***Hurricanes Set to Co-Host Miami/FIU Invitational...***

After winning the *Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic* last weekend, the University of Miami has to quickly prepare for three-straight NCAA Tournament participants from the 2008 season. Facing FIU, Middle Tennessee State and Albany (N.Y.), the Hurricanes will have their hands full against quality competition. FIU and Albany both made it to the first round of the NCAA Tournament, while Middle Tennessee State won its opening-round match and advanced to the Round of 32.

This week/weekend's action is all part of the *Miami/FIU Invitational*, with both school hosting a pair of matches at their respective facility. Miami ventures across town to face local rival FIU on Thursday, Sept. 10. The 'Canes then return home for matches against Middle Tennessee State (Sept. 11) and Albany (Sept. 12).

the University of Kansas. Junior Natalia Valentin was named tournament MVP, while seniors Isadora Rangel and Olga Vergun were selected to the All-Tournament Team. Valentin tallied 124 assists for the weekend, while Vergun and Rangel led FIU in kills with 44 and 34, respectively. Freshman Jovana Bjelica had 26, sophomore Andrea Lakovic had 25 and sophomore Sabrina Gonzalez had 17. Lakovic added a team-best nine blocks over the weekend while freshman Chanel Araujo led the Panthers in digs with 55, a performance which earned her Sun Belt Conference Defensive Player of the Week recognition.

**Quick Hits on Middle Tennessee State...**

The Middle Tennessee State Blue Raiders sit 5-2 on the season after falling in the last match, 3-0, in the championship match of the Blue Raider Bash in Murfreesboro, Tenn. They are led by Izabela Kozon in kills (96), as well as Stacy Oladinni (72). The setter for the Blue Raiders is Leslie Clark, providing a team-best 254 assists and providing defense with 39 digs and 11 blocks.

**Quick Hits on Albany...**

The University of Albany pulled even for the year at 3-3 after winning all three matches in hosting the UAlbany Volleyball Classic. The Great Danes were an NCAA Tournament participant a year ago, and have faced stiff competition already on the year. Setter Brooke Stanley leads the team with 204 assists and 65 digs as she was crowned Tournament MVP for the Great Danes. Senior outside hitter Valerie Sourbeer tops the Great Danes in kills (59) with Teresa Coppiellie just

behind her (56) in that category.

**Cassie Setting Records...Again...**

Senior libero Cassie Loessberg registered a new school record for digs in a three-set match last weekend, pulling in 39 in a 3-0 victory over Eastern Michigan. In posting a new record, she broke her own school record for that category, having previously set the bar at 23 versus UT-Arlington in 2007.

**Gallagher Provides Assistance...**

After missing the first three matches of the season, junior setter Katie Gallagher returned to the lineup for the Hurricanes at the *Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic*. On the weekend, she aided UM with 123 assists, eight kills and 26 digs through three matches. For the Winter Park, Fla. native, her 50-assists and 15-dig match against North Dakota State was the 31st double-double of her career. It was also the 15th match of her career with at least 50 assists.

**Andersson Sets School Record...**

After collecting seven service aces against Prairie View A&M, senior Maria Andersson set a new school-record for service aces in a three-set match, surpassing Kristi Sprinkel who recorded six back in 2001 against Nova Southeastern.

**Tournaments to Start it Off...**

The 'Canes are beginning this year much like the last few—with three

consecutive tournaments. They began the season hosting the Hurricane Invitational, before now embarking to Colorado for the *Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Tournament* hosted by the University of Northern Colorado. They conclude the in-season portion of the schedule sharing the *Miami/FIU Invitational* with cross-town rival FIU in both Miami and Coral Gables, respectively.

**Loessberg Digging Up the Charts...**

Senior libero/defensive specialist Cassie Loessberg is moving up the charts in Hurricanes volleyball history in several areas, including sets played (9th), assists (9th) and digs (2nd). Loessberg is just 72 digs away from passing Jamie Grass (1,621) for first place all-time.

**Mayhew Shooting for 1,000...**

Senior outside hitter Genny Mayhew is closing in on 1,000 kills as she now has 949 kills in her career. If

# Nicole Lantagne Welch

**Head Coach**  
**Ninth Year at Miami**  
**Maryland, 1994**  
**Record at Miami: 153-88**  
**Overall Record: Same**



This season marks Nicole Lantagne Welch's ninth year at the helm of the University of Miami women's volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in six

of the last eight seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

Last season, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.

The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.



Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by three seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her eight years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 18.9 wins per seasons with a career record of 151-87.

While new records were set during the 2007 campaign, the 2008 season saw even those records fall as Lantagne Welch and her staff assembled one of the best records in school history. Lantagne Welch led Miami to its best ACC record in school history. It was also the second-best record in school history on the Division I level of athletics.

Katie Gallagher moved in sole possession of second place all-time at UM for assists in a career during the 2008 season, while Cassie Loessberg placed herself in second place for digs in a career. In addition, Loessberg broke her own school record from a year ago for digs in a single-season, upping the new record to 554—besting her old school-record mark by two.

As for Gallagher, she etched her name once again as one of the Top 10 single-season assists leaders in school history. Already sitting at third place in school history from the 2007 season where she collected 1,243 assists, Gallagher added to that total with 1,202 in 2008—good enough for sixth place all-time in school history.

Freshman Lane Carico broke the freshman record for kills in a single-season for UM with 369, adding her name to 10th all-time for single-season kills. Meanwhile, Miami tied a school-record for hitting percentage in a five-set match, collecting a .329 percentage at Florida State on Nov. 26, 2008. The 'Canes would also collect the second-best single-set hitting mark in school history with a .615 clip against Boston College in the third set on Oct. 10, 2008.

Lantagne Welch would see two more student-athletes graduate following the 2008 season. Angelica Ellis and Bridget Bomhach both earned their Bachelor's Degree, while Ashley Woods completed her Master's Degree.

Woods placed her name eighth all-time in sets played (367), as well as eighth place all-time in total attacks (1,764). Ellis now ranks ninth in attacks (1,209), while also collecting the third-highest individual single-season hitting percentage (.350) from the 2008 campaign. Overall, Ellis is third in school history in career hitting percentage with a .275 clip through 318 sets and 1,209 attacks. Woods is tied for fifth in career hitting percentage, holding a .256 clip, sitting alongside Ciara Michel (2004-07).

The eighth-year head coach also coached three All-ACC Second Team members with

Lane Carico, Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. In addition, Carico and Ellis were each named as AVCA All-America honorable mention, while Carico was selected the 2008 AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico was also the true definition of "student-athlete" as she was named to the All-ACC Academic Team.

A native of Encinitas, Calif., Lantagne Welch grew up in a family where volleyball had been a major part of their livelihood. Her parents, Joe and JoAnn, owned and operated a highly regarded volleyball scouting service that evaluated high school players, covering the regions of California, Nevada and Arizona. Lantagne Welch's sister, Jenelle Duvall, was an All-American at the University of Pittsburgh and served as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona and Northern Illinois. She also served as head coach at Metro State College of Denver.

Lantagne Welch played at the University of Maryland from 1990-1993. In her role as a four-year starting setter, she guided the Terrapins to their first-ever Atlantic Coast Conference Championship (ACC) title and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament in 1990. As a top collegiate setter, Lantagne Welch garnered First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honors in 1992 and '93, and earned Second Team All-ACC accolades in 1991. She would also be named AVCA National Player of the Week (Oct. 12, 1993) following an upset victory over Florida State.

Serving as a team captain through her final two seasons, Lantagne Welch finished her outstanding collegiate career as Maryland's all-time assists, digs and matches played leader. Throughout her career in College Park, Lantagne Welch accumulated various academic honors including ACC Honor Roll and district academic All-America as a senior. She graduated in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Marketing. For her accomplishments as a student-athlete, Lantagne Welch was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference 50th Anniversary Volleyball Team along with five other Terrapins from teams of the 1990s.

Lantagne Welch arrived at Miami after serving as an assistant coach at Texas A&M. During her three seasons there, the Aggies finished ranked in the top 20 and qualified for the NCAA Tournament each season (1997-99). In 1999, Texas A&M advanced to the elite eight of the NCAA Tournament, compiling a 28-6 record and a No. 9 final ranking.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

## Hurricanes VB Media Policy

### KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

### MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

### MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

### WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based Web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Miami Sports Media Relations office at (305) 284-3244.

### INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

Telephone lines at the Knight Sports Complex are limited to home radio and the visiting teams' "official" sports administrator/media relations contact. All media wishing to file stories should contact Bryan J. Harvey prior to the conclusion of the game in order to make arrangements to be escorted back to the Sports Media Relations Office in order to work in a work-friendly environment. Any and all questions will be addressed in this designated area.

*Last Time Out - at Northern Colorado (9/5/09)...*

Miami defeated host Northern Colorado, 3-0, in a volleyball showdown Saturday night to claim the *Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Tournament* at the Butler-Hancock Pavilion in Greeley, Colorado.

Miami sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico was selected Tournament MVP after the final match of the weekend with a team-high tying nine kills. For the Manhattan Beach, Calif. native, this is the first tournament MVP award of her young career.

In the most exciting match of the entire weekend, all three sets were played vigorously by both teams as Miami (5-1) withstood late charges by Northern Colorado down the stretch of each set.

Miami opened the match with a 7-1 advantage on the strength of two kills from Carico and another from Ali Becker. North Dakota State (5-3) used two kills from Kenzie Shreeve and another from Taylor Smith to storm back and knot the set, 13-13.

A kill from Nrithya Sundararaman and Lici McGee broke what was just a one-point advantage six times for UM, allowing the Hurricanes to move out in front, 20-18. Another kill from McGee, and the 'Canes opened up a 24-20 lead, good enough for McGee to post another kill and give UM the opening-set victory, 25-23.

In the second set, neither team cracked the .200 mark for hitting, but Miami rode McGee, Becker and Carico with three kills each.

The 'Canes opened a 7-4 lead following back-to-back attack errors charged to the Bears. UM would push the advantage to 20-15 when Northern Colorado committed four errors in a five-point stretch—added a kill from Mayhew.

The set was tied 24-24 when setter Katie Gallagher provided a kill for Miami to push the Hurricanes in front

late. A bad set by Northern Colorado's Natalie Laband, and Miami held on for the win, 26-24.

With UM holding a 2-0 edge in the match, the third set was a back-and-forth affair until Northern Colorado was aided by back-to-back errors by the 'Canes to take a 10-8 advantage in the set. Miami's Genny Mayhew then added a kill and combined for a block alongside McGee to tie the match, 10-10.

The Bears went up again, this time at 14-11, as Shreeve posted a kill off a Marissa Hughes set. But the 'Canes came right back to knot the set, 14-14, as Sundararaman and McGee combined for kills in a 3-0 stretch.

Sundararaman, a freshman setter/right side hitter from Naperville, Illinois, then helped put UM on top for the first time in the match on the strength of a 3-0 run as she collected a kill and combined with Becker to take an 18-15 lead.

Northern Colorado came back to tie the match, 20-20, as Kelley Arnold stamped a kill and Allison Raguse served an ace.

The set became tied for the 13th time when Carico had an attack error to allow the Bears to score a 24-24 tie.

Blocks from Becker and Gallagher—the fifth of the set for Becker, put Miami on top, 25-24. It would only be fitting for Carico to record the final kill of the tournament in helping the Hurricanes to collect a 26-24 win in the set.

Mayhew was instrumental for the Hurricanes in the set as well, collecting four kills while teammate McGee posted three of her own.

With the win, Miami took its first in-season tournament championship of the season after falling in the championship match of the Hurricane Invitational last weekend. UM has now won three consecutive out-of-state in-season tournaments—the last being the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational last year in San Francisco.

Northern Colorado was led on the night by Shreeve with a match-high 14 kills, and Arnold added another 11 to place her in double-digits. Breanna Vandermost led the squad with 11 digs on the defensive side of things.

Miami was led by three players with nine kills each. The three 'Canes included Carico, Mayhew and McGee. Becker led all players with six blocks (assisted), and Sundararaman added five kills and four blocks (assisted).

Senior Cassie Loessberg led all players with a match-high 17 digs, while Gallagher added 29 assists, six digs, three blocks and three kills.

Joining Carico on the All-Tournament Team for Miami was Becker and Loessberg.
