

MIDWEEK STORY LINES & NEWS

- The Miami Hurricanes will go for a season sweep of FAU on Wednesday, April 19 at Mark Light Field (ACC Network Extra).
- The Canes lead the all-time series with the Owls by a commanding 60-14 margin, and won the first two games of the season series in 2017 - a 5-2 win on the road in Boca Raton on March 1 and a 7-5 win at Mark Light Field on March 22.
- Freshman righthander Evan McKendry (2-1, 3.99 ERA) will start for Miami opposite FAU's Sean Labsan (1-1, 6.44 ERA)
- Sophomore Romy Gonzalez leads Miami with 10 multi-hit games, eight multi-RBI games, six home runs and 24 RBI.
- Senior Randy Batista has reached base in 15 straight games entering Wednesday's game vs. FAU, a career-long streak.
- Head coach Jim Morris has the fifth-most wins in Division I history (1,552), the third-most wins among active coaches, a
 .695 winning percentage (sixth among active coaches), and 187 more wins than the next active coach Mike Fox of UNC.
- The Hurricanes had four different players earn Preseason All-America recognition; Michael Mediavilla, Jesse Lepore and Johnny Ruiz were recognized by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper while Carl Chester was honored by Baseball America.
- The Hurricanes made their 25th trip to the College World Series in 2016, finishing with a 50-14 record and a 21-9 mark in ACC play. Miami was the No. 3 national seed for the postseason, and won the 2016 ACC Regular Season Championship.
- The Canes had **seven** players selected in the 2016 MLB Draft, including Chicago White Sox' first-round pick **Zack Collins.**



THE HURRICANES SKIPPER

It doesn't matter if his roster is full of rookies or veterans. University of Miami head coach Jim Morris continues to produce some of college baseball's most consistent and dominant teams entering his 24th season in Coral Gables. With a talented staff around him, Morris' Hurricanes are continually the class of collegiate baseball, having won national titles in 1999 and 2001 and the ACC Baseball Regular Season Championship in 2008, 2014 and 2016.

In his 23-season tenure at Miami, no program has qualified for the College World Series as much as Morris and his Hurricanes. Miami, which has qualified for the NCAA Tournament a college baseball-record 44 consecutive years, has made it to Omaha in 13 of Morris' 23 seasons in Coral Gables - including most recently in 2016, when Miami was awarded the No. 3 national seed for the NCAA postseason.

Morris set an NCAA record for guiding a program to the CWS in each of his first six years at UM. In addition, Morris has won 17 of 23 NCAA Regional appearances at UM, including a record 13 straight to start his tenure in Coral Gables. His teams have qualified for NCAA Regionals for the last 32 years - all 23 at Miami and his final nine at Georgia Tech.

A three-time national coach of the year and 2008 Atlantic Coast Conference Coach of the Year, Morris has directed the Hurricanes to a 1,048-438-3 (.707) mark since arriving in 1994. Including his 12 seasons at Georgia Tech (1982-93), Morris has forged a 1,552-682-4 (.695) Division I record in 35 years as a head coach. Overall, Morris has been the head coach at the collegiate level for 39 seasons, spending the first four at DeKalb (Ga.) C.C. from 1976-79, and has recorded a 1,683-721-4 (.701) mark.

In addition to carrying on Miami's great baseball reputation in the last 23 years, Morris personally led the charge in the construction of Alex Rodriguez Park, and logged hundreds of hours raising funds for the stadium's renovation prior to its reopening in 2009.

Morris reached two coaching milestones in 2016, as he led the program to its 25th College World Series appearance in history, its third straight ACC Coastal Division title and the program's second ACC Regular Season Championship in a three-year span.

Morris became just the sixth coach in the history of Division I baseball to reach the 1,500-win plateau when Miami topped Louisville 8-4 in dramatic fashion on March 18, 2016. Eight days later, Miami topped Clemson 5-4 in 11 innings - also in walk-off fashion to send Morris to his 1,000th win at the helm of the Hurricanes.

Under his direction, the Hurricanes set the program record for fielding percentage with a sparkling .983 mark in 2016, a figure that ranked best nationwide. Seven Hurricanes were selected in the 2016 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, including the program's first first-round selection since 2010 in catcher Zack Collins (No. 10, Chicago White Sox). Morris also helped guide two Hurricanes to a pair of major awards: Collins became the first Hurricane to win the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher in 2016, while Bryan Garcia set the program saves record and became the first Hurricane to win the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award.

Morris entered 2015 as among the winningest active coaches in Division I baseball with 1,435 wins. He wasted little time in moving up the record books, moving into sole



possession of eighth place in all-time wins (1,439) on Feb. 15 with a 25-4 win over Rutgers and then seventh place with a 9-5 win over Louisville on March 7 (1,445).

Miami captured the 2014 ACC Regular Season Championship under his watch, recording 24 wins in conference play for the first time in program history.

Morris reached two coaching milestones in the first half of the 2014 season. He became just the eighth Division I coach to reach 1,400 wins in a 5-2 win over Boston College on March 8, and won his 900th game at Miami in a 7-1 upset of No. 3 Virginia on March 22.

Among the players Morris coached at Miami that have gone on to play in the Major Leagues are Peter O'Brien (Kansas City), Chris Hermann (Arizona), Yasmani Grandal (Los Angeles Dodgers), Jemile Weeks (Boston), Danny Valencia (Oakland), Jon Jay (Chicago), Yonder Alonso (Oakland), Ryan Braun (Milwaukee), Ryan Jackson (St. Louis), Pat Burrell (Philadelphia), Alex Cora (New York Mets), Bobby Hill (San Diego), Aubrey Huff (Detroit), Chris Perez (Cleveland), Cesar Carrillo (San Diego), Brian Barton (St. Louis), Gaby Sanchez (Florida), Charlton Jimerson (Houston), Jay Tessmer (New York Yankees), Danny Graves (Cincinnati) and Jason Michaels (Houston), among many others. From his days at Georgia Tech include Nomar Garciaparra (Los Angeles), Jay Payton (Oakland) and Jason Varitek (Boston).

Morris has also enjoyed success on the international scene. From 1989-90. Morris served as head coach of the USA Baseball team that won a Silver Medal in the 1989 Presidential Cup (Taiwan), Bronze Medal at the Goodwill Games and the 1990 International Baseball Association (IBA) World All-Star Game in Atlanta.

MIAMI GOING FOR SEASON SWEEP OF FAU

- After winning the **first two head-to-head matchups** of 2017, the Hurricanes will look for a three-game **season sweep** of **FAU** Wednesday night at Mark Light Field (ACC Network Extra).
- The Hurricanes **topped FAU 5-3** in Boca Raton in their first midweek game of 2017 on **March 1**, and captured the season series with a **7-5 win** at Mark Light Field in Game 2 on **March 22**.
- Junior **Carl Chester** leads UM with a .**571** average in two games vs. FAU this season (4-for-7). He has **two homers**, three RBI, three runs, a 1.429 slugging percentage and a .667 on-base against the Owls.
- Miami freshman righthander **Evan McKendry** (2-1, 3.99 ERA) will Wednesday opposite FAU's **Sean Labsan** (1-1, 6.44 ERA).

WEEKEND REWIND: UM WINS SERIES AT PITT

- The Hurricanes won their **second straight series** this past weekend at Charles L. Cost Field, taking **two of three games** against host **Pittsburgh** in an ACC Coastal Division matchup.
- Due to a forecast of inclement weather, Miami played a **doubleheader** Friday and the series finale Saturday. The Hurricanes dropped Game 1 (3-10) but **won Game 2** (1-0) and **Game 3** (5-3).
- Redshirt senior **Edgar Michelangeli** led the offense with a 5-hit, two-home run, four-RBI weekend in the Steel City. He batted .**417** and scored three runs to lead the Hurricanes over three games.
- Miami received strong starts on the hill from **Jeb Bargfeldt** (5.0 shutout innings) and **Michael Mediavilla** (5.2 innings, one run) on short rest, while **Frankie Bartow** earned back-to-back saves vs. Pitt.

HEATING UP: BATISTA, CABEZAS IMPRESSING

- Senior **Randy Batista** has been among Miami's top offensive performers of late, and has reached base in **his last 15 games**. Over that stretch, he is batting a **team-best .302** with a **.483** on-base.
- Miami lefthander **Jeb Bargfeldt** has been the most consistent weekend starter for the Hurricanes. In six ACC starts, Bargfeldt is **3-1** with a **1.19 ERA**. He is holding ACC opponents to a **.184 average**.
- Sophomore **Andrew Cabezas** has been among Miami's top performers out of the bullpen this season. In the last 11 games, he has made a team-high six appearances and totaled **11 strikeouts compared to three walks** in 8.0 combined innings with a 1.12 ERA.
- Freshman **Greg Veliz' .152 average against** is lowest of any pitcher in the ACC, and his **2.41 ERA** is **eighth-best** conference-wide.

LOOKING FOR A FOUR-PEAT

- Miami won its **third straight ACC Coastal Division title** in 2016, posting a **21-7 record in ACC play** to earn the division crown.
- The Hurricanes have won 67 ACC games in the prior three seasons the most wins in a three-year stretch by any program since ACC expanded to a 30-game conference schedule in 2005.
- Miami has won the ACC Regular Season Championship three times, most recently in **2016** when the Canes finished **21-7**; UM **won the ACC regular season crown & ACC Tournament in 2008**.
- The Hurricanes have won **four ACC Coastal Division titles** (2008, 2014, 2015, 2016) in history and **one ACC Championship** (2008).
- Since the beginning of the **2014** season, Miami has won **27 of its past 36 ACC series**. The Hurricanes went **8-2** in ACC series in **2014**, **7-3** in **2015**, **9-1** in **2016** and are **3-3** in **2017**.

SHUT IT DOWN

• In his first season serving as closer, sophomore **Frankie Bartow** ranks **fourth** in the ACC with **eight saves**, including two vs. Pitt.

ROMY POWERING OFFENSE

• Sophomore infielder **Romy Gonzalez** leads Miami in **doubles** (7). home runs (6), RBI (24), slugging percentage (.463) and steals (10)

BARGFELDT SHINING IN YEAR 1 AT MIAMI

- Junior **Jeb Bargfeldt** has been among Miami's top performers this season in his first year as a Hurricane. He transferred to UM after spending 2015 at Wichita State and 2016 at Cisco College (TX).
- Bargfeldt has a **team-best 1.69 ERA** and has made nine starts, all as a member of the weekend rotation. He is holding opponents to a .199 average, allowing just nine earned runs in 48.0 innings, and has **not allowed a run** in the last **18.1 innings** (4th, March 25 at UNC).
- Bargfeldt has been particularly impressive in ACC play; he has compiled a 1.19 ERA and a 3-1 record in six conference starts, surrendering just four earned runs in 30.1 innings.
- The Owasso, Okla., native, whose father is the head softball coach at Tulsa, has the **third-lowest ERA in the ACC** (1.69) and the **lowest ERA** in conference play (1.19).

MIAMI IS #MLBU

• No school in the ACC has had more players drafted than Miami, which has seen 280 players picked into the professional ranks including seven in 2016. Since the 1990 season, Miami has produced **179 draft picks** - 25 more than the next-highest total (154, Clemson).

ONE OF THE GAME'S TOP SKIPPERS

- Jim Morris' 1,552 wins at the Division I level are fifth-most in the history of college baseball and **third-most** among active skippers.
- Morris reached two major milestones in 2016 he became the **fifth coach** to reach **1,500** wins on March 18 against Louisville and won his 1,000th game at Miami on March 26 vs. Clemson.

WELCOME TO THE LIGHT!

- Miami has made College World Series trips in back-to-back seasons (2015 and 2016) thanks in large part to its dominant play inside the confines of Alex Rodriguez Park at Mark Light Field.
- Since the start of the 2015 season, Miami is a whopping **81-17** in its last 98 home games. Miami finished 36-5 at home in 2015 and **34-6** at home in 2016. The Hurricanes went **13-2 in ACC play** at The Light in 2015 and **12-3 at home in ACC** play in 2016.

OFFENSE SPARKS SERIES WIN VS. JACKETS

- Miami had 37 hits against the Yellow Jackets in its first ACC series win. The Hurricanes totaled 23 walks, reached base at a .486 clip as a team, and slugged .532 to win their third straight series against Georgia Tech dating to 2015.
- Miami's 37 hits agains Georgia Tech were more than its combined total in the **previous seven games** (36). UM had double-digit hit totals in each game - 10 in Game 1, 12 in Game 2 and 15 in Game 3.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS

• UM was ranked in the **top 25 in three preseason polls**: **#8** by Collegiate Baseball, **#17** in the Coaches Poll and **#21** from D1Baseball.

DESTINATION: OMAHA

- Miami made its second straight trip to the **College World Series** in **2016**. marking the program's 25th all-time trip to Omaha. Neb.
- Miami's 25 College World Series trips are the second-most of any program in the country. The Hurricanes have won 48 games in the College World Series, the fourth-most of any program; Miami's four national championships rank fifth-most.
- Since the NCAA began award national seeds prior to 1999, Miami has been **among the top eight seven seasons: 1999** (#1), **2001** (#2), **2003** (#8), **2004** (#3), **2008** (#1), **2015** (#5) and **2016** (#3).

FOUR TO WATCH

- Four Hurricanes picked up 2017 Preseason All-America honors: junior outfielder **Carl Chester**. junior righthander **Jesse Lepore**, junior lefthander **Michael Mediavilla** and senior infielder **Johnny Ruiz**.
- Chester, a *Baseball America* Preseason All-America third-team selection, was among 55 players named to the initial watch list for the **2017 Golden Spikes Award** by USA Baseball on Feb. 15.
- Sophomore reliever **Frankie Bartow**, who was recognized as a Louisville Slugger Freshman All America last season, was named to the watch list for the **2017 Stopper of the Year Award** by NCBWA; former closer Bryan Garcia won the prestigious award in 2016.
- UM had three All-Americans in 2016: **Zack Collins** (several publications), **Garcia** (NCBWA) & **Mediavilla** (ABCA/Rawlings).

DEATH. TAXES & THE NCAA POSTSEASON

- The Miami Hurricanes extended their own college baseball record with a **44th consecutive trip to the NCAA postseason** in 2016. Miami has made the postseason each year since 1973.
- The Hurricanes' 44 straight trips to the NCAA postseason are the **longest active postseason streak of any Division I program** in any sport nationwide.
- Miami's **25 College World Series trips** are the second-most of any program all-time, trailing only Texas.
- Jim Morris has led teams to the NCAA postseason in **32 straight** years all **23 years at Miami** & final nine years at Georgia Tech.
- Miami is the **only school in the state of Florida** to have won a **national championship**; UM won titles in **1982**, **1985**, **1999** & **2001**.
