MIAMI AND NORTH FLORIDA MEET FOR FIFTH TIME

Miami and North Florida have a relatively brief all-time series, with the programs meeting four times since 2007 (UNF moved up to Division I in 2005). UM has won each of the previous four, including all three contested at the Watsco Center.

The teams played last November in Jacksonville, with the Hurricanes rolling to a 94-56 victory. Jim Larrañaga is 2-0 in his career against UNF.

A LOOK BACK AT THE 2016 MEETING

Five Hurricanes scored in double figures as Miami scored a 94-56 win at UNF Arena on Nov. 16. 2016.

Davon Reed led UM with 17 points, while Ja'Quan Newton added 16 and Dewan Huell 15. DJ Vasiljevic (13) and Anthony Lawrence (10) also reached double figures.

UM bolted to a 48-20 halftime advantage and led by as many as 48 points in the second half. The Canes shot 54.4 percent, while limiting UNF to 34 percent from the field.

STRENGTH VS. STRENGTH

The Saturday game matches Miami's stout defense against North Florida's potent offense.

UNF averages 78.6 points per game, while Miami yields just 51.2 per contest.

UNF's season low in scoring is 66; the Hurricanes have not allowed an opponent to crack the 60-point barrier.

SEARCHING FOR 5-0

Miami is seeking its second 5-0 start under Jim Larrañaga. The 2014-15 squad started 8-0.

This is the fourth straight year the Hurricanes have started 4-0 and the fifth time in seven years under Larrañaga.

BALANCE ON OFFENSE

Miami put at least five players in double figures in scoring in each of its first three games. The Hurricanes had three such games in 33 contests in the entire 2016-17 season.

Three players are averaging 10 points or more through the first three games, and Dewan Huell is the lone Hurricane to hit for double figures in each of the first four contests.

Eight Miami players are averaging at least 6.0 points per game, while the Hurricanes are shooting an even 50 percent as a team despite a tough shooting night Wednesday against La Salle.

DJ BOUNCES BACK AFTER SLOW START

After going 2-for-12 from the field in the season opener, including 1-for-10 from 3-point range, DJ Vasiljevic has rebounded nicely. The sophomore shot 14-for-29, including 9-for-18 from 3-point range, over the past three games.

Vasiljevic is averaging 11.5 points per game while making the first four starts of his career.

DEFENSE SOLID THROUGH THREE GAMES

Miami's defense has come out of the gates strong, limiting its opponents to 51.2 points per game and 33.8 percent shooting (both are best in ACC).

After holding La Salle to 0-for-15 shooting from 3-point range Wednesday, the Hurricanes are limiting their opponents to 22.1 percent shooting from 3-point range (best in ACC).

Miami's defense has recorded three scoreless stretches of five-plus minutes, including two in the opener against Gardner-Webb and one versus Florida A&M.

HOLDING OPPONENTS UNDER 60

Miami has limited four straight opponents to fewer than 60 points. That marks the second time that has happened in the Jim Larrañaga era.

The other was a six-game stretch from Dec. 25, 2012 to Jan. 16, 2013.

UM is 72-9 in seven seasons under Larrañaga when limiting its opponents to fewer than 60 points.

PLAYING WITH THE LEAD

Miami has played from ahead for the vast majority of the first four games.

The Hurricanes have led for 130 minutes, 58 seconds of the 160 minutes thus far (82 percent). UM has trailed for just 18:03.

Miami has yet to trail in the second half this season

HUELL OFF TO BIG START IN THE POST

Sophomore center Dewan Huell has started the season well and leads the team in scoring at 13.5 points per game. He averaged 5.8 per game last year.

He scored a career-best 16 points on 8-of-10 shooting Wednesday against La Salle.

Huell scored in double figures in each of the first four games and recorded his first career doubledouble on Nov. 12, matching a career high with 10 boards.

He is averaging 7.5 boards per game and has at least five rebounds in each game this year.

NOTING THE LA SALLE GAME

Miami held La Salle without a 3-point field goal, the first time in the Jim Larrañaga era that Miami shut out an opponent from 3-point range (0-for-15).
Both teams struggled offensively: Miami shot a

season-low 36.7 percent, but held La Salle to 28.8 percent shooting, including 0-for-15 from 3-point range. • The teams each shot 23 percent and played to a 19-19 stalemate at halftime.

• Dewan Huell scored a career-high 16 points, topping

his previous high of 15, set last season at North Florida. • Anthony Lawrence II set a career high with 10 boards and tied his career highs in assists (5) and blocks (3).

• Bruce Brown Jr. matched a season and career best with 11 rebounds.

• After redshirting last season and missing the first three games this year with an injury, Sam Waardenburg made his college debut Wednesday. He scored seven points in 13 minutes.

CANES AS A RANKED TEAM

The Hurricanes are ranked No. 11 in the Associated Press and USA TODAY Coaches polls, released Monday. As a ranked team under Jim Larrañaga, Miami is 46-18 overall.

Miami has been ranked in five of Larrañaga's seven seasons at The U, topping out at No. 2 in both polls on Feb. 18, 2013.

When ranked, Miami is 24-12 against ACC opponents in Larrañaga's six seasons, including a 16-2 mark at home and 8-10 on the road.

CANES LOOK FOR 70 POINTS

Miami has eclipsed the 70-point plateau in three of its four games this year, all wins by large margins.

Last season Miami was 17-1 overall and 8-1 in ACC play when scoring 70+ points.

UM is 58-11 when scoring 70 or more points under Jim Larrañaga.

LUCKY SEVENS FROM LONG RANGE

Miami has connected on at least seven shots from long range in 124 of Larrañaga's 211 games at UM, including the first three games in 2017-18. The Canes are 96-28 when making at least seven from 3-point range. Last season, Miami was 11-5 when hitting seven from behind the arc.

Previous seasons: 2015-16: 17-3; 2014-15: 18-5; 2013-14: 9-6; 2012-13: 19-3; 2011-12: 19-6.

Miami is averaging 8.25 3-pointers per game this season.

BROWN JOINS ELITE TRIPLE-DOUBLE COMPANY

Bruce Brown, Jr. started off his sophomore season with a great all-around performance against Gardner-Webb, recording his second career triple-double, the third in school history and the 31st in ACC history.

Brown became just the sixth player in the league's storied history to earn a pair of triple-doubles.

He reached the status at the 5:36 mark of the second half with a field goal for his ninth and 10th points.

As part of the opener, Brown matched his career high in assists and fell one shy of his high in rebounds.

MORE HONORS FOR BROWN

Bruce Brown, Jr. added a pair of early-season honors in the recently, as he was named to the watch list John L. Wooden Award as well as the Citizen Naismith Trophy Top 50.

In the preseason, Brown was named to the Preseason All-ACC Second Team. He aslo was lauded nationally on the watch lists for the Citizen Naismith Trophy, Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award, Lute Olson National Player of the Year Award and the Oscar Robertson Trophy.

After a standout freshman campaign, Brown started his 2017-18 season with a bang, recording a tripledouble in the opener against Gardner-Webb.

BEST PRESEASON RANKING IN PROGRAM HISTORY

Ranked in the preseason polls for the first time since 2008-09, Miami was No. 13 in the preseason Associated Press poll. It marked the highest preseason AP ranking in program history. Miami also was No. 12 in the USA Today Coaches poll.

It is the third occasion in which Miami is among the top 25 teams to start the season. The Canes were ranked No. 25 prior to the 1999-2000 campaign and No. 17 heading into the 2008-09 season.

THE WATSCO ADVANTAGE

Miami has defended its home turf well in recent years, winning 30 of its last 32 games at the Watsco Center. The Hurricanes went 14-2 at home last year and are 80-22 (.784) under Jim Larrañaga.

In the first 16 years at the Watsco Center (formerly BankUnited Center), Miami is 175-66 (.726).

In seven seasons under Larrañaga, Miami is 42-7 in non-conference play and 38-15 in ACC action at home. In both 2012-13 and 2015-16, the Canes had just one loss at Watsco Center.

Miami has won 14 straight home non-conference games, dating to a 78-77 loss to Northeastern on Nov. 27, 2015.

WHO'S BACK

The Hurricanes welcome back 10 players from their 2017 NCAA Tournament squad, including starters Bruce Brown, Jr., Anthony Lawrence II and Ja'Quan Newton. In all, Miami returns six players who averaged double-figure minutes.

Newton averaged 13.5 points and 31.4 minutes per game last year and has made 95 career appearances. After a standout rookie season, Brown (11.8 ppg, 5.6 rpg, 31.9 mpg) is back, as is Lawrence (6.8 ppg, 3.8 rpg, 26 mpg).

Miami also returns Dejan Vasiljevic, Ebuka Izundu and Dewan Huell, each of whom averaged at least 13 minutes per game last year. Izundu and Huell are the Canes' top returning post threats, while Vasiljevic averaged six points in 17 minutes per game off the bench.

CANES WELCOME STRONG CLASS OF ROOKIES

Miami added three high-touted newcomers this year in Deng Gak, Chris Lykes and Lonnie Walker IV. Each was an ESPN Top 100 recruit last season.

A 2017 McDonald's All-American and consensus top-20 recruit, Walker IV was among 20 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2018 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award.

Walker recently was tabbed the "most exciting freshman in America" by ESPN.com's Myron Medcalf.

Lykes was ESPN's No. 45 recruit, while Gak was rated No. 91. Gak is expected to redshirt this season.

ACC PRESEASON POLL

Miami is ranked fourth in the 2017-18 ACC Coaches Preseason Poll, the Hurricanes' highest standing in the poll in Jim Larrañaga's seven years at the helm and matching their highest at any point during their 14 years in the ACC (fourth in 2008-09).

In each of Larrañaga's first six seasons, Miami finished the year in a higher standing than their preseason rank.

Miami followed Duke, North Carolina and Notre Dame in the preseason poll.

2017-18 ROSTER HAS SIX TOP-100 RECRUITS

Miami signed three ESPN Top 100 recruits for the class of 2017, including No. 18 Lonnie Walker from Reading, Pa., No. 46 Chris Lykes from Mitchellville, Md., and No. 92 Deng Gak from Blairstown, N.J.

The trio joins former ESPN Top 100 Hurricanes Bruce Brown (No. 26 in 2016), Dewan Huell (No. 28 in 2016) and Ja'Quan Newton (No. 58 in 2014) in the fall of 2017. In just seven seasons at The U, Larrañaga has recruited six of Miami's 11 ESPN Top 100 players since 2007.

MIAMI EARNS HIGH GSR NUMBERS

Miami's men's basketball team posted an exemplary Graduation Success Rate (GSR), in the latest numbers released on Nov. 8 by the NCAA. Miami recorded a 92 percent GSR, which is based on the four entering classes from 2007-08 through 2010-11.

In addition, the Miami football (83 percent), women's basketball (92 percent) and baseball (83 percent) programs all posted GSR totals above the NCAA average.

The NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was developed in response to college and university presidents suggesting that graduation data more accurately reflect the mobility among college students today. The GSR measures graduation rates at Division I institutions and includes students transferring into the institutions. The GSR also allows institutions to subtract student-athletes who leave their institutions prior to graduation as long as they would have been academically eligible to compete had they remained.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

Miami lost a pair of 2016-17 starters to graduation – guard Davon Reed and forward Kamari Murphy.

A 2017 Third-Team All-ACC honoree, Reed led the Hurricanes in scoring at 14.9 points per game while averaging a team-high 35.3 minutes per game. Reed was selected No. 32 overall by the Phoenix Suns in the second round of the 2017 NBA Draft, the 20th player in program history to be drafted.

Playing in 131 career games (99 starts), Reed scored 1,343 points, good for No. 16 on the Hurricanes' all-time scoring list.

The 6-foot-8, 220-pound Murphy was a force in the middle, averaging 7.1 points and 7.3 rebounds per game.

They were the lone teammates on the 10-man list. Brown and Walker were listed 12th and 13th, respectively on ESPN's top 100 draft prospects for 2018, as Miami was one of 13 college teams to have multiple players on the list.

VASILJEVIC LOOKS TO BUILD ON BIG SUMMER

Sophomore guard Dejan Vasiljevic had a strong summer playing internationally with Australia's Emerging Boomers at the World University Games in Taipei.

The Melbourne native averaged 21.5 points a game on 45.3 percent shooting from the field in eight games in the tournament.

Vasiljevic scored 20-plus points and led the team in scoring in five of the eight games as the Emerging Boomers finished ninth in the field.

He closed out play with a 28-point performance in a 101-96 win over Canada.

SCHEDULE NOTES

Miami has a dozen games scheduled against eight programs that competed in the 2017 NCAA Tournament, with potential matchups with four more in the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic.

Miami travels to face Minnesota in the Big Ten-ACC Challenge on Nov. 29 and comes back to play Princeton in the Hoophall Miami Invitational on Dec. 2 at American Airlines Arena.

Miami plays six ACC opponents (10 games total) that competed in 2017 NCAA Tournament, including reigning national champion North Carolina.

Miami competes in the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic Dec. 22-25, opening with the host, Hawaii. The 2017 edition of the classic features a great field with five NCAA tournament participants from the past season in Miami, Middle Tennessee, New Mexico State, Princeton and USC.

COACHING COORDINATORS

Miami's assistant coaching staff is set up in a coordinator system. Jamal Brunt serves as the offensive coordinator, while Chris Caputo handles the defense. Adam Fisher manages the scout for every opponent.

MILES WILSON JOINS MIAMI PROGRAM

Jim Larrañaga added Miles Wilson to the Hurricanes' incoming class of 2017. A 6-foot-5-inch transfer from Mount St. Mary's, Wilson will sit out the 2017-18 season because of NCAA transfer rules, then have three years of eligibility with the Hurricanes.

Wilson averaged 11.8 points per game and 3.9 rebounds in 28.9 minutes per game and was named to the Northeast Conference All-Rookie Team.

In the NCAA Tournament's First Four, Wilson scored 17 points and grabbed 11 rebounds in a 67-66 win over New Orleans before recording a game-high 22 points with seven rebounds against top-seeded Villanova.

CANES SEEK ANOTHER 20-WIN CAMPAIGN

Jim Larrañaga has posted five 20-win seasons in his first six years at The U and 11 career 20-win seasons. The 21-win campaign in 2016-17 was Miami's eighth 20-win season since joining the ACC for the 2004-05 campaign. Larrañaga is just the second coach in Miami history with five 20-win seasons, joining Bruce Hale (1954-67).

The Canes won seven or more ACC games in each of Larrañaga's first six seasons and have had 10 or more league victories in four years. Prior to Larrañaga's arrival, Miami had never won 10 ACC games in a season.

LARRAÑAGA 12TH IN WINS AMONG ACTIVE **DIVISION I NCAA COACHES**

Entering the 2017-18 season, Jim Larrañaga ranks 12th in career wins among active Division I coaches with 609. Of those 12, five are in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, including four from the Atlantic Coast Conference.

Now in his 34th season as a head coach, Larrañaga ranks 47th in all-time NCAA victories.

In his career, Larrañaga won 27 games at American International, 170 at Bowling Green, 273 at George Mason and 139 at Miami. He is one of 15 coaches alltime with 100 or more wins at three D-I schools, four of whom are actively coaching.

LARRAÑAGA AND CAPUTO IN 16TH YEAR TOGETHER

Head coach Jim Larrañaga and associate head coach Chris Caputo are beginning their 16th season on sidelines together, dating back to their time at George Mason University.

Caputo started on Larranaga's staff as the video coordinator for the 2002-03 season, and along the way, the native of Elmhurst, N.Y., was an assistant coach and is now the associate head coach for the Hurricanes. Caputo helped the 2006 GMU team to the NCAA Final Four and has made five total NCAA Tournament appearances with Larrañaga.

Both Caputo and Larrañaga attended Archbishop Molloy (N.Y.) High School and played for legendary head coach Jack Curran.

SUCCESS FOR BOTH MIAMI BASKETBALL TEAMS

The Miami men's and women's basketball teams both landed in the NCAA Tournament for the second straight season in 2017, the first time both Miami basketball teams play in The Dance in consecutive years.

Miami was one of seven schools, four of which are in the ACC, with both its men's and women's basketball teams ranked in the preseason USA TODAY Coaches Poll. The others on the list were Baylor. Duke. Louisville, Notre Dame, UCLA and West Virginia.

2016-17 TEAM HIGHLIGHTS

• Miami played in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for the first time since going to three straight from 1997-98 to 1999-2000.

 The Hurricanes were one of two (Georgia Tech) unranked teams to defeat eventual national champion North Carolina last season. UM's 15-point victory over then-No. 9/6 UNC was the Tar Heels' worst defeat of the season.

 Miami defeated three ranked teams last season, downing No. 9/6 North Carolina, No. 10/11 Duke in Coral Gables and No. 18/19 Virginia on the road. This was the third straight year and the fifth time in Jim Larranaga's six seasons that the Canes defeated two top 15 teams.

• After receiving votes in at least one poll each of the first 16 weeks, Miami entered the national rankings for the first time in the 2016-17 season at No. 25 in both the AP and USA TODAY Coaches Poll on Feb. 27. • Miami won its third straight ACC-Big Ten Challenge matchup, defeating Rutgers in Coral Gables.

• Jim Larrañaga has posted five 20-win seasons in six years at The U and the Canes have won seven or more ACC games each season under Larrañaga. Former Hurricane guard Senior Davon Reed was the recipient of the ACC's 2017 Skip Prosser Award, presented annually to the top scholar-athlete in ACC men's basketball. Reed graduated in May with a degree in sports administration and double minors in communications and marketing.

• Bruce Brown Jr., who is majoring in sports administration, was named to the All-ACC Academic Team as a freshman.

• Brown recorded a triple-double with 11 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists against South Carolina State on Dec. 6. It was the second triple-double in program history at Miami

• Larrañaga recorded his 600th career win on Jan. 14 at Pitt. With 600 wins, he is one of five ACC coaches with 600 victories, and the other four men are in the Basketball Hall of Fame.
