THE FACTS...

A lot of things could happen on Wednesday for the University of Miami, and the possibility for post season play depends heavily on their match against in-state rival Florida State University in the capital city of Tallahassee. The Hurricanes enter the match with a record of 25-6 (13-6 ACC) and need to win in order to keep their second place league hopes alive, as well as a slim chance at the conference crown.

If UM defeats FSU, they would need for NC State to knock-off rival North Carolina, but they need for Wake Forest to first defeat Duke on Tuesday, Nov. 25 for this to even matter. So, the race for the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) title is still up in the air, but the 'Canes are not out of the hunt just yet.

Entering Wednesday night's contest, Florida State may be playing the best volleyball of anyone in the league at this point after winning their last six matches, including four sweeps in the process. The Seminoles still have a shot at the league title as well, but they need to defeat Miami and hope for the same scenario as the 'Canes as far as other conference foes winning and losing, respectively.

After accomplishing just their second 25-win season since bringing back the program in 2001, the Hurricanes have a chance to see the post season for the first time since their amazing and memorable Sweet 16 run in the 2002 NCAA Tournament before they were defeated by national seed Nebraska, 3-0. The Orange and Green are seeking to equal the total amount of wins this season then they had in the previous two seasons combined with possibly 26 wins ... (12 - 2006, 14 - 2007).

Miami can also join just seven other schools since 1998 to have a winning percentage turnaround of less than 15 wins in one season to 25 or more wins the following year, and finish with less than 10 losses. UM is also seeking their highest finish in the ACC standings since 2004 when they first joined the league.

ON FLORIDA STATE...

The Seminoles of Florida State are celebrating "Senior Day" on Wednesday, and they may-well be playing the best volleyball of anyone in the ACC as of late. With wins over UNC, NC State, Clemson and Georgia Tech in the last weekends combined, the Seminoles have put themselves into position to win the ACC title along with three other schools. They may have enjoyed one of the most successful turn-arounds at the midway point of the season than anyone else in the league.

The 'Noles Lauren Richardson leads the team and sits ranked among the top 10 in the ACC in kills with a total of 310 under her belt. Richardson averages 3.04 kills per set, and has a team second-best tying 23 service aces. A team second-best 274 digs is also owned by Richardson.

Behind her is Jordana Price who has 276 kills while teammates Stephanie Neville (259 kills) and Brianna Barry (235 kills) top the 200-or more kills category for the Seminoles as well. The setter for the 'Noles is Nikki Baker who is among the league leaders in assists with 1,157 to her credit. Digs are provided by Ashlee Moon who leads the squad with an even 450.

All Miami home matches this year will feature live stats through Gametracker on www.hurricanesports.com. A select number of them will feature radio broadcast through WVUM...the official student radio station for the University of Miami. That is also followed by a pair of matches on ACC Select sponsored through the Atlantic Coast Conference. Head Coach ... Nicole Lantagne Welch



Nicole Lantagne Welch enters her eighth season at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in five of the last seven seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In the 2006 season-opener, Lantagne Welch recorded her 100th career win with a 3-2 victory over Alabama. In 2007, UM finished 14-17 overall and 8-14 in ACC play, pushing Lantagne Welch's career

record to 125-81 overall in seven seasons as a head coach, all at Miami.

Her career at UM is highlighted by two consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins (2003 & 2004) and a trip to the Sweet 16 in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her seven seasons at the helm, the Hurricanes have averaged 17.8 wins per season.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. As a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered first-team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and 1993, and earned second-team honors in 1991. She was also named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

As team captain her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career at Maryland, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch began her coaching career in 1994 as an assistant coach on the Maryland staff before becoming a graduate assistant coach at Ohio University in 1995. At Ohio, she developed training sessions for setters and assisted in the scouting of opponents and in the development of game plans.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

Under Lantagne Welch's training, Aggie setter Jenna Moscovic was named the 1999 Big 12 Conference Freshman of the Year and named to the All-American Freshman Team by Volleyball Magazine. As a sophomore, Moscovic was selected to the 2000 All-Big 12 Team and All-District 5 Team. Lantagne Welch also played a major role in bringing the Aggies back-to-back Top 10 recruiting classes. The 1999 class was ranked in the Top 10 by Student Sports Magazine and the 1998 class was ranked sixth by Volleyball Magazine.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7th, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

HURRICANES VB MEDIA POLICY**KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX**

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Information Director Bryan J. Harvey.

WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

sits at an even 5-5 after the Hurricanes won this year's only other meeting in Coral Gables back on Sept. 19 by a count of 3-1. Prior to that, FSU had taken four of the last five meetings leading into the 2008 campaign for both teams.

ACC TITLE RACE HEATING UP AT LAST TURN...

In the last turn, or final matches, of the Atlantic Coast Conference season, the title is still up in the air, so to speak. However, both Duke and North Carolina hold the edge at this point. Both teams are in action on Tuesday, with Duke facing a tough Wake Forest team, as well as UNC playing against a scrappy NC State club. Miami is not out of the picture because if both teams lose, then the Hurricanes would step in as ACC champs if they can also muster up a victory against rival Florida State on Wednesday night in Tallahassee. However, if FSU wins, and the previous scenario stays true to form, then the Seminoles will climb up to ACC championship status after starting the ACC season just 1-4.

MIAMI IN THE ACC RANKINGS...

UM has several players ranked among the top 10 in several categories for the ACC this year. Leading things off for UM is senior Angelica Ellis in hitting percentage (7th) with a .333 clip (200-58-427). Freshman Lane Carico is sixth in the league in kills (334 / 3.21 kps) and teammate Genny Mayhew is right behind her in eighth place (320 / 3.14 kps). Setter Katie Gallagher is fifth in assists (1067 / 10.46 aps), while also ranked seventh in service aces (31). Carico is 10th in service aces (31), and teammate Lici McGee is ninth in blocks (64 / 1.08 bps). Cassie Loessberg is third in digs (500 / 4.81 dps).

ON THIS DATE IN HISTORY...

This will serve as the first-ever match the University of Miami has ever played on Nov. 26 throughout history. The Orange and Green have played matches on Nov. 24 and 25, but never on this particular date.

HURRICANES HAVE GREAT HOME RECORD...

Finishing the 2008 regular season with a record 12-1 at home in the James L. Knight Sports Complex, after defeating Clemson last weekend, the Miami Hurricanes registered their best home effort since moving to the ACC in 2004. Prior to that, UM collected an equally impressive 12-1 mark in 2002--the same year they ventured into the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament.

LOESSBERG MAKES ACES INTO SCHOOL HISTORY...

Against North Carolina on Oct. 18, junior libero/defensive specialist Cassie Loessberg registered six service aces in the match. That last ace moved the Sacramento, California native into a tie for second place all-time in UM history for aces in a single match. She is now tied with Kristi Sprenkel who set the original second-place mark back on Oct. 24, 2001 against Nova Southeastern.

GALLAGHER, MAYHEW HAVE HISTORICAL NIGHTS...

In the loss to the Virginia Cavaliers on Oct. 24, sophomore setter Katie Gallagher had 51 assists to give her sole possession of second place all-time in school history for assists. Gallagher passed Mallory James (2001-04) with 2,202 assists to her credit in just two years in the Orange and Green. She trails all-time leader Jill Robinson (2003-06) by 2,735. Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew's 17 digs added her name to an elite group of athletes in UM volleyball history as she moved into the "500 Club", now holding more than 500 kills and 500 digs in a career.

20-WIN SEASON IN THE BAG FOR FIRST TIME IN ACC...

After defeating ACC power Duke last Friday night in Coral Gables, the University of Miami volleyball team assured themselves their first 20-win season since joining the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC). The 'Canes are now 20-5 overall, and have a chance to record their best record in NCAA Division I history. The current record (27-6) was set during their magical NCAA Sweet 16 run in 2002. The school record, however, is a 49-14-1 season back in 1980 when the Hurricanes were members of the old AIAW league, not associated with the NCAA.

MIAMI SETS NEW RECORD IN WINS...

With their 12th ACC win coming last week-end against foes Georgia Tech and Clemson, UM set a new school record for ACC wins. The previous high had been 11 coming in both 2004 and 2005. They are now just one victory away from their first 25-win season since 2002, and just the fourth in school history overall.

HOME IS WHERE THE HITS ARE...

At home this year in the friendly confines of the James L. Knight Sports Complex, the 'Canes have yet to hit below a .200 clip. In fact, they are averaging a .263 hitting percentage (528-166-1375) at home. Meanwhile, opponents are being held to a .180 clip (461-207-1409) at "The Knight."

SHUTTING THE DOOR...

Miami has shutout 14 opponents this season in 27 matches on the campaign. Last year, the Hurricanes managed eight shutouts in 2007 altogether. The 2006 class had just four and 2005 with six. This is now the most shutouts for the Hurricanes since joining the ACC back in 2004.

TRACKING LOESSBERG AND THE DIGS...

Junior libero Cassie Loessberg continues to jump up the charts this season as she now has 500 digs on the campaign, upping her career total to 1,370. The Sacramento, Calif. junior is just 251 digs behind the all-time leader, Jamie Grass (2001-04) for the top place in school history. With an average of 4.86 digs per set, and at least 15 sets to play, the junior All-ACC Candidate could break the record by the 10th match of the 2009 season.

MAYHEW NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-ACC TEAM...

Junior outside hitter Genny Mayhew was named to the Preseason All-ACC Team as voted on by head coaches around the Atlantic Coast Conference. Mayhew, a 5-foot-11 junior from Clovis, Calif. (Clovis HS), finished ninth in the conference in both kills (428) and points (465) a year ago. She also finished fourth on the squad in digs (224) and tied for fifth in blocks (43) alongside teammate Ariell Cooke while playing in 111 games for the 'Canes.

CLEMSON PREDICTED TO WIN ACC ... AGAIN...

After finishing atop the league last season, the Clemson Tigers have been predicted to repeat as conference champs after collecting 11 of a possible 12 first place votes. Georgia Tech received the other first place vote while being predicted to finish second. Duke and North Carolina were third and fourth, while Florida State and Virginia tied for fifth,

respectively.

'CANES STUMBLE IN RECORD SEEKING...

Seeking to tie or break the school record for wins to start the year (15-0, 2002), the 2008 Hurricane squad went 13-0 before falling at Wake Forest. It was, however, the second-best start for any Miami volleyball team in school history. Only one other time had the 'Canes held an undefeated record entering the month of October.

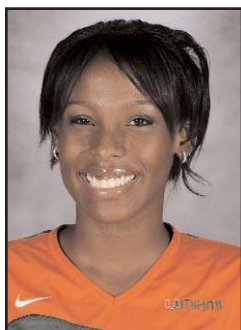

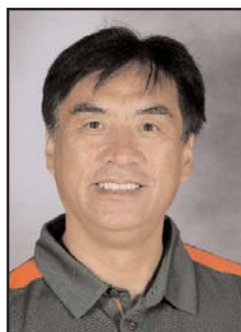
