THE GAME

► Miami embarks upon a new era in its football history when the Hurricanes host the Charleston Southern Buccaneers for their first game in their new home - Dolphin Stadium. It will be the first game between the two schools.

► Miami won its season opener over Marshall, 31-3, last season, snapping a two-game losing skid in openers. The Hurricanes had won nine straight season openers before falling to rival Florida State in 2005 and 2006.

► Head coach Randy Shannon enters his second season at the helm of the Hurricane program. He returns 48 letterwinners including 11 starters. Miami welcomes 33 newcomers. The 2008 signing class ranked No. 1 in the country by ESPN.com.

► The Hurricanes return one of the top offensive lines in the country led by offensive tackle Jason Fox. That line combined with running back duo junior Javarris James and sophomore Graig Cooper finished third in rushing in the Atlantic Coast Conference last season. Cooper is the team's leading returning rusher as he gained 682 yards on 125 carries and averaged 5.5 yards per carry. His 682 yards ranked third on the school's all-time true freshman rushing list and fourth nationally in rushing among true freshmen last season. James gained 582 yards on 159 attempts and scored four touchdowns.

► Defensively, UM returns junior linebacker Colin McCarthy, who ranked fifth on the team in tackles in 2007. He played in 11 games and tied for the team-lead with 12 tackles for loss while finishing with 74 tackles. Miami's defense gets a boost with the return of senior linebacker Glenn Cook, who missed the 2007 season after starting 11 of 12 games in 2006. Four regular starters return in defensive end Eric Moncur, McCarthy and defensive backs Bruce Johnson and DeMarcus Van Dyke.

THE OPPONENT

► Charleston Southern is a member of the Big South Conference and a FCS (Football Championship Subdivision (formerly I-AA)) school. The Buccaneers are coming off a season in which the team won at least five games for the fourth straight season in 2007 finishing 5-6. Three of CSU's top four receivers return, including All-Big South selection Dee Brown, who recorded 898 yards and nine touchdowns in 2007. Defensively, all-conference defensive linemen Jake Killeen and Justin Witzmann return. CSU has 44 players from the state of Florida on its roster.

THE SERIES

► This is the first ever meeting between Miami and Charleston Southern.

THE COACHES

► Randy Shannon is 5-7 after one season at Miami. Charleston Southern's Jay Mills is 27-28 in five seasons with the Buccaneers.

DID YOU KNOW?

► Of the 23 seniors on this year's squad, 13 have already earned degrees, while the remaining 10 are all on course to graduate either in December of 2008 or May of 2009.

► Last Spring, the NCAA released its annual Academic Progress Report (APR) and the Hurricane football team scored a 969, the eighth-highest mark out of the 119 Bowl Sub-division football programs. Miami's score - also the third-highest mark in the 12-team Atlantic Coast Conference - put the team in the 80th-90th percentile nationally based on its performance in the classroom.

► Miami will start a freshman quarterback for the first time since 1983. Bernie Kosar started as a redshirt freshman in 1983.

A HURRICANES VICTORY OVER THE BUCCANEERS WOULD

► Give Miami their second straight season opening win under Randy Shannon and the team's first win as a tenant in its new home – Dolphin Stadium.

HURRICANES EXCELLING IN THE CLASS ROOM

► Miami's APR score in 2008 was a slight improvement over its mark of 966 in 2007 when the team was ranked 10th nationally in academic success.

► Of the 23 seniors on this year's squad, 13 have already earned degrees, while the remaining 10 are all on course to graduate either in December of 2008 or May of 2009.

► The 13 players that have already earned degrees include: Carlos Armour (Sports Administration), Tyrone Byrd (Liberal Arts), Glenn Cook (Marketing and Business Management, Sports Management master's candidate), Romeo Davis (Liberal Arts), Dwayne Hendricks (Business Management), Khalil Jones (Sports Administration), Joe Joseph (Sports Administration), Eric Moncur (Liberal Arts), Anthony Reddick (Liberal Arts), Chris Rutledge (Liberal Arts), Xavier Shannon (Enrollment Management master's candidate), Derron Thomas (Sports Administration) and Chris Zellner (Geography).

► Last season, Miami had 12 early graduates - the second-highest total nationally behind fellow ACC member Boston College and in 2006, Miami had an ACC-high eight players named to the All-ACC Academic Football Team.

Miami's fall semester begins Wednesday, Aug. 27, one day before the Hurricanes open the season against Charleston Southern at 7:30 p.m. at Dolphin Stadium.

HURRICANES AT DOLPHIN STADIUM

► Miami is a perfect 3-0 in games played in Dolphin Stadium. UM defeated Virginia, 31-21, in the Carquest Bowl in 1996; NC State, 46-23, in 1998 in the Micron PC Bowl and Florida State, 16-14, in the 2003 Orange Bowl.

JAMES ON MAXWELL WATCH LIST

► Junior running back Javarris James has been named to the 2008 watch list for the Maxwell Award presented to the outstanding collegiate football player in America since 1937 and is named in honor of Robert W. "Tiny" Maxwell. Semifinalists for the Maxwell and Bednarik Awards will be announced in early November and three finalists for each award will be announced November 25th.

MONCUR ON HENDRICKS WATCH LIST

► Senior defensive end Eric Moncur is on the preseason watch list for the 2008 Ted Hendricks Defensive End of the Year Award. Previous recipients of the Hendricks Award include: Terrell Suggs (Arizona State), David Pollack (Georgia), Elvis Dumervil (Louisville), LaMarr Woodley (Michigan) and Chris Long (Virginia).

► The Ted Hendricks Defensive End of the Year Award is named in honor of college football's first three-time first-team All-American. As a defensive end at the University of Miami, Ted used his agility, height and reach to block passes and kicks, force interceptions and pressure quarterbacks and running backs. He roamed the front line, read plays and blitzed on impulse, completely transforming the way the defensive end position was played. His professional career spanned 15 years and 215 consecutive games. It included four Super Bowl victories, eight Pro Bowl selections and inductions into the College and Pro Football Halls of Fame. It is in the spirit of Ted Hendricks' aggressive style of play, winning attitude and determination that the Defensive End of the Year Award for college football's premier defensive end is presented.

HOPING FOR FRESHMAN DEJA VU

► Redshirt freshman quarterback Robert Marve has been named the starter and true freshman Jacory Harris will back Marve up as well as play. Harris will start the opener for the Hurricanes against Charleston Southern, making it the first time since the 1983 season that a freshman started the first game of the season and a redshirt freshman was named the starting quarterback. Bernie Kosar started the 1983 opener at Florida and finished his first collegiate game 24-of-45 for 223 yards and three interceptions as UF beat UM, 28-3, on Sept. 13, 1983 in Gainesville. Miami finished 11-1 on the season winning its first national title.

Game Day Press Policies

Only working press will be admitted to the Dolphin Stadium press box. Seats will be issued according to the following criteria:

1. State newspapers by circulation, wire services, national publications, newspapers from opponent's area, and student newspapers from UM and opponent's schools.
2. Other daily newspapers, with preference to those that regularly cover UM.
3. Radio and television personnel not broadcasting, but considered reporting.
4. Non-daily newspapers, with preference to those which regularly cover UM.
5. Scouts. Freelance and/or non-daily writers may be asked to produce copies of actual publications in which their work has appeared. In some cases, these materials will be required as verification of the writers' status.

Conference Road Game Credentials

Writers covering UM on a regular basis should make all requests for conference road credentials directly with the home team.

Non-Conference Road Game Credentials

Writers covering UM on a regular basis may make requests for non-conference road credentials with the UM Sports Information Office. Credential requests are faxed to the opponent school by Monday two weeks prior to the contest.

TWO NEW COACHES ON 2008 STAFF

► Randy Shannon's 2008 team has two new assistant coaches – defensive coordinator Bill Young and wide receivers coach Aubrey Hill.

► **Bill Young, Defensive Coordinator** – Young is a 39-year coaching veteran, with 21 seasons as a defensive coordinator. He has been a defensive coordinator at Tulsa, Ohio State, Oklahoma, Southern California and most recently at Kansas, where the Jayhawks finished the 2007 season 12-1 with a victory in the Orange Bowl over Virginia Tech with a defense that ranked 12th in the nation. Young also had a one-year stint in the NFL.

► Under Young's guidance, the 2007 Kansas defense ranked fourth nationally in scoring defense (16.3 points per game) and turnovers gained (35), eighth in run defense (94.8 yards per game) and ninth in pass efficiency defense (105.3). It featured All-American cornerback Aqib Talib. Young was defensive coordinator at Kansas for six seasons under Mark Mangini. In 2006, Kansas finished third in the Big 12 and 28th in the nation in rushing defense (109.0 yards per game), as it held four opponents to under 70 yards of rushing and limited all opponents to a fourth-down conversion rate of less than 25 percent. Young was defensive line coach with the Detroit Lions in 2001. Prior to his stint in the NFL, he worked three seasons as defensive coordinator at Southern California under Paul Hackett. While at USC in 1999, his defense led the nation in total takeaways and topped the conference in rushing defense and turnover margin (third nationally). His USC defense in 1998 was No. 1 in the Pac-10 in total defense, pass efficiency defense (third nationally) and scoring defense. It was also ranked second in the country in forced turnovers.

► In addition to his three years at USC, his stints as defensive coordinator came at Tulsa in 1983-84, Ohio State from 1988-95 and Oklahoma in 1996-97.

► During his 27 years in college coaching, Young has helped elevate 31 players to the NFL. Prior to his college coaching career, Young spent six seasons on the prep level at two high schools in Oklahoma. He played outside linebacker and defensive end at Oklahoma State from 1965-67 and led the Cowboys in interceptions in 1965. He was an academic All-Big Eight selection as a senior in 1967 and earned his bachelor's degree in education that year. He then went on to earn his master's degree in secondary education at Central Oklahoma in 1971. He is married to Lawana Young.

► **Aubrey Hill, Wide Receivers Coach** – Hill played and coached in Steve Spurrier's "Fun 'n Gun" offense at Florida. He was a standout receiver at Florida from 1991-94 before moving into the coaching ranks. He spent the last three years on the Pittsburgh coaching staff, where he tutored first-team All-Big East performers with Greg Lee in 2005 and Derek Kinder in 2006 and a freshman All-America in Oderick Turner in 2006. In 2004 Hill coached at NCAA I-AA Elon (N.C.) University as receivers coach. Prior to that he was the receivers coach at Duke for five seasons and also served in a pair of NFL coaching internships.

► As a player, Hill helped Florida to a four-year record of 43-10-1 (.806) and three SEC championships. He totaled 86 receptions and 18 touchdowns during his career and caught a touchdown every 4.78 catches, the third best TD ratio in Gators history. He was a team captain as a senior in 1994. Following his playing career, Hill served as a Florida graduate assistant from 1996-98. In his first season as an assistant, Florida captured the national championship with a 12-1 mark, capped by a 52-20 victory over Florida State in the Sugar Bowl.

► During his three years on the Florida staff, the Gators went a combined 32-5 (.865). Hill earned his first full-time appointment at Duke, where he served as receivers coach from 1999-2003. He was instrumental in the development of Scottie Montgomery, who finished his collegiate career ranked second in career receptions (171) and third in yardage (2,379) in Blue Devil annals. He supplemented his collegiate experience with a pair of NFL internships, including stints with the Washington Redskins (summer 2001) and Miami Dolphins (summer 2002). Hill was involved with receivers and special teams in both internships. Hill owns two degrees from Florida, including a bachelor's degree in exercise and sport sciences and a master's degree in leisure/sports management. He and his wife, Shanae, were married on July 4, 2008. He has a 16-year-old daughter, Destini.

TAKIN IT AWAY

► The University of Miami has always taken pride in creating turnovers. Since 2001, the Hurricanes have created at least 20 turnovers every season, including a national-high of 45 in 2001. During that seven-year span, the Hurricanes rank seventh nationally with 201 turnovers (28.7 per season).
