

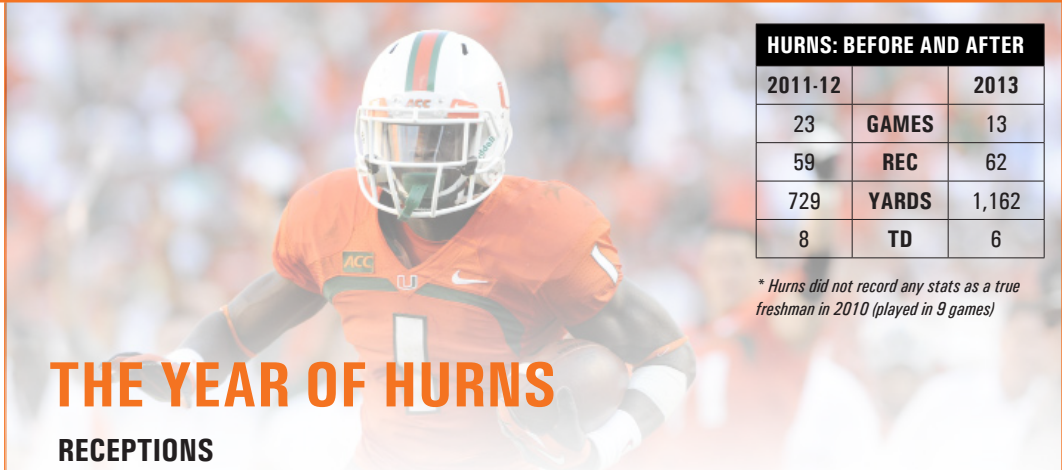

## #6THINGS

- 1 Senior WR **Allen Hurns** set the Miami single-season receiving yards record with 1,162 yards – only the fourth 1,000-yard receiving season in program history.
- 2 Miami is 11-4 in its last 15 games under head coach **Al Golden** (started 11-11).
- 3 Freshman **Stacy Coley** finished the 2013 season as the only FBS player this season to record a TD by rushing, receiving, punt return and kick return.
- 4 Senior **Stephen Morris** finished the 2013 season as the only QB in FBS with a pass of 50+ yards in nine difference games this season. Morris also led the FBS with 3 passes of 80+ yards this season.
- 5 Five Miami Hurricanes have been invited to the 2014 NFL Scouting Combine in February – **Stephen Morris, Brandon Linder, Seantrel Henderson, Allen Hurns** and **Pat O'Donnell**.
- 6 Miami's six home wins in 2013 were the most in the Sun Life Stadium era and its most home wins since 2003.

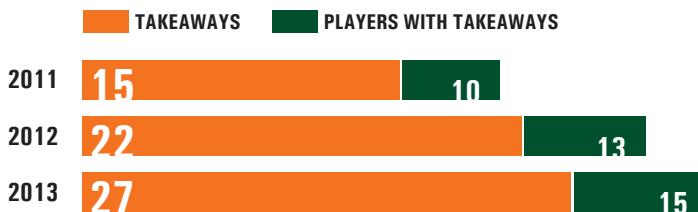

## DEFENSIVE IMPROVEMENTS

### SCORING DEFENSE

- Miami gave up 3.7 fewer points per game, moving up 17 spots in the national rankings from 2012.  
2012 = 30.5  
2013 = 26.8 (66th nationally)

### RUSHING DEFENSE

- Miami gave up 42 fewer yards per game on the ground, moving up 36 spots in the national rankings from 2012.  
2012 = 218 yards / game  
2013 = 176 yards / game (78th nationally)

### OPPONENT 1ST DOWNS

- Miami gave up four fewer first downs per game, moving up 30 spots in the national rankings from 2012.  
2012 = 26  
2013 = 22 (92nd nationally)

### INTERCEPTIONS

- Miami had seven more interceptions, moving up 52 spots nationally.  
2012 = 11  
2013 = 18 (13th nationally / 3rd in ACC)

### FORCED FUMBLES

- Miami forced two more fumbles, moving up 25 spots nationally.  
2012 = 13  
2013 = 15 (16th nationally / 5th in ACC)

### TAKEAWAYS

- Miami took the ball away five more times in 2013, moving up 40 spots in the national rankings and five spots in the ACC.  
2012 = 22  
2013 = 27 (18th nationally / 2nd in ACC)

### RED ZONE SCORING PERCENTAGE

- Miami decreased its red zone scoring defense by five percent, moving up 52 spots in the national rankings.  
2012 = 85%  
2013 = 80% (37th nationally / 5th in ACC)

### RED ZONE TOUCHDOWN PERCENTAGE

- Miami decreased its red zone touchdown percentage defense by six percent, moving up 36 spots nationally and five spots in the ACC.  
2012 = 60%  
2013 = 54% (29th nationally / 3rd in ACC)

### YARDS PER RUSH

- Miami decreased its yards per rush allowed by 0.6 yards per game, moving up 21 spots in the national rankings.  
2012 = 4.97  
2013 = 4.40 (77th nationally)

### YARDS PER PLAY

- Miami decreased its yards per play allowed by 0.36, moving up 17 spots.  
2012 = 6.11  
2013 = 5.75 (80th nationally / 12th in ACC)

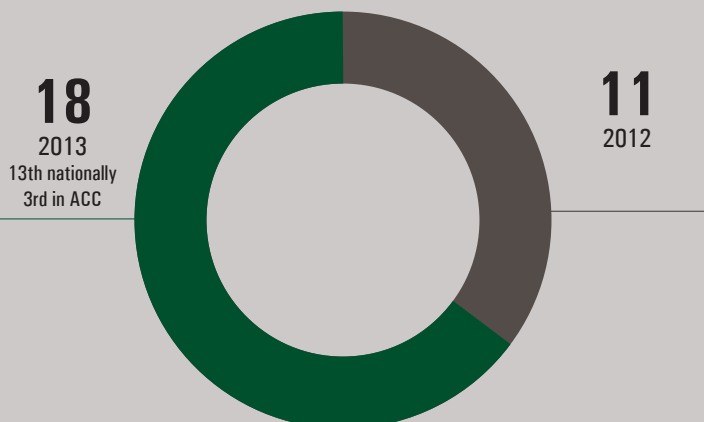
- Miami's defense scored four touchdowns in 2013 (two INT, two fumble returns), an improvement of three scores from 2012 (one INT).

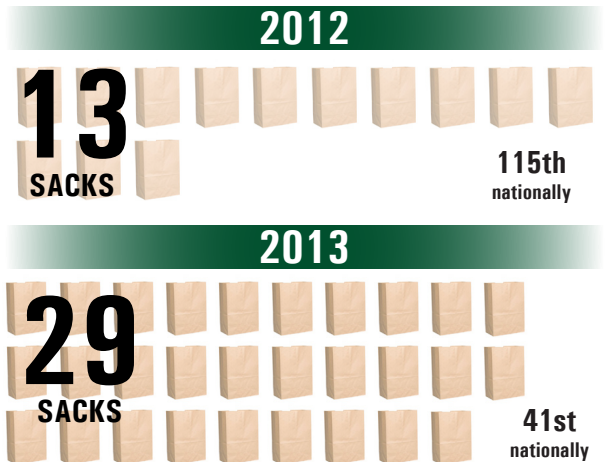

## INTERCEPTIONS

Miami had seven more interceptions in 2013, moving up 52 spots in the national rankings.



Miami sacked the opposing QB 16 more times in 2013, moving up 74 spots in the national rankings.



## OFFENSIVE IMPROVEMENTS

### POINTS PER GAME

- Miami averaged 2.4 more points per game in 2013, moving up 15 spots nationally and two spots in the ACC.  
2012 = 31.4 (49th nationally, 6th in ACC)  
2013 = 33.8 (34th nationally, 4th in ACC)

### TOTAL TOUCHDOWNS

- Miami scored 12 more TDs in 2013, moving up 36 spots nationally and two spots in the ACC.  
2012 = 45 (67th nationally, 7th in ACC)  
2013 = 57 (31st nationally, 5th in ACC)

### YARDS PER PLAY

- Miami moved up seven spots in the nationally ranks and jumped to 2nd overall in the ACC.  
2012 = 6.45 yards per play (18th nationally, 3rd in ACC)  
2013 = 6.75 yards per play (11th nationally, 2nd in ACC)

### 30+ YARD PLAYS FROM SCRIMMAGE

- Miami has 12 more plays of 30+ yards in 2013, moving up 24 spots nationally and four spots in ACC.  
2012 = 32 (26th nationally, 5th in ACC)  
2013 = 44 (2nd nationally, 1st in ACC)

### 20+ YARD PLAYS FROM SCRIMMAGE

- Miami had nine more plays of 20+ yards in 2013, moving up 14 spots nationally and two spots in the ACC.  
2012 = 63 (40th nationally, 5th in ACC)  
2013 = 72 (26th nationally, 3rd in ACC)

### RUSHING YARDS PER GAME

- Miami averaged nearly 16 more yards per game rushing in 2013, moving up 10 spots nationally.  
2012 = 144.75 yards rushing per game (83rd nationally)  
2013 = 160.3 yards rushing per game (73rd nationally)

### RUSHING YARDS PER ATTEMPT

- Miami averaged 0.1 more yards per attempt rushing in 2013, moving up six spots nationally.  
2012 = 4.68 yards per rush attempt (42nd nationally)  
2013 = 4.78 yards per rush attempt (36th nationally)

### RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS

- Miami had six more rushing TDs in 2013, moving up 18 spots nationally.  
2012 = 19 TDs rushing (64th nationally / 5th in ACC)  
2013 = 25 TDs rushing (46th nationally / 4th in ACC)

### 10+ YARD RUNS

- Miami had 22 more runs of 10+ yards in 2013, moving up 44 spots nationally.  
2012 = 49 (93rd nationally / 7th in ACC)  
2013 = 71 (49th nationally / 5th in ACC)

### 20+ YARD RUNS

- Miami had four more runs of 20+ yards in 2013, moving up 21 spots nationally.  
2012 = 11 (91st nationally)  
2013 = 15 (70th nationally)

### THIRD DOWN RUSHING

- Miami averaged 2.6 yards more per rush on 3rd down, moving up 72 spots nationally and six spots in the ACC.  
2012 = 2.3 yards per rush (95th nationally / 9th in ACC)  
2013 = 4.9 yards per rush (23rd nationally / 3rd in ACC)

### YARDS PER PASS ATTEMPT

- Miami averaged 1.1 more yards per attempt, improving 15 spots nationally and two spots in the ACC.  
2012 = 7.9 yards per attempt (25th nationally / 4th in ACC)  
2013 = 9.0 yards per attempt (10th nationally / 2nd in ACC)

### PASSING TOUCHDOWNS

- Miami threw two more passing TDs in 2013, moving up 17 spots nationally and one spot in the ACC.  
2012 = 23 (53rd nationally / 6th in ACC)  
2013 = 25 (36th nationally / 5th in ACC)

### 20+ YARD PASSES

- Miami had five more 20+ yard passes in 2013, moving up five spots nationally and one spot in the ACC.  
2012 = 52 (20th nationally / 3rd in ACC)  
2013 = 57 (15th nationally / 2nd in ACC)

### 30+ YARD PASSES

- Miami had 11 more 30+ yard passes in 2013, moving up 12 spots nationally and one spot in the ACC.  
2012 = 25 (15th nationally / 2nd in ACC)  
2013 = 36 (3rd nationally / 1st in ACC)

### 80+ YARD RUNS

- Miami had the most 80+ yard passes in the nation, two more than in 2012.  
2012 = 1  
2013 = 3 (1st nationally)

### SACKS ALLOWED

- Miami allowed one less sack in 2013, moving up four spots nationally and one spot in the ACC.  
2012 = 18 (27th nationally / 3rd in ACC)  
2013 = 17 (23rd nationally / 2nd in ACC)

### RED ZONE TOUCHDOWNS

- Miami had six more red zone TDs, moving up 24 spots nationally and one spot in the ACC.  
2012 = 27 (72nd nationally / 6th in ACC)  
2013 = 33 (48th nationally / 5th in ACC)

### RED ZONE TOUCHDOWN PERCENTAGE

- Miami improved its red zone TD percentage by eight percent in 2013, moving up 16 spots nationally.  
2012 = 52% (97th nationally / 10th in ACC)  
2013 = 60% (73rd nationally / 9th in ACC)

### RUSHING TOUCHDOWNS IN RED ZONE

- Miami had eight more rushing TDs in 2013, moving up 36 spots nationally and three spots in the ACC.  
2012 = 14 (75th nationally / 7th in ACC)  
2013 = 22 (39th nationally / 4th in ACC)

## SPECIAL TEAMS SUCCESS

### KICKOFF RETURNS

- Miami averaged 25.08 yards per return, ranking seventh nationally and 2nd in the ACC (0.88 behind Florida State).
- Miami's **KOR average is the fourth highest in school history.**
- Eight different players returned a kickoff in 2013 – **Stacy Coley, Duke Johnson, Phillip Dorsett, Herb Waters, Artie Burns, Malcolm Lewis, Jamal Carter and Corn Elder.**
- **Stacy Coley** was the first UM player since **Devin Hester** in 2004 to return a kickoff and punt in the same season. He averaged 22.0 yards per punt return and 26.0 yards per kick return.
- **Duke Johnson** averaged 28.29 yards per kick return before suffering a season-ending injury. **Artie Burns** averaged 26.1 yards per kick return.

### PUNT RETURNS

- Miami averaged 11.30 yards per return, ranking 30th nationally and 3rd in ACC behind only UNC and Duke.

### BLOCKED KICKS

- Miami blocked two kicks (one FG, one PAT) – including one returned for a touchdown. It was the most blocks by Miami in the last seven seasons.
- **Artie Burns** blocked the FG, while **Olsen Pierre** blocked a PAT.
- **Dallas Crawford** and **Tyriq McCord** also blocked a punt.
- Miami's four combined kicks blocked were tied for 10th nationally in 2013.
- It was the most combined blocked kicks at Miami in more than 10 years.

### KICKOFFS

- Miami's average kickoff return allowed was 19.83 yards per return – ranking 34th nationally and 4th in the ACC. Opponents' average starting field position was the 20-yard line.

### PUNTING

- Miami averaged 39.30 net yards per punt, ranking 20th nationally and 2nd in the ACC.
- Miami averaged 46.26 yards per punt in 2013, setting a new single-season school record. Miami ranked 4th nationally and 1st in the ACC.

### FIELD GOALS

- Miami was 13-of-17 on field goal attempts in 2013, including a career-long 49-yarder by **Matt Goudis**. Goudis ended the season with seven straight made FGs.

### PATs

- **Matt Goudis** was a perfect 57-of-57 on PATs in 2013, making a single-season school-record 57 consecutive PATs.

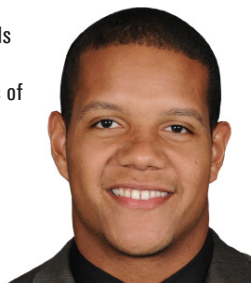

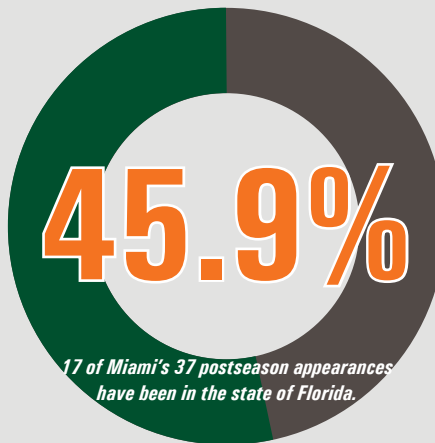
Senior **Stephen Morris** is the only FBS QB this season to complete a pass of 50+ yards in **nine different games**.

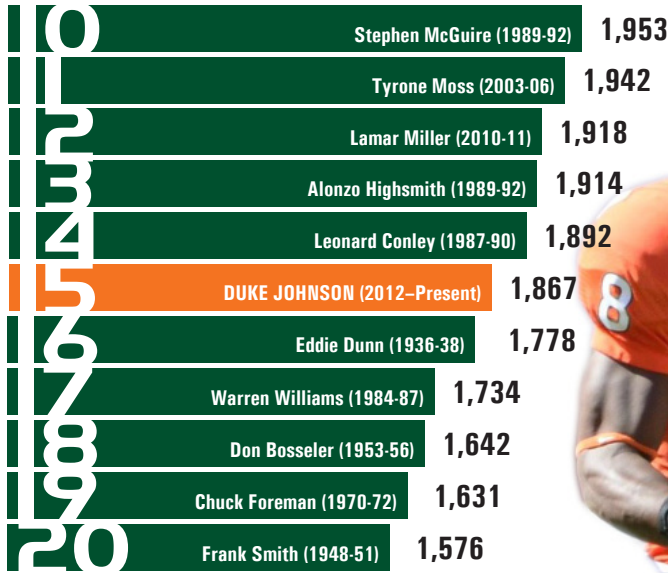

## FIVE CANES INVITED TO NFL COMBINE

- Five Miami Hurricanes have accepted invitations to participate at the 2014 NFL Scouting Combine, while will be held Feb. 22-25 at Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis. The four-day combine will be televised live on NFL Network.
- QB **Stephen Morris**, OG **Brandon Linder**, OT **Seantrel Henderson**, WR **Allen Hurns** and P **Pat O'Donnell** will be among the more than 300 prospects evaluated by all 32 NFL teams. Linder, Henderson and O'Donnell will work out on Feb. 22, while Morris and Hurns will work out Feb. 23.
- Morris, a two-year starter under center and a 2013 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team member, finished his career ranked third in Miami history with 7,896 passing yards and 49 touchdowns. A 2013 All-ACC third-team selection, Morris is one of only two QBs in Miami history with multiple 3,000-yard passing seasons (Gino Torretta).
- Linder started all 13 games along the offensive line in 2013 and concluded his career with 37 consecutive starters. He was a second-team All-ACC selection and was named the team's Offensive MVP at the end of the season. Henderson, a third-team All-ACC selection, played in 12 games along the offensive line, making eight starts at right tackle.
- Hurns enjoyed one of the greatest receiving seasons in program history in 2013. The second-team All-ACC receiver set a single-season school record with 1,162 receiving yards and finished with 62 receptions – the third-most in a single season. He finished his career ranked seventh in both receptions (121) and receiving yards (1,891).
- In his one season in Coral Gables, O'Donnell made a considerable impact, setting the school single-season record with a 47.1 yards-per-punt average. O'Donnell booted 23 punts of 50+ yards and downed 19 inside the opponent's 20-yard line.
- In last two years, Miami has had **SEVEN** NFL Combine invites – 5 on offense, 1 on defense and 1 on special teams.

## NINE CANES NAMED ALL-ACC

- Nine Miami Hurricanes were selected to the 2013 All-ACC Football team by the league's 14 head coaches. Miami's first- and second-team All-ACC selections mirrored those selections made by ACSMA.
- Junior LB **Denzel Perryman** and graduate P **Pat O'Donnell** were both named to the first team. Sophomore RB **Duke Johnson**, senior WR **Allen Hurns** and senior OG **Brandon Linder** were named to the second team.
- Senior QB **Stephen Morris**, a third-team All-ACC selection by ACSMA, was named to the coaches' All-ACC third team and was joined by senior OT **Seantrel Henderson**, junior C **Shane McDermott** and freshman specialist **Stacy Coley**. Henderson, McDermott and Coley were All-ACC honorable mention by ACSMA.

- Miami Hurricanes head coach **Al Golden** was presented with the 2013 Lombardi Award for Excellence in Coaching in December night at the 44th Rotary Lombardi Award Ceremony. The ceremony was televised live on CBS College Sports.
- Legendary BYU coach LaVell Edwards presented Golden with the award.
- "What a great honor to receive this award from Coach Edwards," Golden said in his acceptance speech. "I humbly dedicate this award to the 2013 Miami Hurricanes. They overcame a lot of adversity over the last three years. And in so doing, they taught us a lot about perseverance, and leadership itself, and - maybe perhaps - overall about class."
- During his acceptance speech, Golden thanked Miami AD Blake James, President Donna E. Shalala, staff, his wife Kelly and his mom and dad.
