#### **THINGS TO KNOW**

- Miami is the only ACC team with five players averaging in double-figure scoring.
- Miami was picked 10th in the 2018-19 ACC Preseason Poll but UM exceeded its predicted finish in each of Jim Larrañaga's first seven seasons.
- Ebuka Izundu leads the ACC in field-goal percentage (.693) and is fifth in rebounding (9.3).
- Anthony Lawrence II has averaged 15 points and seven rebounds in Miami's last three wins.
- Zach Johnson reached 1,500 career points with his 22-point effort Saturday (first three years at FGCU).
- DJ Vasiljevic has hit at least one 3-pointer in 25 straight games – the longest current streak in the ACC.
- Chris Lykes is 10th in the ACC in scoring (16.6).
- UM averages 8.8 3-pointers per game (third in ACC). NC State is fourth at 8.7 per game.
- Junior forward Dewan Hernandez has been withheld from competition thus far as the University and NCAA review his eligibility.

#### **BRING ON ACC PLAY**

Miami is 6-8 in ACC openers since joining the league for the 2004-05 season. UM is 5-3 at home in ACC opening games.

Miami is 4-3 in ACC openers under Jim Larrañaga.
The Canes are opening ACC play at home for the fifth time in the last six seasons.

## **CANES LOOK TO BUILD ON ACC SUCCESS**

Miami has scored 10 or more league victories in five of Jim Larrañaga's first seven years, including four straight seasons.

The Canes join Virginia, Duke and UNC as the lone teams to win 10 or more ACC games each of the last four years.

Prior to Larrañaga's arrival, Miami never had won 10 ACC games in a season.

Miami finished with 11 ACC wins last season, its third-most conference wins since joining the league in 2004-05.

#### **CHALLENGING ACC SLATE LOOMS**

Miami's ACC schedule is not for the faint of heart. Nine of UM's 18 conference games pit the Canes against teams currently ranked in the AP Top 20.

Miami and Wake Forest each play a league-high nine games against ACC teams that currently are ranked in the top 20.

The Canes' challenging conference schedule includes 11 games against teams that competed in the 2018 NCAA Tournament, including home-and-homes with Florida State, North Carolina and Virginia Tech, all of which are currently ranked in the top 15.

#### **FIRST RANKED FOE OF 2018-19 SEASON**

Miami is facing its first top-25 opponent this season. The Canes are 19-35 against ranked foes under Jim Larrañaga.

UM is 56-151 all-time against top-25 teams, including 29-66 in ACC play.

## **MIAMI-NC STATE SERIES**

NC State holds a 12-11 lead in the series, while Miami owns a 5-4 edge in Coral Gables.

UM has won the last three contests, including an 86-81 decision in the last matchup on Jan. 21, 2018, in Raleigh.

The programs' last meeting in Coral Gables was Dec. 31, 2016, an 81-63 Miami victory.

Jim Larrañaga is 7-6 against NC State in his career, including a 7-5 mark while at Miami.

## **LAST MEETING: UM 86, NC STATE 81**

Miami shot 57.6 percent from the field in pulling out an 86-81 win at NC State on Jan. 21, 2018.

Bruce Brown Jr. led Miami with 19 points and nine assists. UM's emphasis on sharing the ball was on full display, as the Hurricanes racked up a seasonhigh 26 assists on 34 field goals.

Ebuka Izundu was 7-for-7 from the field in scoring a season-high 15 points, while Anthony Lawrence II also scored 15 points.

Omar Yurtseven scored a game-high 28 points for NC State.

#### THE MAGNIFICENT SEVEN

With Dewan Hernandez unavailable, Miami has primarily played with a rotation of seven to eight players for the first 12 games.

UM currently has seven scholarship studentathletes available.

Anthony Lawrence (33.8, 6th), Chris Lykes (33.0, 8th), and DJ Vasiljevic (32.4, 11th) each rank among the ACC's top 25 in minutes played.

The rotation was shortened to seven when Deng Gak went down with a season-ending injury on Dec. 1.

## **BALANCE ON OFFENSE**

Five Miami players are averaging at least a dozen points per game apiece.

The Canes are the lone ACC team with five players averaging in double-figure scoring.

The five: Chris Lykes (16.6), Zach Johnson (13.3), Anthony Lawrence (13.3), DJ Vasiljevic (12.5) and Ebuka Izundu (12.2).

#### **IZUNDU: THE DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE**

Ebuka Izundu has stepped into a starting role this season and averaged 12.2 ppg and a team-high 9.3 rebounds per game (5.0 ppg, 3.8 rpg last season). Izundu has produced four double-doubles.

He leads the ACC in field-goal percentage (.693) and ranks third in offensive rebounds (3.3/game), fourth in blocks (2.08/game) and fifth in rebounds per game.

With 22 points and 19 rebounds against SFA, he fell one rebound shy of the first 20-rebound performance by a UM player since Reggie Johnson's 20-rebound effort against FAU on March 16, 2011.

#### **VASILJEVIC AMONG ACC 3-PT LEADERS**

DJ Vasiljevic is 35-for-81 (43.2%) from 3-point range and averaging 12.5 ppg. He ranks second in the ACC to UVA's Kyle Guy in 3-pointers per game (2.9) and total 3-pointers made. He stands seventh in 3-point field goal percentage.

He has hit at least one 3-pointer in 25 consecutive games (longest current streak in ACC). With a 3-pointer against NCSU, he would match Steven Edwards (1993) for the sixth-longest streak at Miami.

Vasiljevic led the ACC in 3-point field goal percentage last season (41.1%), becoming the fifth Hurricane to top the conference in 3-point shooting (first since Malcolm Grant in 2011).

He also is 23-for-24 at the free-throw line this year, more than his total all of last season in 32 games (16).

#### LYKES PACES OFFENSE

Chris Lykes is averaging 16.6 ppg and ranks 10th in the ACC in scoring.

He scored 20 or more points in each of the first three games this season, becoming the first UM player since Joe Wylie in 1989 to do so to begin a season.

He was the first UM player to record three straight 20-point efforts since Shane Larkin put up 20 or more points in consecutive games against Boston College, NC State and UNC in winning the 2013 ACC Tournament.

#### **MACK PROVIDING VALUABLE MINUTES**

Anthony Mack has given Miami valuable minutes off the bench in the last three games, averaging 17.3 minutes and 5.7 points per game (5-10 3FG).

He recorded six points and four boards in 17 minutes against HBU and followed it up with eight points in a season-high 21 minutes against FAU.

Mack scored five total points while playing in five of UM's first nine games.

#### **JOHNSON REACHES 1,500 POINTS**

Zach Johnson reached 1,500 career points on Saturday with his 22-point effort against Campbell.

Now with 1,504 career points (1,344 at Florida Gulf Coast, 160 at UM), Johnson is 35th nationally in career scoring among active Division I players.

He is averaging 13.3 ppg this season.

Johnson had three strong games at the Wooden Legacy, averaging a team-high 18.0 ppg en route to all-tournament team honors.

He scored a season-high 24 points in the semifinal win over Fresno State. His putback dunk with 0.6 seconds remaining provided the winning basket.

#### **NOTING THE CAMPBELL GAME**

- Miami held Chris Clemons to a season-low 19 points, 10 of which came in the game's final four minutes. He did not score in the first 13 minutes of the game.
- Clemons entered the game as the nation's leading scorer (30.5 ppg) but hit just 7-of-21 field-goal attempts.
- Miami matched a season high by shooting 54.5 percent and shot a season-best 50 percent (12-24) from 3-point range.
- UM committed 19 turnovers, one off a season high.
- Zach Johnson scored 22 points to reach the 1,500-point plateau in his career (1,504 total).
- Chris Lykes scored 21 points, one off a career high.
- DJ Vasiljevic went 1-for-3 from 3-point range, connecting from long range for the 25th straight game, which is the longest current streak in the ACC.
- It also ranks as the sixth-longest streak of games with a 3-pointer in program history.
- Miami held Campbell scoreless for 6:22 in the first half, going on a 14-0 run.

#### THE WATSCO ADVANTAGE

Miami has defended its home turf well in recent years, winning 44 of its last 50 games at the Watsco Center. The Canes are 94-26 (.783) at home under Jim Larrañaga.

Miami had its 19-game home non-conference win streak snapped on Nov. 28 in a 57-54 defeat to Rutgers. The streak dated to a 78-77 loss to Northeastern on Nov. 27, 2015.

In its 17th year at the Watsco Center (formerly BankUnited Center), Miami is 187-70 (.728) on its home court.

In eight years under Larrañaga, Miami is 44-18 in ACC action at home and 50-8 in non-conference play.

## **SUCCESS AT 70 POINTS**

Miami has eclipsed the 70-point plateau in 11 of 12 games this season. The Canes are 8-3 in those games this year.

UM went 16-3 when scoring 70-plus points last season. The Canes are 113-18 when scoring 70 or more points under Larrañaga and 48-3 when breaking the 80-point barrier.

#### **GAK OUT FOR SEASON**

Redshirt freshman forward Deng Gak will miss the remainder of the season after suffering a left-knee injury on Dec. 1 against Yale.

He had surgery Dec. 18 to repair the injured knee. He averaged 2.5 ppg and 4.1 rpg in eight games. He made his first career start against Yale and played a season-high 19 minutes in that contest.

#### **CANES TO VISIT ITALY IN AUGUST**

The UM men's basketball team will head abroad next summer as the Canes will take a foreign tour of Italy from August 9-18, 2019.

The 10-day tour will include visits to Rome, Florence and Como. The Canes are scheduled to play four exhibition games, with at least one at each stop on the trip. The opponents are yet to be determined.

Once every four years, college basketball programs are permitted to embark on a foreign tour and given 10 extra summer practices to prepare. Miami's last foreign tour was to Spain in 2014.

# CANES START SEASON AGAINST LEAGUE FAVORITES

Miami opened its season with three straight games against teams that were picked to win their respective conferences.

Lehigh was chosen as the preseason favorites in the Patriot League. Stephen F. Austin was picked to repeat as the Southland Conference champion, while Bethune-Cookman was selected as the preseason MEAC favorite.

#### MILLER JR. TO REDSHIRT

Junior center Rodney Miller Jr. will redshirt the 2018-19 season.

Miller lost 25 pounds during the offseason. He averaged 1.1 points in 3.6 minutes per game in 30 games during his first two seasons.

#### WHO'S GONE

Miami lost three players from its 2017-18 squad, each of whom started at least 18 games: Lonnie Walker IV, Bruce Brown Jr. and Ja'Quan Newton.

Walker was an Honorable Mention All-ACC pick and ACC All-Freshman Team honoree last year. He was selected 18th overall in the NBA Draft by the San Antonio Spurs.

Brown started 19 games before missing the remainder of the season with a foot injury. He was picked 42nd overall in the NBA Draft by Detroit.

Newton played in 127 career games (seventh in program history) and finished with 1,134 career points.

## **PROGRAM EARNS PERFECT GSR**

The Miami men's basketball program earned its first perfect GSR rating, coming in 19 percent above the NCAA average of 81 percent.

The GSR measures graduation rates at Division I institutions and includes students transferring into the institutions. The most recent Division I Graduation Success Rates are based on the four entering classes from 2008-09 to 2011-12

Mack is back together with Deng Gak, with whom he played two seasons at Blair Academy in New Jersey.

#### **HUELL BECOMES HERNANDEZ**

The name is unfamiliar, but Dewan Hernandez remains a familiar face for the Canes. Formerly Dewan Huell, Hernandez legally changed his last name in the offseason.

The switch was made to honor his mother. Christina Hernandez, and was officially finalized in mid-October.

#### HERNANDEZ LOOKS TO BUILD ON **BREAKOUT SOPHOMORE SEASON**

Dewan Hernandez is looking to take another step in his junior season. Last season, Hernandez more than doubled his numbers in scoring and rebounding from his freshman campaign.

Hernandez entered his name in the NBA Draft following the season but withdrew following consultations with NBA officials.

He finished second on the team in scoring at 11.4 ppg (5.6 as frosh) last year and also averaged 6.6 rebounds per game (3.1 as frosh).

A 6-foot-6 guard. Proctor played at Bishop Gorman High School in Las Vegas, where he won a pair of state championships.

He was the the 14th-ranked player in Nevada in 2017 according to 24/7 Sports and the 103rd-ranked shooting guard in the nation per 24/7.

#### **CANES SIGN TWO TO 2019-20 NLI**

Miami announced Nov. 14 the signing of Anthony Walker and Isaiah Wong to National Letters of Intent for the 2019-20 school year.

Walker and Wong each are four-star recruits who are rated among the top 100 players nationally in the latest Rivals recruiting rankings. Walker is a 6-foot-9, 210-pound power forward from Nottingham, Md., and Wong is a 6-foot-3, 170-pound guard from Trenton, N.J.

Lonnie Walker IV was chosen 18th overall by the San Antonio Spurs.

Bruce Brown Jr. was picked in the second round by Detroit with the 42nd overall pick.

Brown made his NBA debut on Opening Night with a start against Brooklyn. Walker has yet to play because of injury.


