Miami Prepares for ACC Play with 19th-ranked Florida State...

The University of Miami volleyball team will step into Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) play this weekend, traveling to 19th-ranked Florida State on Saturday, Sept. 18 in Tallahassee. The following day, UM takes on Notre Dame in Tallahassee, serving as part of what is billed as the *Seminole Tri-Tournament*.

The 'Canes ride into Tallahassee having won their last two matches, both coming against NCAA Tournament opponents from a year ago in Middle Tennessee State (W, 3-1) and Albany (W, 3-0). Genny Mayhew and Lici McGee were selected to the *Miami/FIU Invitational All-Tournament Team*.

UM is currently atop the ACC in team kills per set (13.58) and sits sixth in the overall ACC standings at 7-2. Miami is also third in blocks as a team (2.63 bps) and tops in digs (15.58 dps). Senior libero Cassie Loessberg leads the league in digs (6.03 dps) while sophomore Lane Carico is second in kills (3.71 kps). Junior setter Katie Gallagher ranks near the top of

the league in assists per set (11.05) having seen action in the last 21 sets for the Hurricanes.

Quick Hits on Florida State...

Florida State comes into the match at 8-1, and winning last weekend's Miami/FIU Invitational with a 3-0 record. They established wins over Albany, Middle Tennessee State and FIU en route to the outright tournament title. By winning the event, the Seminoles are now a perfect 3-0 in regular-season tournaments this year and are off to the program's best start since the 2000 campaign.

The 'Noles are ranked 19th nationally this week. They are led by Mira Djuric (95) and Stephanie Neville (81) in kills, while a two-setter system is employed by FSU. Both Nikki Baker (197) and Duygu Duzceler (165) handle the setting duties, while middle blocker Brianna Barry and Jordana Price are tied atop the team in blocks with 29 apiece.

Quick Hits on Notre Dame...

Notre Dame comes into the weekend sporting a 4-3 record on the year, including a win over Wisconsin in the last outing. Outside hitter Serinity Phillips sits atop the team in kills (81), and teammate Jamel Nicholas serves setter for the Fighting Irish with 256 assists. Kristen Dealy holds 79 kills for the Irish, and libero Frenchy Silva tops the team in digs (60).

Miami has ties with Notre Dame, as assistant coach Matt Botsford used to be a longtime assistant under UM head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch. Botsford

spent the 2004-07 seasons with the Hurricanes before traveling to South Bend, Indiana to join the Fighting Irish program.

Series Against Florida State...

In a series that dates back to 1978 between these two "Sunshine State" rivals, the series sits at an even 16-16-1 all-time record. Miami swept last year's series with wins in Coral Gables and Tallahassee—the latter being a five-set thriller with UM earning a come-from-behind win. Since joining the ACC, UM holds a slight 6-4 advantage in the series, including wins in three of the last five contests.

Series Against Notre Dame...

The one-time BIG EAST foes are seeing each other for the first time since the 2003 season - Miami's last year with the conference before moving to the ACC. Notre Dame holds a 3-1 advantage in the series, including winning three consecutive. The Hurricanes' only win against the Fighting Irish was a 3-2 decision back on Nov. 15, 2002—the year UM advanced to the "Sweet 16" of the NCAA Tournament.

Loessberg Approaching Top Spot...

Senior libero/defensive specialist Cassie Loessberg enters the weekend needing just 11 digs to move ahead of Jamie Grass (2001-04) for first place all-time at UM in career digs. Currently, Loessberg sits second with 1,611 digs.

Cassie Setting Records...Again...

Senior libero Cassie Loessberg registered a new school record for digs in a three-set match last weekend, pulling in 39 in a 3-0 victory over Eastern Michigan. In posting a new record, she broke her own school record for that category, having previously set the bar at 23 versus UT-Arlington in 2007.

Mayhew Shooting for 1,000...

Senior outside hitter Genny Mayhew is closing in on 1,000 kills as she now has 978 kills in her career. If she cracks the 1,000-kill plateau, she will be just the fifth UM player all-time to have eclipsed that mark. Currently, she ranks fifth all-time at UM in career kills.

McGee Sitting on the Blocks...

Redshirt junior Lici McGee was noted to be a "player to watch" coming into the season for Miami, and that has proven true right from the spot. Not only

This season marks Nicole Lantagne Welch's ninth year at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in six

of the last eight seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

Last season, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.



Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by three seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her eight years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 18.9 wins per seasons with a career record of 151-87.

While new records were set during the 2007 campaign, the 2008 season saw even those records fall as Lantagne Welch and her staff assembled one of the best records in school history. Lantagne Welch led Miami to its best ACC record in school history. It was also the second-best record in school history on the Division I level of athletics.

Katie Gallagher moved in sole possession of second place all-time at UM for assists in a career during the 2008 season, while Cassie Loessberg placed herself in second place for digs in a career. In addition, Loessberg broke her own school record from a year ago for digs in a single-season, upping the new record to 554—besting her old school-record mark by two.

As for Gallagher, she etched her name once again as one of the Top 10 single-season assists leaders in school history. Already sitting at third place in school history from the 2007 season where she collected 1,243 assists, Gallagher added to that total with 1,202 in 2008—good enough for sixth place all-time in school history.

Freshman Lane Carico broke the freshman record for kills in a single-season for UM with 369, adding her name to 10th all-time for single-season kills. Meanwhile, Miami tied a school-record for hitting percentage in a five-set match, collecting a .329 percentage at Florida State on Nov. 26, 2008. The 'Canes would also collect the second-best single-set hitting mark in school history with a .615 clip against Boston College in the third set on Oct. 10, 2008.

Lantagne Welch would see two more student-athletes graduate following the 2008 season. Angelica Ellis and Bridget Bomhach both earned their Bachelor's Degree, while Ashley Woods completed her Master's Degree.

Woods placed her name eighth all-time in sets played (367), as well as eighth place all-time in total attacks (1,764). Ellis now ranks ninth in attacks (1,209), while also collecting the third-highest individual single-season hitting percentage (.350) from the 2008 campaign. Overall, Ellis is third in school history in career hitting percentage with a .275 clip through 318 sets and 1,209 attacks. Woods is tied for fifth in career hitting percentage, holding a .256 clip, sitting alongside Ciara Michel (2004-07).

The eighth-year head coach also coached three All-ACC Second Team members with

Lane Carico, Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. In addition, Carico and Ellis were each named as AVCA All-America honorable mention, while Carico was selected the 2008 AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico was also the true definition of "student-athlete" as she was named to the All-ACC Academic Team.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

Hurricanes VB Media Policy

KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

All media wishing to file stories should contact Bryan J. 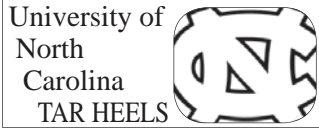
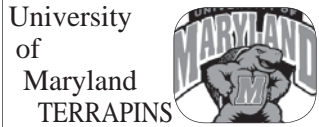

Duke Predicted to Win ACC Regular Season...

The Duke University volleyball team is predicted to win the 2009 Atlantic Coast Conference championship and headlines a list of 18 student-athletes selected to the 2009 Preseason All-ACC volleyball team, as announced today by Commissioner John D. Swofford.

Duke takes in 116 of a possible 121 points, including seven of 12 first place votes. Coaches' votes for the predicted order of finish were tallied with 11 points being applied to a first-place vote, 10 points for a second-place vote, etc. Coaches were not permitted to predict their own team's order of finish.

Just 17 points separate the top-four teams as Florida State, Miami, and North Carolina also take in first-place votes. Florida State follows Duke in second place with 104 points and three first-place votes, while Miami is tabbed to finish in third with 101 points and one first-place vote. North Carolina lands in fourth with 99 points and one first-place vote.

Clemson is tabbed fifth with 75 points, and is followed by Virginia Tech (71), Virginia (62), Georgia Tech (49), Wake Forest (47), Maryland (33), NC State (21), and Boston College (14).

Last Time Out - vs. Albany (9/12/09)...

Sophomore Lane Carico supplied 10 kills and Katie Gallagher handed out 35 assists to help the University of Miami volleyball team power past the University of Albany, 3-0, Saturday evening at the James L. Knight Sports Complex in Coral Gables, Fla. The match was the final one for UM in the Miami/FIU Invitational.

Playing the third consecutive 2008 NCAA Tournament participant in as many days, Miami (7-2) played solid volleyball on Saturday in order to earn the win. The Hurricanes hit a solid .256 clip (44-12-125) as a team and pulled together 11 total blocks.

Miami led 9-8 in the first set when an Albany (4-5) service error allowed sophomore Ali Becker to slam home a kill on the ensuing play to start a 4-1 run that stretched the UM advantage at 13-10. Following an Albany time-out, the Great Danes' Brooke Stanley collected a kill to bring her team within 14-13.

Becker added another of her team-high tying four kills in the opening set to edge UM back out a little further, 17-14.

Albany took the lead at 20-19 when Hillary White placed a kill in the middle, aided by a UM blocking error. Moments later, an attack error by Albany, as well as another timely Becker kill, put the 'Canes back in front, 21-20.

With the set tied, 22-22, UM closed it out on a 3-0 run

as Genny Mayhew registered a kill and senior Griffin Udelson served an ace to give UM the set, 25-22.

In the second set, Miami hit a match-high .319 percentage (17-2-47) as junior Lici McGee placed five kills and a block assist.

After trailing 1-0 in the opening, UM quickly grabbed the lead and never relinquished it en route to the second set win, 25-21.

The 'Canes led 18-12 as Lane Carico and Maria Andersson each had kills during an important run for Miami. Albany called a time-out, and then fought back to within 20-15 before UM head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch called timeout.

Blocks from McGee and Katie Gallagher put UM at set-point, 24-21, and an attack error charged to the Great Danes closed the set in favor of the Hurricanes.

The 'Canes led 11-10 in the third set when McGee posted a kill that began a 5-2 run that increased the UM lead, 16-12.

After an Albany time-out, the Great Danes used a pair of blocks from Kelly Corkum and Traci Vandergrift to bring Albany to within 19-18. But Miami quickly responded as Lici McGee had three consecutive blocks, helped by Gallagher and Carico at the net, to push the Miami lead back out to a 22-18 advantage late in the match.

A shot down the middle for Carico ended the match, 25-20, giving Miami its second consecutive win over an NCAA Tournament team from a year ago.

Albany was led on the night by Valerie Sourbeer with a match-high 13 kills, while teammate Hillary White followed with 11. Setter Brooke Stanley posted a double-double with 34 assists and 16 digs, and libero Laurie Gonzalez grabbed a match-high 21 digs with four assists.

Miami was led in kills by Carico (10), while Genny Mayhew and Becker each had eight. McGee used seven kills and seven blocks (five assists), while Gallagher had 35 assists, eight digs, five kills and five blocks for a solid overall performance.

For McGee, this is her third match of the season grabbing five or more blocks. She leads all UM players with 37 on the year.
