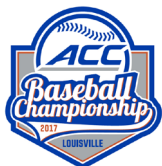

2017 ACC CHAMPIONSHIP STORY LINES & NEWS

- #6 seed Miami will open the postseason May 23 vs. #10 seed Georgia Tech at the 2017 ACC Championship in Louisville, Ky.
- Freshman righthander **Evan McKendry** (4-2, 3.24 ERA) will start Tuesday opposite Georgia Tech's **Jake Lee** (4-2, 5.51).
- UM is 19-19 all-time in the ACC Championship, having won two games in each of the last two tournaments in Durham, N.C.
- The Canes have one ACC Championship (2008) all-time and have made two Championship appearances (2008, 2012).
- Head coach **Jim Morris** has the **fifth-most wins** in Division I history (1,564), the **third-most** wins among active coaches, a **.695** winning percentage (**sixth** among active coaches), and **183** more wins than the next active coach - Mike Fox of UNC.
- The Hurricanes made their **25th trip to the College World Series in 2016**, finishing with a 50-14 record and a 21-9 mark in ACC play. Miami was the No. 3 national seed for the postseason, and won the **2016 ACC Regular Season Championship**.

3 JIM MORRIS HEAD COACH

THE HURRICANES SKIPPER

- 1999 & 2001 National Coach of the Year (*Collegiate Baseball*)

It doesn't matter if his roster is full of rookies or veterans, University of Miami head coach Jim Morris continues to produce some of college baseball's most consistent and dominant teams entering his 24th season in Coral Gables. With a talented staff around him, Morris' Hurricanes are continually the class of collegiate baseball, having won national titles in 1999 and 2001 and the ACC Baseball Regular Season Championship in 2008, 2014 and 2016.

In his 23-season tenure at Miami, no program has qualified for the College World Series as much as Morris and his Hurricanes. Miami, which has qualified for the NCAA Tournament a college baseball-record 44 consecutive years, has made it to Omaha in 13 of Morris' 23 seasons in Coral Gables - including most recently in 2016, when Miami was awarded the No. 3 national seed for the NCAA postseason.

Morris set an NCAA record for guiding a program to the CWS in each of his first six years at UM. In addition, Morris has won 17 of 23 NCAA Regional appearances at UM, including a record 13 straight to start his tenure in Coral Gables. His teams have qualified for NCAA Regionals for the last 32 years - all 23 at Miami and his final nine at Georgia Tech.

A three-time national coach of the year and 2008 Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year, Morris has directed the Hurricanes to a 1,060-445-3 (.707) mark since arriving in 1994. Including his 12 seasons at Georgia Tech (1982-93), Morris has forged a 1,564-689-4 (.695) Division I record in 35 years as a head coach. Overall, Morris has been the head coach at the collegiate level for 39 seasons, spending the first four at DeKalb (Ga.) C.C. from 1976-79, and has recorded a 1,695-728-4 (.701) mark.

In addition to carrying on Miami's great baseball reputation in the last 23 years, Morris personally led the charge in the construction of Alex Rodriguez Park, and logged hundreds of hours raising funds for the stadium's renovation prior to its reopening in 2009.

Morris reached two coaching milestones in 2016, as he led the program to its 25th College World Series appearance in history, its third straight ACC Coastal Division title and the program's second ACC Regular Season Championship in a three-year span.

Morris became just the sixth coach in the history of Division I baseball to reach the 1,500-win plateau when Miami topped Louisville 8-4 in dramatic fashion on March 18, 2016. Eight days later, Miami topped Clemson 5-4 in 11 innings - also in walk-off fashion - to send Morris to his 1,000th win at the helm of the Hurricanes.

Under his direction, the Hurricanes set the program record for fielding percentage with a sparkling .983 mark in 2016, a figure that ranked best nationwide. Seven Hurricanes were selected in the 2016 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, including the program's first first-round selection since 2010 in catcher Zack Collins (No. 10, Chicago White Sox). Morris also helped guide two Hurricanes to a pair of major awards: Collins became the first Hurricane to win the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher in 2016, while Bryan Garcia set the program saves record and became the first Hurricane to win the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award.

Morris entered 2015 as among the winningest active coaches in Division I baseball with 1,435 wins. He wasted little time in moving up the record books, moving into sole



possession of eighth place in all-time wins (1,439) on Feb. 15 with a 25-4 win over Rutgers and then seventh place with a 9-5 win over Louisville on March 7 (1,445).

Miami captured the 2014 ACC Regular Season Championship under his watch, recording 24 wins in conference play for the first time in program history.

Morris reached two coaching milestones in the first half of the 2014 season. He became just the eighth Division I coach to reach 1,400 wins in a 5-2 win over Boston College on March 8, and won his 900th game at Miami in a 7-1 upset of No. 3 Virginia on March 22.

CANES OPEN POSTSEASON PLAY IN LOUISVILLE

- After sweeping its final regular season series with Virginia Tech, No. 6-seeded Miami will open its run at the **2017 ACC Championship** on Tuesday, May 23 vs. 10th-seeded Georgia Tech at 11 a.m. (RSN).
- The Hurricanes, Yellow Jackets and third-seeded Wake Forest are all members of **Pool C**; Miami plays the Demon Deacons on Thursday at 3 p.m., while Wake Forest and Tech square off Wednesday at 7 p.m.
- The winner of Pool C advances to Saturday's semifinal round, with games being played at 1 p.m. and 5 p.m. Sunday's ACC Championship Game is set for 1 p.m. and will be broadcast on ESPN2.
- Miami **has not missed the ACC Championship** since joining the conference prior to 2005; UM's lone ACC title came in **2008**. UM went **2-1** as the No. 1 seed at the **2016 ACC Championship**; its last title game appearance came in **2012**, an 8-5 loss to Georgia Tech.
- Freshman righthander **Evan McKendry** (4-2, 3.24 ERA) will start Tuesday opposite Georgia Tech righthander **Jake Lee** (4-2, 5.51 ERA).
- Junior lefthander **Jeb Bargfeldt** (7-3, 2.20 ERA) is expected to start Thursday afternoon; Wake Forest's starting pitcher is **TBA**.

WEEK IN REVIEW: PERFECT IN FINAL STRETCH

- Thanks in large part to dominant starting pitching, the Hurricanes won all four games of a season-ending homestand to end with momentum heading into the 2017 ACC Championship.
- Freshman righthander **Evan McKendry** had the best outing of his young career to lead Miami past FGCU, **5-1**, Tuesday, May 16.
- Making the sixth start of his career, McKendry set a **career high** with **10 strikeouts** in a **career-long-tying seven innings** Tuesday. He allowed just two hits and two walks across 102 pitches.
- Junior lefthander **Jeb Bargfeldt** allowed one run in 7.0 innings, freshman **Greg Veliz** allowed one run in 8.0 innings, and junior **Jesse Lepore** allowed two runs in 5.0 innings.
- Over the four games, UM's starting rotation compiled for a **1.33 ERA** in 27.0 innings with **31 strikeouts** compared to just five walks.

HEATING UP: RUIZ, CHESTER IMPRESSING

- Junior **Carl Chester** has been Miami's top performer at the plate for the last two weeks and is riding a **nine-game hitting streak** into Tuesday's Championship opener. Over that stretch, he is batting .417 (15-for-36) with five doubles, 11 runs and a .488 on-base percentage.
- Senior **Johnny Ruiz**, has also been one of Miami's top performers over the last three weekends since returning to the starting lineup with an elbow nag. Ruiz has batted **.343** over those 11 games with 12 hits, two doubles, two home runs and a team-best nine RBI.
- Miami lefthander **Jeb Bargfeldt** has been the most consistent weekend starter for the Canes. In nine ACC starts, Bargfeldt is **6-2** with a **1.63 ERA**. He is holding ACC opponents to a **.172 average**.

UNC SNAPS STREAK OF UM COASTAL CROWNS

- Miami won its **third straight ACC Coastal Division title** in 2016, posting a **21-7 record in ACC play** to earn the division crown.
- North Carolina clinched the 2017 Coastal Division crown in a series against Virginia Tech (May 12-14), snapping the impressive run.
- Since the beginning of the **2014** season, Miami has won **29 of its past 40 ACC series**. The Hurricanes went **8-2** in ACC series in **2014**, **7-3** in **2015**, **9-1** in **2016** and were **5-4-1** in **2017**.

• In his first season serving as closer, sophomore **Frankie Bartow** ranks **fourth** in the ACC with **12 saves**.

ROMY POWERING OFFENSE IN YEAR 2

• Sophomore infielder **Romy Gonzalez** leads Miami in **home runs** (11), **RBI** (36) and **slugging percentage** (.469), and ranks second in **doubles** (8) and **steals** (13).

JEB! SHINING IN YEAR 1 AT MIAMI

• Junior **Jeb Bargfeldt** has been among Miami's top performers this season in his first year as a Hurricane. He was named a **Second Team All-ACC pitcher** on Monday before the ACC Championship.

- Bargfeldt has a **team-best 2.20 ERA** and has made 14 starts, all as a member of the weekend rotation. He is holding opponents to a .192 average, allowing just 20 earned runs in 82.0 innings.
- Bargfeldt has been particularly impressive in ACC play; he has compiled a **1.63 ERA** and a **6-2 record** in 10 conference starts, surrendering just 11 earned runs in 60.2 innings.
- The Owasso, Okla., native, whose father is the head softball coach at Tulsa, has the **fourth-lowest ERA in the ACC** (2.20) and the **lowest ERA** of any starter in conference play (1.63).

• No school in the ACC has had **more players drafted than Miami**, which has seen **280** players picked into the professional ranks - including seven in 2016. Since 1990, UM has produced **179 draft picks** - 25 more than the next-highest ACC total (154, Clemson).

ONE OF THE GAME'S TOP SKIPPERS

• Jim Morris' **1,564** wins at the Division I level are **fifth-most** in the history of college baseball and **third-most** among active skippers.

• Morris reached two major milestones in 2016 - he became the **fifth coach** to reach **1,500** wins on March 18 against Louisville and won his **1,000th game at Miami** on March 26 vs. Clemson.
