


## 1997-98 Season Review

The 1997-98 season was one of growth and accomplishment for a young Hurricane squad looking to move into the college basketball spotlight. Along the way Miami experienced tremendous highs and devastating lows, but in the end they persevered and accomplished something that hadn't been done at UM since 1960. Competing in the NCAA Tournament.

**Hurricanes Start Fast**

Miami opened the 1997-98 season with nine straight victories tying a school record. The season opener took place in Carbondale, Illinois against the Salukis of Southern Illinois. Miami's 73-61 win was its first non-conference road win since Nov. 25, 1995 and snapped the Salukis' 33-game winning streak in home openers.

Following a 69-47 win over Florida Atlantic, Miami faced 17th-ranked North Carolina Charlotte in the Miami Arena. Tim James put on a masterful performance recording 23 points, six rebounds, six blocks and five steals as the Hurricanes stunned the 49ers, 89-72, marking the first

non-conference victory over a ranked opponent since 1989. For his performance James would be named the BIG EAST Player of the Week (Nov. 24).

The Hurricanes continued to knock off the competition improving to 8-0 with wins over Eastern Kentucky (86-64), Jacksonville (74-70), Rutgers (63-55), Georgetown (66-56), and Georgia State (80-64). Miami's wins over Rutgers and Georgetown marked the first 2-0 conference start in school history.

Miami then traveled to Memphis looking to tie the 1962-63 school record for consecutive wins to open the season. James once again put on show hitting his first 11 shots from the floor on his way to 27 points and 11 rebounds and a 65-57 victory. The game marked the return of Vernon Jennings who missed the first eight games of the season with a broken foot. Jennings played 20 minutes off the bench and recorded a team-high eight assists.

**Streak Ends but Hurricanes Press On**

The Hurricanes' winning streak would end the next game as 23rd-ranked Georgia Tech defeated Miami, 69-61, at the HIP Health Plan Orange Bowl Basketball Classic in Miami Arena. Georgia Tech was led by MVP Matt Harpring who recorded 24 points and 12 rebounds. The Yellow Jackets outrebounded the Hurricanes 53-40 while holding Miami to a season low 23-71 (.324) shooting from the field. One positive note for Miami was senior guard Kevin Norris who recorded six assists to become the Hurricanes career assists leader.

Miami bounced back with two conference road wins against Seton Hall (78-65) and Pittsburgh (73-65) before returning to Miami to face 8th-ranked Connecticut. Miami registered a resounding 76-67 win in front of 8,247 fans, the sixth largest crowd in UM history. The victory was the highest ranked opponent Miami had ever defeated in Miami Arena.

**UM Stumbles on Road Trip**

Following the Connecticut game the Hurricanes stood at 12-1 and found themselves on the verge of recorded their first national ranking since Feb. 23, 1965. Miami registered 95 points in the Associated Press poll and 41 points in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll to rank 26th in the nation.

The Hurricanes magical ride came to an abrupt halt with one of the toughest three-game road swings in league history. Miami had to travel to West Virginia, St. John's and Syracuse and face teams with a combined record of 44-11 (.800). In each game Miami faced either a sell out crowd or season-high attendance at that time of the season. Miami dropped all three games and suddenly found themselves struggling to find the chemistry that gave them their early success.

**Hurricanes Rebound from Adversity**

Things became even more difficult as Coach Hamilton lost three players, including two starters, over the next two games. Sophomore starting forward Lucas Barnes was disciplined for violating team policy before the Hurricanes game with Villanova on Jan. 22 and would later leave school for personal reasons. Also against Villanova the Hurricanes lost reserve center Nick Donovan for the season after tearing the anterior cruciate ligament in his left knee while going for a rebound. Two games later Coach Hamilton was forced to discipline starting guard Johnny Hemsley for four games for a violation of team policy.

Through it all the Hurricanes managed to finish the regular season with six wins over the final 10 games. In that stretch Tim James became the 21st player in UM history to surpass 1,000 career points with an alley-oop dunk at Boston College on Jan. 28 and Kevin Norris moved ahead of Jerome Scott on UM's career steals list with one swipe versus Providence on Feb. 4.

Miami concluded the regular season with a dramatic 70-66 win over 19th-ranked West Virginia on Senior Night in the Miami Arena. In story book fashion, senior guard Kevin Norris scored the Hurricanes' last seven points over the final 69 seconds of the game to lead Miami to the win.

The win locked up the forth seed for Miami who would face Georgetown in the first round of the BIG EAST Tournament. Prior to the BIG EAST Tournament it was announced that Tim James was named to the All-BIG EAST first team becoming the first Hurricane to named first-team All-Conference.

**Hurricanes Wait on Selection Sunday**

A 62-56 loss to Georgetown in the opening round of the BIG EAST Tournament made NCAA Selection Sunday an anxious one for the Hurricanes. The players and coaches watched in the basketball conference room as each bracket was announced.

Nervousness would change to adulation, however, as it was announced in the final half of the final bracket that Miami would make its second NCAA appearance in school history. The Hurricanes were placed in the South Region and would take on UCLA at the Georgia Dome.

**Miami Battles to the End**

Against one of the most storied programs in NCAA college basketball history, no one gave the Hurricanes much of chance for the upset. Miami showed they were ready to play jumping to a 10 point lead midway through the first half. UCLA would go a run late in the half and the teams found themselves tied 32-32 at the half.

UCLA looked to have the game in hand after jumping to a 10 point lead of their own with 10:52 to play in the game. Miami fought back and actually led 62-59 after two free throws from Mario Bland with 1:55 to play. But UCLA would score the game's final six points for the 65-62 win.

## 1997-98 Season Recap and Boxscores

## Game 1 - MIAMI 73, SOUTHERN ILLINOIS 61

November 14, 1997  
SIU Arena, Carbondale, IL

Sophomore forward Johnny Hemsley hit for 16 points and junior forward Tim James added 14 points and 12 rebounds to lead Miami to a 73-61 victory over Southern Illinois in Carbondale, IL. Monte Jenkins scored 22 points to lead Southern Illinois.

The win by Miami, its first non-conference road win since Nov. 25, 1995, snapped the Salukis' 33-game winning streak in home openers.

Trailing 32-31 at halftime, Hemsley scored seven points as Miami opened the second-half with a 22-8 run and took a 53-40 lead with 12:26 to play.

SIU cut the lead to seven with 9:10 to play but Miami would score the next five points, capped by a driving slam by James to extend the lead to 60-48 with 7:32 left.

## Game 2 - MIAMI 69, FLORIDA ATLANTIC 47

November 16, 1997  
Miami Arena, Miami, FL

Junior forward Tim James poured in a team-high 14 points and grabbed seven rebounds in only 19 minutes to lead Miami to a 69-47 win over Florida Atlantic in the Miami Arena.

Mario Bland added a season-high 12 points while Johnny Hemsley hit for double figures (11 points) for the second consecutive game. Point guard Kevin Norris added a career-high 11 assists, most of the no look variety, while committing only one turnover for the Hurricanes.

Miami's defense was stifling holding FAU to 13-of-66 (.197) shooting from the field. The 19.7 percent field goal percentage allowed was the lowest allowed by a Hurricane team since the rebirth of the program in 1985.

J.R. Henderson scored 26 points, including two free throws with 25 seconds remaining to put UCLA ahead, and the sixth-seeded Bruins outlasted Miami, 65-62, in the first round of the South Region at Atlanta.

Toby Bailey added 21 points for the Bruins, who went on to defeat third seed Michigan in the second round. UCLA blew a 10-point lead in the second half but recovered by scoring the game's final six points.

Mario Bland scored 18 points and Kevin Norris added 14 for the Hurricanes, who were denied their first NCAA Tournament win in school history in just their second NCAA appearance. The other came in 1960.

Henderson, the lone option in the post for UCLA, banked a 12-footer with 84 seconds to go, pulling the Bruins within 62-61. After a stop on defense, Henderson was fouled by Bland as he drove into the lane.

A 65 percent foul shooter, Henderson made both to put UCLA ahead 63-62. Miami called timeout to set up a play, but Johnny Hemsley's 18-footer from the left baseline bounced off the rim. Bailey grabbed the rebound and was fouled with 7.4 seconds left.

The senior made both and UCLA called timeout to set its defense for a final play. However, the Hurricanes were still able to get a clean look at the basket, but Charles Wiseman's jumper from 20 feet hit the rim and bounced away.

After the teams played to a 32-32 tie at the half, Baron Davis had two layups to trigger a 17-7 UCLA run as the Bruins took a 49-39 lead with 10:52 to play.

The Bruins still led 52-43 with 8:56 to play after Earl Watson made one of three free throws. Miami countered with five straight points as Norris hit a three-pointer and Johnny Hemsley hit a jumper around Henderson's miss of the front end of a 1-and-1.

A three-pointer by Bailey pushed the lead back to 55-48, but jumpers by Hemsley and Bland closed the deficit to three with 5:15 to play. Bailey and Bland traded baskets, and a free throw by Watson left the Bruins ahead 58-54 at the 4:31 mark.

Bland had a tip-in 13 seconds later, and Hemsley buried a three-pointer to give Miami a 59-58 lead with 3:08 to go. Vernon Jennings and Henderson traded free throws, but Bland added two of his own to give the Hurricanes a 62-59 lead with 1:55 remaining.

Davis was the only other UCLA player in double figures, scoring 13. The Bruins shot 46 percent (24-of-52) from the field and overcame 12 missed free throws by scoring 24 points off 24 Miami turnovers.

Hemsley, who was 5-of-17 from the field, finished with 13 points and Tim James added 12 for Miami, which shot 38 percent (23-of-61) but held a 44-32 rebounding advantage, including 22-8 on the offensive end.


