The Hokies enter the game 20-8 overall and 9-7 in ACC action ... Miami is 20-8 overall and 10-6 in conference play ... This is the second of two meetings this season ... Miami defeated the Hokies, 7468, in Coral Gables on Feb. 8.

## Last Time Out: VT 91, BC 75

The Hokies had an offensive explosion in the second half in the 91-75 road win at Boston College on Saturday afternoon ... Tech scored 53 second half points and shot 67.4 percent from the floor, including 75.0 percent in the second half ... Zach LeDay led six Hokies in double-figures with 18 points and Ty Outlaw added 16 points, on 5-of-5 from three-point range
... Justin Robinson recorded his first career double-double with 13 points and 11 assists.

## Series Against the Hurricanes

The Hurricanes lead the series, 20-13 ... Tech lost the last meeting, 74-68, in Coral Gables on Feb. 8 ... Tech won the last meeting in Cassell Coliseum, 77-52, last season, when the Hurricanes were ranked seventh nationally ... Tech is 7-6 in home games against Miami, all coming in Cassell Coliseum ... Every game in the series has been played as either an ACC or Big East Conference game.

## Reaching a Milestone

In the Hokies' 91-75 win at Boston College on Saturday, Justin Bibbs scored his 1,000 th career point ... He becomes the 45th Hokie to score 1,000 career points and currently has 1,001 points ... Zach LeDay needs just 21 points to reach his 1,000 th career point as a Hokie.

## The Hokies at 20

Virginia Tech enters tonight's game 20-8 overall and 9-7 in ACC play ... The win at Boston College on Saturday gave the Hokies back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since the 2009-10 and 2010-11 seasons.

## Board Control

In the Hokies' win at Boston College on Saturday, Tech out rebounded the Eagles, 27-18 ... The 18 rebounds allowed sets a new school, ACC record for fewest rebounds allowed in a game ... The previous low was 19 rebounds in Feb. 12, 2012, against Boston College in Cassell Coliseum ... On Saturday, Tech allowed BC just four offensive rebounds, the lowest amount for a Tech ACC opponent this season.

## Anything But Marginal

The Hokies defeated Boston College, 9175, in the Conte Forum on Saturday ... The 16-point margin of victory was the most for the Hokies in a road ACC game since Jan. 20, 2011, when Tech defeated Maryland, 74-57, in College Park ... It is only the third time since the Hokies joined the ACC that Tech has won a conference road game by more than 15 points.

## Percentage Talk

The Hokies shot 75.0 percent in the second half of the win at Boston College, their highest percentage in a half this season ... The Hokies shot 66.7 percent from three-point territory in both wins over Boston College this season ... The two BC games tie the school's record for three-point percentage in an ACC game ... Tech shot 66.7 percent from three-point range in a $76-62$ win at Wake Forest on Feb. 22, 2011 ... The Hokies shot 59.2 percent from the floor in the loss at Louisville, the team's third-best of the season and best in ACC play ... Tech shot 59.1 percent in the win over Boston College on Jan. 22.

## The Shot

The Hokies defeated Clemson, 71-70, in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 21 ... Trailing 70-68 with 7.4 seconds remaining, Seth Allen made a three-pointer from the top of the key with 3.8 second remaining to give the Hokies the win ... It was Allen's second game-winning basket in as many home games, as he scored the gamewinner in double overtime against UVa ... He has hit the eventual game-winner in four of the Hokies' nine ACC wins this season.

## On Top of the List

Justin Bibbs is 179-412 from three-point range for his career, good for 43.4 percent ... He is currently fourth all-time in threepoint field goal percentage in the ACC, having passed Rusty LaRue of Wake Forest


Justin Bibbs in the win at Boston College on Saturday ... He is currently tops at Virginia Tech, as the existing school mark is 40.9 percent, set by Brian Chase from 1999-2003 ... In the last five games, Bibbs is $18-33$ from three-point range, for 54.5 percent.

## Playing the Percentages

The Hokies are shooting 40.6 percent from beyond the arc this season ... The school record for three-point field goal percentage for a season is 39.5 percent, set in the 199596 season ... The Hokies are shooting 41.7 percent from three-point territory in ACC games this season ... The school record for three-point percentage in ACC games is 38.7 percent in the 2014-15 season ...The Hokies are shooting 49.1 percent from the field in ACC games this season ... The school, ACC record is 47.3 percent in the 2006-07 season ... The Hokies are shooting 73.1 percent from the line in ACC play this season, the third-best since joining the league ... The school, ACC record is 75.5 percent in the 2009-10 season.

## Solid Stats for LeDay

Zach LeDay has scored in double figures in 27 of the 28 games, including three games of 20 -or-more-points ... He leads the Hokies in scoring, at 15.6 points per game and in rebounding (among


Zach LeDay active players), at 7.0 boards per game ... In the win over Syracuse, he tied his ACC-high of 22 points ... LeDay grabbed his 400th Virginia Tech rebound against Notre Dame ... He recorded his third double-double of the season in the loss at Miami and his fourth in the win at Pittsburgh ... LeDay's streak of 23 consecutive doublefigure scoring games is the best current streak in the ACC.

## Improvement from 3

Last season, Seth Allen was 44 of 157 from three-point range, for 28.0 percent ... This season, he has made 46 of 96 three-point attempts, for 47.9 percent from three-point range ... He is 30 of 60 ( 50.0 percent) from three-point range in ACC games this season.

## 5 With 11

In the win at Pittsburgh, Justin Robinson tied his then-career-high with eight assists ... In the home win over Clemson, he had eight assists with three turnovers ... In the Pitt win, he also dished out his 200th


Justin Robinson career assist in just his 60th career game ... In the win at Boston College, Robinson set a new career-high and tied the school's ACC game record with 11 assists ... He has 37 assists and just 12 turnovers in the last five games ... He has 228 career assists, to just 126 career turnovers.

## Making Shots

The Hokies lead the ACC field goal percentage and three-point field goal percentage in conference games and in all games this season ... Tech is 13th nationally in field goal percentage and eighth in three-point field goal percentage ... Tech is shooting 49.1 percent from the field in ACC play and 49.1 percent in all games ... Tech is shooting 41.7 percent from three-point range in conference games and 40.6 percent in all games ... The Hokies shot 51.0 percent from the floor at UNC and are the first ACC opponent to make better than 50 percent of their shots against the Tar Heels ... Tech shot 59.1 percent from the field in the home win over Boston College and 59.2 percent from the field at Louisville ... In the win at Boston College, the Hokies shot a school ACC record 67.4 percent from the floor.

## Moving On Up

The Hokies are shooting 72.5 percent from the free throw line ... Entering the Jan. 18 game against Georgia Tech, the Hokies were shooting 69.8 percent from the line ... Since then, the Hokies have made 166 of 214 free throw attempts, good for 77.6 percent ... Tech is shooting 73.1 percent from the line in ACC competition.

## Putting the Ball in the Basket

The Hokies are averaging 79.2 points per game this season ... The last time the Hokies averaged more points per game than that number was in the 1988-89 season, when the Hokies averaged 87.2 points per game ... Tech averaged 75.0 points per game last season, the most since the 1994-95 season (75.4 ppg).

## Ty Likes Road Saturdays

Ty Outlaw has had his best two games in the Hokies'last two Saturday road games ... At Louisville, Outlaw scored a career-high 19 points ... He made a career-high five threepointers in 35 minutes of action ... He was 7 -of-8 from the field, including 5-6 from three-point range ... He also grabbed seven rebounds, tying a careerhigh and setting a personal best in an ACC game ... In the win at Boston College the next week, Outlaw had


16 points, making all five of his three-point attempts ... He also had seven rebounds to leas the Hokies in a career-high 38 minutes.

## Coming Back

The Hokies defeated No. 12/13 Virginia, 80-78, in double overtime in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 12 and trailed the Cavaliers, 37-23, at halftime ... The 14-point comeback is the most by Tech in an ACC game this season and second only to the Michigan game, where Tech came back from a 15 point deficit ... The 14 point comeback in the win over Virginia is the largest for Tech in an ACC game since coming back from a 16 point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of last season ... The Hokies followed that game with a 13-point come-from-behind win at Pittsburgh on Feb. 14 ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 9187 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum.

## Strong Play by Allen

Seth Allen has scored in double figures in 11 of the 13 games since returning from an injury which caused him to miss the Florida State game ... In that span, he is averaging 15.1 points per game ... Allen scored 20 points in the win over Virginia and made a big three-pointer late in the win over Pittsburgh ... He scored 25 points in the loss at Louisville and made the game-winning three-pointer in the final seconds in the home win over Clemson.

## Being Stingy is a Good Thing

In the win over Syracuse, the Hokies committed a season-low six turnovers ... The previous low was seven against Texas A\&M ... This is the fewest turnovers in an ACC game for the Hokies since committing six turnovers against Wake Forest on Jan. 13, 2016 ... Tech committed just eight turnovers in the win at Pitt and just nine in the loss at No. 8/7 Louisville and the home win over Clemson.

## Whew, That's Close

The Hokies are 9-7 in ACC games this season ... In the last seven victories, the Hokies have won by more than three points just twice, in both Boston College games ... Tech has won by double digits just three this ACC season, 89-75 over Duke, 83-73 over Syracuse and 91-75 at Boston College ... Tech is 5-2 in ACC games this season decided by five-or-fewer points and 7-3 in all games this season decided by five-or-fewer points.

## Clarke Out

Virginia Tech forward Chris Clarke suffered a tear in the the anterior cruciate ligament in his left knee and will miss the remainder of the season ... He injured the knee in the second half of the win over Virginia ... He underwent successful surgery on Feb. 17.

## Threes All Around

The Hokies were 17 of 26 from three-point range in the loss at No. 8/7 Louisville ... The 17 three-pointers sets a new school record for three-pointers in a game, breaking the old mark of 16 three-pointers in a 93-90 loss to Marquette in Cassell Coliseum on Jan. 7, 1989 ... Tech shot 65.4 percent from three-point range in the Louisville game, second-best this season ... Tech has shot better than 60 percent from three-point territory four times in ACC play this season ... Tech's 17 threepointers set a KFC Yum! Center record for an opponent ... That matched UofL's record at the KFC Yum! Center (Morgan State, Dec. 27,2010 ) ... Tech set a record for a UofL opponent in a non-overtime game (WVU made 18 in an 2005 Elite Eight overtime game).

## The Big 2-0-0

Buzz Williams won his 200th career game with the win over Boston College on Jan. 29 and has a 204-131 record in his 10th season as a collegiate head coach ... He is $51-45$ in his third season at Virginia Tech ... He was recognized for his 200th win prior to the Virginia game.

## Getting to the Line More

This season, the Hokies are 444 of 612 from the free throw line, for 72.5 percent ... Tech opponents have SHOT just 435 free throws this season ... In ACC play, Tech has made 61 more free throws than its opponents.

## Lights, Camera, Action!

So far this season, the Hokies have played a total of 14 games on one of the three ESPN over-the-air networks ... In those games, Tech is a combined 12-2 ... Tech is 1-1 on ESPN, 3-0 on ESPN2 and 8-1 on ESPNU ... Tech won all three of its Sunday night ESPNU games ... The Hokies will play Miami tonight on ESPN2 and at least one game on the family of networks in the 2017 ACC Tournament.

## Milestones, Here and Approaching

Zach LeDay needs 21 points for 1,000 at Virginia Tech and scored his 400th point of the season in the home win over Clemson and his 300th career rebound at Boston College ... At Miami, Chris Clarke pulled down his 300th rebound and had his 50th assist ... Justin Robinson scored his 500th career point in the win over UVa and recorded his 200th career assist at Pitt ... In the win at Pitt, Ahmed Hill scored his 600th career point.

## Setting New Marks

The Hokies have 226 assists in ACC play ... The former school record was 220, set in the 2014-15 season ... Tech had 206 assists in ACC games last season ... The Hokies have made 247 three-pointers this season ... The old school record was 241 threes, set in the 2014-15 season.

## Great Numbers

The Hokies are 20-8 this season ... This marks the team's best start through 28 games since the 2009-10 season, when Tech started the 21-7 ... The Hokies have reached 20 victories the earliest since that same 200910 season ... The Hokies finished the month of November this season, 6-1 overall and finished December, 6-0 ... Tech's 6-0 is its first undefeated December since 2009-10, when Tech finished that December 7-0.

## Making Some Points on Points

The Hokies defeated Boston College, 91-75, in Chestnut Hill on Saturday ... The 91 points is the most in an ACC game for the Hokies this season and third-highest point total in any game this season ... The last time the Hokies scored more than 90 points in an ACC game was Jan. 13, 2016, when Tech defeated Wake Forest, 93-91, in Cassell Coliseum ... The last time the Hokies scored more points in an ACC road win was on Jan. 23, 2007, when Tech defeated Miami92-85, in Coral Gables ... The previous Saturday, Tech lost at Louisville, 94-90 ... It is the most points that Tech has scored in an ACC non-overtime loss and the second most in any ACC loss.

Last season, Chris Clarke had 33 assists in 22 games ... This season, in 24 games, Clarke dished out 79 assists ... In the win over High Point, Clarke registered six assists ... He smashed that number in the win over The Citadel, when he recorded a career-high 10 assists ... Last season he averaged 1.5 assists per game and this season; that rose to 3.3 assists ... His 10 assists in The Citadel game is the most assists by a Hokie since Devin Wilson had 11 assists in a loss to No. 4 Duke on Feb. 25, 2015 ... In the win over Syracuse, he dished out a new personal ACC-high of six assists ... To go along with his assists numbers, Chris Clarke had 21 steals in 22 games last season ... He has 30 steals in 24 games this season ... He leads the Hokies in steals this season ... Clarke will miss the remainder of the season with a knee injury.

Wilson, who has not played yet this season and will redshirt the 2016-17 season, had returned to Blacksburg at 2:30 a.m. Dec. 30 with the team, who had defeated Arkansas, 35-24, in the Belk Bowl in Charlotte on Dec. 29 ... Wilson has completed his degree requirements and is currently working on a second major.

The last time Tech did not record a three-point field goal in a game was at Providence on Feb. 1, 2003.

## Ty Likes 3s

Ty Outlaw has made 48 field goals ... Of that number, 37 have come from three-point range ... He was 3 -for- 5 from three-point range at NC State ... Both of his baskets at Florida State were two-point field goals, the first time this season he has had two, twopointers in the same game ... He was 5-of-6 from three-point range in the loss at Louisville and 5-of-5 from three in the win at Boston College.

## LeDay is Solid from the Line

In the Hokies' last 10 games, Zach LeDay is 50-61 from the free throw line, good for 82.0 percent ... He is shooting 77.5 percent from the line this season and 77.1 percent from the line in ACC play.

The Hokies have a 575-189 overall record in Cassell Coliseum, for a .753 winning percentage ... The win over Florida State in 2011 was the 500th victory in the building ... Tech has had just one break-even home season and two losing seasons ... Tech is 14-1 in Cassell this year, 6-1 in ACC games.

## What a Sellout, x4

Virginia Tech has sold out four games this season ... The sellouts are the home opener against Maine and ACC games against Duke, Notre Dame and Virginia ... The Duke game sold out less than 24 hours after single game ACC tickets went on sale to Hokie Club members and season ticket holders.

## More on the Gate

With the four sellouts this season, the Hokies are averaging 7,371 per game this season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 6,658 and in the 2014-15 season, Tech averaged $5,744 \ldots$ This year's attendance would be the largest for the Hokies since averaging 8,395 in the 2010-11 season ... Last season, the Hokies averaged 7,529 for nine ACC home games; this season, Tech is averaging 7.985 through seven ACC home games.

## Giving an Assist

The Hokies dished out 18 assists on 31 made baskets in the win at Boston College ... It was the 10th time this season that the Hokies have had at least 18 assists in a game ... In the 113-71 win over The Citadel, the Hokies dished out a season-high 30 assists, second-most assists in school history.

## That Pittsburgh Game

Less than 48 hours after the Hokies' 80-78 double overtime victory over No. 12/13 Virginia, Tech was back on the court in Pittsburgh ... The Hokies played their first game without Chris Clarke, who was lost for the season in the UVa win ... Trailing by 11 points at the half and by 13 points early in the second half, Tech recorded its second consecutive double-digit come-from-behind ACC victory ... Tech played eight players, but two played fewer than 10 minutes each ... Although out rebounded 43-29, Tech forced the Panthers into 13 turnovers, while commiting just eight ... Tech committed a season-low-tying 10 fouls and made 12-of15 free throw attempts ... Tech also assisted on 16 of its 22 made baskets ... The Hokies defeated the Panthers in Pittsburgh for the first time since Jan. 23, 1967.

## That Virginia Game on Feb. 12

Less than two weeks after falling at Virginia, 71-48, the Hokies won an epic rematch, 8078, in double overtime in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 12 ... Tech came back from a 14 point halftime deficit to tie the game on a Ty Outlaw put-back in the final second of regulation ... Seth Allen scored the gamewinning basket in the lane with 3.1 seconds remaining in the second overtime for the Hokies ... Tech played both overtimes without leading scorer Zach LeDay, who fouled out with 1:22 remaining in regulation and Chris Clarke, who had suffered a torn ACL in his left knee in the second half ... The Hokies have defeated the Cavaliers in Cassell in consecutive years for the first time since the 2009-10 and 2008-09 seasons ... Those years were the last two of a four consecutive home win streak against UVa ... In the win, Justin Bibbs tied the school record for minutes played in an ACC game, with $46 \ldots$ In all, three Hokies played more than 40 minutes in the game.

## Earning It

Head coach Buzz Williams has announced that Matt Galloway has earned a full scholarship for the spring semester ... Galloway, who graduated last May with a degree in history, is currently in graduate school at Virginia Tech ... He joined the team last season as a walk-on.

## $3 \times 2+2 \times 2$

In the Hokies' win over The Citadel, Chris Clarke recorded the Hokies' first-ever tripledouble, scoring 13 points, grabbing 12 rebounds and dishing out a career-high 10 assists ... Clarke is one of three ACC players with a triple-double this season ... He scored 185 points in 22 games last season and 274 points in his 24 games this season.

## Beating Top Teams

Last season, the Hokies won two games against top 10 teams, including a home win over No. 7 Miami ... That marked the first time that had happened since Tech defeated three top 10 (actually top 5) teams in the 2006-07 season ... Tech added another Top 5 victory this season, defeating No. 5/5 Duke, 89-75, on Dec. 31 ... Tech is 2-5 against ranked teams this season, 1-2 against top 10 teams.


## A Good Night from the Line

The Hokies made 16 of 17 free throw attempts in the win at Clemson, for 94.1 percent ... That marked the third time this season that Tech had shot better than 90 percent from the line ... Tech made 19 of 20 attempts in the win over New Mexico in the Wooden Legacy and 19 of 21 attempts in the win at Michigan in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... The last time the Hokies made at least 94 percent from the line in an ACC game (attempting at least 10 free throws) was on March 4, 2009, when the Hokies made all of their 17 free throw attempts in an 86-78 home win over No. 2 North Carolina ... Tech was 7 -of-8 from the line in the home win over Clemson.

## O Canada

Virginia Tech assistant coach Jamie McNeilly spent some of his summer in Chile ... He was an assistant coach with the Canadian National team at the FIBA U18 Americas Championship in Valdivia, Chile, a team that featured Virginia Tech signee Nickeil Alexander-Walker and finished with the Silver Medal ... Last summer, he was an assistant with the Canadian team at the FIBA U19 Championship in Herkalion, Greece, where Justin Bibbs' USA Basketball team won the gold medal ... McNeilly has contributed to the Canadian National team since 2011.

## Scoring Balance

The Hokies have five players averaging in double figures ... The Hokies have played 11 players this season and eight have scored at least 100 points ... Six players have scored at least 200 points, and three of those have scored more than 300 points ... Zach LeDay has scored 436 points this season to lead the Hokies ... In the win over Boston College, the Hokies placed six players in double figures for the second time in ACC play this season (the Duke win was the first).

## Close Games vs. the Tigers

The Hokies defeated Clemson, 71-70 in Cassell Coliseum on Feb. 21, after defeating the Tigers 82-81 in Littlejohn Coliseum on Jan. 22 ... Since the Hokies joined the ACC in the 2004-05 season, Tech has played the Tigers 20 times ... Of those 20 games, 14 have been decided by 5-or-fewer points ... Four more have been decided by 10 -or-fewer points ... In those 20 games, only 22 points divide the two teams and only a 23 point difference in all 33 games.

In his two yearsplus at Virginia Tech, Buzz Williams already has ushered in an exciting new era of basketball. The head coach of the men's squad is in his third season here in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach - "Get Better."

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Now in his 10th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 204-131. Williams has compiled a 51-45 record in his first three seasons in Blacksburg.

Last season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an identity - one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. And while he has been

Division I level for 20 seasons, and 201617 was will mark his 10 th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14 -win campaign in 2006-07, and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A\&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the

nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline. com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A\&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A\&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.
