a college baseball-record 44 consecutive years, has made it to Omaha in 13 of Morris' 23 seasons in Coral Gables - including most recently in 2016, when Miami was awarded the No. 3 national seed for the NCAA postseason.

Morris set an NCAA record for guiding a program to the CWS in each of his first six years at UM. In addition, Morris has won 17 of 23 NCAA Regional appearances at UM, including a record 13 straight to start his tenure in Coral Gables. His teams have qualified for NCAA Regionals for the last 32 years - all 23 at Miami and his final nine at Georgia Tech.

A three-time national coach of the year and 2008 Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year, Morris has directed the Hurricanes to a 1,056-445-3 (.707) mark since arriving in 1994. Including his 12 seasons at Georgia Tech (1982-93), Morris has forged a 1,560-689-4 (.695) Division I record in 35 years as a head coach. Overall, Morris has been the head coach at the collegiate level for 39 seasons, spending the first four at DeKalb (Ga.) C.C. from 1976-79, and has recorded a 1,691-728-4 (.701) mark.

In addition to carrying on Miami's great baseball reputation in the last 23 years, Morris personally led the charge in the construction of Alex Rodriguez Park, and logged hundreds of hours raising funds for the stadium's renovation prior to its reopening in 2009.

Morris reached two coaching milestones in 2016, as he led the program to its 25th College World Series appearance in history, its third straight ACC Coastal Division title and the program's second ACC Regular Season Championship in a three-year span.

Morris became just the sixth coach in the history of Division I baseball to reach the 1,500-win plateau when Miami topped Louisville 8-4 in dramatic fashion on March 18, 2016. Eight days later, Miami topped Clemson 5-4 in 11 innings - also in walk-off fashion - to send Morris to his 1,000th win at the helm of the Hurricanes.

Under his direction, the Hurricanes set the program record for fielding percentage with a sparkling .983 mark in 2016, a figure that ranked best nationwide. Seven Hurricanes were selected in the 2016 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, including the program's first first-round selection since 2010 in catcher Zack Collins (No. 10, Chicago White Sox). Morris also helped guide two Hurricanes to a pair of major awards: Collins became the first Hurricane to win the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher in 2016, while Bryan Garcia set the program saves record and became the first Hurricane to win the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award.

Morris entered 2015 as among the winningest active coaches in Division I baseball with 1,435 wins. He wasted little time in moving up the record books, moving into sole



possession of eighth place in all-time wins (1,439) on Feb. 15 with a 25-4 win over Rutgers and then seventh place with a 9-5 win over Louisville on March 7 (1,445).

Miami captured the 2014 ACC Regular Season Championship under his watch, recording 24 wins in conference play for the first time in program history.

Morris reached two coaching milestones in the first half of the 2014 season. He became just the eighth Division I coach to reach 1,400 wins in a 5-2 win over Boston College on March 8, and won his 900th game at Miami in a 7-1 upset of No. 3 Virginia on March 22.

Among the players Morris coached at Miami that have gone on to play in the Major Leagues are Peter O'Brien (Kansas City), Chris Hermann (Arizona), Yasmani Grandal (Los Angeles Dodgers), Jemile Weeks (Boston), Danny Valencia (Oakland), Jon Jay (Chicago), Yonder Alonso (Oakland), Ryan Braun (Milwaukee), Ryan Jackson (St. Louis), Pat Burrell (Philadelphia), Alex Cora (New York Mets), Bobby Hill (San Diego), Aubrey Huff (Detroit), Chris Perez (Cleveland), Cesar Carrillo (San Diego), Brian Barton (St. Louis), Gaby Sanchez (Florida), Charlton Jimerson (Houston), Jay Tessmer (New York Yankees), Danny Graves (Cincinnati) and Jason Michaels (Houston), among many others. From his days at Georgia Tech include Nomar Garciaparra (Los Angeles), Jay Payton (Oakland) and Jason Varitek (Boston).

Morris has also enjoyed success on the international scene. From 1989-90, Morris served as head coach of the USA Baseball team that won a Silver Medal in the 1989 Presidential Cup (Taiwan), Bronze Medal at the Goodwill Games and the 1990 International Baseball Association (IBA) World All-Star Game in Atlanta.

CANES OPEN HOME STRETCH WITH FGCU

- Miami will wrap up the regular season with a **four-game homestand** beginning Tuesday, May 16 against **FGCU** at 7 p.m. at Mark Light Field (ACC Network Extra, WVUM 90.5 FM)
- The Hurricanes lead the all-time series with the Eagles by a commanding **16-4 margin**, but dropped the first two games to FGCU this year; Miami fell 3-0 in Fort Myers on March 29 and dropped a 5-4 decision at The Light on April 12.
- Miami will end its regular season with a three-game series against **Virginia Tech** (May 18-20) before traveling to Louisville, Ky., for the **2017 ACC Baseball Championship** (May 23-28).
- Freshman RHP **Evan McKendry** (3-2, 3.68 ERA) will oppose FGCU RHP **Peyton Gray** (3-2, 4.71 ERA) Wednesday night.

WEEKEND REWIND: MIAMI FALLS TO #10 UVA

- For the first time since **March 30**, the Hurricanes dropped a weekend series, falling in two of three games in Charlottesville, Va., to homestanding No. 10 Virginia.
- Junior lefthander **Jeb Bargfeldt** twirled a gem in the first game of a doubleheader on May 13, tossing the first complete game by a Hurricane since May 2015 to lead Miami to a 5-1 win.
- Bargfeldt allowed just **three hits** and **one run**, needing 107 pitches to get through the best start of his Hurricanes career. He struck out six batters and walked one, facing just three batters over the minimum against the **top-ranked offense** in the ACC.
- Miami took a **4-0 lead in Game 2** of the doubleheader, but allowed eight runs in a second inning that ultimately doomed them in a 13-6 loss to set up a rubber match.
- Trailing for most of the game Sunday, the Hurricanes **tied the game 3-3 in the eighth** but allowed four runs in the home half of the inning, and fell 7-4 to drop the series.

HEATING UP: RUIZ, CHESTER WITH BIG WEEKS

- Senior **Johnny Ruiz** was Miami's top performer at the plate last week, hitting .538 (7-for-13), reaching base at a .684 clip and slugging .692. Ruiz batted **.556** in three games at No. 10 Virginia.
- Junior **Carl Chester**, hitting leadoff for the first time since a February series at Florida, batted **.429** in the team's series against the Cavaliers. He led the team with **six hits** and totaled two doubles, three RBI and a .467 on-base percentage.
- Miami lefthander **Jeb Bargfeldt** has been the most consistent weekend starter for the Canes. In nine ACC starts, Bargfeldt is **5-2** with a **1.68 ERA**. He is holding ACC opponents to a **.173 average**.

UNC SNAPS STREAK OF UM COASTAL CROWNS

- Miami won its **third straight ACC Coastal Division title** in 2016, posting a **21-7 record in ACC play** to earn the division crown.
- North Carolina clinched the 2017 Coastal Division crown this past weekend in a series against Virginia Tech (May 12-14), snapping Miami's impressive streak.
- Miami has won the ACC Regular Season Championship three times, most recently in **2016** when the Canes finished **21-7**.
- Since the beginning of the **2014** season, Miami has won **28 of its past 39 ACC series**. The Hurricanes went **8-2** in ACC series in **2014**, **7-3** in **2015**, **9-1** in **2016** and are **4-4-1** in **2017**.

• In his first season serving as closer, sophomore **Frankie Bartow** ranks **fourth** in the ACC with **11 saves**, including two vs. Pitt.

ROMY POWERING OFFENSE

• Sophomore infielder **Romy Gonzalez** leads Miami in **home runs** (11), **RBI** (35) and **slugging percentage** (.490), and ranks second in **doubles** (8) and **steals** (11).

JEB! SHINING IN YEAR 1 AT MIAMI

• Junior **Jeb Bargfeldt** has been among Miami's top performers this season in his first year as a Hurricane. He transferred to UM after spending 2015 at **Wichita State** and 2016 at **Cisco College** (TX).
 • Bargfeldt has a **team-best 2.28 ERA** and has made 13 starts, all as a member of the weekend rotation. He is holding opponents to a .195 average, allowing just 19 earned runs in 75.0 innings.

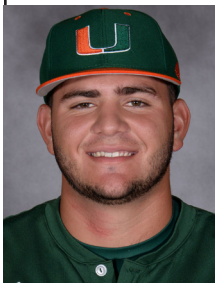
