BOSTON COLLEGE VS. MIAMI - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game marks the 51st meeting between the two schools.
- The Eagles hold a 26-24 lead in the all-time series.
- In ACC regular season play, BC is 9-15 versus the Hurricanes.
- Last season, BC earned a 64-57 win at home on Feb. 17, 2019.
- Six of the last seven games between BC and Miami have been decided by seven points or fewer.
- The margin of victory in the last four games is a total of 11 points - including two one-point wins for UM and a two-point victory by BC.
- From 1989-2004, both schools were members of the Big East.
- BC compiled a 15-6 mark vs. the U during that span.
- The Eagles are 11-13 all-time in Coral Gables.

BOSTON COLLEGE IN ACC PLAY

- Boston College is 87-162 in 13 seasons in the ACC.
- BC started 2-0 and 3-1 in ACC play for the first time since 2010-11.
- The Eagles have surpassed its ACC win total from a season ago.
- BC finished with a 5-13 record in ACC play in 2018-19.
- The 11th-place finish a year ago was its best finish since 2012-13.
- BC's best ACC mark came in its inaugural season, going 11-5 in conference play in 2005-06 en route to a third place finish.
- BC also tied for third in 2006-07 (10-6) and finished fourth in 2010-11 (9-7).

STEFFON MITCHELL'S HISTORIC STAT LINE AT VIRGINIA TECH

- Steffon Mitchell posted a historic stat line in the overtime win at Virginia Tech on Feb. 8.
- Mitchell tied his career-highs with 21 points and 15 rebounds, while dishing out a season-high six assists.
- The Shakopee, Minn. native was 5-of-10 from the floor (2-4 3FG) and 9-of-11 from the foul line.
- The 6-8 forward also notched two blocked shots and a steal in a season-high 43 minutes of play.
- Mitchell's stat line was the only one of its kind against a Division I opponent this season and the best in the ACC in 20+ years.
- The last player to post a stat line of 21 points/15 rebounds/6 assists/2 blocks/1 steal in an ACC game: Tim Duncan.
- The Big Fundamental posted 21 points/23 boards/6 dimes/3 swats/1 steal in a 66-60 win over Virginia on Feb. 22, 1997.

DERRYCK OVER THE LAST FOUR

- Derryck Thornton is averaging 16.0 ppg over his last four games - the second-highest four-game scoring stretch of the season.
- The grad transfer guard had his third 20-point performance of the season, scoring 21 points vs. Duke on Feb. 4.
- Thornton is 23-of-27 from the foul line over the last four games, good for 85.2% from the charity stripe.

TODAY'S BOSTON COLLEGE NOTE(S) YOU CAN'T LIVE WITHOUT

- Boston College has improved by over 30 points on the KenPom rankings this month, from 172 on Feb. 1 to 147 today.
- Steffon Mitchell is .04 assists/game shy of qualifying for the ACC's assist/TO ratio rankings. His 1.84:1 mark would rank 10th.
- The Feb. 8 win at Virginia Tech was the first overtime game of the season and BC's first OT win since Feb. 4, 2018 (vs. GT).
- In both games vs. Virginia Tech this season, Boston College overcame a double-digit first half deficit to comeback with the win.

ON THIS DATE: FEBRUARY 12

- Boston College is 12-8 overall and 2-1 in ACC play all-time in games played on February 12.
- February 12 marks the celebration of National Plum Pudding Day.
- On this day in history on February 12 - 1873: Congress passes the Coinage Act, establishing the gold standard; 1876: Al Spalding opens his sporting goods shop; 1909: The NAACP forms; 1914: The Lincoln Memorial dedicated in Washington, D.C.; 1924: Gershwin's "Rhapsody in Blue" premieres; 1950: Sen. Joseph McCarthy claims to have list of Communist government officials; 1958 & 1961: Bill Russell grabs 41 and 40 rebounds against Syracuse and Philadelphia, respectively; 1999: President Bill Clinton acquitted by the Senate in his impeachment trial.
- Notable February 12 birthdays: U.S. President Abraham Lincoln; NBA Hall of Famer Bill Russell; biologist Charles Darwin; actress Christina Ricci; rapper Gucci Mane; singer Michael McDonald; and former First Lady Louisa Catherine Adams.

IS JAY HEATH THE BAROMETER?

- When Jay Heath scores 15 points or more this season, Boston College is 7-2.
- In those games, Heath is shooting 51.0% (51-100) from the floor, including 26-of-53 from 3-point land (49.1%).
- When the freshman guard scores at least 16 points, Boston College is 6-2 and 4-0 when he scores 17 or more.

JAY DOT BUCKETS

- Among all ACC freshmen, Jay Heath ranks second in scoring (12.6 ppg), tied for second in 3FG made (43), third in 3FG% (.384), fourth in assists (47), and second in steals (34).
- Entering the Dec. 10 game vs. Albany, Jay Heath ranked fourth nationally among freshman in 3FG% (21-42; 50.0%)
- Over his last six games, Jay Heath is 15-33 from the 3-point line. Prior to that, he made 11-43 3FG over his previous nine.
- Earlier this season, Heath knocked down 5-of-7 from deep versus Eastern Washington.
- The last BC freshman to make five 3-pointers in a game: Ky Bowman (5) vs. Notre Dame on Feb. 14, 2017.
- Heath has scored in double figures in 18 of the 23 games in which he has appeared.
- The D.C. native has scored a season-best 18 points in the season-opening win over Wake Forest and at Virginia Tech.
- He scored 18 points, grabbed five rebounds, and logged four assists in his collegiate debut vs. Wake Forest.
- The last BC freshman to tally that stat line in his first collegiate game - Jerome Robinson vs. St. Francis N.Y. on Nov. 14, 2015.
- Robinson - a 2018 lottery pick of the L.A. Clippers - had 19 points, six boards, and five dimes in his college debut.

TRENDING: JAIRUS HAMILTON

- Jairus Hamilton poured in a career-high 23 points on Jan. 25 in a home win over Virginia Tech.
- The sophomore forward connected on 7-of-11 shots from the floor, including a career-best five 3-pointers (5-7 3FG).
- He scored 15 of his 23 points in the second half - 12 of those 15 points came over the final 5:49 of play.
- He grabbed a season-best eight rebounds in 32 minutes of play vs. the Hokies.
- Hamilton posted three straight double-digit scoring performances - Pitt, VT, Louisville - for the first time in his career.
- Over his last five games, Hamilton is averaging 11.6 points per game.
- From Jan. 22-25 - a two-game span - Hamilton connected on 76.5% from the floor (13-17) and 75% of his 3-pointers (6-8).
- He is the fifth player in the ACC this season to shoot 76.5% over a two-game span (min. 15 FGA).
- The last time an ACC player shot at least 76.5% and 75% from 3FG over two games: Keyshawn Woods (Wake Forest) in 2016.
- The last ACC player to shoot 76.5%/75% AND average 7.0 rebounds/game in two games: BC's Jared Dudley in 2007.

ALLOW ME TO RE-INTRODUCE MYSELF

- Graduate transfer Derryck Thornton has returned to the ACC to play his final season of eligibility.
- He is Boston College's leading scorer (13.0 ppg) and ranks 13th in the ACC in assists, averaging 3.5 assists per contest.
- His top three career scoring performances have come this season, including a career-best 23 points vs. Wake Forest.
- Overall, four of Thornton's top five and seven of his top 10 single-game scoring totals have come in a BC uniform.
- Thornton began his career at Duke in 2015-16, averaging 7.1 points, 1.8 rebounds, and 2.6 assists in 36 games (20 starts).
- The L.A. native played two seasons USC, averaging 6.0 points, 2.2 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and a 1.73:1 ATR in 57 games.
- His assist/turnover (2.22:1) ranked third and his assists average ranked sixth (4.3) in the Pac-12 in 2018-19.

STEFFON MITCHELL DOES IT ALL

This season...

- Steffon Mitchell leads BC in rebounding (8.7), steals (2.3), and blocks (1.0) per game, while ranking second in assists (2.9).
- He is the only player nationally to log 8.7 rebounds, 2.9 assists, 2.3 steals, and 1.0 blocked shots per game.
- Since 1996, only three other players have posted those per game averages throughout an entire season.
- Mitchell has led the team in rebounding in 18 games, steals 15 times, blocks on 14 occasions, and assists 10 times.
- He has posted five double-doubles this season, including career-high tying 21 points and 15 boards at Virginia Tech.
- He set a new career-high with six steals on Dec. 15 against Central Connecticut.
- In the ACC, he leads the league in steals and ranks fifth in rebounding (second in offensive rebounding - 3.26 OR/g).

For his career...

- Mitchell has led BC in at least one statistical category (scoring, rebounds, assists, steals, blocks) in 78 of his 84 career games.
- The 6-7 forward is the ACC's active rebounding leader, averaging 8.3 rebounds per game for his 84-game career.
- He ranks 27th among all active Division I players in rebounding average (8.3) and is 46th in total rebounds.
- Last year, he ranked fifth overall in the league (7.9 rpg). As a freshman, he ranked seventh in the conference (8.3 rpg).
- The Shakopee, Minn. native became the first true freshman in Boston College history to average better than 8.0 rpg.
- He has registered 10 or more rebounds in a game on 30 occasions. BC is 18-12 in those games.
- A skilled passer from the post, he is averaging 2.4 assists per game as well as a 2.14:1 assist/turnover ratio in his career.
- The point forward has dished out four or more assists on 23 occasions - BC is 17-6 in those games.

EAGLES POSTING NOTABLE ACC WIN MILESTONES IN 2019-20

- The six ACC victories so far this season surpassed the total from a season ago and is one away from the total in 2017-18 (7).
- BC swept a regular season series for the first time since 2013-14. In both instances, the Eagles took two from Virginia Tech.
- BC's three ACC road wins are the most since 2010-11, when the Eagles won three conference road games.

NOT THROWING AWAY HIS SHOT

- Jared Hamilton is having his best offensive season of his collegiate career.
- He ranks fifth on the team in scoring (8.1 points per game): 6.8 as a starter (eight games) and 9.0 as a sub (13 games).
- On Feb. 1 at North Carolina, Hamilton tied his season-high with 18 points, including the late game go-ahead free throws.
- It was his second game winning shot of the year - he hit the go-ahead 3-pointer in the 60-53 win over #18/18 Virginia on Jan. 7.
- He has scored in double-digits in seven of 18 games. BC is 7-0 when Hamilton scores 10 or more points.
- He is shooting 61.0% (36-59) from the floor and 11-of-18 (61.1%) in the seven games where he has scored in double digits.
- Twice he has scored 18 points - at North Carolina and in a home win over Central Connecticut.
- Hamilton's 17 3-pointers in 2019-20 are a career-high. He entered the season with nine career 3-pointers.

SHORTHANDED EAGLES AT WAKE

- On January 19 at Wake Forest, BC dressed seven scholarship players.
- Boston College was without four rotation players: rebounds/steals/blocks leader Steffon Mitchell (flu), fifth-leading scorer Jared Hamilton (ankle), starting forward Nik Popovic (back), and reserve guard Julian Rishwain (leg).
- Junior Luka Kraljevic made his first start of the season, tallying four points and four boards in 20 minutes of action.
- Freshmen Kamari Williams (24 min.) and Andrew Kenny (28 min.) - a recruited walk-on - saw season-highs in playing time.

POPOVIC RETURNS AFTER MISSING NINE GAMES

- Nik Popovic returned to the BC lineup at Pittsburgh after missing nine games due to injury (back).
- Popovic saw 30 minutes of action off the bench, finishing with 12 points, two rebounds, and a blocked shot.
- Prior to the injury, the senior forward ranked second on the squad in scoring (11.8) and rebounding (5.9).

HONEY, DO YOU THINK KFC'S STILL OPEN?

- Boston College has snapped several losing streaks so far this season.
- On Dec. 7, BC ended a 13-game slide overall - and 12-game streak in ACC play - vs. Notre Dame dating back to Feb. 8, 2005.
- Additionally, the win ended a streak of 11 losses at the Joyce Center that dated back to Jan. 11, 1997.
- Last time out, BC halted an 12-game losing streak vs. North Carolina, dating back to Feb. 1, 2010.
- Boston College also snapped similar streaks of six (Virginia) and five (Virginia Tech) this season.
- At current, BC's longest active losing streak is against Clemson (eight games).

HEATH ONE OF BC'S TOP FRESHMEN SCORERS

- With his 14-point performance at Wake Forest, Jay Heath reached the 200-point mark in his 17th game.
- Since 1990, only eight other BC freshmen have reached the 200-point mark through their first 17 games.
- Craig Smith did so in 10 games in 2003-04, while Troy Bell needed 11 games in 1999-2000.
- A season ago, Wynston Tabbs needed 15 games - same as Scoonie Penn in 1995-96.
- Olivier Hanlan (2012-13), Jared Dudley (2003-04) and Rakim Sanders (2007-08) needed 16; Ky Bowman (2015-16) took 17.

STEFFON MITCHELL HAD QUITE A WEEK

- Steffon Mitchell posted the most complete stat line among all Division I players from Dec. 9-15.
- During that week, he averaged 14.0 points, 12.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 5.5 steals per game in a 2-0 week for the Eagles.
- On Dec. 10 vs. Albany, Mitchell has his second double-double of the season, with 15 points, 13 rebounds to go with five steals.
- Against CCSU, he stuffed the stat sheet again, with 13 points, 12 boards, three assists, and a career-best six steals.
- Mitchell connected on just under 60% shooting from the floor (10-17), including 2-of-4 from the perimeter.
- In the 10 games prior to this past week, Mitchell was 3-of-13 from beyond the arc on the season.

- For close to a seven-minute stretch, Jared and Jairus Hamilton combined to score 15 consecutive points for Boston College.
- This went from the 5:08 mark in the first half - a jumper from Jared - to the 18:22 mark of the second half
- Jairus scored a career-high 18 points, including the go-ahead 3-pointer, en route to earning game MVP honors.
- Jared added 12 points - 10 coming in the first half.
- Jairus (vs. Cal) and Jared (vs. Virginia) are believed to be the only pair of brothers at the NCAA Division I level to play on the same team and each have a game-winning/go-ahead 3-pointer this season.

SWISH-RAIN

- On Dec. 21 versus Cal, Julian Rishwain tallied 10 of his 12 points during a key second-half run.
- He connected on 2-of-4 from beyond the arc and 4-of-7 from the floor in the Dec. 21 win in San Francisco.
- His best shooting night of the season came in BC's home game versus DePaul, knocking down 4-of-7 from beyond the arc.
- The 6-5 freshman guard tallied a season-best 15 points vs. the Blue Demons, adding 3-of-4 from the foul line.
- For the season, the freshman guard has connected on 21 3-pointers, shooting just under 35% from the perimeter.

BACKCOURT EFFICIENCY AT NOTRE DAME

- Derryck Thornton and Jay Heath combined for 35 points, five rebounds, five assists, and three steals at Notre Dame.
- Thornton (9-12; 1-1 3FG) and Heath (6-12; 4-6 3FG) combined to shoot 15-24 from the floor, including 5-7 from the perimeter.
- Jared Hamilton (6-8 FG; 1-1 3FG) and Julian Rishwain (2-3; 2-3 3FG) combined to shoot 8-11 from the field (3-4 3FG).

10/40 CLUB

- Three times this season, the Eagles have made 10 3FG in a game, connecting on a 40% clip from beyond the arc.
- On Nov. 23 at home against DePaul, Boston College made 10 3-pointers, making 41.7% (10-24).
- At Notre Dame, the Eagles drilled a season-best 11 3-pointers while making a season-high 47.8% of it long-range attempts.
- BC was 10-of-24 from the perimeter at Pittsburgh, good for a 41.7% percentage.

- Boston College moved to 8-15 all-time when facing the defending NCAA champion.
- The Eagles posted wins over CCNY (1/11/51), North Carolina (3/20/94; 1/25/06, 3/11/06; 2/20/10), Syracuse (3/11/04), Connecticut (1/5/05), and Virginia (1/7/20).
- It snapped a six-game losing streak vs. the Cavaliers, as the Eagles won its first game vs. UVA since March 3, 2013.
- The 60 points scored vs. Virginia were the most by BC since Jan. 19, 2011, in a 70-67 win at Conte Forum.
- It marked the first time this season that Boston College earned a win when trailing with 5:00 remaining in regulation.

ROOKIE RESERVES PLAY BIG OFF BENCH AT USF

- Julian Rishwain and CJ Felder combined for 21 points and seven boards off the bench in the win at USF.
- Both freshmen reached double-digits in the scoring column for the first time in their collegiate career vs. the Bulls on Nov. 10.
- Rishwain scored 11 points (3-6 FG; 1-3 3FG; 4-6 FT) while Felder had 10 (3-5 FG; 1-1 3FG; 3-3 FT).

THE DEFENSIVE HIGH POINT

- Boston College held High Point to the lowest scoring total by an opponent in Jim Christian's tenure - 33 points.
- The point total is the lowest by a BC opponent since holding NJIT to 32 points in Jan. 5, 2010.
- It ties as for the second-lowest points allowed since the 1946-47 season and is the second-lowest of the NCAA shot clock era.

- DeMarr Langford Jr. and Justin Vander Baan - have signed their National Letters of Intent to continue their academic and athletic endeavors at Boston College.
- Head coach Jim Christian: *"We are excited to announce that DeMarr and Justin have signed their national letters of intent. We welcome them and their families into our Boston College men's basketball family. They are outstanding young men with bright futures on and off the court. BC is a perfect fit for them, especially being Massachusetts natives, and they are perfect fits for our program."*
- Both Langford Jr. and Vander Baan play for the Mass Rivals AAU and head coach Vin Pastore. They are the first two student-athletes to sign with the Eagles from the storied grassroots basketball program.
- Langford Jr. - a 6-5, 195 lb. guard - is a consensus top 100 rated recruit from Brewster Academy.
- Vander Baan - a 7-0, 225 lb. center - is a consensus three-star recruit from Whitinsville Christian.

- The Eagles held Miami to 36.7 percent shooting on the night and just 4-of-26 shooting from three-point range.
- It marked the first time in ACC history that Boston College held opponents in consecutive games to less than 58 points.
- BC defeated Pitt 66-57 in its last game prior to tonight's 64-57 win over the Hurricanes.
- BC controlled the action throughout, leading for over 35 minutes and by as many as 14 in the second half.
- The Eagles held a 40-31 advantage on the glass for the game, including a 19-10 advantage with second-chance points.
- Boston College led 25-21 at halftime behind a strong first-half defensive performance.
- BC held Miami to 30 percent shooting from the field, including just 3-of-13 from behind the arc.

JIM CHRISTIAN THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Jim Christian enters his sixth season on the Heights in 2019-20. Named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Boston College in April, 2014, Christian has helped inspire a turnaround in the Eagles program on and off the court.

This past season, Christian led BC to its highest finish in the ACC standings in six years. The injury-added Eagles were 11th in the league despite having starters miss 40% of the season. Ky Bowman - the nation's most dynamic guard - ranked among the conference leaders in points, rebounds, assists, and 3-point shooting as he earned All-ACC second team honors. Bowman became Christian's second NBA

player in as many seasons, as he signed a deal with the Golden State Warriors.

In his six seasons at the helm of BC men's basketball, Jim Christian has recruited and developed five All-ACC honorees, the program's first-ever NBA Lottery Pick, and an Associated Press All-American.

In 2017-18, Christian helped guide BC to a 19-win season - the most victories since the 2010-11 season - and a return to the postseason. The Eagles' season was highlighted by a win over top-ranked Duke in December, a trip to the quarterfinals of the 2018 ACC Championship, and a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Under Christian's tutelage, Jerome Robinson became Boston College's fifth All-American and first-ever NBA Lottery Pick. Runner-up for 2017-18 ACC Player of the Year, Robinson was selected 13th overall in the first round by the Los Angeles Clippers. In his 13 seasons as a head coach, Christian has coached five All-Americans and 34 all-conference selections and has guided his teams to the postseason on nine occasions.

Christian and his staff developed one of the top scoring backcourts in the country in 2016-17. The duo of Jerome Robinson (17.4 ppg) and Ky Bowman (17.4) combined to average 34.8 points per game in ACC play which ranked fifth in the country among the major conferences. Robinson finished fourth in the conference in scoring (18.7) and earned All-ACC Honorable Mention accolades. Bowman was named to the All-ACC Freshman Team after averaging 14.3 points per game. He was also the only ACC freshman to rank in the top 10 in seven different categories in league play.

In his first season at Boston College, Christian guided guard Olivier Hanlan to First Team All-ACC and honorable mention All-America honors. Hanlan was the leading scorer in the ACC (19.5) which ranked 22nd in the country. He also led all major conference players in scoring average during league play (21.9). In addition, Hanlan led the ACC in 3-point percentage (.436). He was drafted by the Utah Jazz in the second round (42nd overall) of the 2015 NBA Draft.

Prior to moving to Chestnut Hill, Christian spent two seasons as head coach at Ohio, leading the Bobcats to a 49-22 record in that time. He is the Mid-American Conference's all-time leader in winning percentage (187-80, .700) and reached 20 wins in eight seasons as a head coach in the conference. His .731 winning percentage in league games (101-37) is second-best in MAC history. Christian also spent six seasons at Kent State from 2002-08.

In his first season at Ohio in 2012-13, the Bobcats went 24-10 and earned a bid to the NIT. Ohio captured the MAC regular season title - the school's first since 1994 - and tied the program record with 14 league wins and seven road victories. He was named the NABC District 14 Coach of the Year.

Ohio led the nation in assists per game (17.5) in 2012-13 and ranked seventh in the country in turnover margin (+4.7). Under Christian's guidance, guard D.J. Cooper ranked seventh in the nation in assists and was the first MAC Player of the Year from Ohio since 1995.

In 2013-14, the Bobcats went 25-12 and advanced to the quarterfinals of the College Insider Tournament. It was just the third time in school history that an Ohio team reached 25 wins.

Prior to his time at Ohio, Christian was the head coach at TCU from 2008-12. While in Fort Worth, he led the Horned Frogs to their first postseason appearance since 2005 when they played in the 2012 College Basketball Invitational.

He coached six All-Mountain West players while in Fort Worth, including guard Hank Thorns, Jr. - a first team All-MWC honoree who was the only player in the country to rank in the top 12 in both assists and assist/turnover ratio in 2010-11.

Christian began his head coaching career at Kent State where he compiled a record of 138-58 (.704). He led the Golden Flashes to five postseason appearances in his six seasons at the helm. He earned MAC Coach of the Year accolades in 2006 and 2008, both times leading Kent State to the conference title and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament. The Golden Flashes earned NIT berths in each of his first three seasons.

Kent State won at least 20 games every year with Christian at the helm. He guided the Golden Flashes to the program's first-ever top 25 ranking in both the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today polls. Kent was No. 23 on the Associated Press poll and 24 on the USA Today/Coaches poll, released on Feb. 25, 2008.

The 2007-08 season was one of the best in Kent State history. The Golden Flashes finished 28-7, including a school-record 25 regular season wins. Kent won both the MAC regular season and tournament championships and earned a program-best no. 9 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

While at Kent, Christian mentored two All-Americans (Antonio Gates, DeAndre Haynes), two MAC Players of the Year (DeAndre Haynes, Al Fisher), three MAC Defensive Players of the Year (Demetric Shaw, John Edwards, Haminn Quaintance), one MAC Sixth Man of the Year (Kevin Warzynski) and a total of 19 All-MAC selections, including six first teamers. Gates signed with the San Diego Chargers of the National Football League and has put forth one of the finest careers as a tight end in pro football history.

Christian served as an assistant coach at Kent State in 2001-02, when the program advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight. Prior to Kent, Christian was an assistant at four different programs.

While at Pittsburgh from 1996-99, Christian guided the development of Vonteego Cummings, a two-time All-Big East player who went on to play for the Philadelphia 76ers and Golden State Warriors. During the 1995-96 season, Christian was part of the Miami (Ohio) program that posted a 21-8 overall record - including a 12-6 mark in MAC play - en route to a trip to the NIT.

He served two stints as an assistant at Western Kentucky, including the highly-successful 1994-95 season in which the Hilltoppers went 27-4, including a 17-1 record in the Sun Belt Conference, en route to a conference championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. The 27 wins were the fourth-most in program history.

Christian's first full-time assistant coaching position came at St. Francis (Pa.) from 1992-94.

From 1999-2001, Christian was a college basketball talent evaluator at Octagon Sports Marketing and Management.

A native of Bethpage, N.Y., Christian was an all-state guard at St. Dominic High School while playing under Ralph Willard. Christian was recruited by Hall of Fame head coach Rick Pitino to Boston University where he played two seasons. Christian played his final two campaigns under Tom Penders at Rhode Island where he helped the Rams reach the Sweet Sixteen in the 1988 NCAA Tournament.

The standout guard led the Rams to victories over Missouri and Syracuse before losing a 73-72 game to Duke for the right to advance to the Elite Eight. After graduation, Christian spent one season playing professionally in Australia for the Sydney City Comets.

Christian earned his bachelor's degree in consumer affairs from the University of Rhode Island in 1988. He and his wife, Patty, have three children, MacKenzie, Zach and Jay.
