### **QUICK NOTES**

- EKU is second in the nation in turnover margin and second in steals per game.
- Eastern cut an 18-point deficit to two in the final eight minutes, but lost 63-60 to East Tennessee on Tuesday.
- Eric Stutz became the 27th member of EKU's 500-rebound club on at IUPUI (Dec. 13).
- Corey Walden scored 20 points, grabbed seven rebounds, dished out six assists and came up with four steals at IUPUI (Dec. 13).
- Denzel Richardson finished with a careerhigh 19 points at No. 1 Kentucky.
- The Colonels were down only two at halftime, but lost at BYU, 90-76, on Nov. 29.
- Newcomer Ja'Mill Powell scored a career-best 26 points at BYU (Nov. 29).
- Corey Walden scored a career-high 33 points against Southern Utah and became the 33rd player to score 1,000 points as a Colonel.
- Eastern set a new school record for margin of victory by beating Kentucky Christian by 80.
- Corey Walden was named OVC Co-Player of the Week and Denzel Richardson was picked as the Newcomer of the Week on Nov. 17.
- Denzel Richardson recorded a double-double (11 pts, 10 rebs) in his first official game as a Colonel, against Savannah State.
- Corey Walden was chosen as a Lou Henson Preseason All-American by CollegeInsider.
- In four games against pro teams during a summer tour in Australia, Corey Walden averaged 18.3 points, 6.0 rebounds, 4.8 assists and 4.0 steals per game.

### WHAT TO WATCH FOR...

- Miami is holding its opponents to 29 percent shooting from three-point range.
   EKU averages 9.9 three's per game, but has shot only 34 percent this season.
- The Hurricanes have made 42 percent of their three-point attempts this season.
   Eastern allowed East Tennessee to shoot 44 percent (15-of-34) on Tuesday.
- Miami has allowed only two opponents to score more than 68 points this season and is allowing just 58.8 points per game. EKU has been held to 66 points or less in three of its last four games.
- The Colonels are second in the nation with an average of 12.3 steals per game and second in turnover margin (+11.2).
- Both teams shoot well from the free throw line. EKU is 10th in the nation at 76.8
  percent and Miami is 24th at 74.9 percent. However, the two teams are in the
  top-100 for fewest fouls committed.

### **UNDER 70, WE WIN - ALMOST ALWAYS**

Eastern's loss to East Tennessee on Tuesday snapped a 34-game winning streak for the Colonels when they hold their opponent under 70 points. EKU was 5-0 this season, and 16-0 last year, when holding its opponent under 70 points. The Colonels' last loss when holding its opponent to fewer than 70 points was on Dec. 16, 2012 when No. 10 Illinois earned a 66-53 victory.

### **ALLOW ME TO "ASSIST" YOU**

EKU had 17 assists on 22 made field goals against East Tennessee (Dec. 16).

### **TURNING TURNOVERS INTO POINTS**

EKU has committed 101 fewer turnovers and outscored its opponents by 118 points off turnovers (224-106) this season. Last season, the Colonels committed 215 fewer turnovers and out-scored their opponents by 287 points off turnovers (699-412). In 2012-13, Eastern committed 199 fewer turnovers than its opponents and out-scored its foes by 268 points (736-468) off turnovers.

well against teams from the Power-5 conferences (Big 10, Big 12, PAC 12, SEC, ACC).

- This year, EKU's 49 points against No. 1 Kentucky were more than Kansas and Providence scored against the Wildcat defense.
- In the 2014 NCAA Tournament, EKU led No. 2 seed Kansas by nine in the first half. The Colonels still had a lead with 8:55 remaining in the game and were down only five with 2:28 on the clock.
- During the 2013-14 season, Eastern had a 10-point lead in the first half at North Carolina State, led by six at halftime and trailed by just three with six minutes left in the game.
- During the 2012-13 season, EKU overcame a 16-point second half deficit at West Virginia and took a 2-point lead with 4:21 left in the game. The Colonels were down only three with 24 seconds to go before falling by seven.
- Eastern suffered its first loss of the 2012-13 season at No. 10 Illinois but the Colonels didn't go down easy. EKU trailed by only five at halftime. In the second half Eastern cut a 14-point deficit to four with less than 10 minutes to play. In the final five minutes the Colonels made a run to cut another 14-point deficit to eight.

### JIM LARRANAGA VS. EKU

Miami coach Jim Larranaga has only faced EKU once. While serving as the head coach at Bowling Green, Larranaga lost at Eastern, 73-59, on Dec. 19, 1987.

### **EKU IN THE NCAA RANKINGS (Dec. 16)**

In addition to being second in the nation in turnover margin, Eastern Kentucky is second in steals per game (12.3), seventh in three-point field goals per game (9.9), 10th in free throw percentage (76.8), 27th in scoring (78.1) and 45th in assists per game (15.7).

### **SERIES HISTORY**

The Colonels and Hurricanes will be meeting for the fourth time. Miami leads the series 2-1. The first

meeting came on Dec. 16, 1967 when UM won 93-87 at home. EKU won 66-61 on Nov. 30, 1991 in San Juan. The Hurricanes won the most recent game, 86-64, on Nov. 24, 1997 in Miami.

### **COLONELS VS. THE ACC**

EKU is 35-81 all-time against current members of the Atlantic Coast Conference. Seventy of those 116 games have been against Louisville. The Colonels have 22 wins against the Cardinals. Eastern also has victories over North Carolina State, Virginia, Miami, North Carolina, Syracuse, Virginia Tech and Florida State.

### **MID-MAJOR TOP 25**

Eastern Kentucky has enough votes (22) in this week's Mid-Major Top 25 to be ranked 33rd. Eastern finished the 2013-14 season ranked 19th in the Collegelnsider.com Mid-Major Top 25. The Colonels received enough votes to place 34th in the 2014-15 Preseason Poll released on Nov. 11.

### **SUMMER TRIP TO AUSTRALIA**

The Colonels took a 4-game summer trip to Australia in August. EKU won one game. Nine Colonels saw action during the trip. Corey Walden averaged 18.3

### A LOOK AT THE OPPONENT

Miami is 9-1 this season and ranked No. 18 in the AP Poll and No. 19 in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

The Hurricanes began the season with eight straight wins before falling at home to Green Bay. UM has victories at Florida and at home over Illinois.

Sheldon McClellan, a 6-foot-5 junior guard, leads the team in scoring at 16.2 points per game and has shot 58 percent from the field. The transfer from Texas is second on the team in rebounding (6.4 rpg) and assists (2.7 apg). Angel Rodriguez, a 5-foot-11 guard, is second on the team in scoring (14.2 ppg) and leads the squad in assists (4.5 apg). The transfer from Kansas State has gotten to the free throw line a team-best 46 times and is tied for the team lead with 24 three-pointers. Both McClellan and Rodriguez are in their first season playing for the Hurricanes.

Sophomore Manu Lecomte, a 5-foot-11 guard, averages 12.1 points per game and is 24-for-47 from three-point range for 51 percent.

Tonye Jekiri, a 7-foot, 244-pound junior center pulls down 9.7 rebounds per game for Miami while scoring 7.4 points per game.

As a team, the Hurricanes average 73.4 points and allow 58.8 per game. Miami is shooting 47 percent from the field and 42 percent from three-point range. UM is holding its opponents to 39 percent shooting overall and 29 percent from long distance.

EKU and Miami have both played Savannah State this season. The Colonels beat SSU 76-53 in Richmond. The Hurricanes picked up a 70-39 victory over Savannah State at home on Monday. Rodriguez had 17 points. McClellan finished with 15 points, four rebounds, three assists and two steals. Jekiri had eight points and nine rebounds.

### 80 = WIN FOR COLONELS

EKU is 2-0 this season when scoring 80 or more points. After beating Cincinnati-Clermont 115-50 (Nov. 22), the Colonels are 51-7 (.879) under Jeff Neubauer when scoring 80-plus. Eastern was 13-1 in 2013-14 and 10-1 in 2012-13 when scoring 80 or more.

### **TOP-5 OPPONENT**

After taking on No. 1 Kentucky (Dec. 7), EKU has now faced a top-10 team in three straight seasons (No. 10 Illinois in 2012-13, No. 4 Wisconsin in 2013-14). It was Eastern's third game against a top-5 opponent since 2007, when the Colonels faced No. 4 North Carolina in the NCAA Tournament on March 15.

### LAST TIME WE LOST THREE

Earlier this season, EKU suffered its first three game losing streak since November 2011.

### **TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS AT HOME**

Eastern Kentucky is 31-5 in its last 36 home games.

### C'MON MAN

Eastern Kentucky turned the ball over a season-high 21 times at IUPUI (Dec. 13). The Colonels came into that game averaging 10.6 turnovers per game and No. 1 in the nation with a  $\pm$ 13.9 turnover margin.

### GOOD, GOOD, GOOD, GOOD

The Colonels shot 55.3 percent from the field against IUPUI (Dec. 13). Their 41 percent shooting on three-point attempts was their best performance from long range against a Division I opponent this season. Eastern also made 70 percent of its shots from INSIDE the arc against the Jaguars.

### **DEFENDING THE TREY**

The Colonels held No. 1 Kentucky (Dec. 7) to 23.1 percent shooting from three-point range. The top-ranked Wildcats made just 3-of-13 from deep.

### **BETTER THAN KANSAS**

Eastern's 49 points at No. 1 Kentucky (Dec. 7) were the fourth most allowed by the Wildcats at the time. The Colonels scored more against UK than Kansas (40) and Providence (38).

### **CLOSER LOOK AT THE BOARDS**

EKU was out-rebounded by 20 at No. 1 Kentucky, but that was more of a product of shooting 26 percent from the field. The Colonels limited the much taller Wildcats to just 10 offensive rebounds. Eastern grabbed 14 offensive rebounds of their own, which tied for its second highest total of the season.

### 2ND STRAIGHT TOP-25 FOE

Valparaiso (Dec. 3) was EKU's second straight opponent to be ranked in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top-25. The Crusaders were No. 14 (Dec. 1). BYU was No. 3 when it played the Colonels.

### 12TH LONGEST WIN STREAK ENDS

Eastern was tied for the 12th longest home court non-conference winning streak in the nation at 25 straight games before falling to Valparaiso (Dec. 3).

#### **FAST START**

Since the start of the 2012-13 season, Eastern Kentucky is 16-3 in the month of November.

### **MID-MAJOR TOP-5 TEAM**

BYU was ranked third in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top-25 when they beat the Colonels.

### **MOST POINTS BY A NEUBAUER SQUAD**

Eastern Kentucky's 115 points against Kentucky Christian (Nov. 18) and Cincinnati-Clermont (Nov. 22) are the most-ever by a Jeff Neubauer coached team. The previous scoring high was 114 against Warren Wilson (Nov. 13, 2013).

### **FEWEST TURNOVERS SINCE...**

Eastern's four turnovers against Cincinnati-Clermont (Nov. 22) were the fewest in one game since turning it over four times against Brescia on Dec. 3, 2011.

### **SCHOOL RECORD 80-POINT MARGIN**

EKU's 115-35 win over Kentucky Christian (Nov. 18) set a new program record for margin of victory (80 points). The previous record was 73 points set against Wilberforce on Dec. 1, 1990.

### MORE TURNOVERS THAN POINTS

Kentucky Christian had more turnovers (36) than points (35) against the Colonels on Nov. 18. EKU outscored the Knights 56-4 off turnovers.

### **MOST TURNOVERS SINCE...**

Kentucky Christian's 36 turnovers against EKU on Nov. 18 were the most by an opponent since Crowley's Ridge (Feb. 5, 2013) turned it over 36 times as well.

### SIX OR MORE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Against Kentucky Christian (Nov. 18), six or more Colonels scored in double figures for the first time since six players did it against Crowley's Ridge on Feb. 5, 2013. Seven Colonels reached 10 or more points against the Knights.

The Colonels 19.2 percent (5-for-26) three-point shooting against Savannah State (Nov. 14) was its lowest from long range since shooting 11.1 percent (3-for-27) at home against SIU Edwardsville on Feb. 23, 2012.

### **BANNER #9**

Eastern Kentucky unveiled its 2014 Ohio Valley Conference Tournament Championship banner in a ceremony before its game against Savannah State (Nov. 14). It is the ninth men's basketball banner raised to the wall in McBrayer Arena.

### **SEASON OPENERS/HOME OPENERS**

EKU has won its season-opener each of the last three years. The Colonels have won 17 straight homeopeners starting with the 1998-99 season.

### **COLONELS TAKE KANSAS TO THE WIRE**

Eastern Kentucky led No. 2 seed Kansas by nine in the first half of its second round NCAA Tournament game in March. The Colonels still had a lead with 8:55 remaining in the game and were down only three with 3:39 on the clock.

### **LEADING KANSAS**

EKU led No. 2 seed Kansas for more than half the game (21:28) in the NCAA Tournament.

### **BACK-TO-BACK POSTSEASON TRIPS**

Eastern Kentucky has earned consecutive bids to national postseason tournaments for the first time in program history. Eastern played in the CollegeInsider. com Tournament in 2013 and the NCAA Tournament in 2014.

### **EXHIBITON RECAP**

In its only exhibition game, Eastern Kentucky beat Urbana, 96-81. The Colonels shot 53 percent from the floor, including 43 percent from behind the arc. EKU committed seven fewer turnovers and out-scored Urbana 23-12 off turnovers. Despite getting out-rebounded by eight, Eastern out-scored the Blue Knights 32-18 in the paint. Urbana pulled down 16 offensive rebounds.

### **OVC PRESEASON PICKS**

EKU was picked to finish third this season in the Ohio Valley Conference East Division. Corey Walden was selected to the 10-member preseason All-OVC team.

Eastern earned four first-place votes and a total of 102 points. Belmont garnered 16 first-place votes and 125 points to take the top spot in the East. Morehead State (103), with four first place votes, earned one more point than EKU for the second spot. Murray State is the preseason favorite to win the West Division and the overall title.

### **COLONELS ON TV IN 2014-15**

At least four Eastern Kentucky games will air live on the national television during the 2014-15 season.

EKU's game at preseason No. 1 Kentucky will be shown on the SEC Network.

Three Ohio Valley Conference regular season games were will air live on ESPNU beginning with Eastern's game at Murray State on Jan. 29. Two home games -- versus Belmont on Feb. 5 and Morehead State Feb. 11 -- will also be shown on ESPNU.

One more contest will be shown on ESPN3. Eastern's games at Miami (Fla.) on Dec. 19 will air on the web based network.

### TWO WILL JOIN TEAM NEXT SEASON

Two players signed in November to play for the Colonels next season. Nick Mayo is a 6-foot-8 high school senior from Maine. Paul Jones is a 6-foot-7 sophomore forward at Palm Beach State College.

### **WINNING BY 3 POINTS OR LESS**

After beating Murray State (March 7), 86-83, in the OVC semifinals, Eastern Kentucky is now 26-15 under head coach Jeff Neubauer in games decided by three or less

### 2ND IN NATION IN TURNOVER MARGIN

In the final 2013-14 NCAA statistical rankings, Eastern finished second in the nation in turnover margin (+6.3). Louisville led the nation at +6.7.

### **THREE-POINT LEADERS**

After finishing first in the OVC in 2013-14 with an average of 9.3 three-pointers per game, Eastern Kentucky has led the conference in 3-pointers five of the last six years.

### **EKU IN THE RPI**

EKU was ranked 95th in the final release of the NCAA RPI (April 23). Eastern had the second highest RPI in the OVC. The Colonels won two of three meetings with Belmont (48). EKU split a pair of meetings with Murray State (101), the next highest OVC team.

### 2013-14 Team Achievements

#### **8TH NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCE**

Eastern Kentucky made its eighth NCAA Tournament appearance and first since 2007.

#### SIXTH OVC TOURNAMENT TITLE

The Colonels won the program's sixth Ohio Valley Conference Tournament Championship with a 79-73 win over No. 1 seed Belmont (March 8). EKU has the third most conference tournament titles in the OVC.

### **2ND MOST WINS EVER**

Eastern Kentucky's 24 wins in 2013-14 are the second most wins ever in one season for the program. The school record of 25 was set last year.

### **BEST 4-YEAR STRETCH, YES**

With its 24th win of 2013-14, against Belmont (March 8) in the OVC Tournament finals, the Colonels set a new record for the winningest 4-year stretch in program history. The previous best was 79 wins from 1944-48. EKU has 80 victories over the last four seasons.

### **BEST 3-YEAR STRETCH, YES**

With its 22nd win of 2013-14, against Southeast Missouri (March 6) in the OVC Tournament quarterfinals, EKU set a new record for the winningest 3-year stretch in program history. The previous best was 62 wins from 1944-47. EKU has 65 victories over the last three seasons.

### **CONSISTENT TOURNAMENT PARTICIPANT**

Eastern made its 12th straight OVC tournament appearance. EKU and Murray State are the only two teams to earn spots in each of the last 12 conference tourneys.

### **NINTH-EVER 20-WIN SEASON**

With a 74-67 win over Tennessee Tech (Feb. 27) Eastern secured the program's ninth 20-win campaign.

### **BEST 2-YEAR STRETCH - 43RD WIN**

With their 18th win of the season (at Jacksonville State, Feb. 15) and 43rd over the last two seasons, the Colonels broke the record for the winningest 2-year stretch in program history. EKU won 42 games combined in 1945-46 and 1946-47.

### **HOME NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS**

With their win over Chattanooga (Feb. 4), the Colonels set a new program record with their 22nd straight home non-conference win. EKU stands at 44-7 (.863) in home non-conference games under head coach Jeff Neubauer. The program record of 21 straight was set from 1977-78 to 1980-81.

### AT LEAST 10 TURNOVERS IN EVERY GAME

Eastern Kentucky's opponents had at least 10 turnovers in every game last season. EKU's foes turned the ball over 14 or more times in 26 of 34 games, including Kansas (14) in the NCAA Tournament.

### **PROTECTING THE BALL**

In 12 of its 34 games last season, EKU had fewer than 10 turnovers, including seven against Kansas in the NCAA Tourney.

# 2014 Australia Summer Trip

In August, the Colonels traveled to the Land Down Under for a four-game summer trip. EKU played in four cities — Sydney, Wollongong, Brisbane and Cairns. NCAA rules allow teams a maximum of 10 days of practice before leaving for a foreign trip.

Eleven players made the trip, including three newcomers. Senior Deverin Muff and junior college transfer Ja'Mill Powell did not play because of injuries.

The trip included a 16-hour flight from Dallas to Brisbane and another 16-hour flight from Sydney to Dallas on the way home.

The Colonels faced the Sydney Kings, the Wollongong Hawks, the Suncoast Clippers and the Cairns Taipans. The Kings, Hawks and Taipans are professional teams playing in Australia's National Basketball League (NBL). The Clippers play in the Queensland Basketball League (QBL).

In the four games combined, Eastern had 29 more steals, committed 37 fewer turnovers and out-scored its opponents by 29 points off turnovers.

#### GAME 1

In its first game, Eastern Kentucky lost 76-65 to Sydney. The Colonels overcame a 7-point halftime deficit to take a 43-42 lead in the third quarter. However, the Kings rolled off 11 unanswered and never trailed again.

Corey Walden tied for the game-high with 20 points. He also had nine rebounds, six assists and two steals. Jaylen Babb-Harrison scored 16 points while Eric Stutz contributed 11 points and seven rebounds.

Eastern Kentucky shot only 31 percent (22-of-70) from the field. The Colonels made just 2-of-16 from behind the three-point line in the first half (13 percent) and finished 7-for-37 (19 percent) from deep. As it has done for most of the past two seasons, EKU committed fewer turnovers (24-15), but the visitors were out-scored 40-20 in the paint.

#### **GAME 2**

EKU overcame an 11-point fourth quarter deficit, but fell to Wollongong, 106-99, in overtime in its second game of the tour.

Babb-Harrison's driving lay-up in the closing seconds tied the score and sent the game to overtime. Wollongong seized control in the extra period by scoring six of the first eight points.

The lead changed hands 26 times in the game and the score was tied 15 times.

Walden finished with 28 points, eight steals, three rebounds and two assists. He made 11-of-21 from the field (52 percent). Timmy Knipp finished with 19 points, four rebounds and three assists. Stutz contributed 11 points, seven assists, seven rebounds and two blocks.

EKU was out-rebounded by 24, but forced 34 turnovers off 19 steals. The Colonels attempted 27 more shots than the Hawks. Despite being out-rebounded, Eastern was only out-scored in the paint by six. The Colonels shot 42 percent from the field, 28 percent from three-point range (11-of-40) and 90 percent at the charity stripe (18-of-20).

### **GAME 3**

A 12-0 run to end the second quarter propelled Eastern Kentucky to a 125-91 victory over Suncoast.

The Colonels never trailed and the game was tied just three times. All nine players that played scored in double figures, eight had at least one rebound and seven dished out at least one assist.

Babb-Harrison led all players with 21 points. Knipp finished with 17 points, six rebounds, four assists, two steals and two blocks. He hit 5-of-9 from the field, including 4-of-8 from behind the three-point line.

Isaac McGlone accounted for six of EKU's points during the big run with a pair of threepointers. Babb-Harrison's two free throws sent the Colonels to the locker room leading 69-46.

EKU shot 56 percent from the field, including 46 percent from deep. The Colonels made 21-of-46 attempts from behind the arc. More than half of the teams 80 field goal attempts came from three-point land. Eastern committed just 12 turnovers, compared to 24 for Suncoast.

Walden finished the night with 13 points, six assists, five rebounds and three steals. Stutz contributed 14 points, six rebounds, four assists, two steals and two blocks.

Robbie Stenzel (14), McGlone (13), Norl (13), Paul Jackson (10) and Matthews (10) also scored in double figures. Jackson, a freshman, hit 4-of-5 from the field, dished out five assists and grabbed four boards.

#### **GAME 4**

Eastern Kentucky lost 77-75 to Cairns in its final game. Knipp led all players with 21 points. Stutz finished with 17 points. Walden contributed 12 points, seven rebounds and five assists.

With the game tied 60-60 early in the fourth quarter, Cairns went on a 7-1 run to build a cushion. After a pair of free throws, the Taipans had a seven-point lead late in the quarter. However, Knipp scored five straight to get the Colonels back within two. Cairns hit two more free throws before Walden took it the length of the floor and laid it in with about four seconds remaining to keep the margin at two. EKU fouled and the Taipans missed both free throws, but a shot for the win at the buzzer missed.

In its first three games in Australia, Eastern had committed an average of 12 fewer turnovers per game than its opponents. In this game both teams finished with 18 turnovers.

Eastern Kentucky scored the first five points of the second quarter to take a 10 point lead, its largest of the game. The Colonels took a 44-38 lead into the locker room at the half.

EKU shot 43 percent from the field and 34 percent from three-point range. The Taipans hit on 45 percent of their shots but were just 3-of-19 from deep for 16 percent.

Eric Stutz became the 27th player in school history to register 500 career rebounds when he grabbed an offensive rebound with 4:24 left in the game against IUPUI (Dec. 13).

### STUTZ AMONG NATION'S BEST SHOOTERS

Eric Stutz has the 19th best field goal percentage (61.5 percent) and the 22nd-best free throw percentage (91.3 percent) in the nation.

#### **CAREER MILESTONES**

Eric Stutz needs 57 more points to become the 13th player in program history to score 1,000 points and grab 500 rebounds.

### **BACK WITH A VENGEANCE**

After missing a game with an injury, senior Eric Stutz made his return to the court at IUPUI (Dec. 13) and finished with 17 points, five rebounds, two steals and one block.

### **DRAINING THE THREE**

Eric Stutz hit his third 3-pointer of the season against Valparaiso (Dec. 3) and attempted a career-high three 3-point field goals.

### **CHARGE TAKER**

Eric Stutz has taken nine charges this season, including two in each of EKU's four games.

#### **GRABBING THE BOARDS**

Stutz pulled down 11 rebounds against Southern Utah (Nov. 26), one short of tying his career-best.

### PERFECT NIGHT FOR THE SENIOR

Stutz was perfect from the field (10-for-10), the three-point line (1-for-1) and the free throw line (2-for-2) on his way to scoring a career-best 23 points against Cincinnati-Clermont (Nov. 22). He also had six rebounds, three assists and two blocks. Stutz previous career-high of 22 points happened twice – versus Brescia on Dec. 3, 2011 and against Southeast Missouri in the guarterfinals of the OVC Tournament on March 7, 2013.

### **LAND DOWN UNDER**

Started all four games during Eastern's summer tour in Australia . . . averaged 13.3 points, 5.8 rebounds, 3.3 assists, 2.3 steals and 1.8 blocks per game ... shot 51 percent from the field and 79 percent from the free throw line ... had 13 assists and only eight turnovers ... scored in double figures in all four games ... finished with 11 points, seven rebounds, seven assists and two blocks against the Wollongong Hawks (Aug. 10) ... had 14 points, six rebounds, four steals, three assists and two blocks in a win over the Suncoast Clippers (Aug. 11).

#### **3RD BEST SHOOTING PERCENTAGE EVER**

Stutz made 65.1 percent (110-of-169) of his shots from the field in 2013-14. That percentage is the third best in EKU history. Tyrone Howard (1986-87) owns the record of 67.8 percent and Alonzo Hird (2004-05) is second at 65.7 percent.

#### THIRD IN OVC IN SHOOTING

Stutz ranked third in the Ohio Valley Conference in 2013-14 in shooting (65.1 percent).

### FIRST THREE-POINTER OF THE SEASON

Stutz hit his first and only three-pointer of the 2013-14 season against No. 2 seed Kansas in the NCAA Tournament. His trey at the 18:49 mark of the second half brought Eastern to within one, 36-35.

### FOURTH CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR STUTZ

Stutz recorded his fourth career double-double at Belmont (Jan. 25, 2014). He finished with 14 points and 11 rebounds. His six offensive rebounds in the game were a career-best.

Not many college basketball players get the chance to play for a program that averages a postseason trip every two years, but that is what EKU players have experienced under head coach Jeff Neubauer.

The Colonels have made four trips to national postseason tournaments in Neubauer's nine seasons as head coach. This past March, Eastern nearly upset No. 2 seed Kansas in the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

EKU led the Jayhawks by nine in the first half and still had the lead with 8:55 left in the game. The Colonels trailed by only three with 3:39 on the clock. Eastern held the lead for more than half the game.

In Eastern Kentucky's 93 seasons of basketball before Neubauer became the head coach, the team made only seven appearances in national postseason tournaments. The Colonels have now made four trips in the past nine seasons, including back-to-back appearances for the first time (2012-13 and 2013-14).

The past four seasons have been like none other. Eastern Kentucky's 80 victories the last four years are the most during any four-year period in school history. The Colonels also set records this past season for winningest 3-year and 2-year stretches. EKU won a school-record 25 games in 2012-13 and with 24 more wins in 2013-14 the team has 49 victories in the past two seasons.

Before giving Kansas all it could handle in the NCAA Tournament, Neubauer led the Colonels on a methodical march through the Ohio Valley Conference tourney. Eastern won three games in three days and trailed for only 41 seconds during the entire tournament.

EKU finished second in the nation in turnover margin, fifth in three-point field goals per game and sixth in steals. With a win over Chattanooga on Feb. 4, the Colonels set a program mark with their 22nd straight home court non-conference victory. EKU is 44-7 (.863) in home nonconference games under Neubauer.

In recognition of a spectacular season, Neubauer was one of 15 finalists for the 2014 Hugh Durham Award, which is given annually to the nation's top mid-major coach.

In addition to the team's accomplishments in 2013-14, a number of individuals posted outstanding seasons under Neubauer's guidance. Marcus Lewis won the Denny's Slam Dunk Championship at the 2014 Final Four. Corey Walden was the OVC Tournament MVP, the 2014 OVC Defensive Player of the Year and selected as a Lefty Driesell Defensive All-American. Glenn Cosey was chosen as a Lou Henson All-American and first team all-conference. Cosey broke the school record for three-pointers in a game and the mark for three's in a season. His 35-foot three-pointer to beat Southeast Missouri earned the No. 1 spot on SportsCenter's Top-10 Plays.

Neubauer's 2012-13 team finished 25-10 and earned a spot in the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT). Eastern finished with three more wins than the previous program-best of 22, including the program's first victory in a national postseason tournament game in 68 years. The 69-62 victory over Garner-Webb in the first round of the CIT was Eastern's first tournament win since 1945.

The Colonels were picked to finish fifth in the six-team Ohio Valley Conference East Division, but entered the final day of the regular season with a chance to claim a share of the conference championship. EKU finished with the second best record in the OVC at 12-4.

At the end of the season, Neubauer was chosen as the 2013 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 19 Coach of the Year.

Eastern Kentucky started the season with nine straight wins. It was the program's best start in 66 years. Neubauer's Colonels were the last remaining unbeaten mid-major team and one of the final nine undefeated teams in the nation. EKU's 9-game winning streak tied for the fifth longest in school history.

The Colonels went 15-1 at home in 2012-13, tying the school mark for most home wins in a season. Eastern Kentucky also played well on the road. Neubauer led the team to a program record nine road wins.

With 167 victories in nine seasons on the EKU bench, Neubauer now trails only Paul McBrayer on Eastern's all-time wins list. He will enter the 2014-15 season 47 wins away from tying McBrayer. Neubauer is the only coach in program history to lead his teams to four 20-win seasons. He has won 58 percent (167-122) of his games as head coach.

Over the last two seasons, Eastern has recorded its two best RPI rankings in the modern era (69th and 95th).

Before arriving at Eastern Kentucky, Neubauer served three seasons as the top assistant at West Virginia under head coach John Beilein where he helped fuel the Mountaineers' rapid rise to national prominence.

He is married to the former Karen Feret of Hackettstown, N.J.


