Miami Set to Host 10th Annual Hurricane Invitational...

The University of Miami is set to host the 10th Annual Hurricane Invitational this weekend, Sept. 10-11, at the James L. Knight Sports Complex on the UM campus. The Hurricanes welcome three teams from Bethune-Cookman, FIU and the University of San Francisco.

Miami went 2-1 in last year's Hurricane Invitational, falling to the University of South Florida in the championship match. In 2008, UM went 3-0 to finish as tournament champions.

Miami enters the weekend working with a 7-1 record, winners of its last five matches. The 'Canes swept through last weekend's Blue Raider Bash at Middle Tennessee State, and defeated Florida Atlantic on Aug. 31, finishing 5-0 on the week.

The 'Canes are led offensively by junior outside hitter Lane Carico with 107 kills (3.34 per set), ranking her seventh in the Atlantic Coast Conference. Setter Katie Gallagher sets up the offense, having collected a league second-best 290 assists (10.74 per set). Meanwhile, senior

middle blocker Ariell Cooke leads the front line with 26 blocks (24 assisted), while sitting third on the squad in kills (64).

Defensively, Miami looks towards freshman libero Ryan Shaffer, as she sits eighth in the conference for digs with 119 (3.72 per set). Carico is behind her with 108 digs (3.38 per set), managing six double-doubles in eight matches this year. Dating back to last season, Carico has registered 14 double-double efforts (kills/digs) in her last 16 matches.

**Quick Hits on San Francisco...**

The USF Dons come into the *Hurricane Invitational* with an 0-6 overall record, with tough losses to Kansas, Washington State and UC Santa Barbara. The Dons are led on offense by Joan Coloiaro with 59 kills and 117 assists from her setter position. Malina Terrell owns 44 kills (2.10 per set) for the Dons, while Jordan Irish leads the team in blocks with 15 total (13 assisted). Defensively, USF is charged by Whitney Swain with a team-leading 94 digs (4.48 per set), as well as Caloiaro (60 digs).

The last time the Dons met the 'Canes was on Sept. 13, 2008 in San Francisco for the championship of the *Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational* hosted by the Dons. Miami won the match and the tournament title via the 3-2 victory.

**Quick Hits on Bethune-Cookman...**

The Bethune-Cookman Wildcats enter the weekend with a 1-8 record overall. The 'Cats have fallen to mostly in-state opponents, including touch

setbacks to FGCU, FAU and UCF. The 'Cats are led on offense by the play of Krysta Gardner with 68 kills (2.34 per set), followed by Linda Nwabuko with 51 kills (1.76 per set). The defense is paced by libero freshman Jennifer Jimenez (90 digs) and sophomore Jacqueline Woodyear (75 digs). The setter for B-CU is Alexis Bliese, leading the charge with 188 assists (6.71 per set).

**Quick Hits on FIU...**

FIU is now 2-4 on the season following a 1-2 showing at the *Iowa State Challenge*, where the Panthers defeated South Dakota State and fell to North Dakota State and No. 12 Iowa State. Senior Natalia Valentin continues to add to her FIU all-time assist leading total as she posted 124 assists across 12 sets of action to put her season total at 233 and her career total at 3,376. The setter posted her second double-double of the season with a season-high 59 assists and 13 digs versus South Dakota State and reached career-highs in kills (seven) and digs (20) against North Dakota State.

**UM Sweeps ACC Weekly Honors...**

Katie Gallagher was selected as this week's ACC Player of the Week, and rookie Alex Johnson was named this week's ACC Freshman of the Week.

Gallagher, a native Winter Park, Fla., started all 18 sets for the Hurricanes last week, averaging 12 assists and 2.28 digs per set from her setter position. She also tallied 15 kills while committing just one error in 32 attempts. Gallagher led the Hurricanes with 216 assists and ranked second on the team with a .438 attack percentage. Her 41 digs placed

her fourth on the team in that category, with the Lake Highland Prep alum adding nine blocks (eight assisted).

Johnson, a freshman from Tallahassee, Fla., has started in all eight matches for the Hurricanes thus far on the campaign. Last week, she hit at a .356 clip, averaging 2.56 kills and 2.50 digs per set. She played in all of the Hurricanes' 18 sets, tallying 10 blocks and six service aces. She had double-digit kills in three matches, and scooped up double-digit digs in two matches.

**Carico Nears 1,000 Kills...**

Just eight matches into her junior season, outside hitter Lane Carico is nearing another record-breaking performance in her career at UM. The Manhattan

# Nicole Lantagne Welch

Nicole Lantagne Welch is beginning her 10th season as head coach of the University of Miami volleyball program. Under her guidance since 2001, the team has posted winning records in seven of the

last nine seasons, including a second-place finish in the team's first year in ACC play in 2004.

In 2009, Lantagne Welch helped the Hurricanes to their second NCAA Tournament appearance, competing in the Gainesville [Fla.] Regional. UM earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after holding the 33rd toughest schedule in the nation according to the end-of-year RPI rankings. Earlier in the season, Lantagne Welch guided the Hurricanes to the Hampton Inn & Suites Northern Colorado Classic championship.

She would add to her growing list of All-Atlantic Coast Conference student-athletes, as well as All-America performers, seeing senior libero Cassie Loessberg and sophomore outside hitter Lane Carico named to both lists. Carico and Loessberg each collected AVCA All-America Honorable Mention selections, while both were tabbed to the AVCA All-East Region Team.

During the 2008 campaign, Lantagne Welch led the Hurricanes to a tie for third place in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) standings, and the team's best regular season record since 2002. During the year, Lantagne Welch collected her 150th career victory when the 'Canes defeated NC State, 3-0, on November 21, 2008. It was just two seasons ago that she posted her 100th career victory in the 2006 season-opener for UM with a 3-2 win over Alabama.



The 2008 season was special for UM as the team posted a record of 26-6 overall (14-6 ACC), finishing just one match shy of tying for an ACC Championship. Not to be overlooked was Lantagne Welch leading the 'Canes to three in-season tournament titles, including a tournament title at NCAA Tournament participant University of San Francisco as part of the Asics/Coca-Cola Invitational in San Francisco, Calif.

For those achievements and more, Lantagne Welch was tabbed ACC Coach of the Year, as well as American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) East Region Coach of the Year. It was her first ACC coaching honor, while being the second AVCA Regional honor, collecting the award in 2002 during Miami's historic run to the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament.

Under her guidance, Lantagne Welch would later see freshman Lane Carico named ACC Freshman of the Year, as well as AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico would go on to be named to the All-ACC Second Team, as well as teammates Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. Carico would represent the first-ever ACC Freshman of the Year coached by Lantagne Welch, while Ellis and Mayhew would become the seventh and eighth players in school history to be named to the All-ACC Volleyball Team.

Overall, her career at UM is highlighted in part by three seasons with at least 20 wins (2003-04, '08) and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in the Hurricanes' first-ever appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2002. In her nine years at the helm in Coral Gables, Lantagne Welch has averaged 18.8 wins per seasons with a career record of 169-100.

While new records were set during the 2007 campaign, the 2008 and 2009 seasons, respectively, saw even those achievements mastered as Lantagne Welch and her staff assembled one of the best marks in school history. Lantagne Welch led Miami to its best ACC record in school history. It was also the second-best record in school history on the Division I level of athletics.

Katie Gallagher moved in sole possession of second place all-time at UM for assists in a career during the 2008 season, while Cassie Loessberg would go on to become Miami's all-time leader in digs in 2009, departing from UM with 2,008 career digs. In addition, Loessberg broke her own school record from a year ago for digs in a single-season, upping the new record to 584—besting her old school-record mark by more than 20 digs.

Though missing most of the season due to injury, senior outside hitter Genny Mayhew became just the fifth Hurricanes performer in school history to collect 1,000 kills in her career. Mayhew departed from UM sitting fourth all-time in kills (1,018).

During the 2009 season, Maria Andersson and Lane Carico were selected to the All-ACC Academic Team, while helping UM to its second ever appearance to the NCAA Tournament [Gainesville Regional].

In 2008, Gallagher etched her name once again as one of the Top 10 single-season assists leaders in school history. Already sitting at third place in school history from the 2007 season where she collected 1,243 assists, Gallagher added to that total with 1,202 in 2008—good

enough for sixth place all-time in school history. Gallagher enters the 2010 season with 2,744 assists, still second all-time at UM for career assists.

Also during the 2008 season, Lane Carico broke the freshman record for kills in a single-season for UM with 369, adding her name to 10th all-time for single-season kills. In 2009, Carico went on to set a new sophomore record for kills in a season, putting down 402 for the year. Additionally in 2008, Miami tied a school-record for hitting percentage in a five-set match, collecting a .329 percentage at Florida State on Nov. 26, 2008. The 'Canes would also collect the second-best single-set hitting mark in school history with a .615 clip against Boston College in the third set on Oct. 10, 2008.

Lantagne Welch would see four more student-athletes graduate following the 2009 season. Maria Andersson, Cassie Loessberg, Genny Mayhew and Griffin Udelson earned their degrees from UM.

In 2008, Ashley Woods placed her name eighth all-time in sets played (367), as well as eighth place all-time in total attacks (1,764). Ellis now ranks ninth in attacks (1,209), while also collecting the third-highest individual single-season hitting percentage (.350) from the 2008 campaign. Overall, Ellis is third in school history in career hitting percentage with a .275 clip through 318 sets and 1,209 attacks. Woods is tied for fifth in career hitting percentage, holding a .256 clip, sitting alongside Ciara Michel (2004-07).

Lantagne Welch also coached three All-ACC Second Team members in 2008 with Lane Carico, Angelica Ellis and Genny Mayhew. In addition, Carico and Ellis were each named as AVCA All-America honorable mention, while Carico was selected the 2008 AVCA East Region Freshman of the Year. Carico was also the true definition of "student-athlete" as she was named to the All-ACC Academic Team.

Miami's team accomplishments under the guidance of Lantagne Welch in 2008 were plentiful as the Hurricanes posted the first-ever sweep of the Duke Blue Devils, as well as finishing in a tie for third place in the final league standings—the second-best finish for the Hurricanes in their ACC history. The 14-6 ACC record was the best conference record in Miami's five-year ACC volleyball history.

In 2002, she married Wesley Paul Welch of Denver City, Texas, in her hometown of Encinitas, Calif. On Dec. 7, 2004, the couple celebrated the birth of their daughter, Riley Jaye and on April 8, 2007, son Ayden Fletcher was born. Lantagne Welch and her family reside in Miami.

## Hurricanes VB Media Policy

### KNIGHT SPORTS COMPLEX

Press row for University of Miami volleyball matches is located on the north side of the court at the James L. Knight Sports Complex, across from the team benches. The media entrance to the arena is from the southwest corner of the Complex, and the southwest entrance is also used for Will Call pick-up of credentials. Parking is located in either the lot for Mark Light Field, or Cobb Stadium directly adjacent to the Knight Sports Complex.

### MEDIA & PHOTO PASSES

Credentials for Hurricanes home matches are issued for working media only and must be requested through the sports media relations office at least 24 hours prior to the selected home event you wish to attend. Credentials are issued on a match-by-match basis and a formal request must be issued to the Miami Sports Media Relations Office. Only photographers on assignment from an accredited media agency will be issued credentials. Photographers are required to abide by the guidelines set forth by the NCAA on shooting limitations from the sidelines. Those not complying with the guidelines may be removed.

### MEDIA SERVICES

Pregame media supplements including notes, statistics, media guides and gameday programs will be available prior to the start of the first set. Between-game and final statistics, plus a running play-by-play and post game notes will be provided. Final statistics will be emailed and/or faxed via Miami's broadcast system following the conclusion of the match. In-game questions or concerns can be addressed on press row by Assistant Sports Media Relations Director Bryan J. Harvey.

### WEBSITES

As a general rule, fan-based web sites containing at least one or more of the following: chat rooms, message boards, recruiting information, scouting reports and links to news sites, as well as other fan-based features shall not be issued credentials to Miami volleyball matches. Local and national organizations that maintain a news-based web site in connection with their regular newspaper or magazine, as well as radio or television broadcast, shall be issued credentials on a match-by-match basis. Live, real-time updates will not be permitted. Fan-based web sites wishing to discuss coverage and credential options should contact the Office of Sports Media Relations at (305) 284-3244.

### INTERVIEWS

Following home games, Miami head coach Nicole Lantagne Welch will return to the court to handle any media questions, and players will also be available after a brief cooling-off period following the match's conclusion. Miami's locker will be closed at all times.

### TELEPHONES

Telephone lines at the Knight Sports Complex are limited to home radio and the visiting teams' "official" sports administrator/media relations contact. All media wishing to file stories should contact Bryan J. Harvey prior to the conclusion of the match in order to make arrangements to be escorted back to the Office of Sports Media Relations in order to work in a work-friendly environment. Any and all questions will be addressed in this designated area.

Beach, Calif., native needs just 18 kills to surpass 1,000 kills in her career. If she accomplishes the task within the first 10 games this season, it would make Carico the third-fastest to achieve the honor—only Francheska Savage and Valeria Tipiana achieved the honor quicker in their careers.

### Two Former 'Canes Playing Pro...

Two former Hurricanes teammates, Ashley Woods (2005-08) and Ciara Michel (2004-07), both signed professional contracts in 2010, adding to the growing list of players to play professionally from UM.

Woods played with Club Voleibol in Benidorm, Spain, finishing her UM career ranked in the top 10 in seven categories. Meanwhile, Michel recently signed a contract taking her talents to Alemannia Aachen, a member of Germany's 14-team national first league, Bundesliga. At UM, Michel established herself sixth all-time in kills (962), seventh in total attempts (1,993) and 10th in kills per set (2.24).

### Recapping the 'Canes Last Match...

The University of Miami volleyball team finished the Blue Raider Bash a perfect 4-0 on Sunday, taking down host Middle Tennessee State, 3-1, inside Alumni Memorial Gymnasium in Murfreesboro, Tenn.

UM won its fifth consecutive match as a result of Sunday's victory, using three players in double-digits for kills, including a double-double effort from junior outside hitter Lane Carico.

Miami was led offensively by Carico's double-double effort (14 kills, 14 digs) and three service aces. Williamson and McGee each claimed 12 kills in the match, with McGee striking at a .346 clip (12k-3e-26ta). Gallagher setup the Hurricanes' offense with a match-high 47 assists, pitching in three kills, nine digs and three blocks (two assisted). Williamson also added three assisted blocks.

The UM defense was charged by freshman libero Ryan Shaffer with 10 digs, and it was the play of fellow freshman Johnson providing five kills, six digs and two block assists.

### UM Present on All-ACC Preseason Team...

Junior outside hitter Lane Carico and senior middle blocker Lici McGee were named to the Preseason All-ACC Team representing the Hurricanes. McGee had a breakthrough season in 2009, ending the year ranked seventh in the league in blocks (117), while finishing second on the UM squad for total points (312) with 371 kills added to her 117 total blocks. Meanwhile, Carico led the ACC in kills (506), while leading UM in kills per set average (4.36). She currently holds records for kills in a single-season by both a freshman – finishing with 369 in 2008, and a sophomore with her total from the 2009 campaign.
